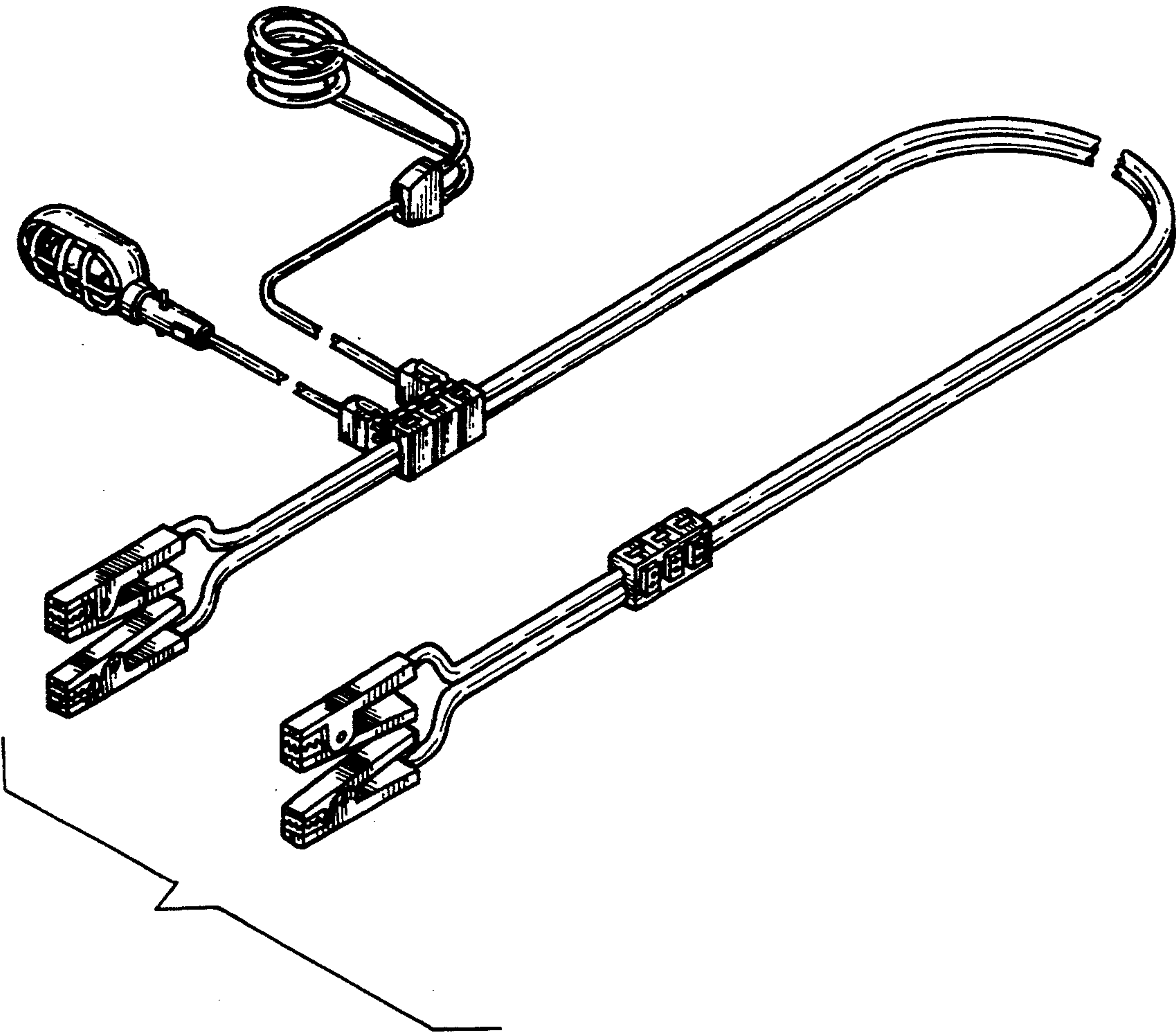
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view shown in FIG. 6.

