DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a biohazardous waste container according to my invention, the rear view being identical thereto;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof.

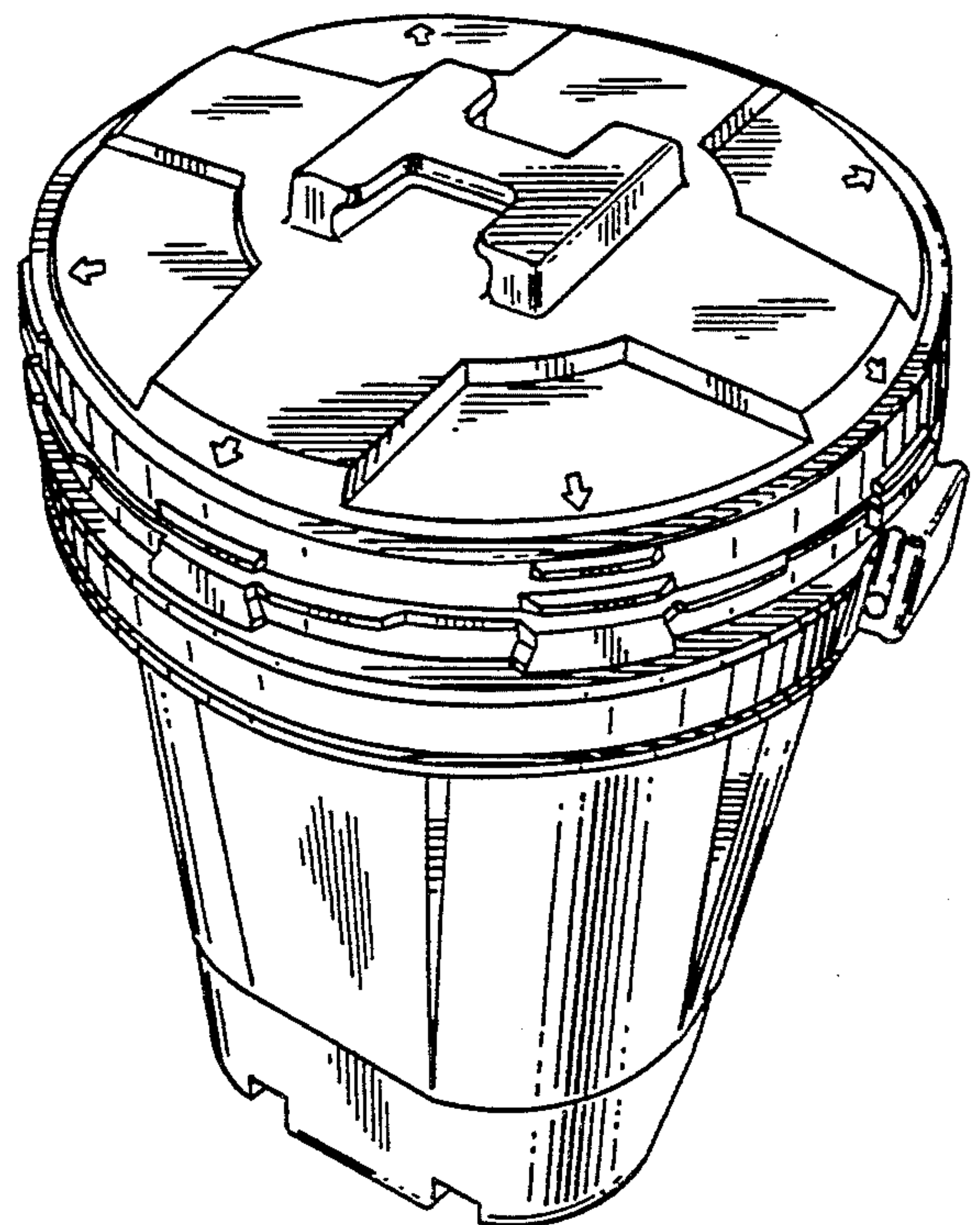
