FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the combined doll and stand for teaching hair braiding showing my new design;

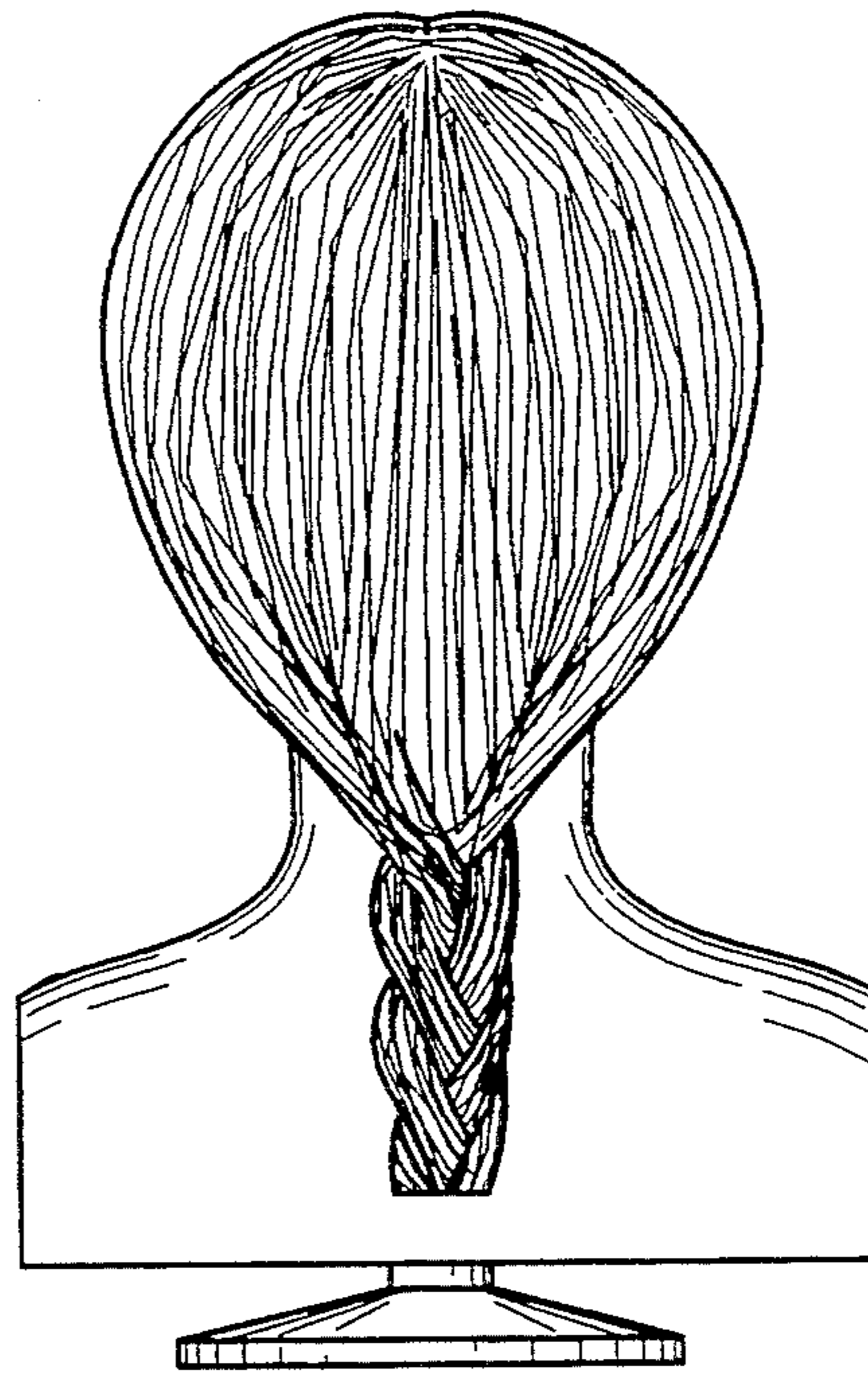
