[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for panel for cabinetry, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a panel for cabinetry showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and,  
FIG. 5 is a sectional view thereof, taken generally along line V—V of FIG. 2.  
The rear of the article is plain and unornamented.

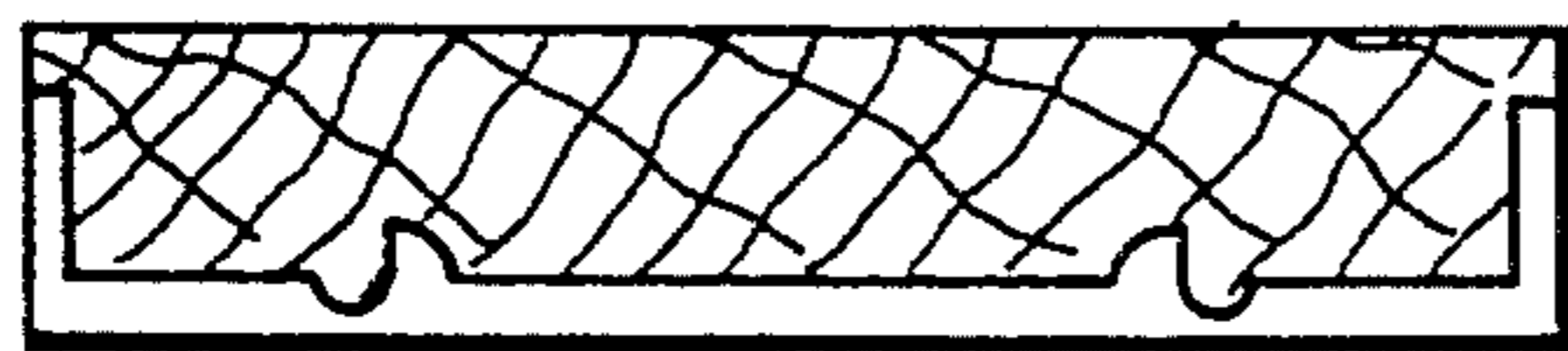

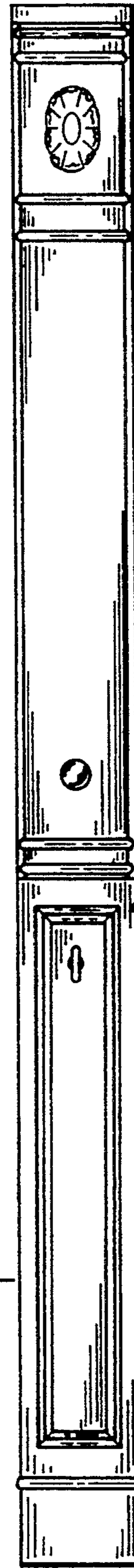