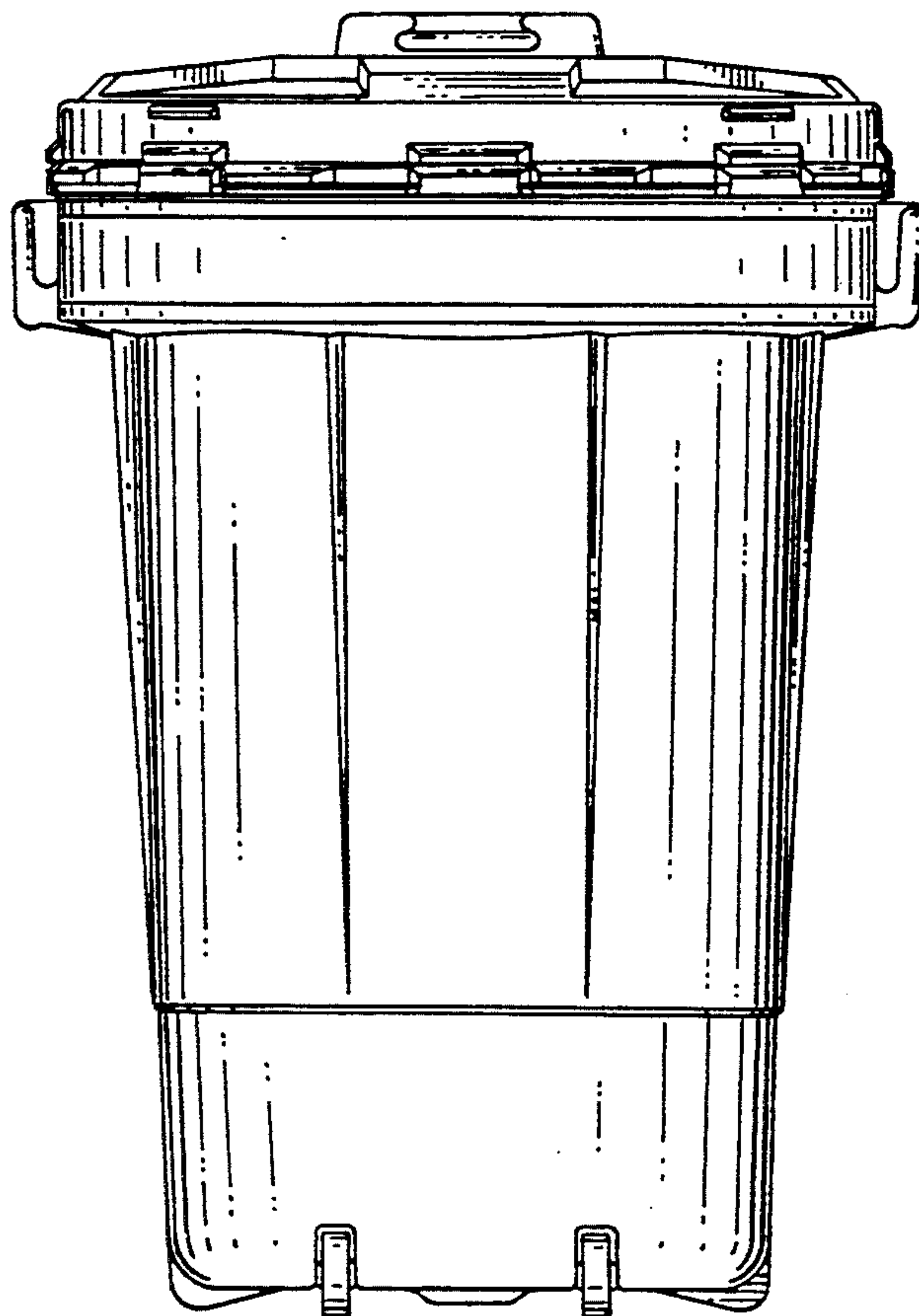