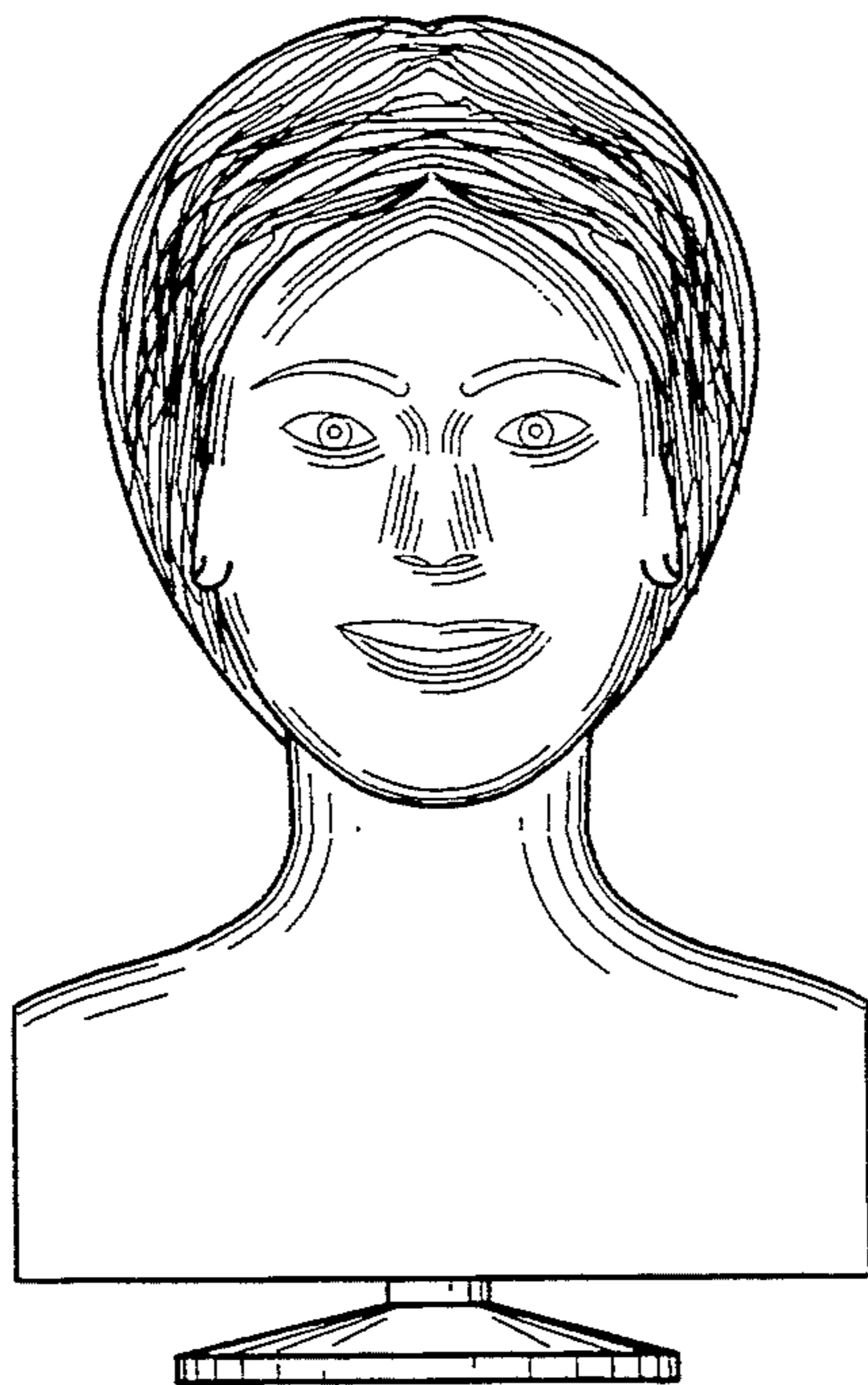
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

