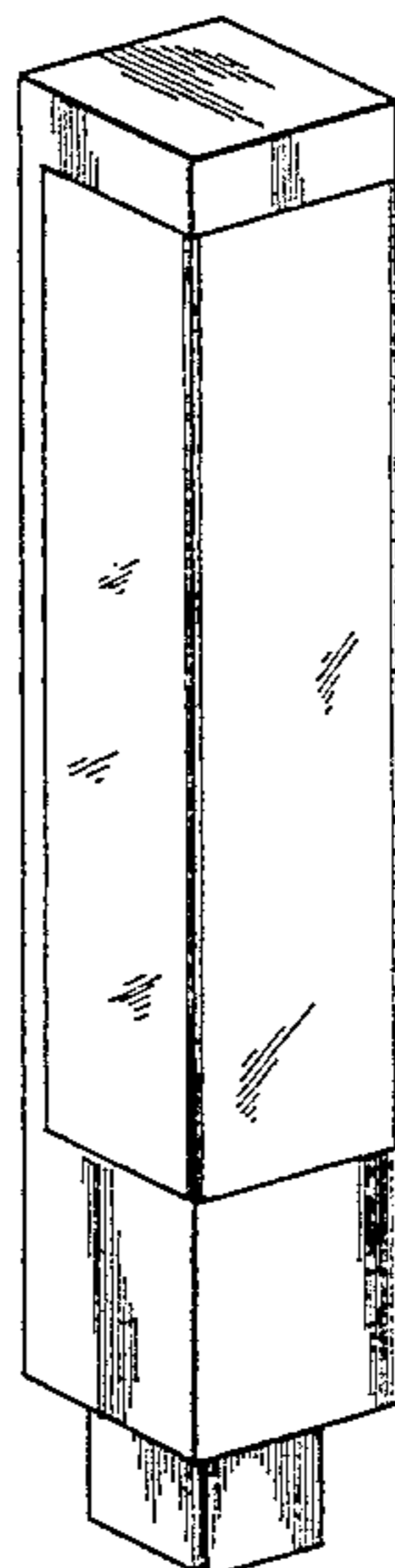
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 31 is a bottom view of said thirteenth embodiment.