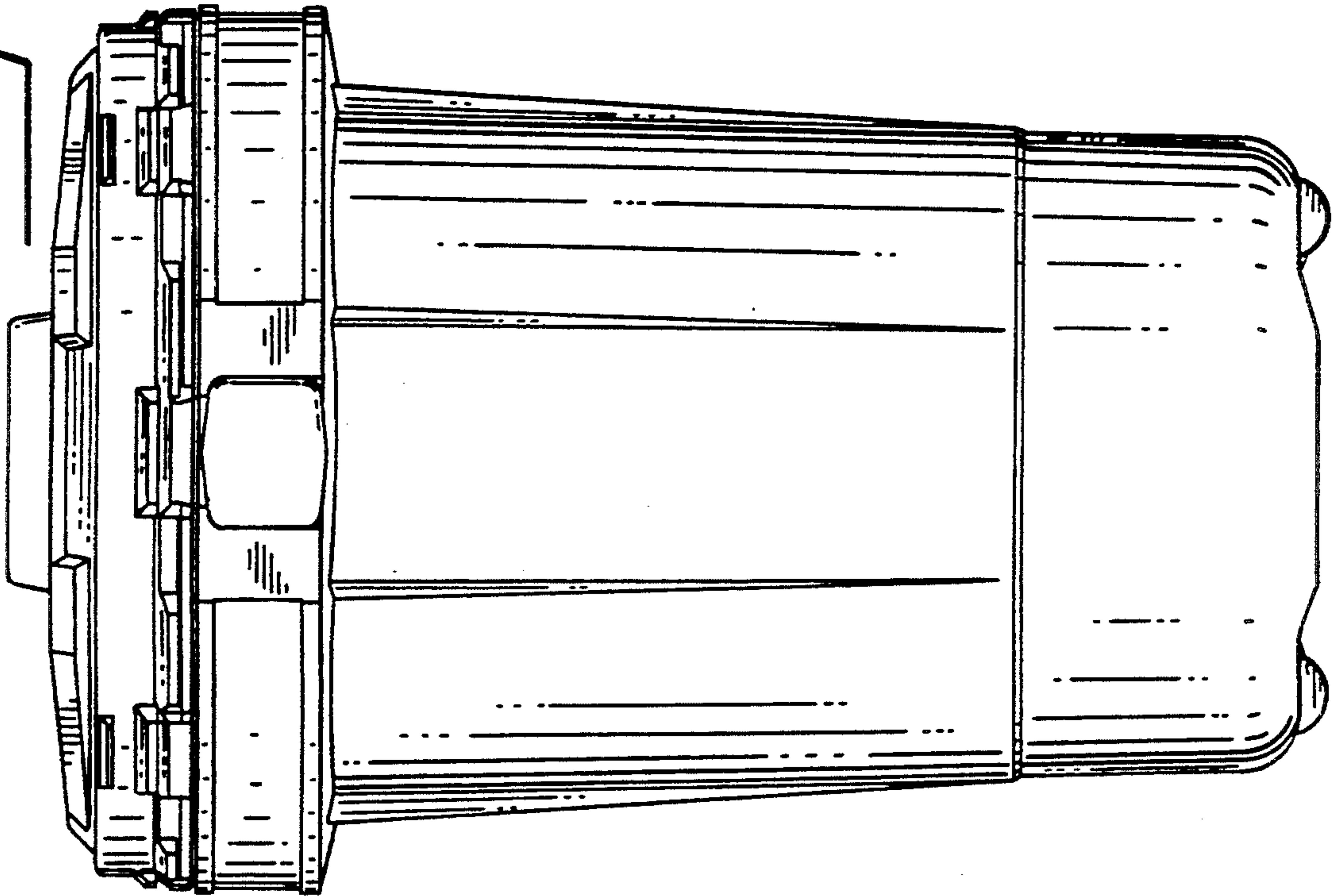

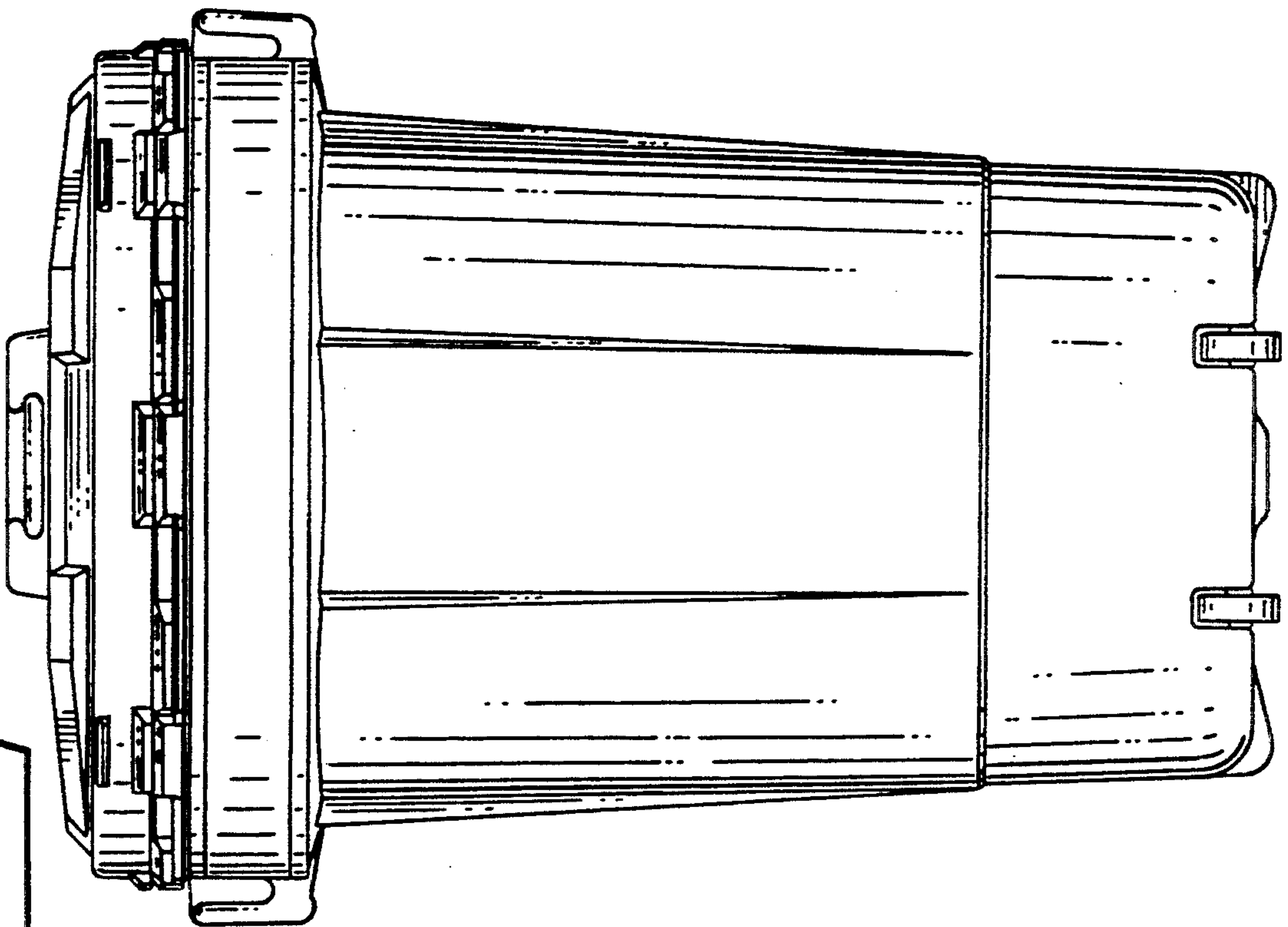