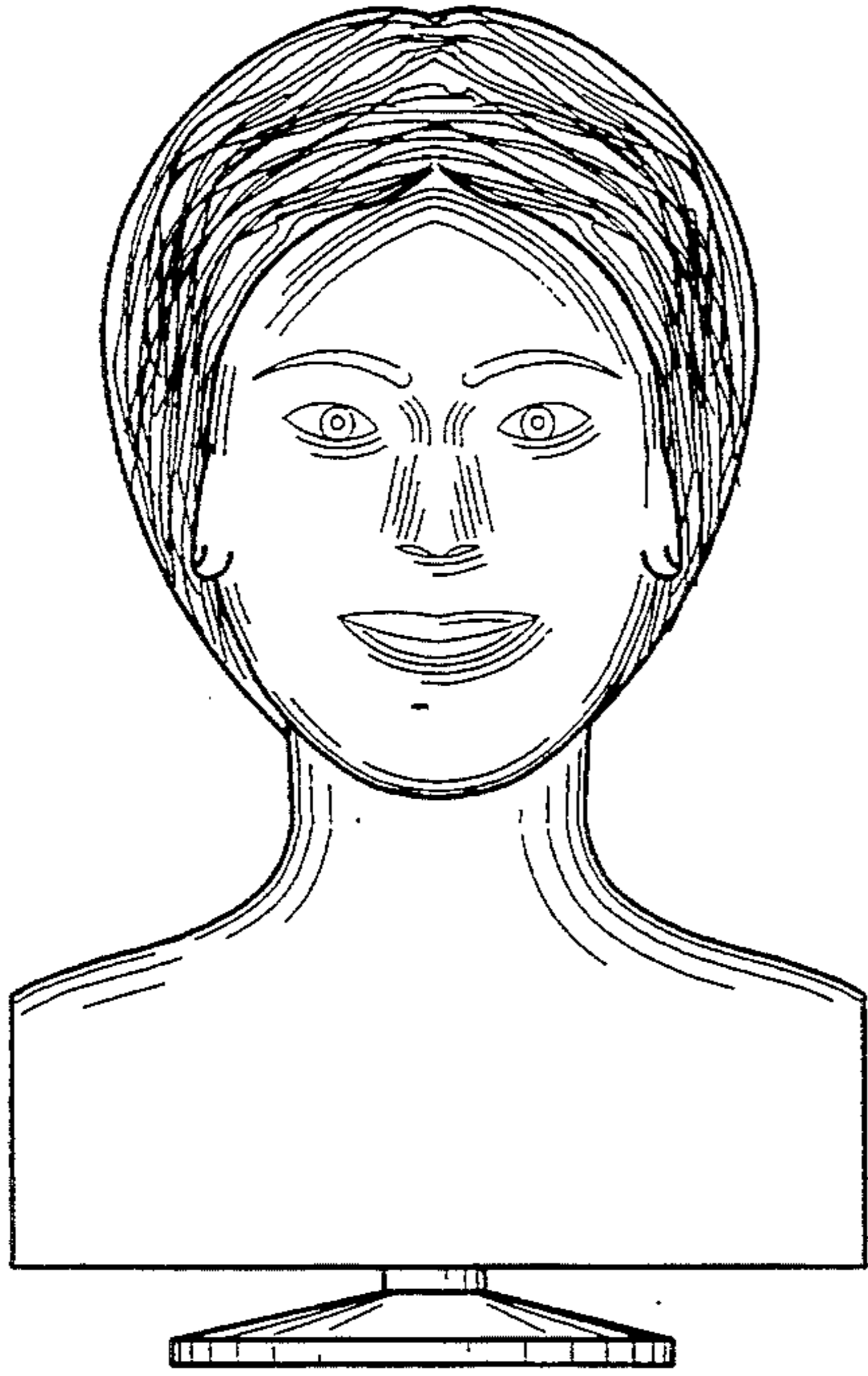
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

