FIG. 1 is a perspective rear view of the desk showing our new design;


FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front view thereof; and,


FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the ornamental detail of the desk.