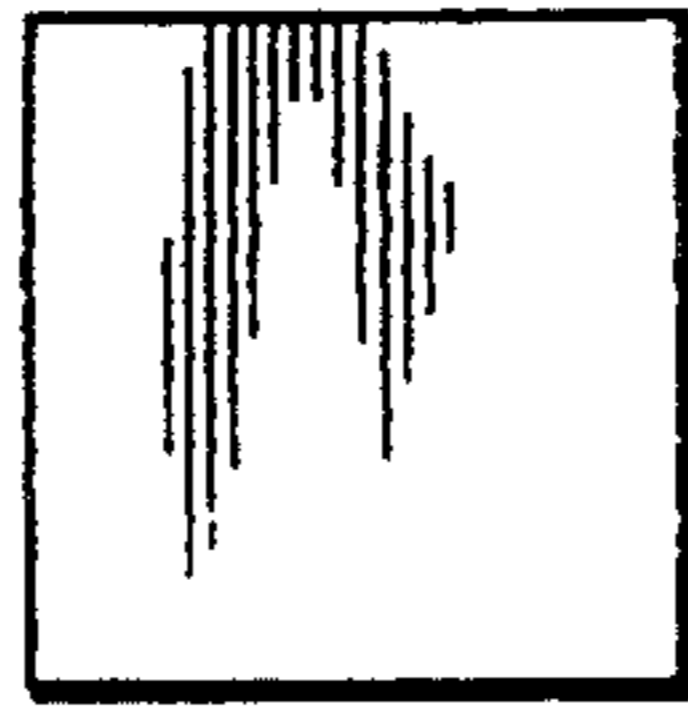

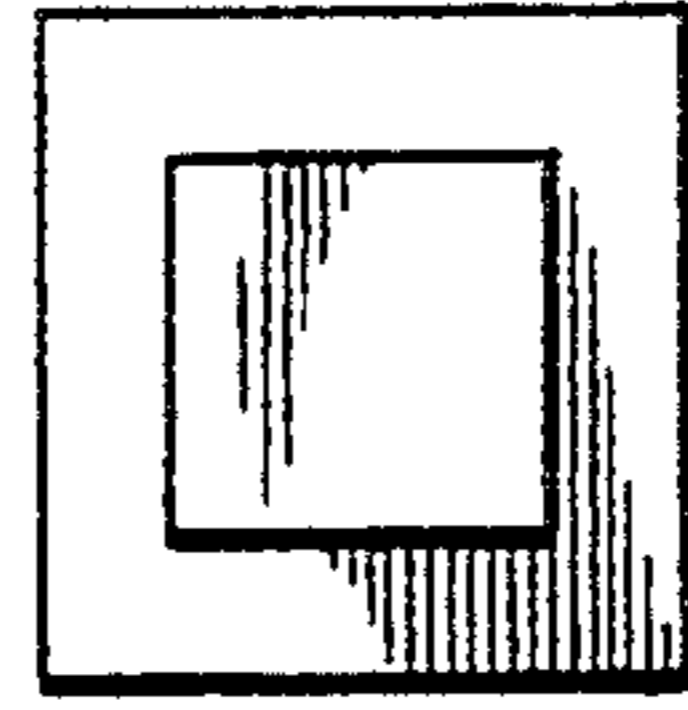

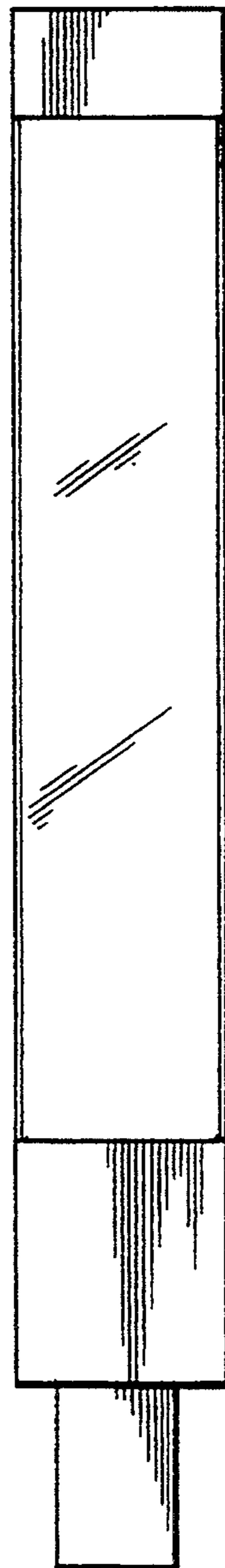

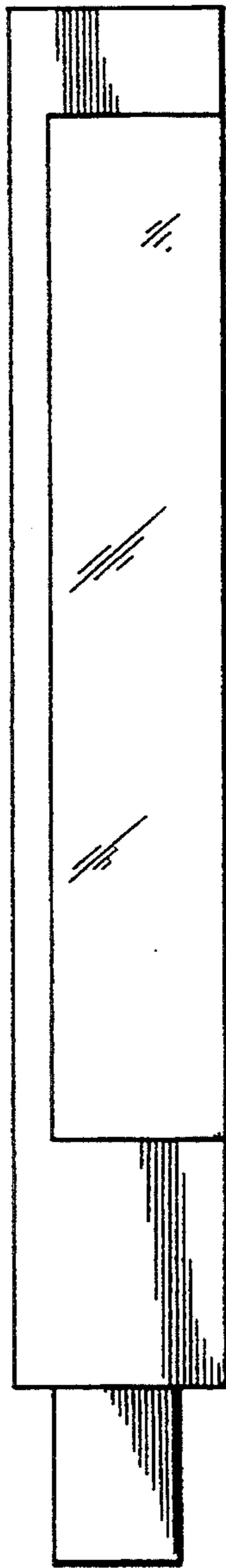