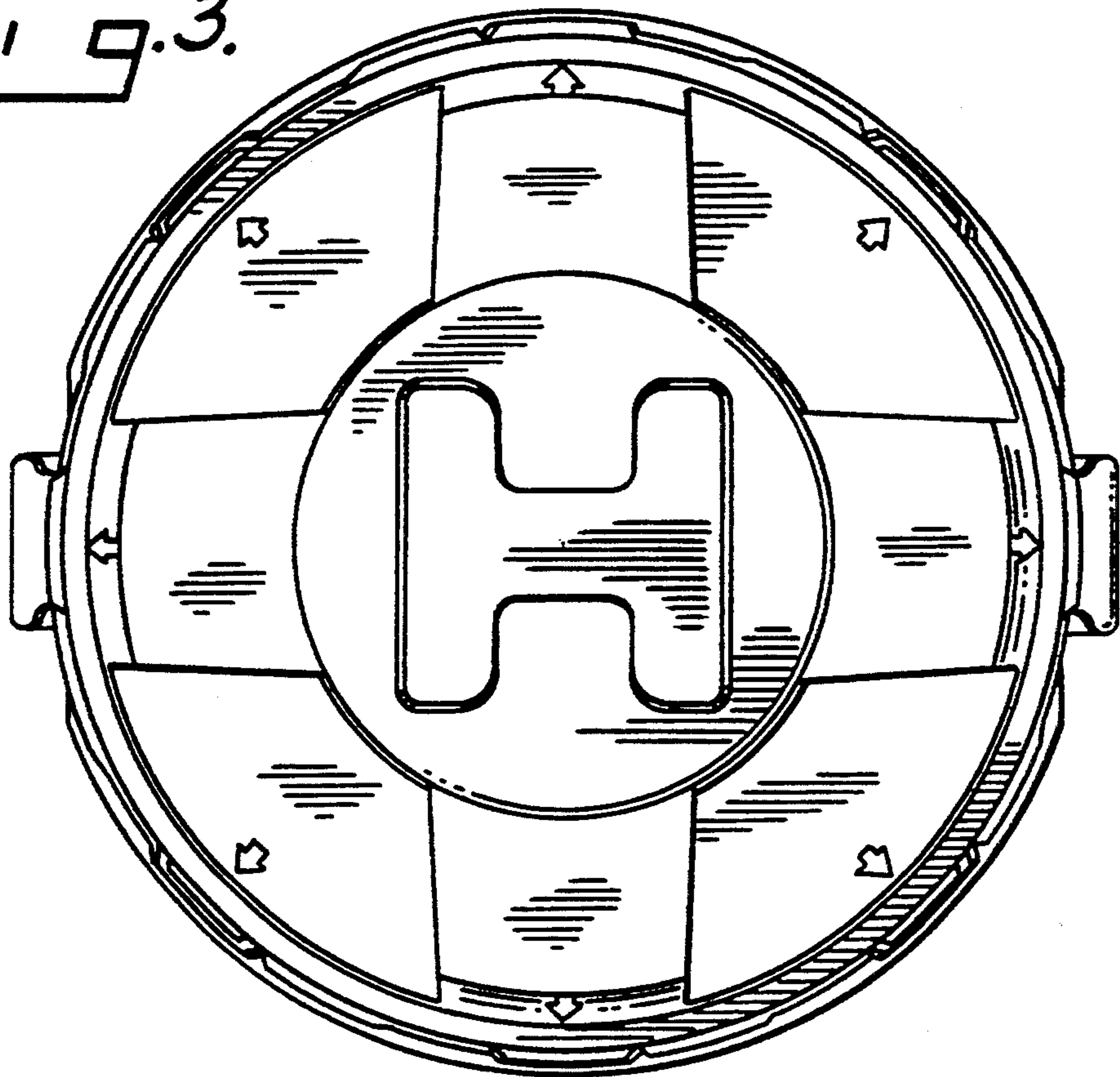

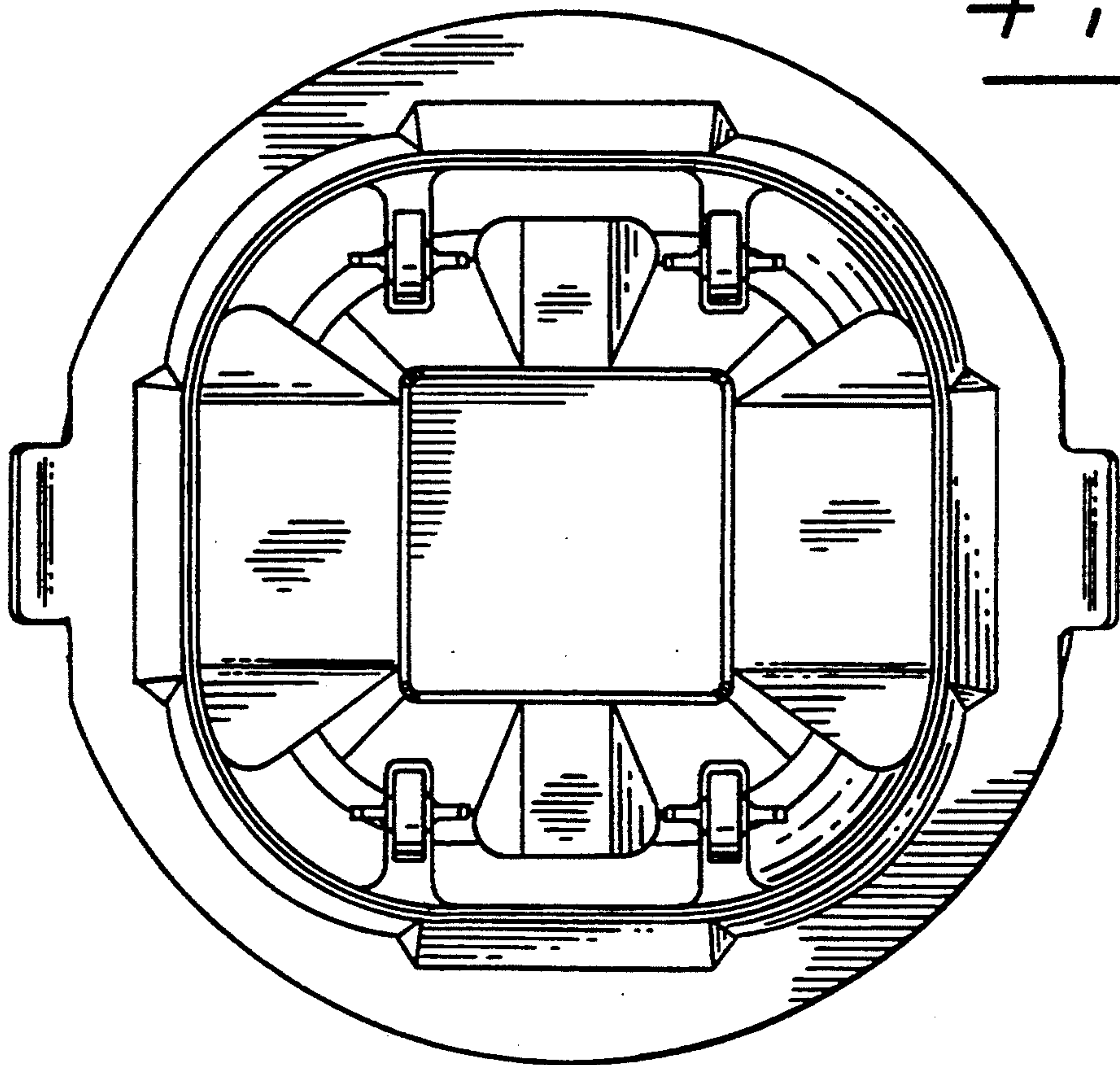
