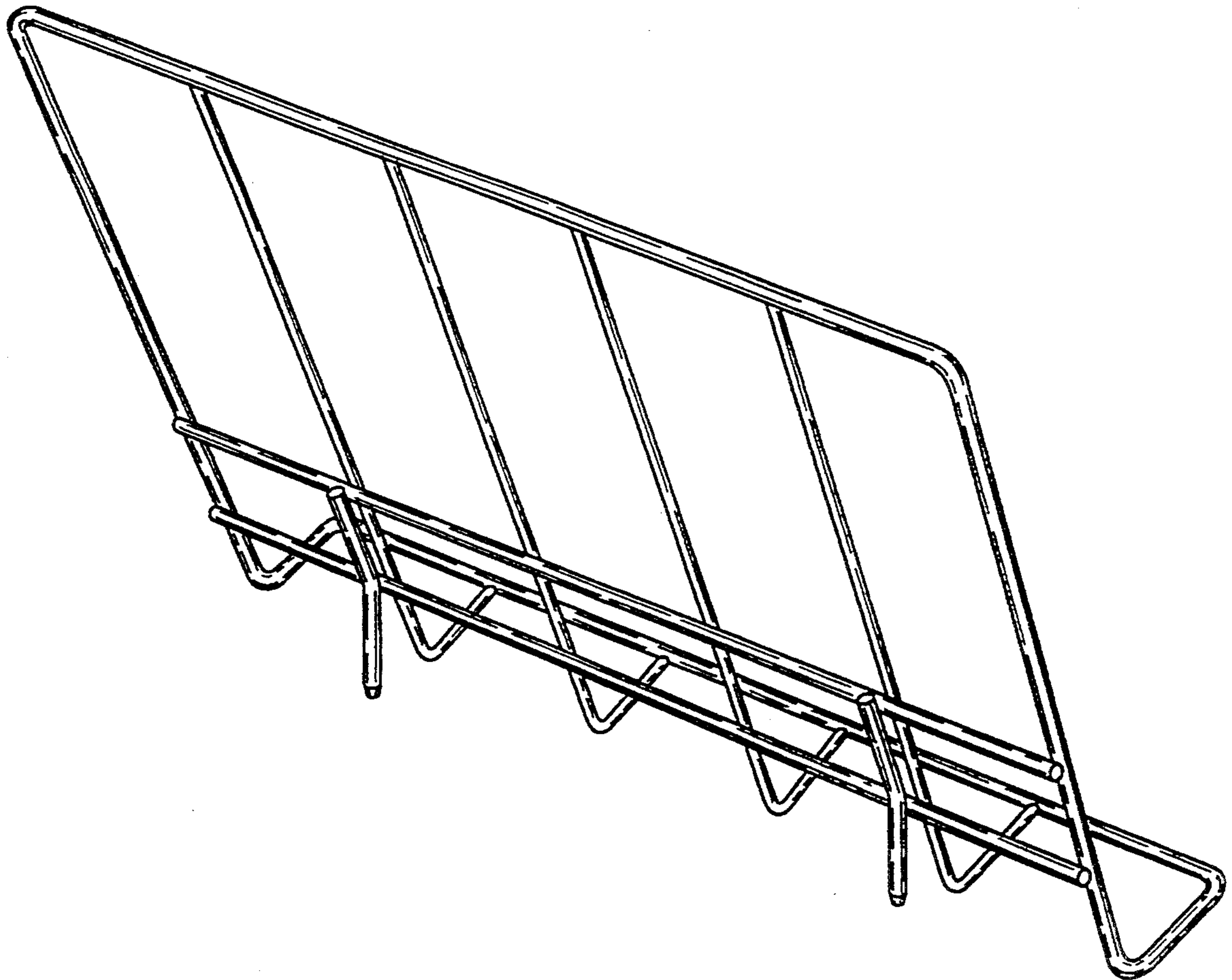

[57] **CLAIM**

The design for a wire document stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