DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a stereoscopic view showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.
The rear elevational view is identical to FIG. 2, and the right side elevational view is identical to FIG. 5.

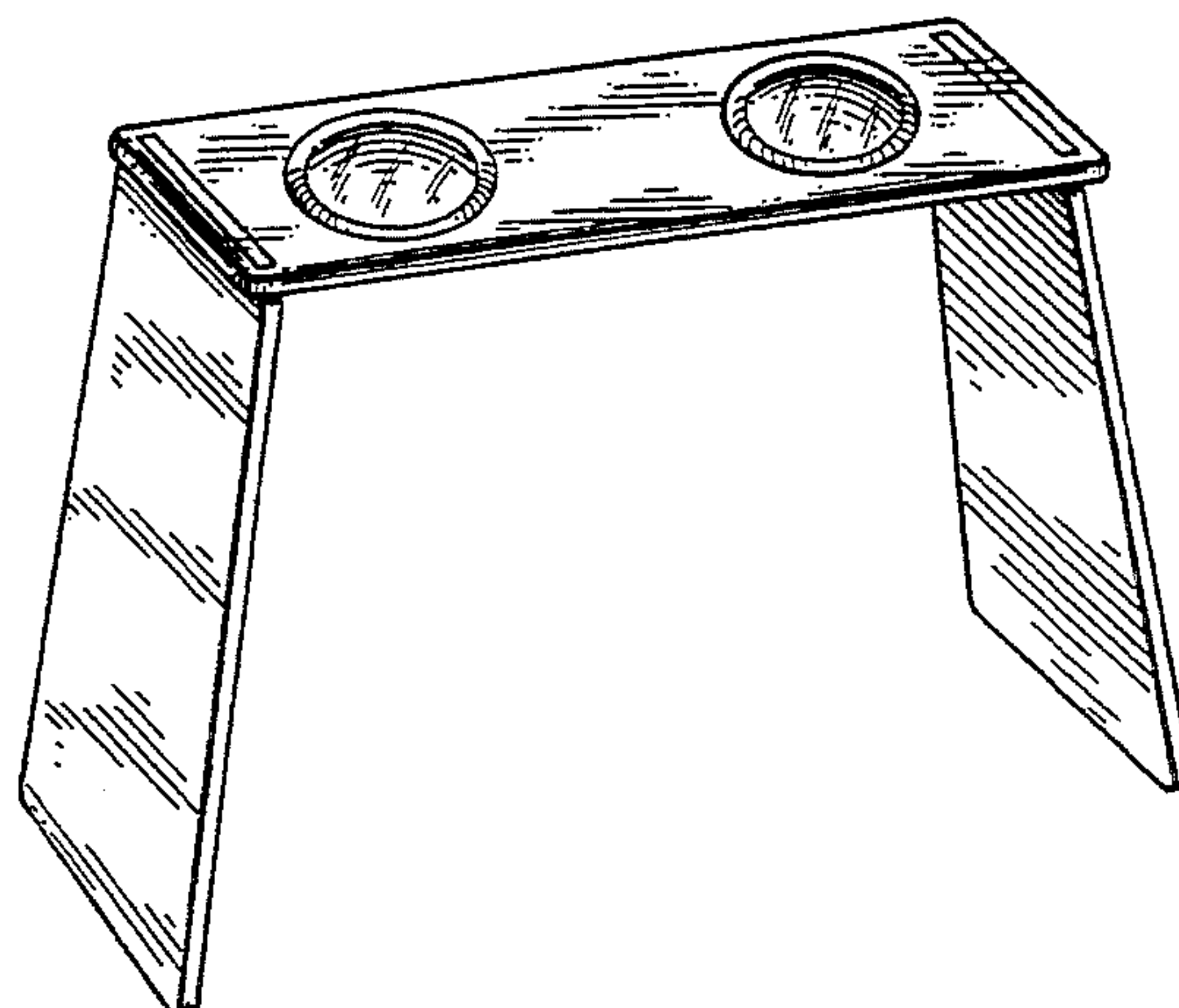

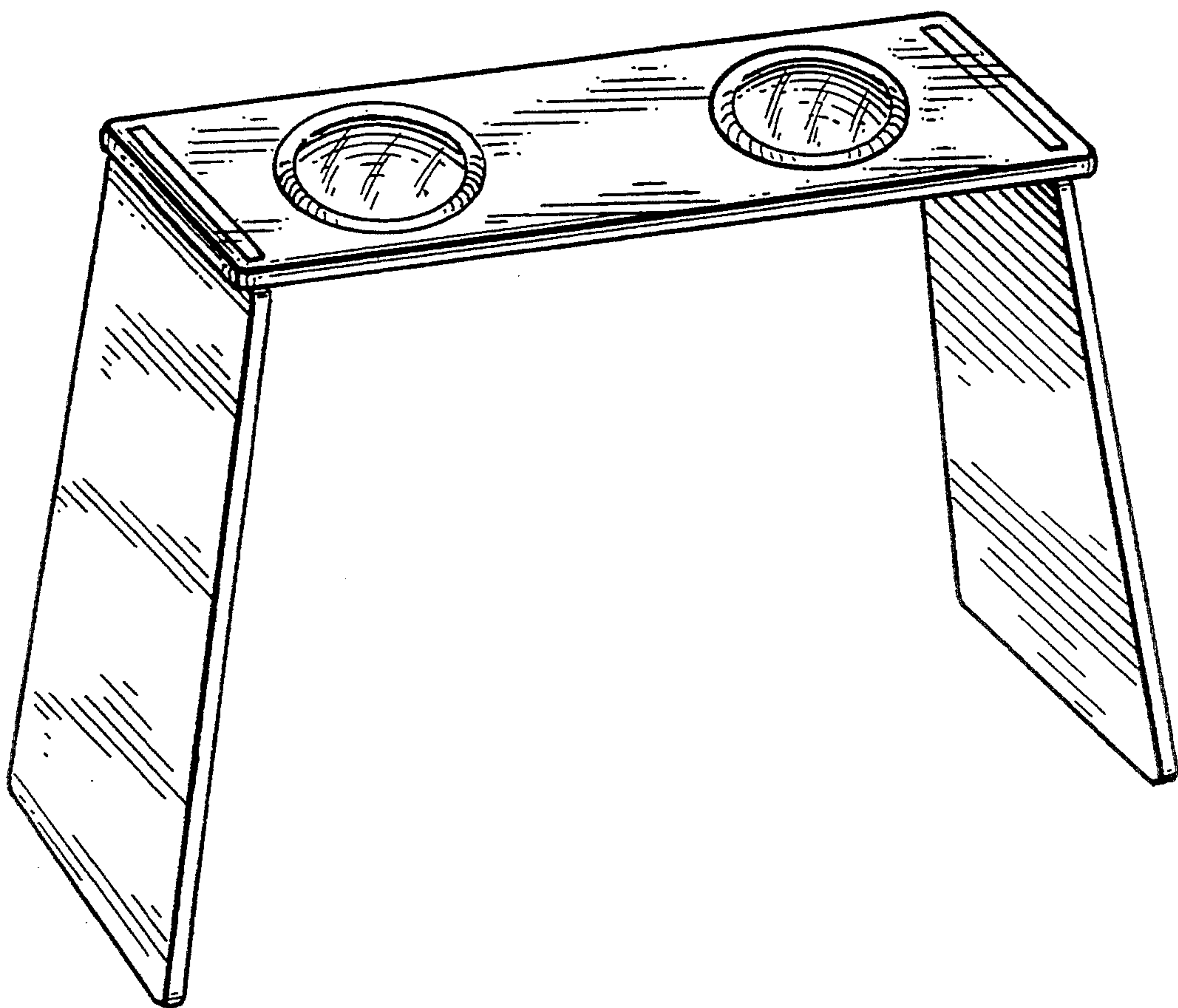