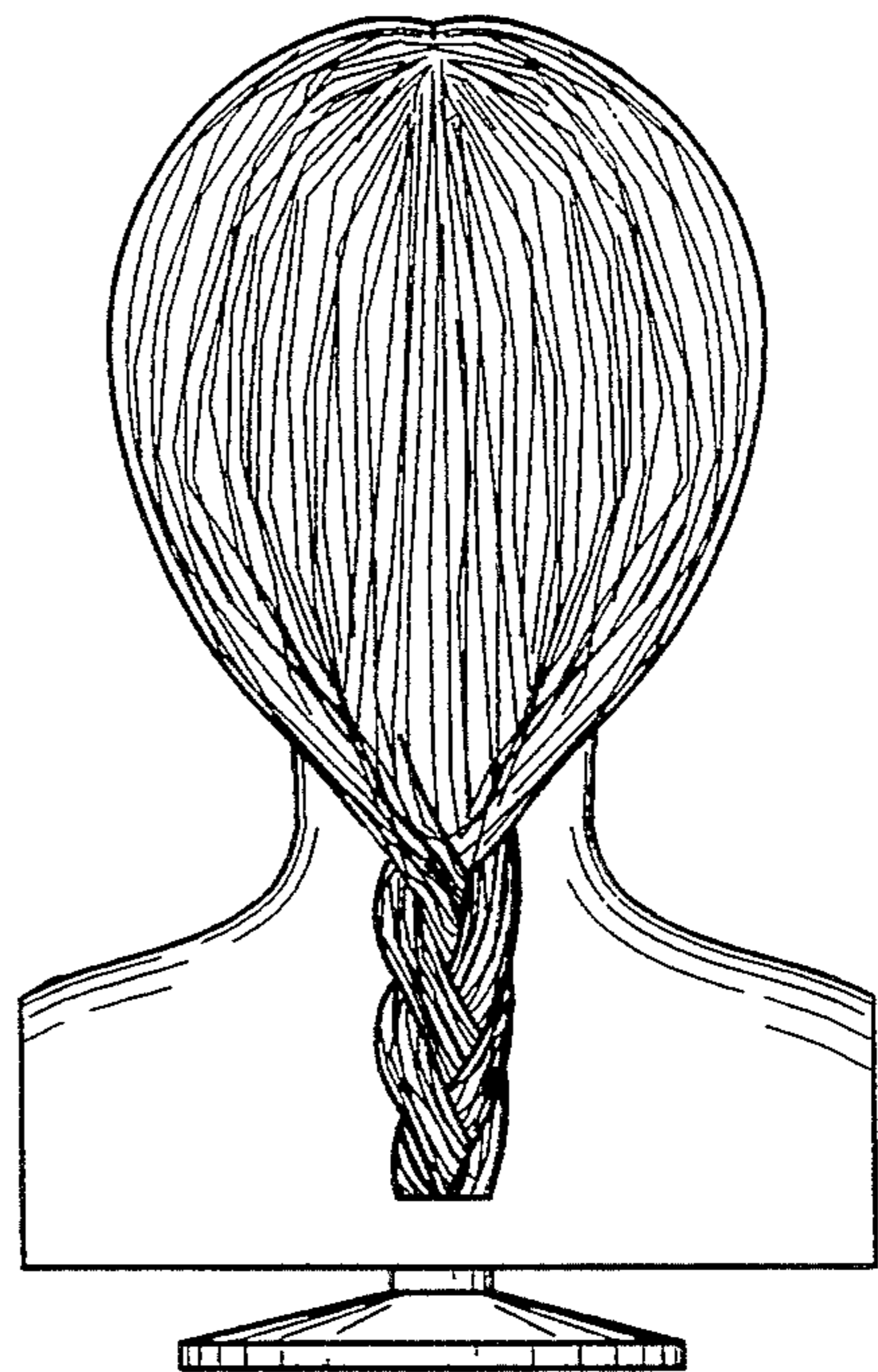

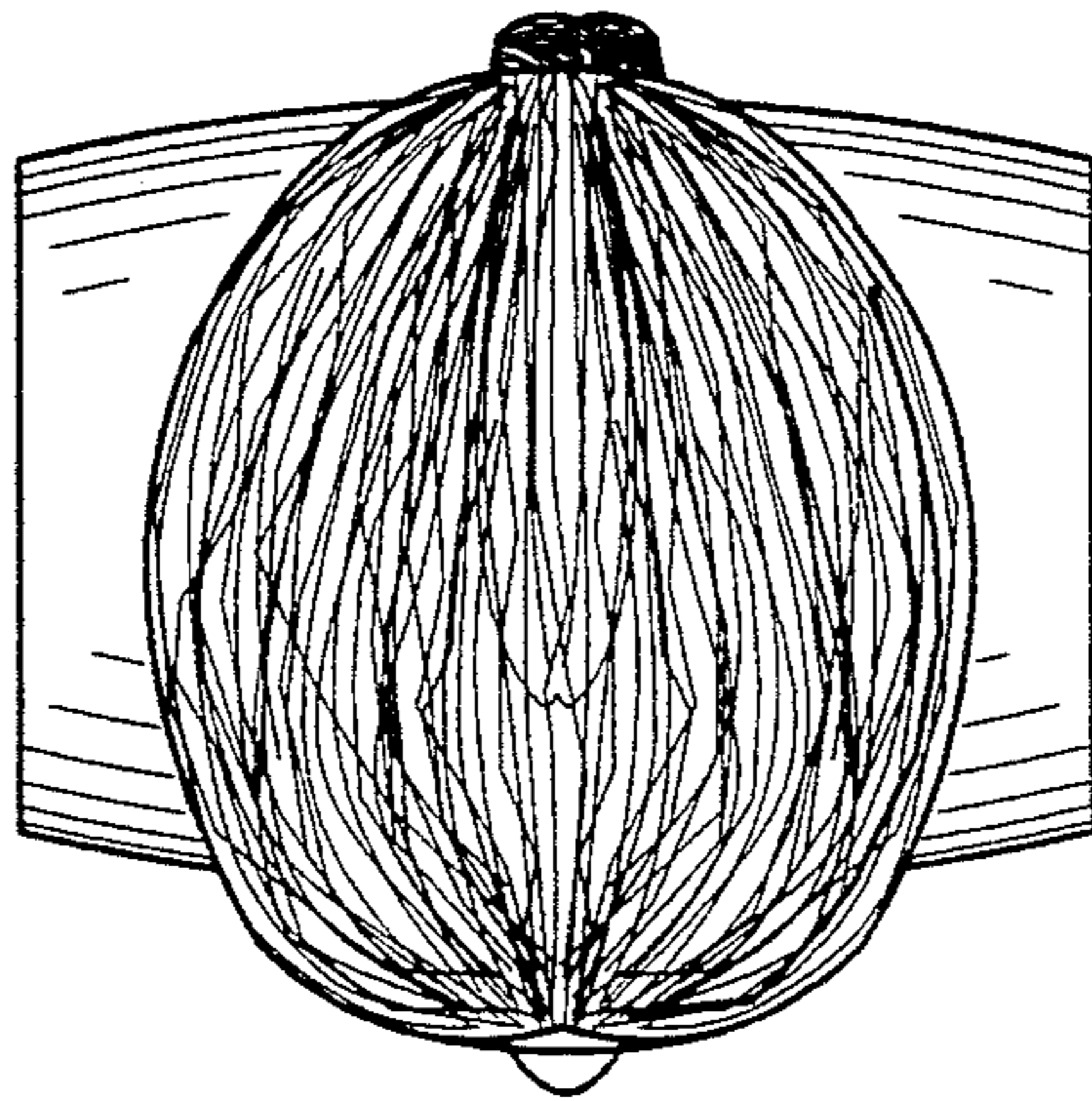