right, rear perspective view of a wire document stand;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the support bracket and fragmentary horizontal surface being depicted by means of broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



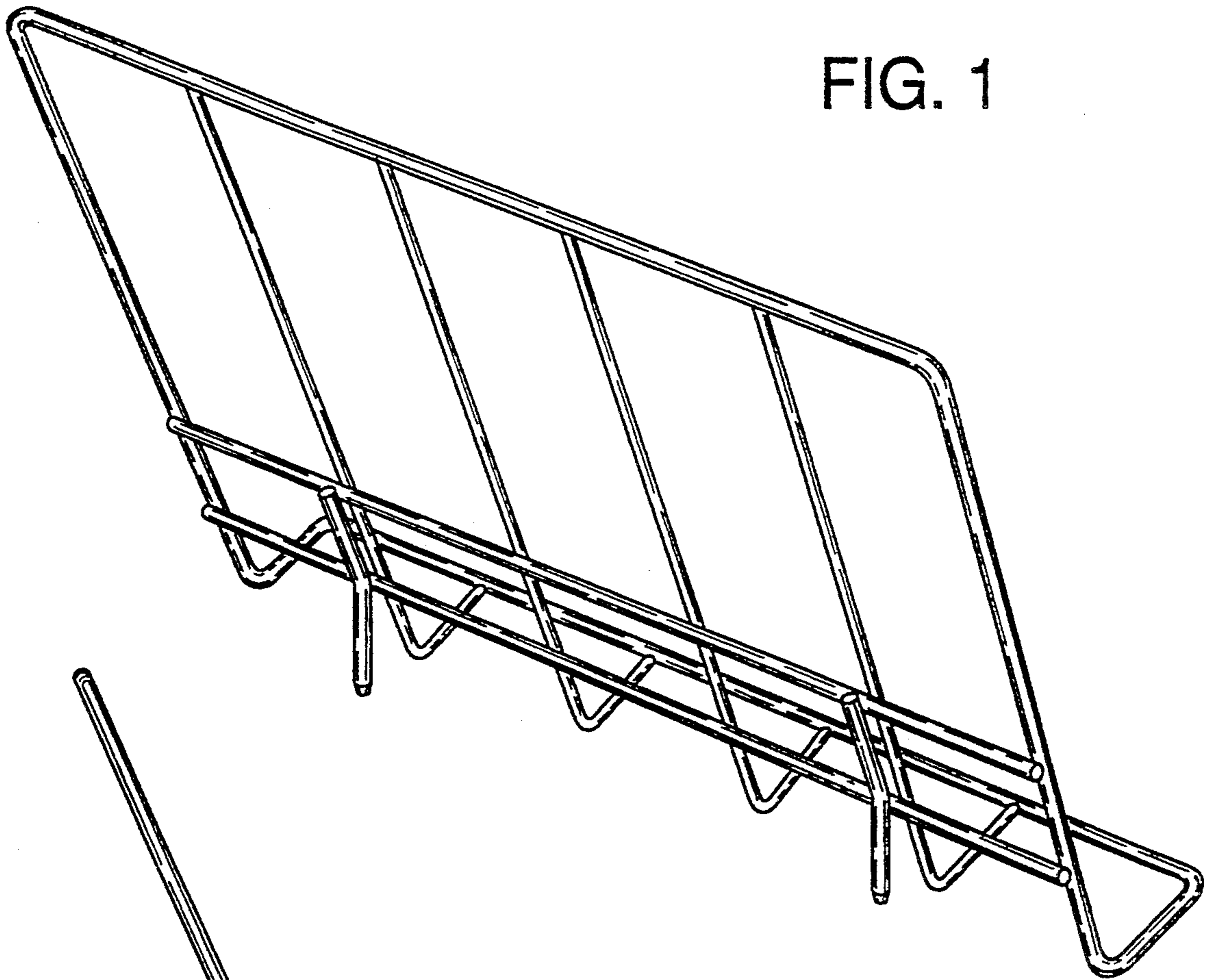

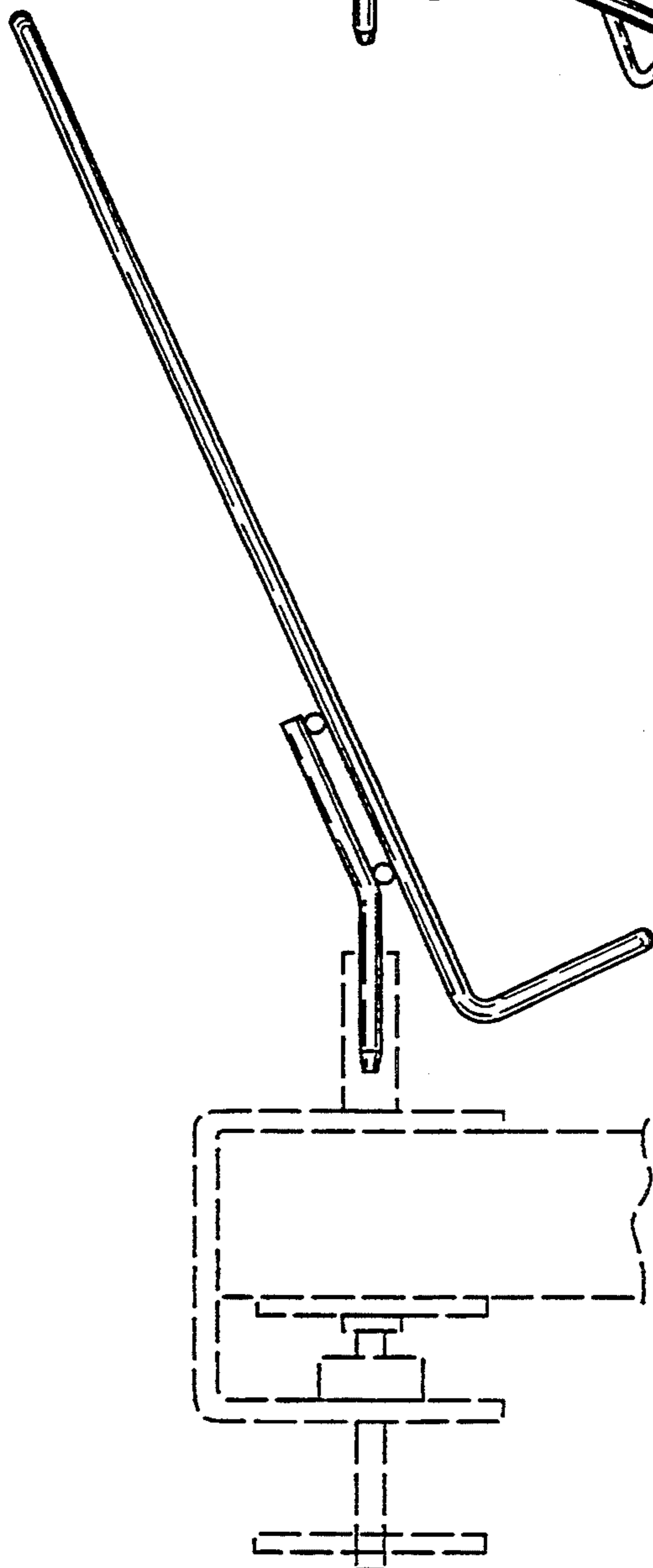