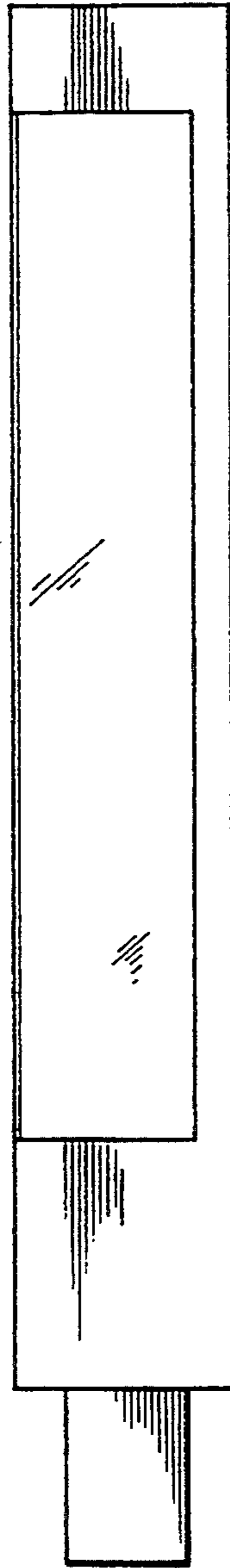

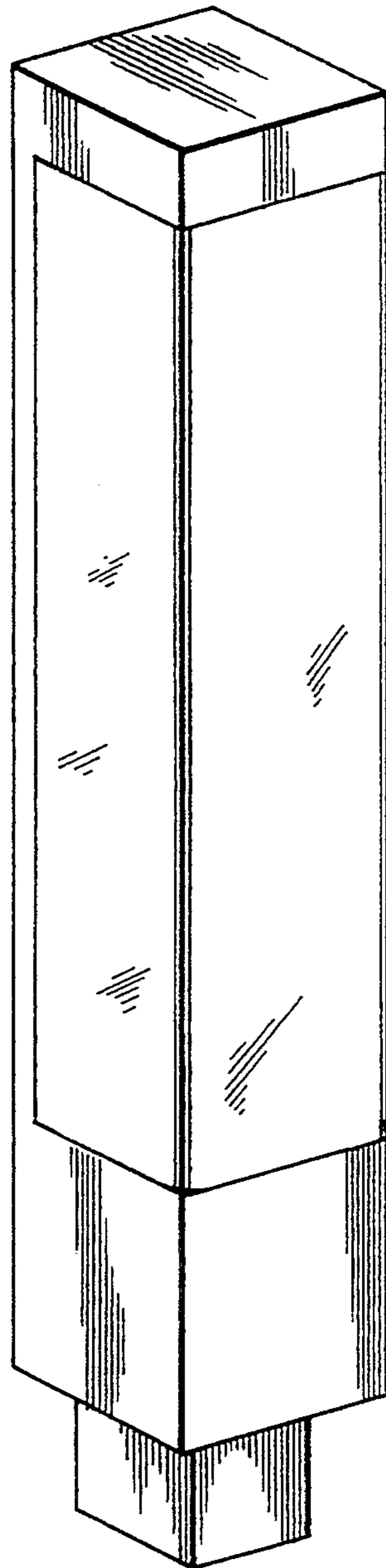

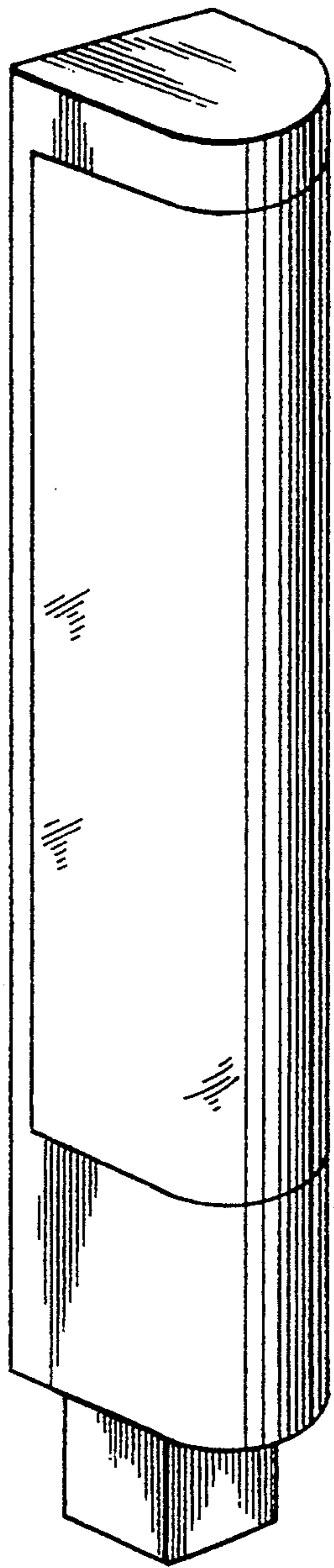

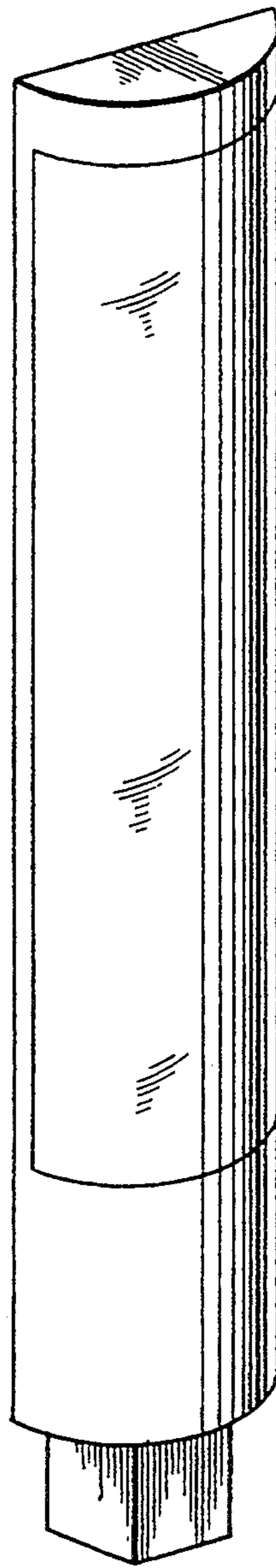

