### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bat for playing the game of buntball, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a bat for playing the game of buntball showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of a second embodiment of the bat as disclosed in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of FIG. 4;

FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of a third embodiment of the bat as disclosed in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of FIG. 7.

The bat has radial symmetry about its major axis.


