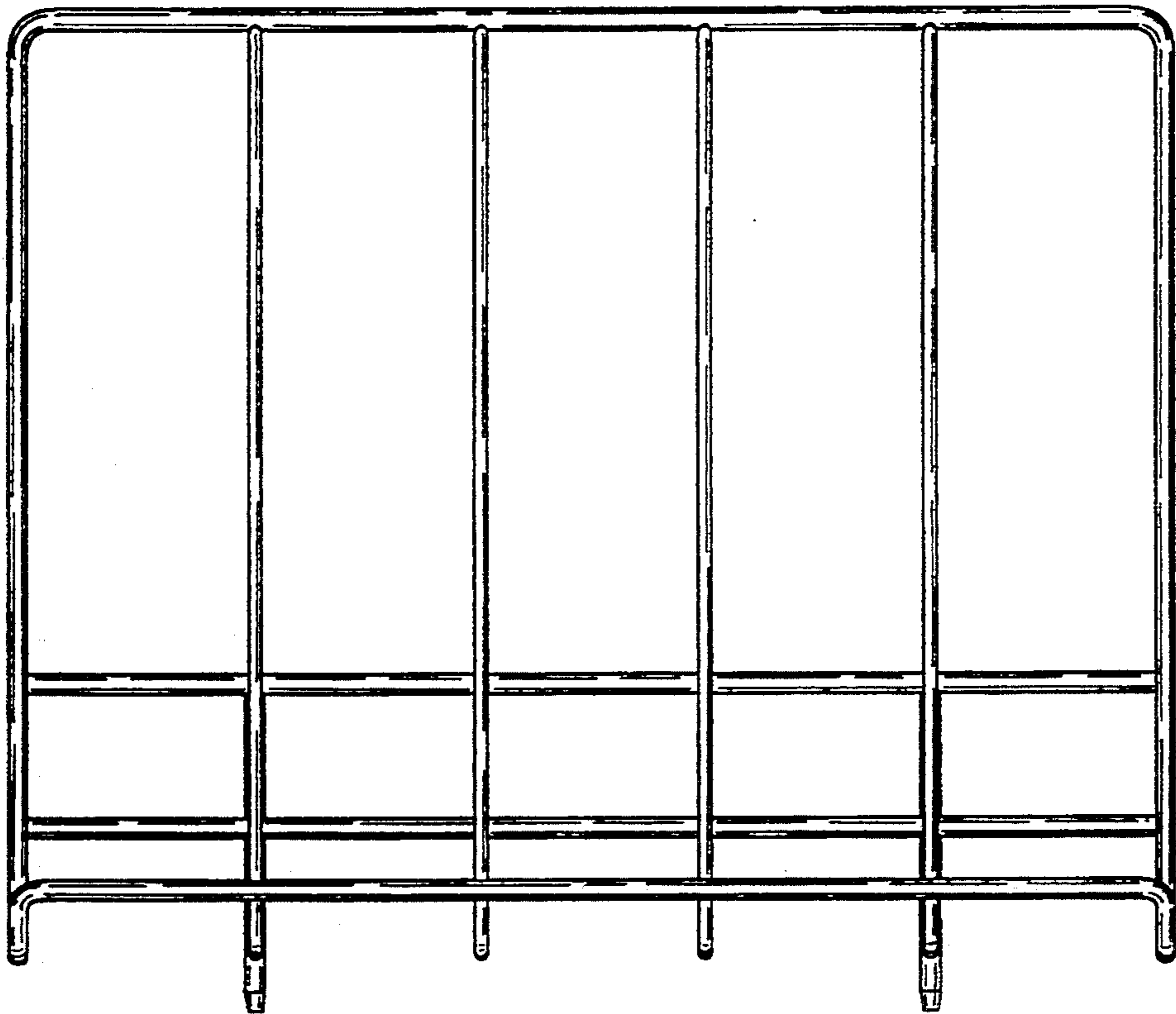

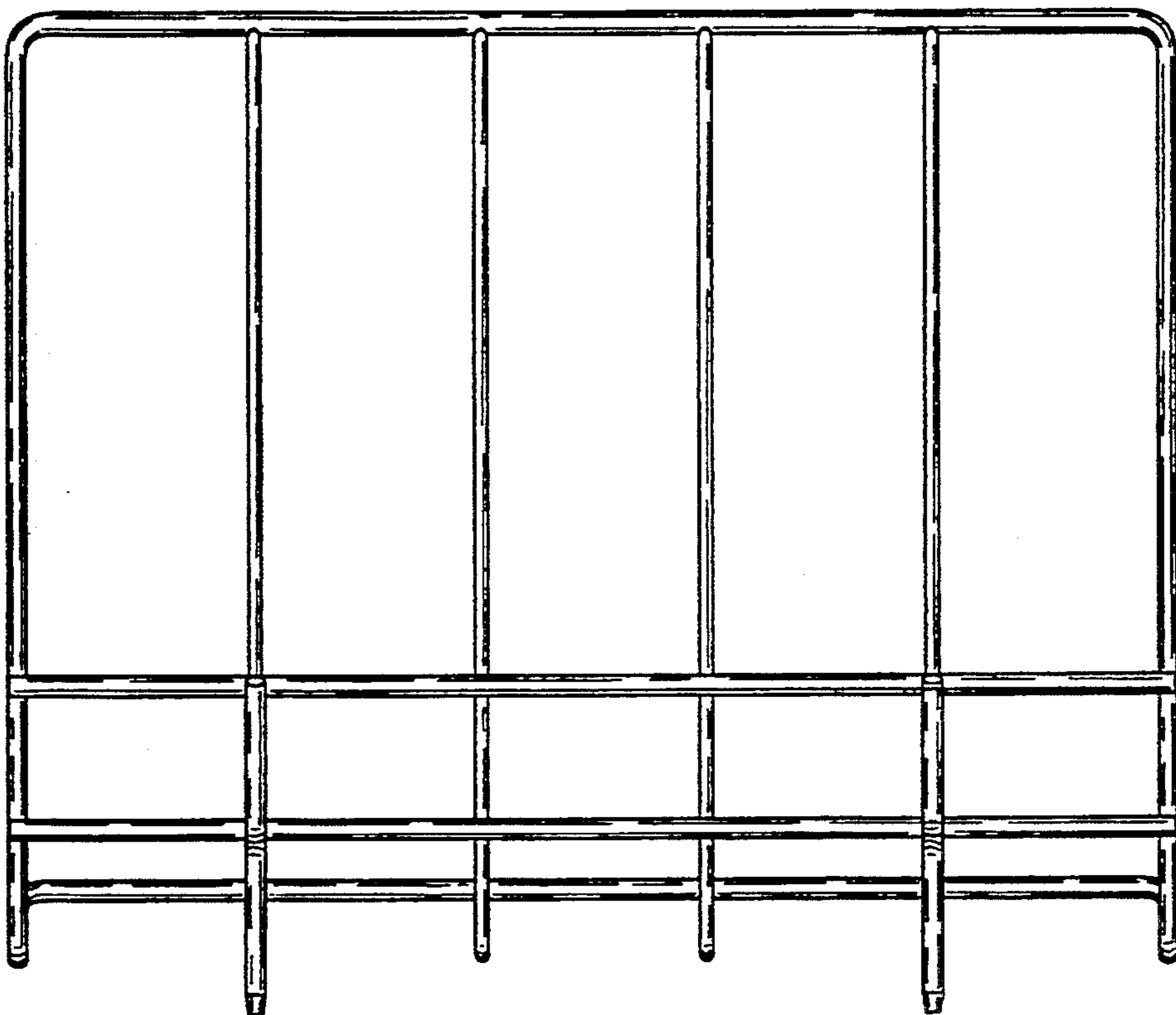

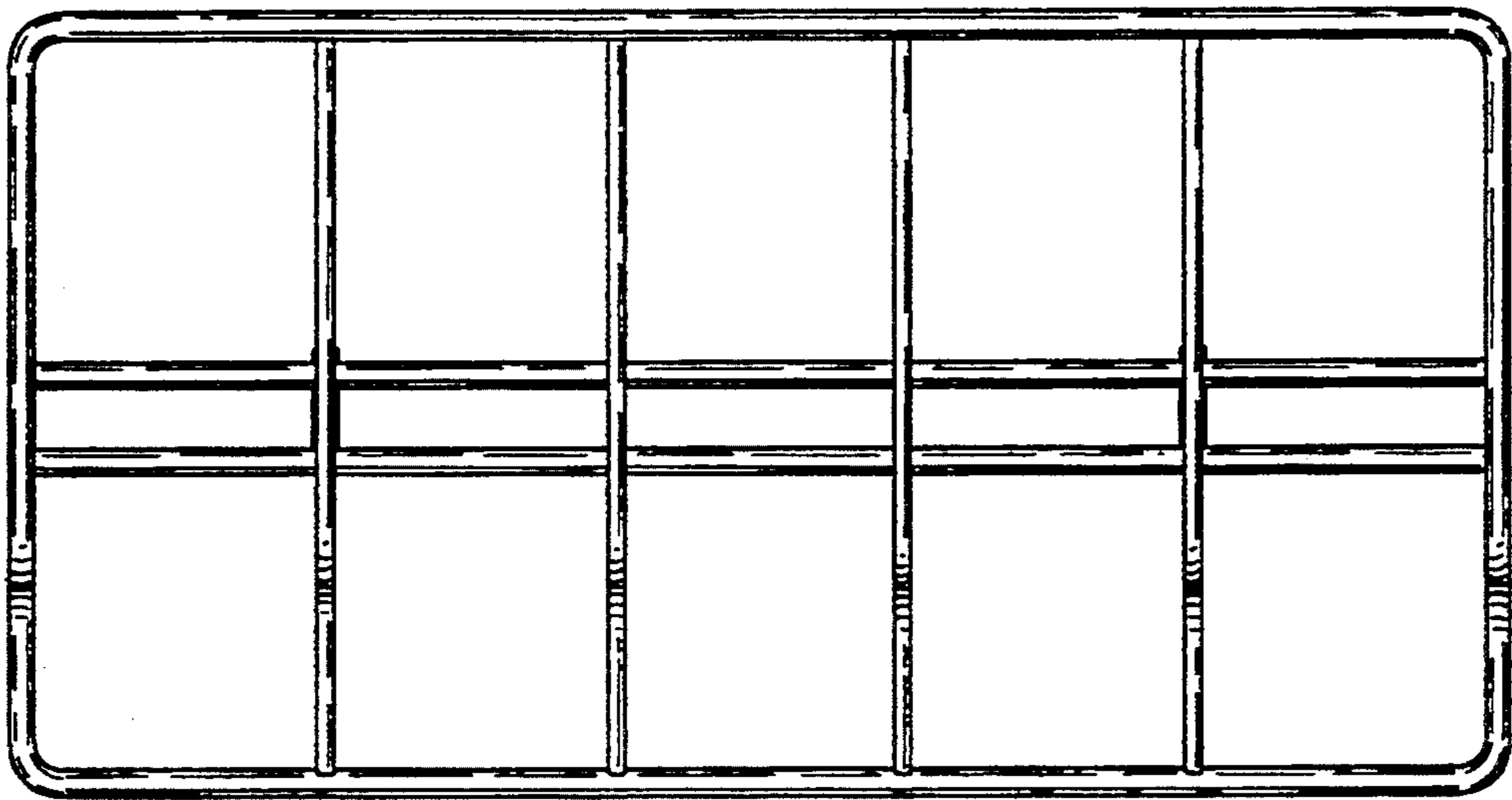