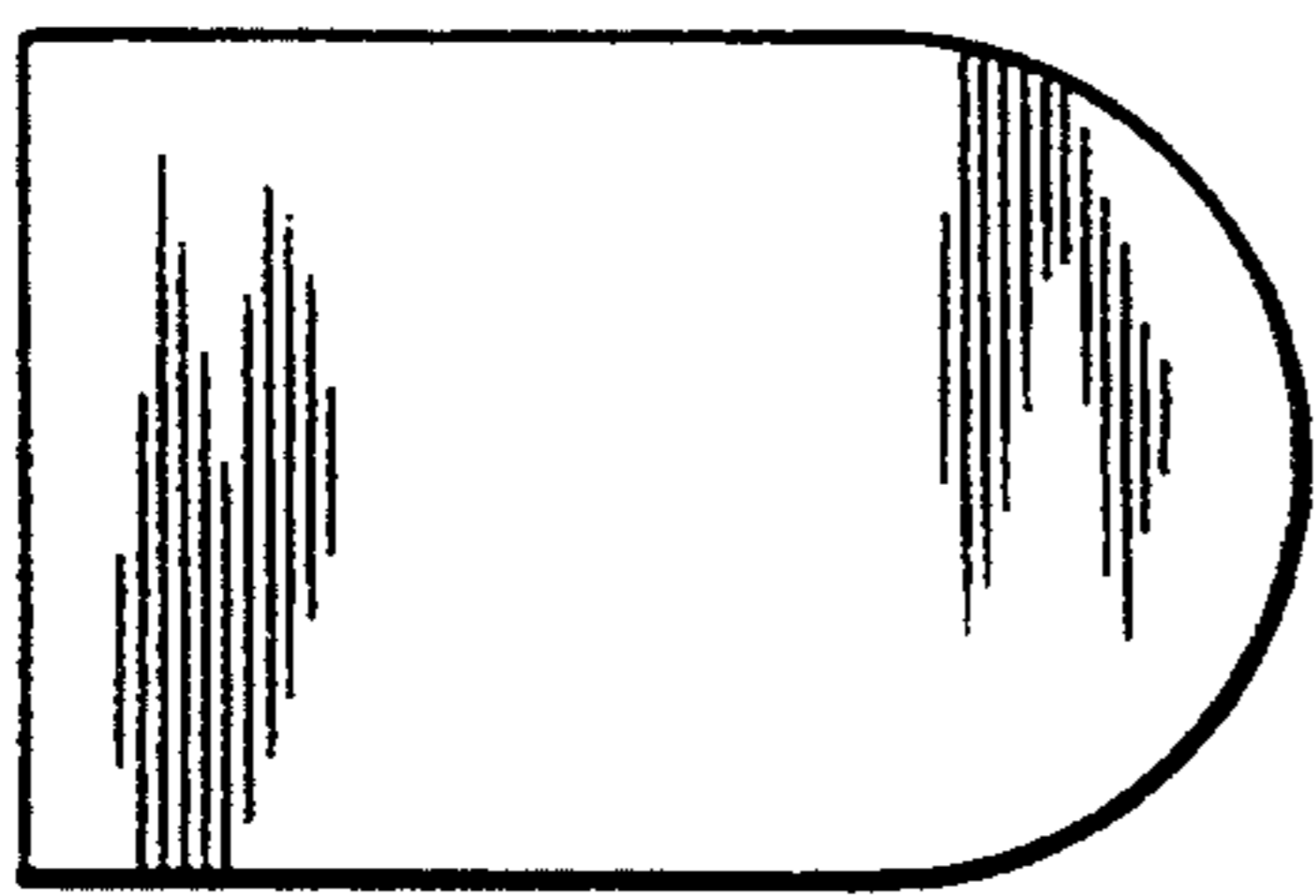

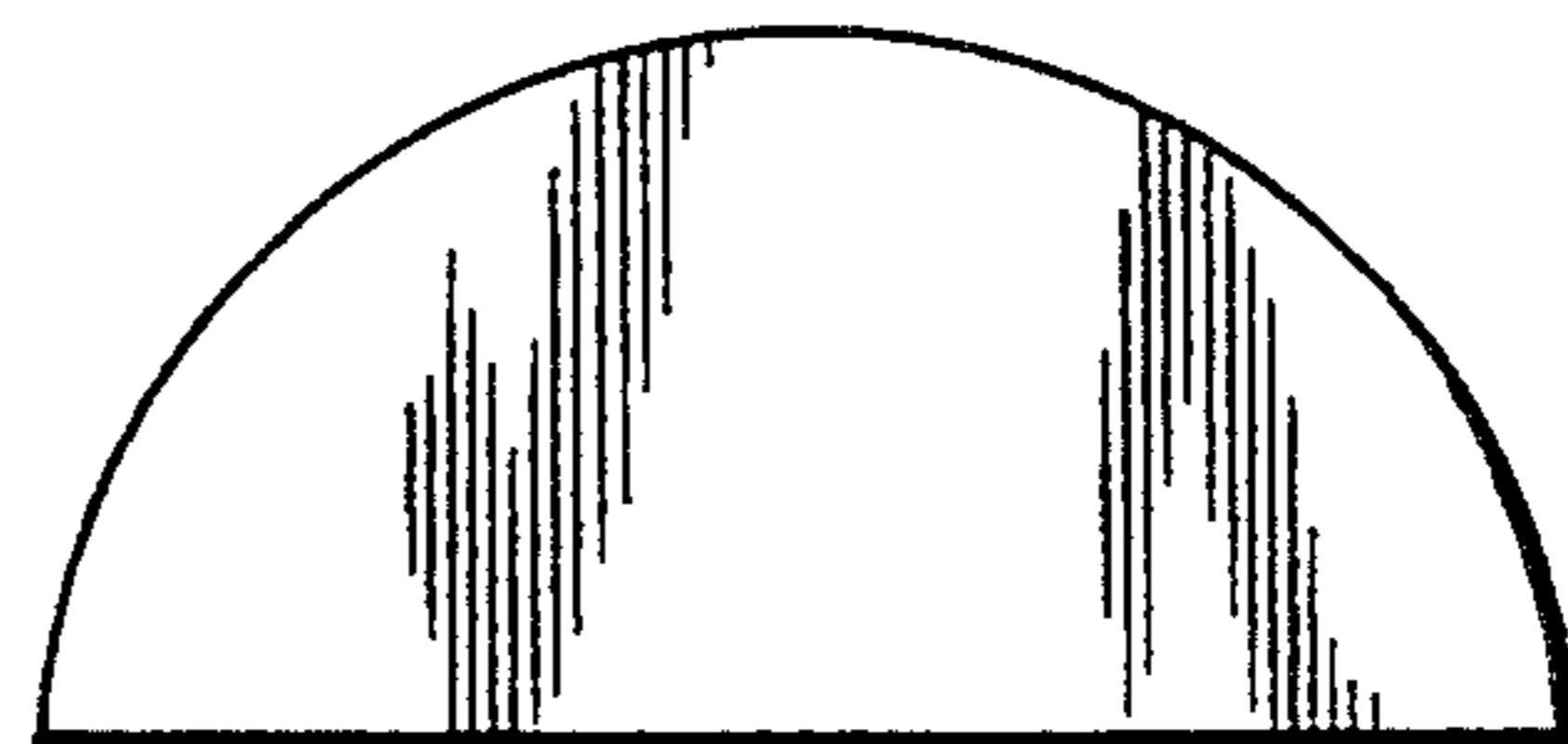

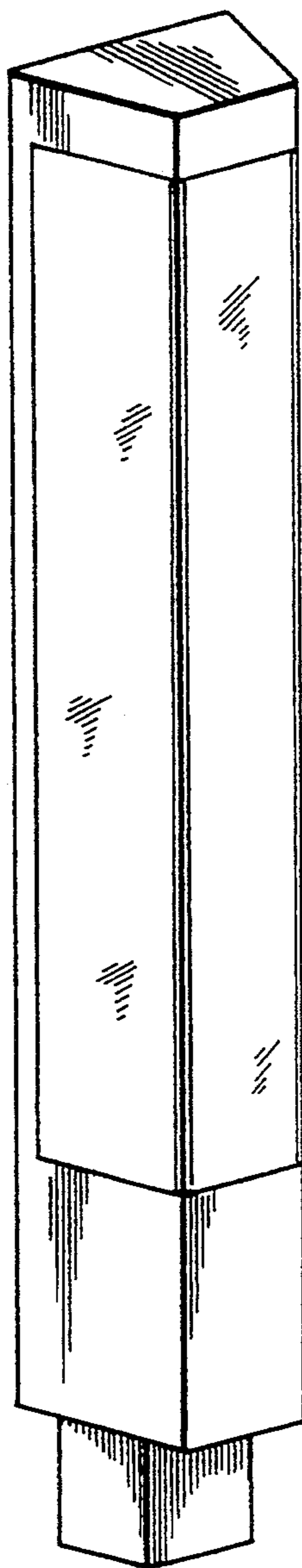

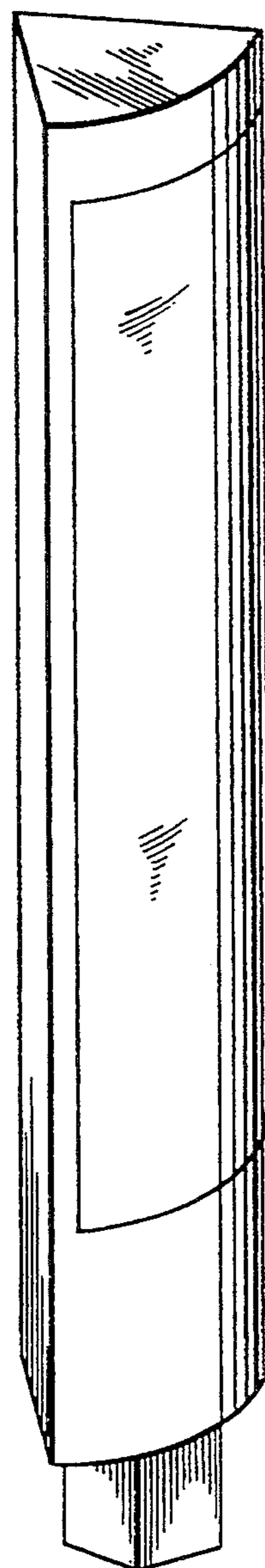