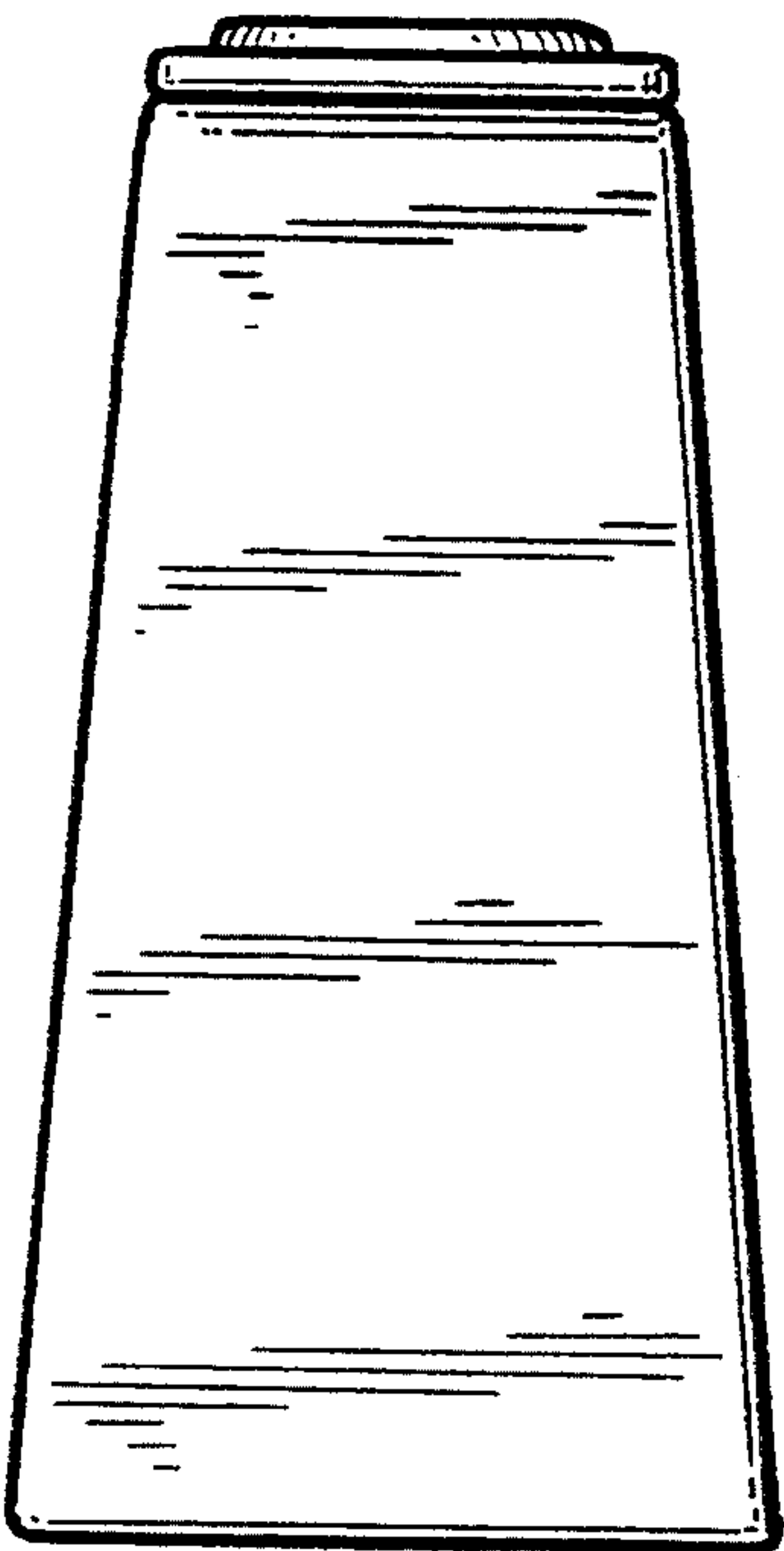

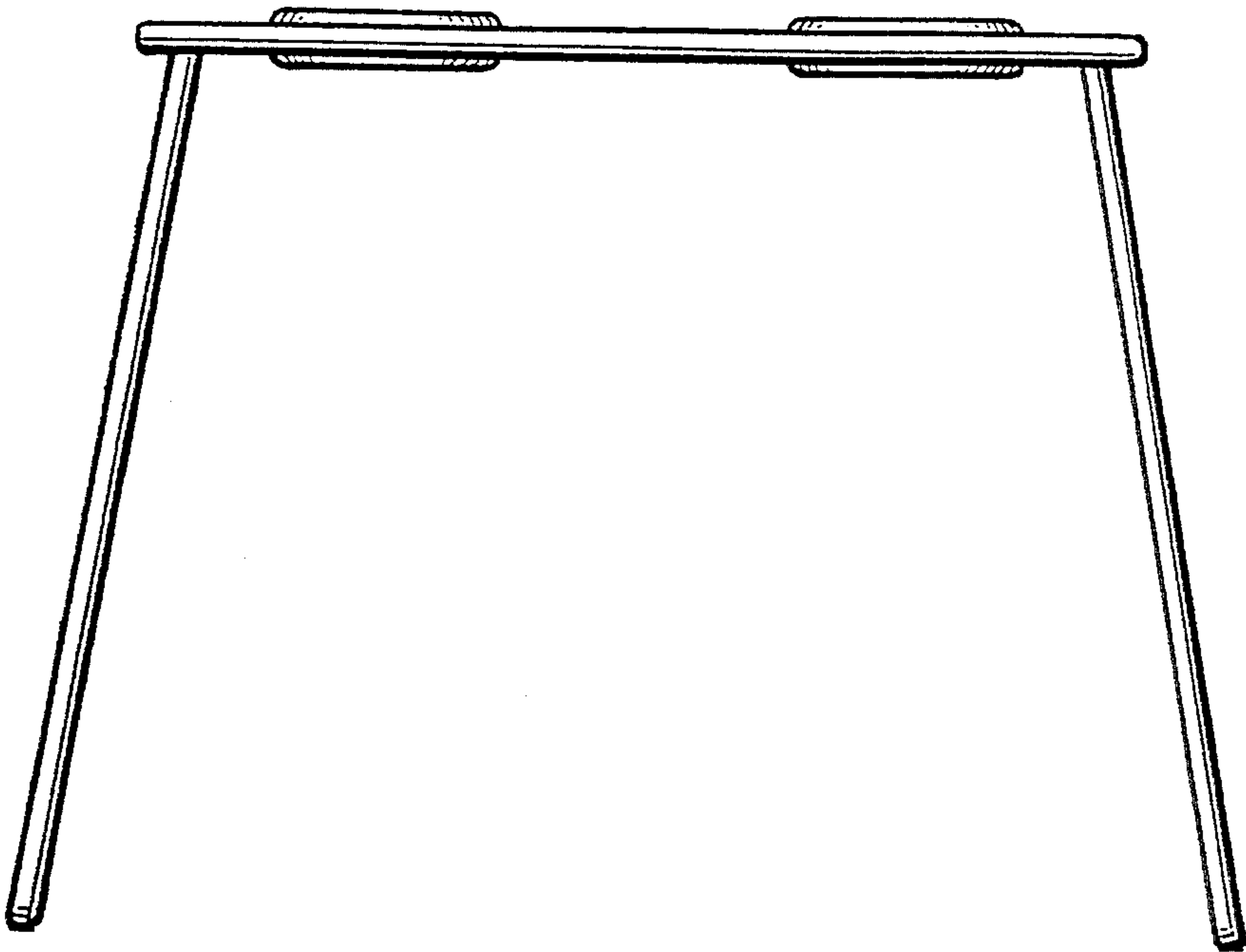

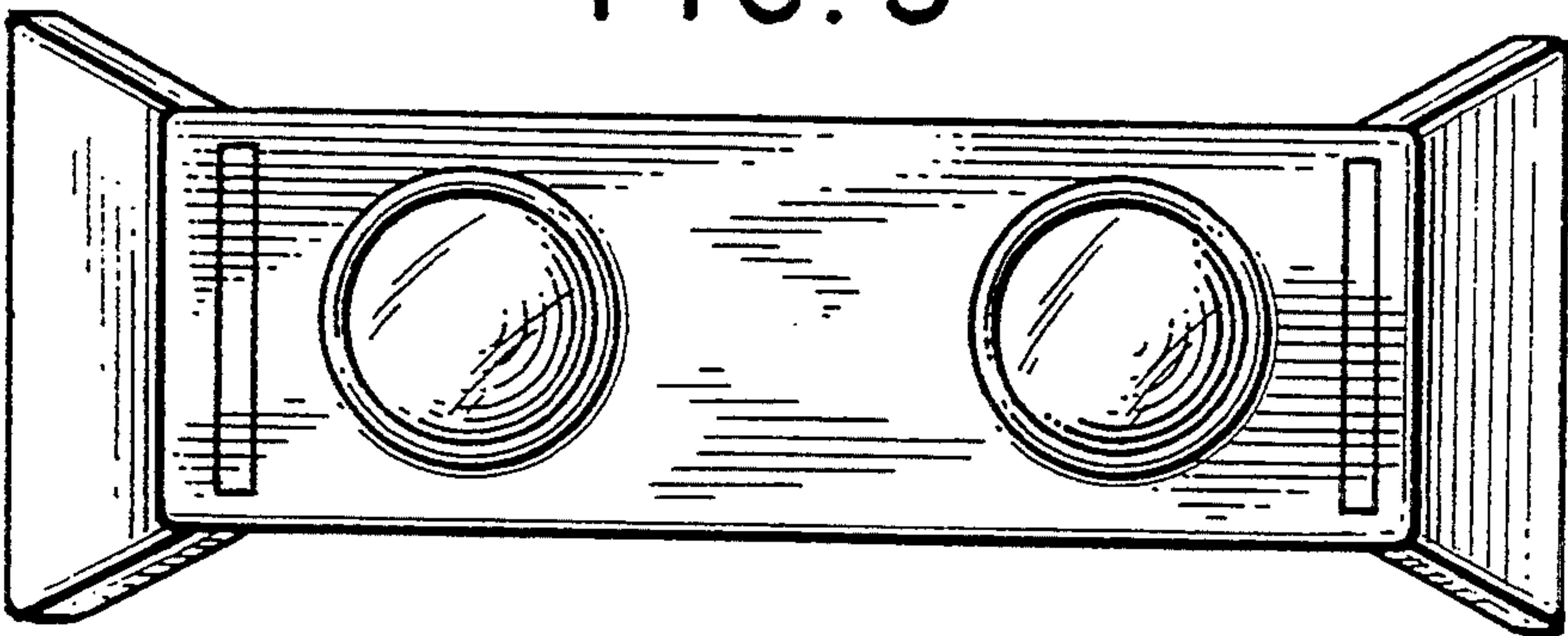