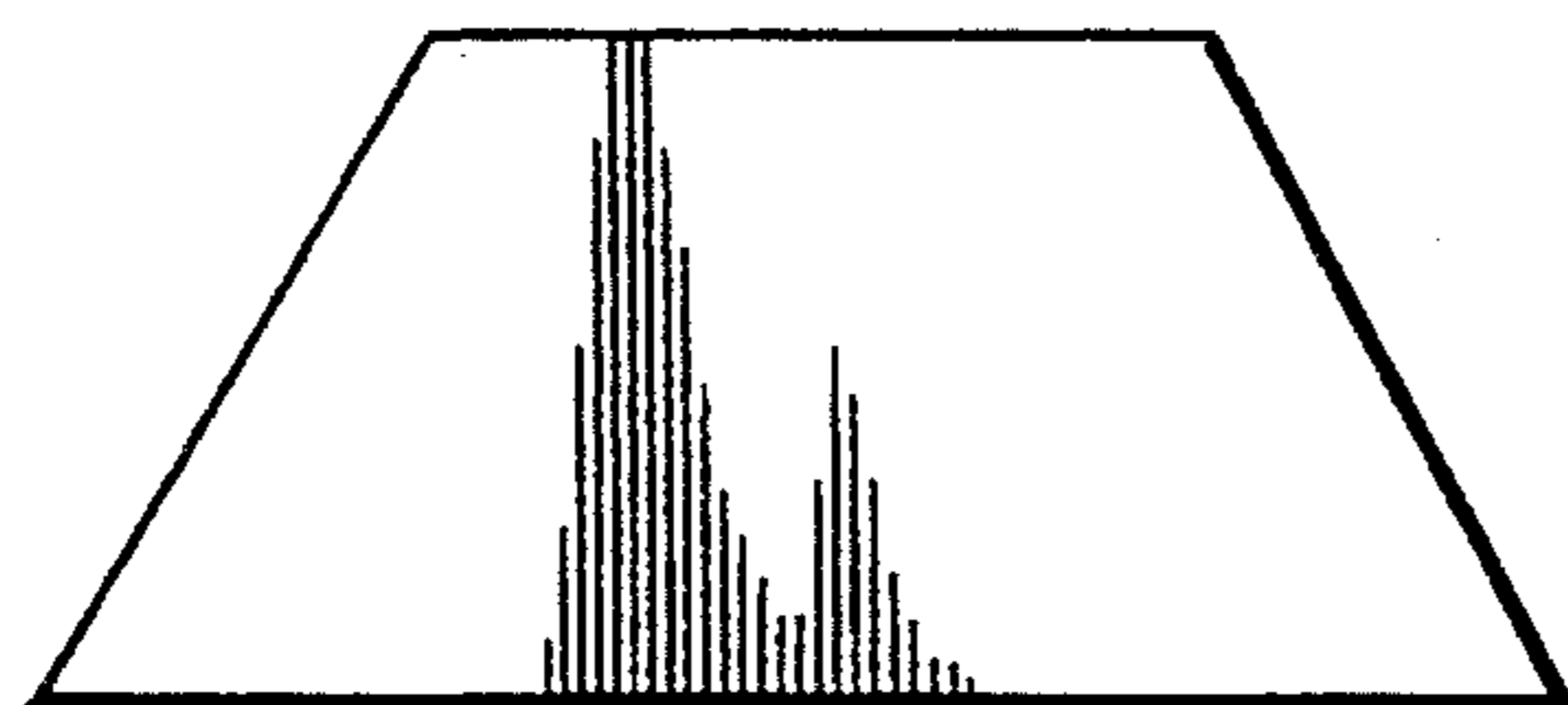

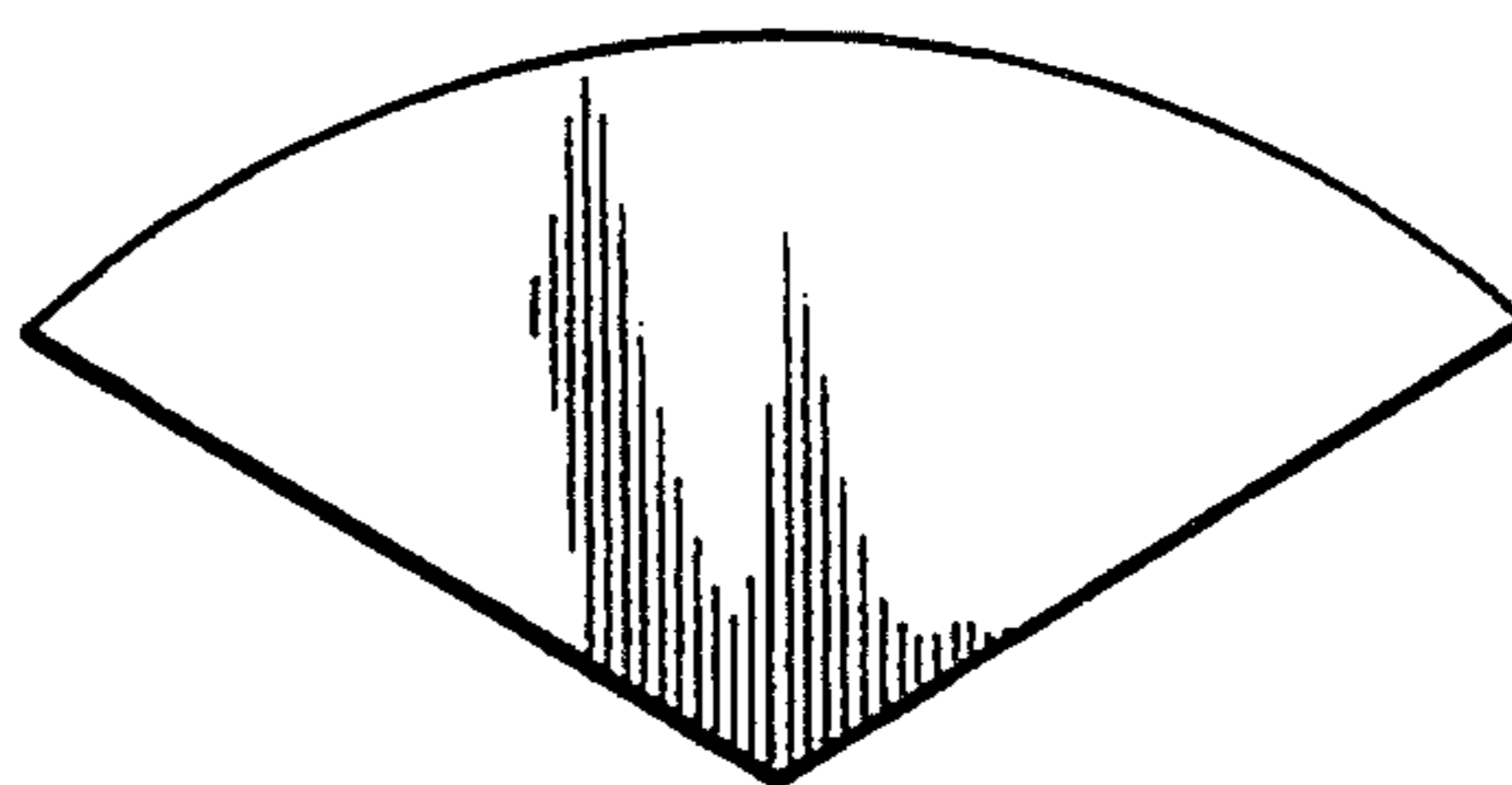

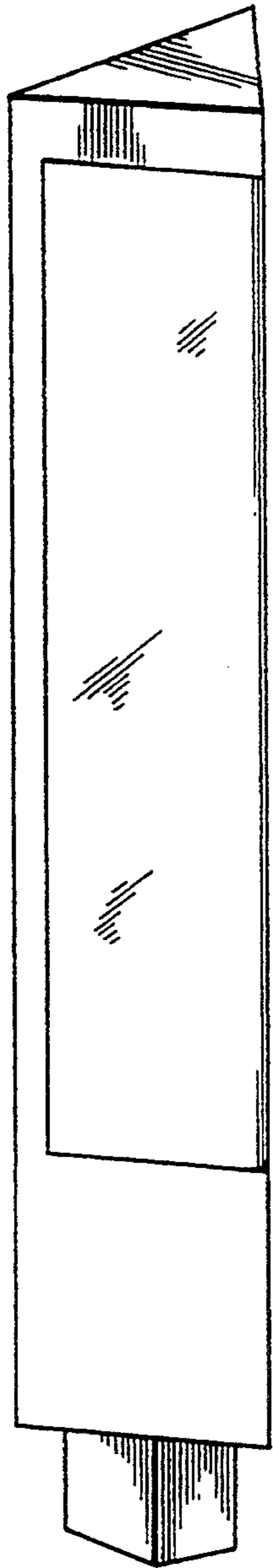

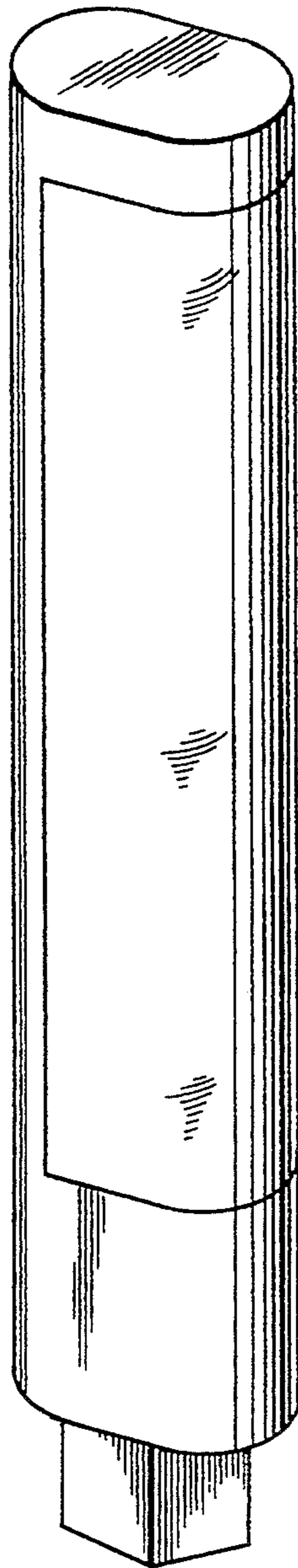

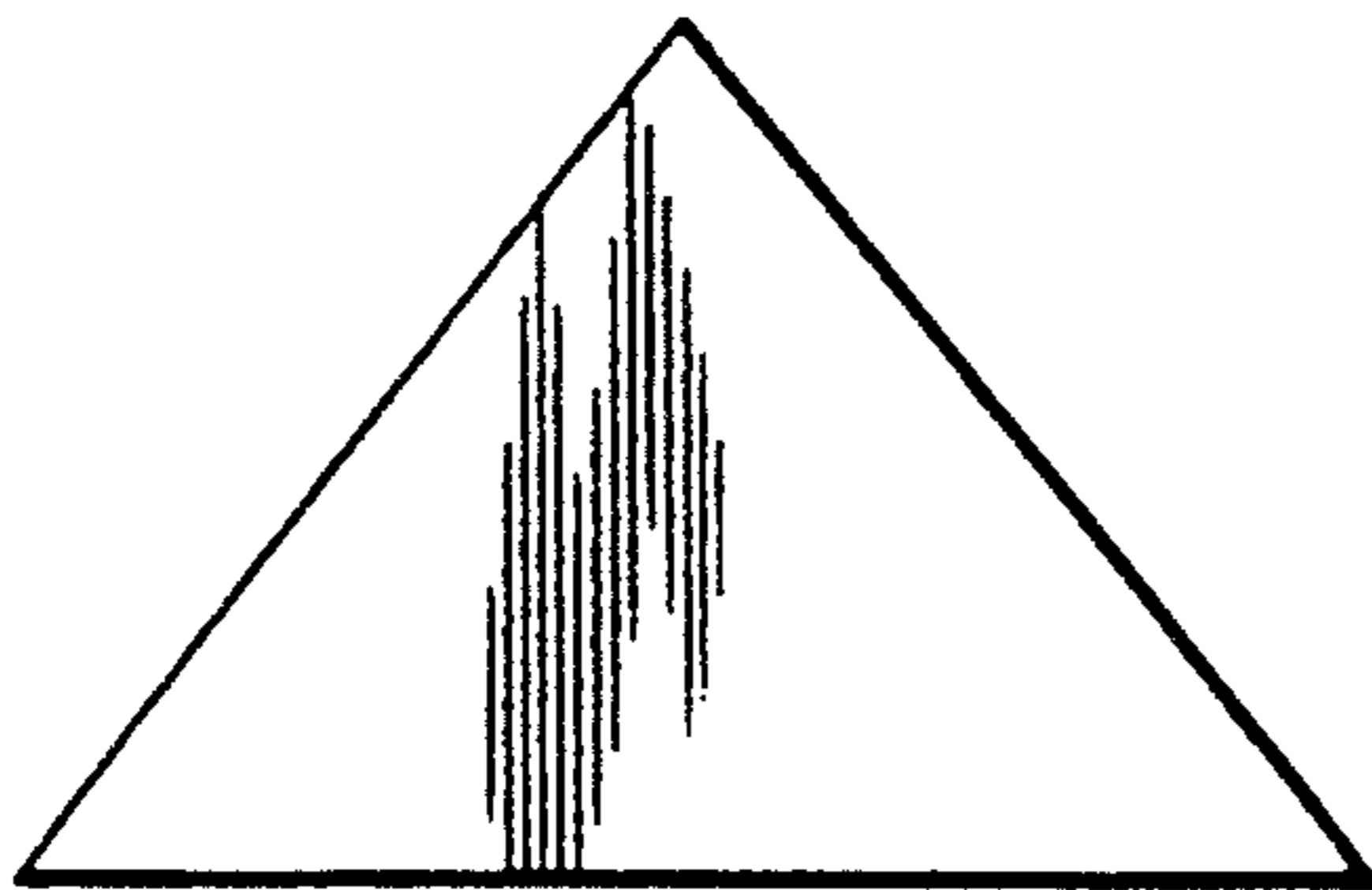

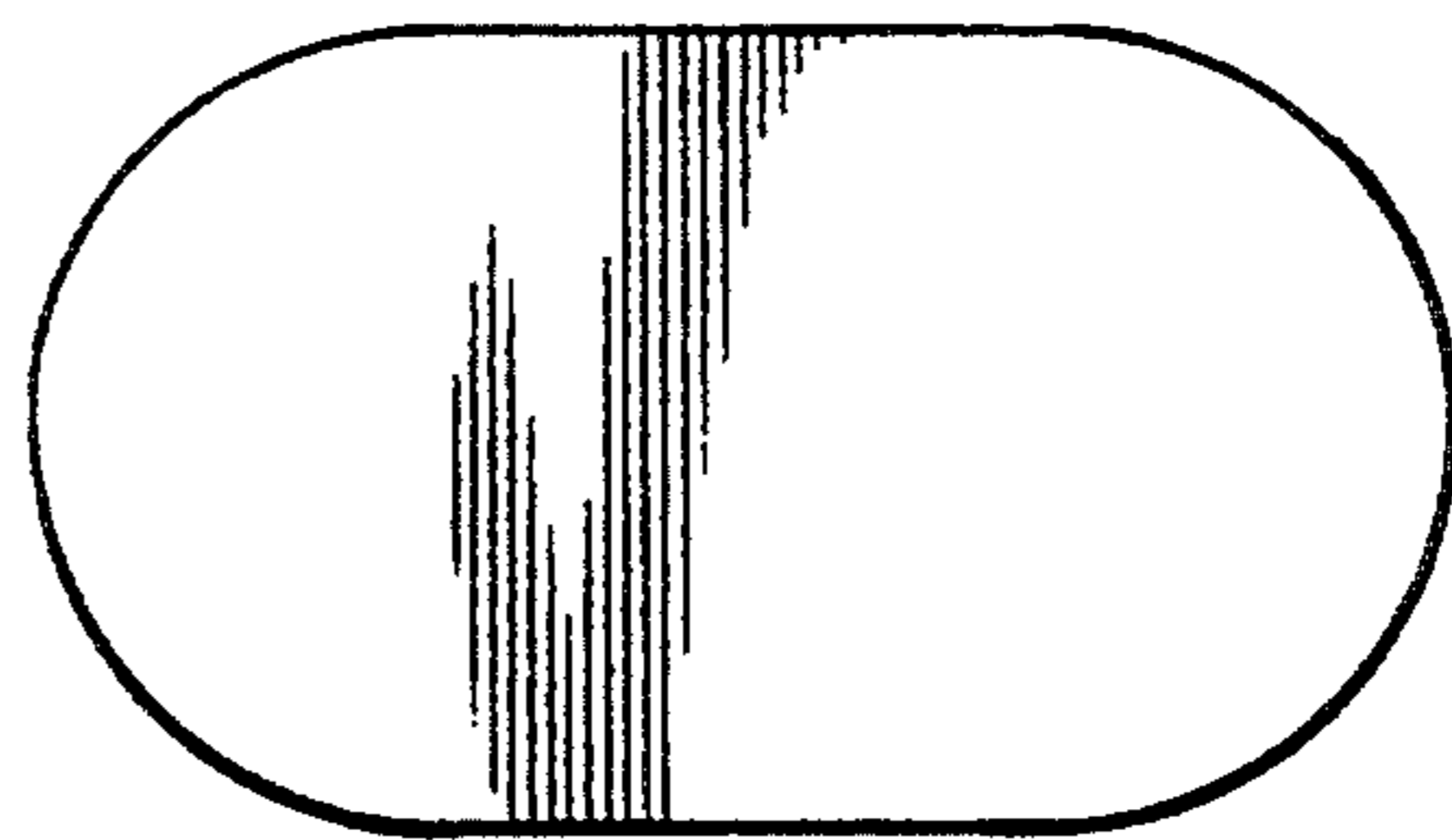

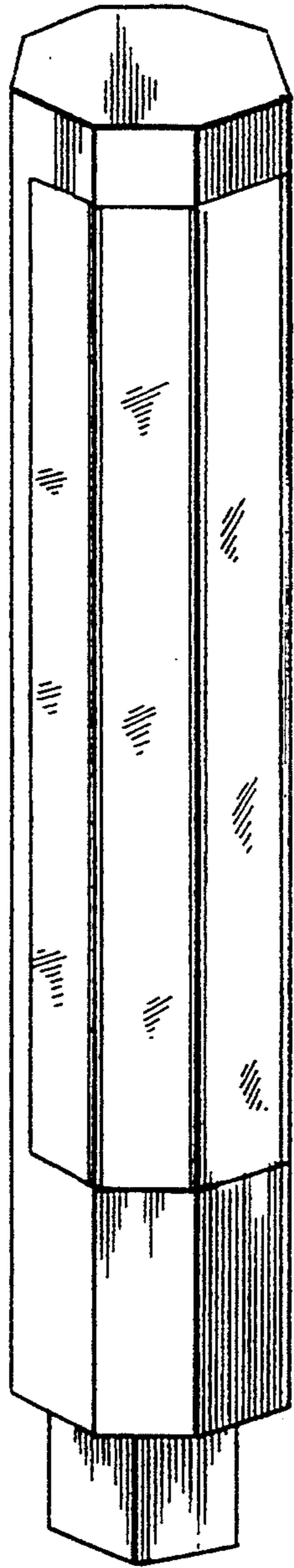

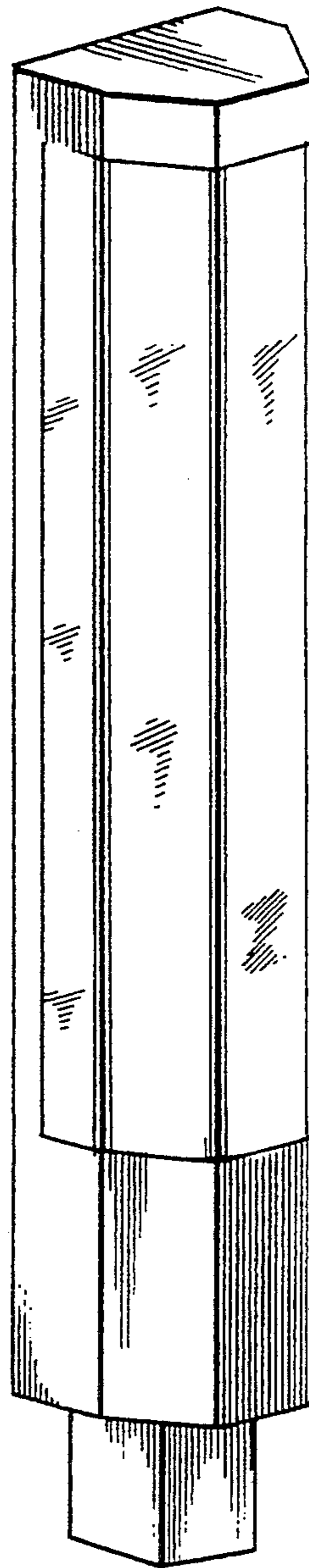

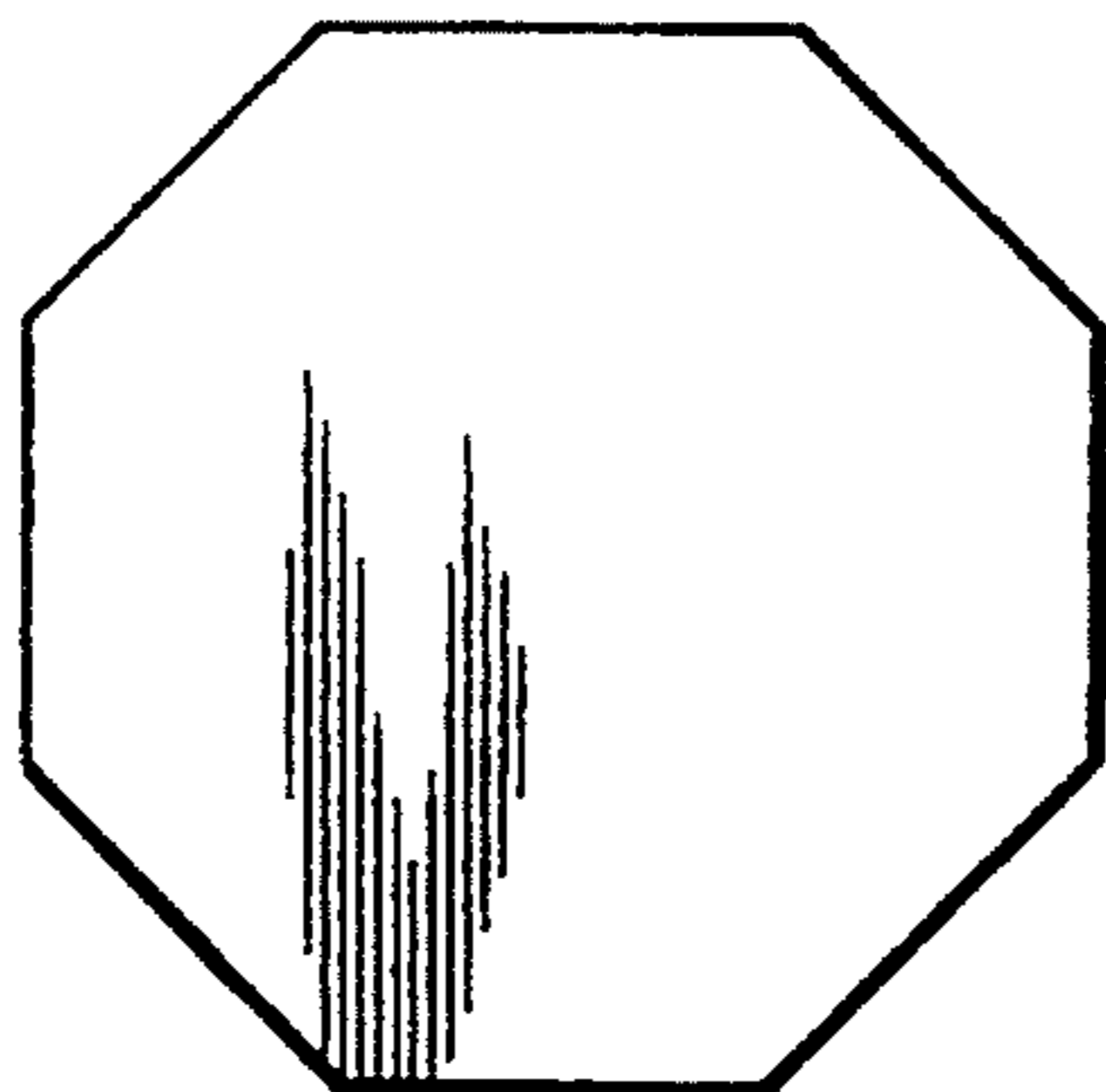

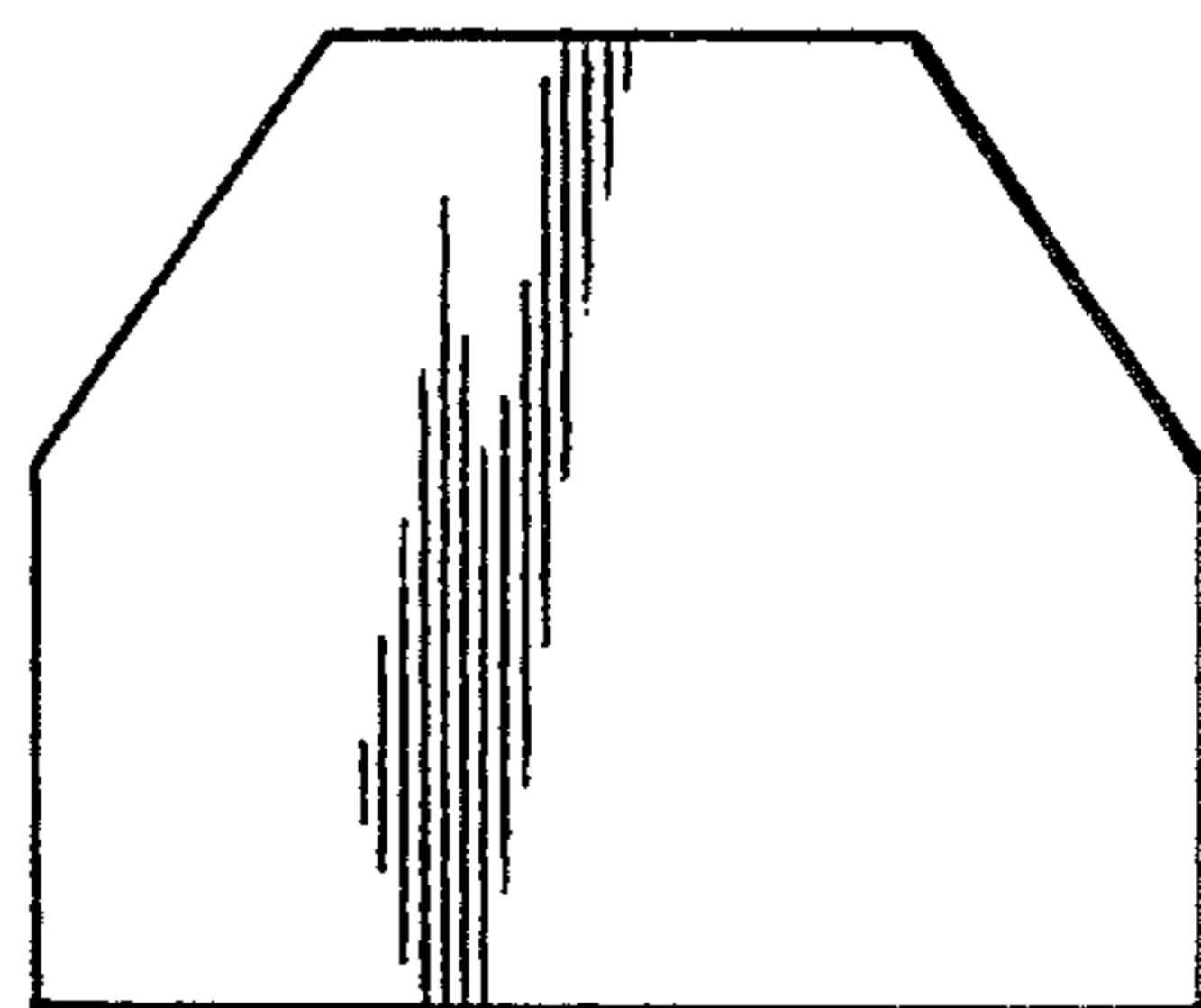

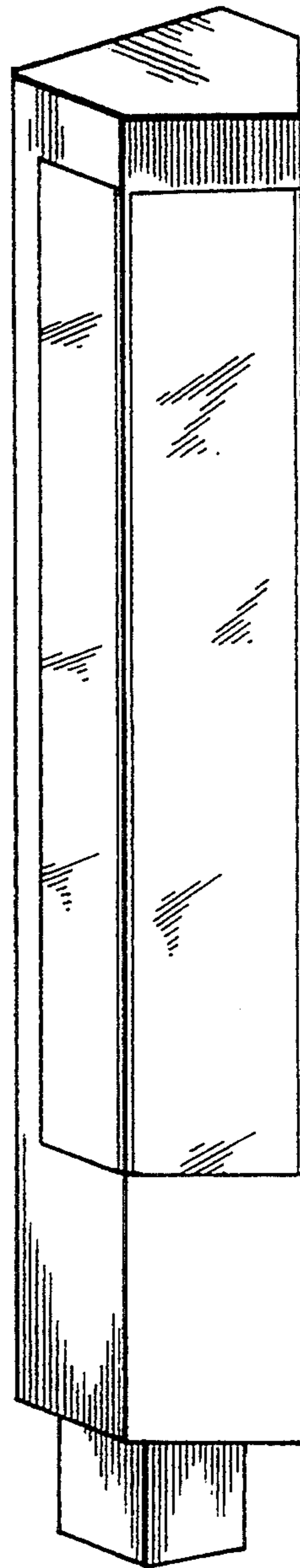

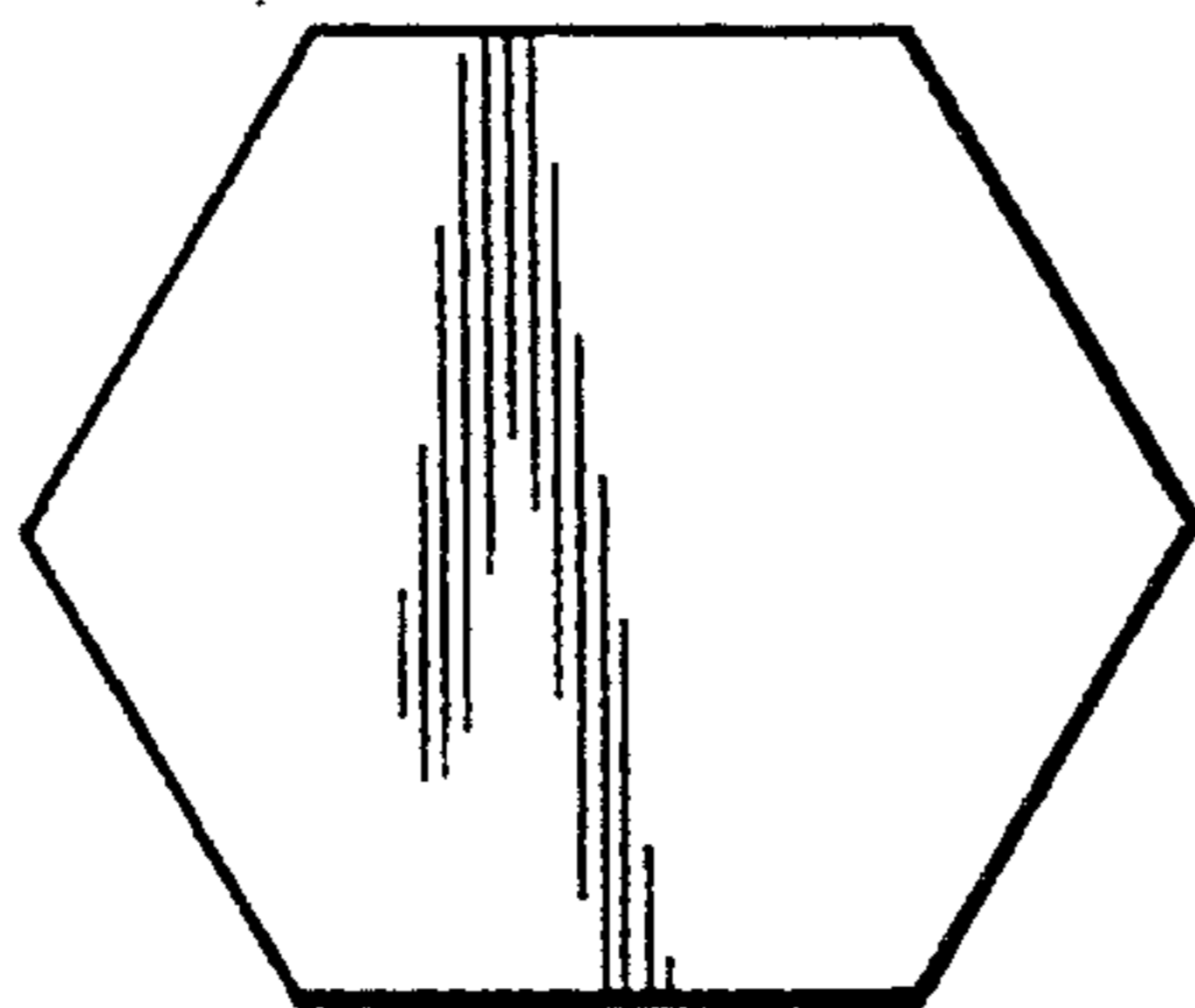

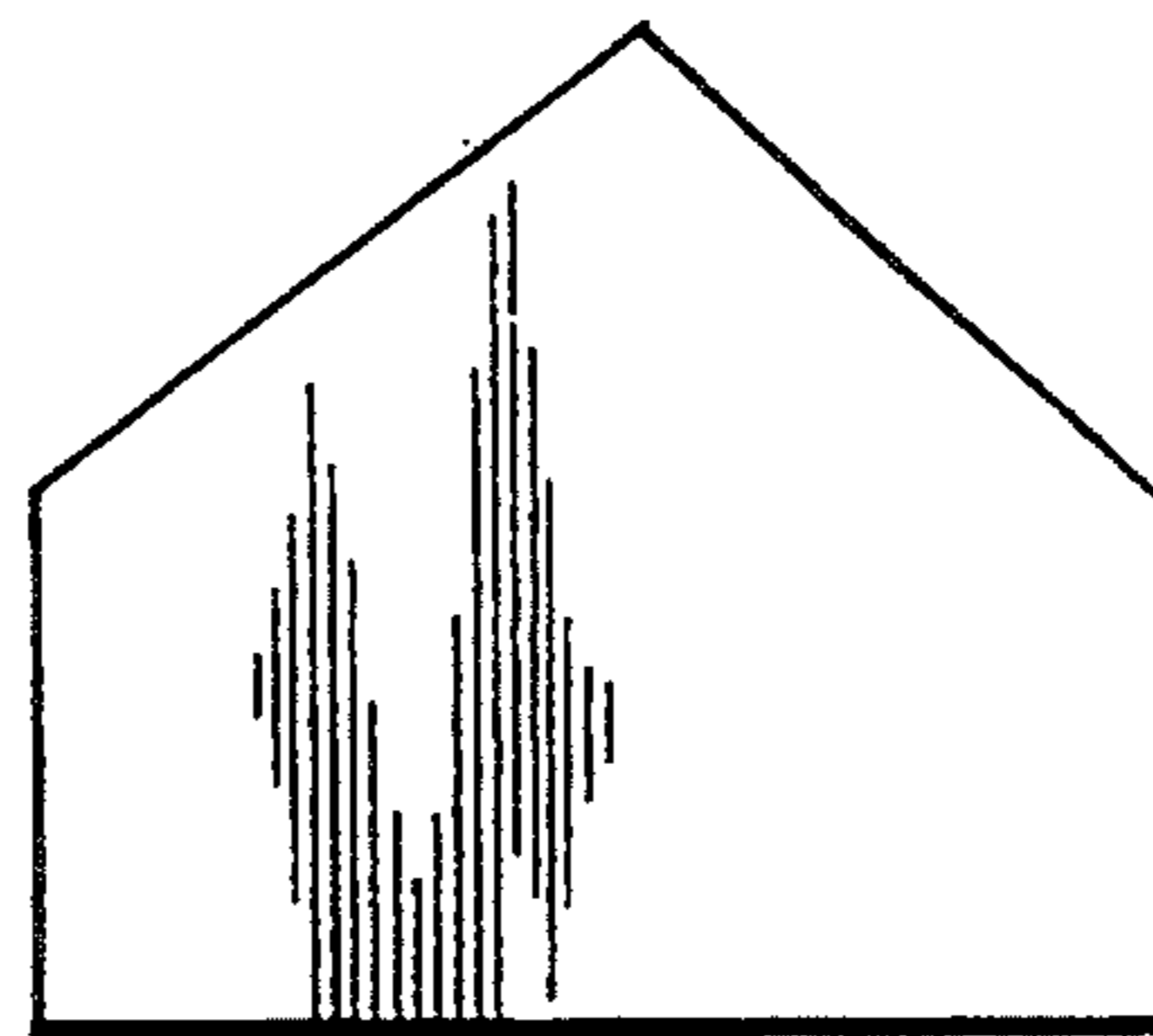

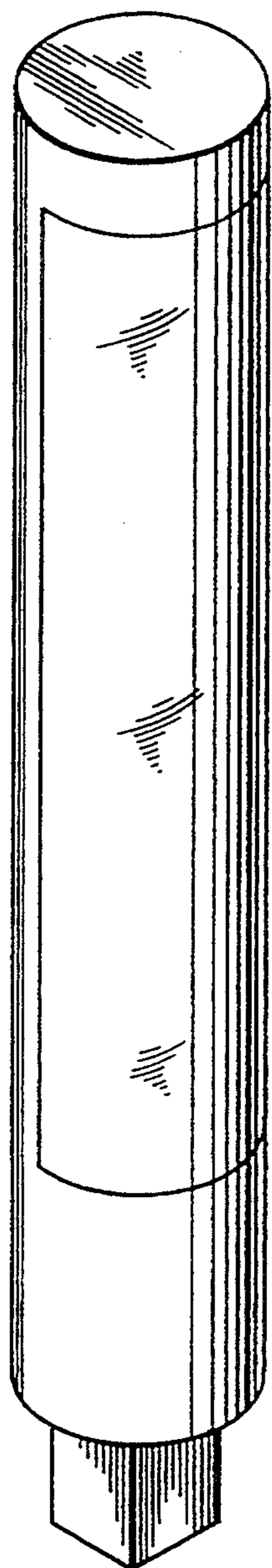

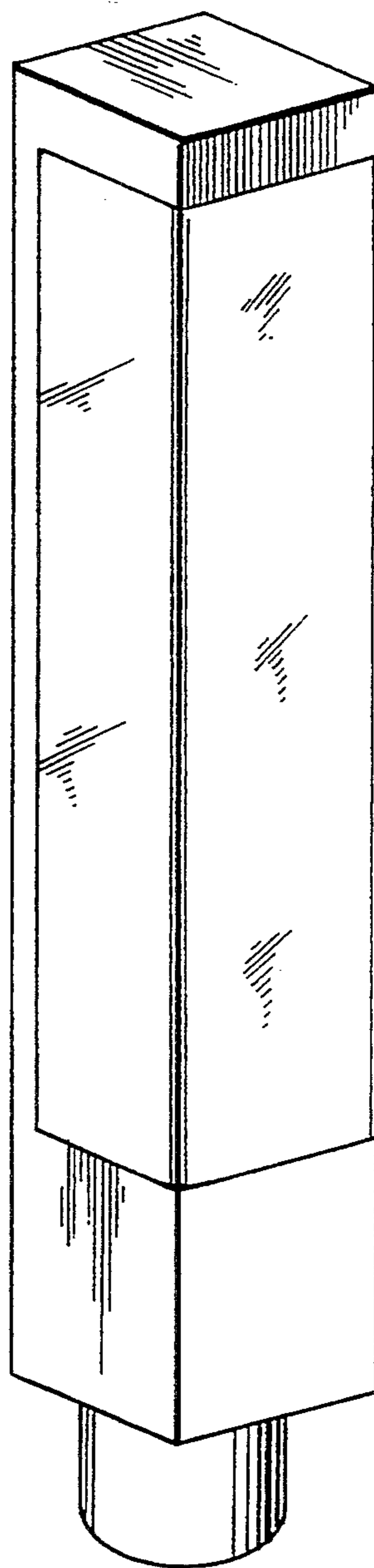

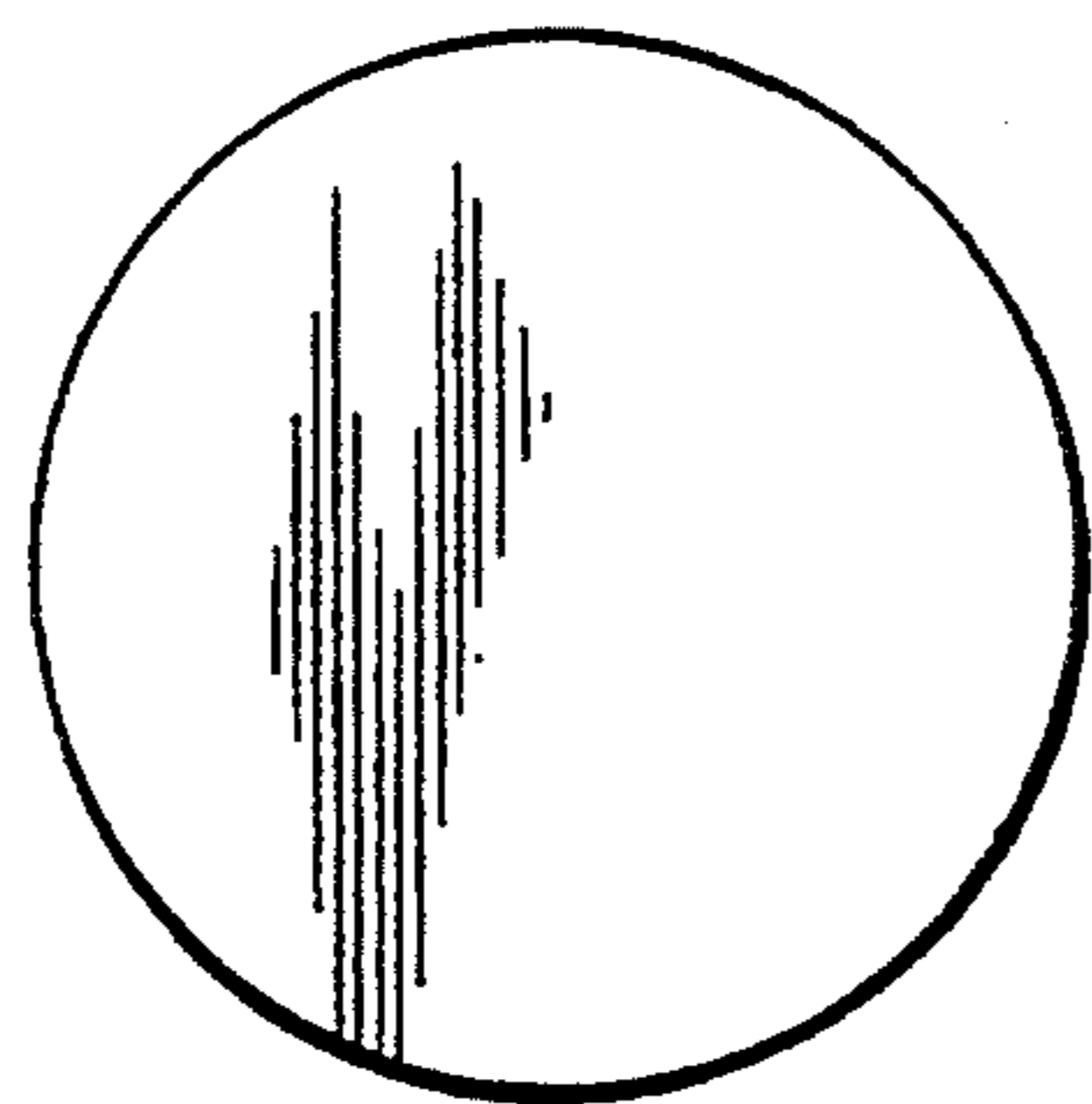

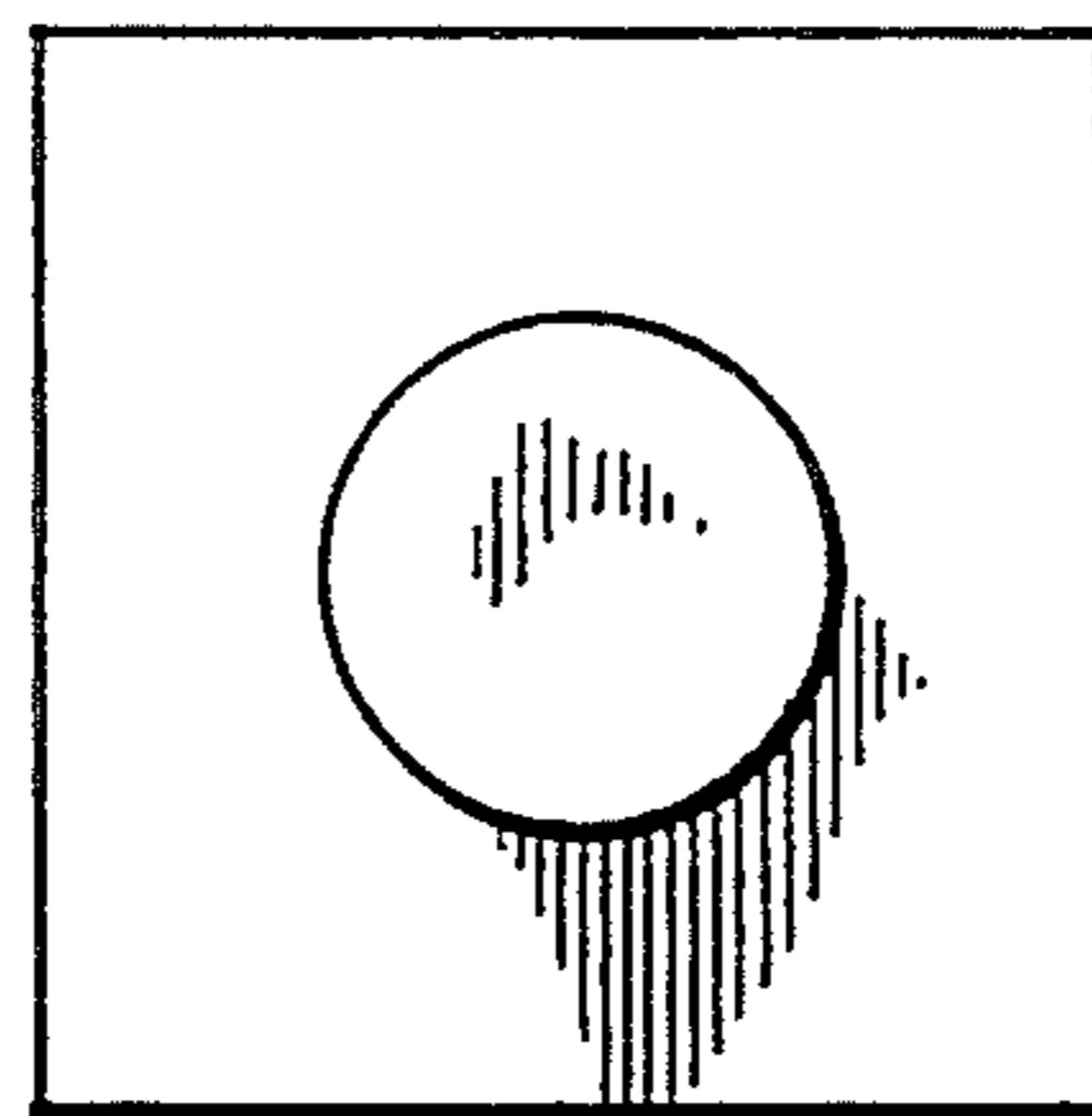