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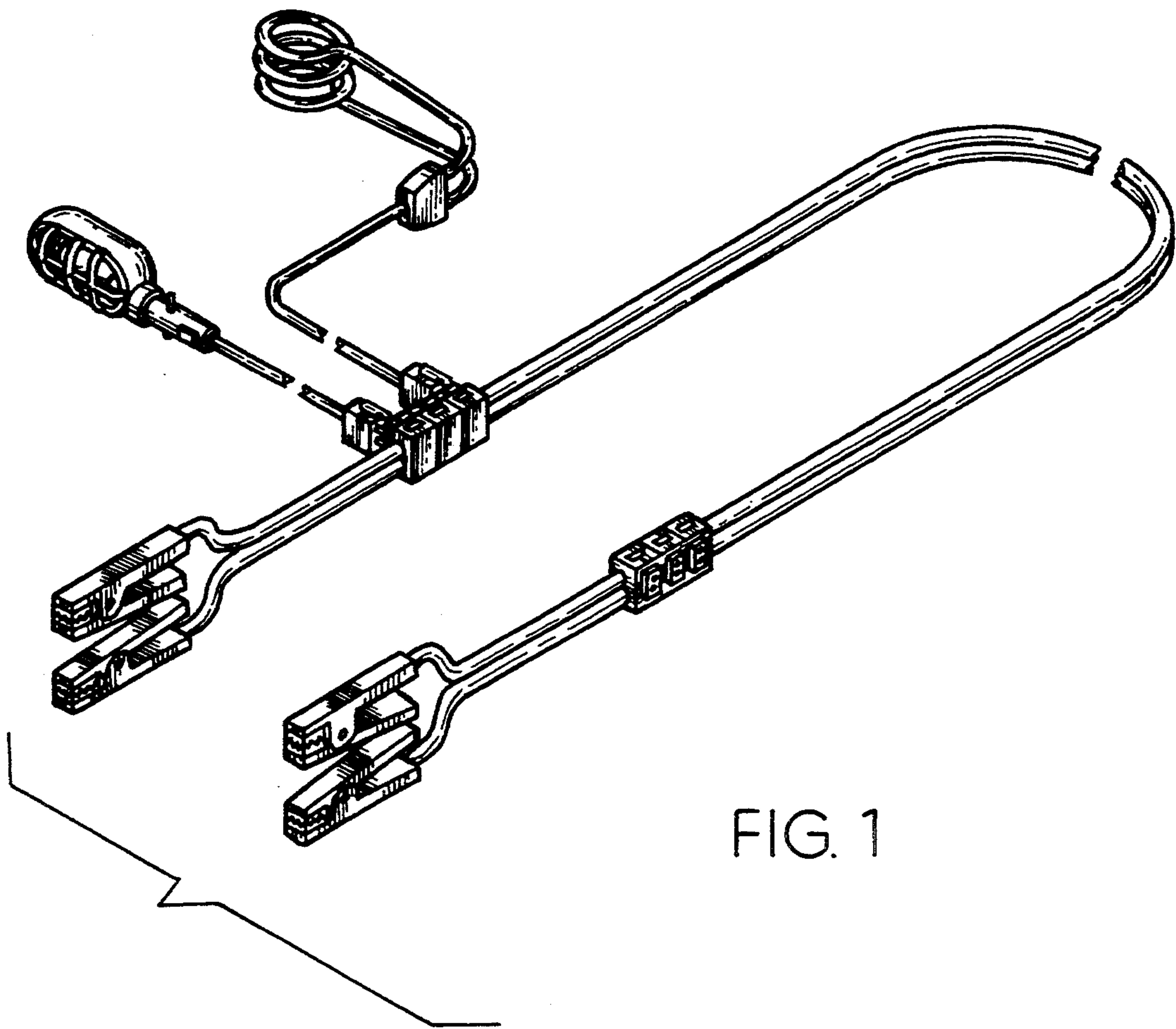

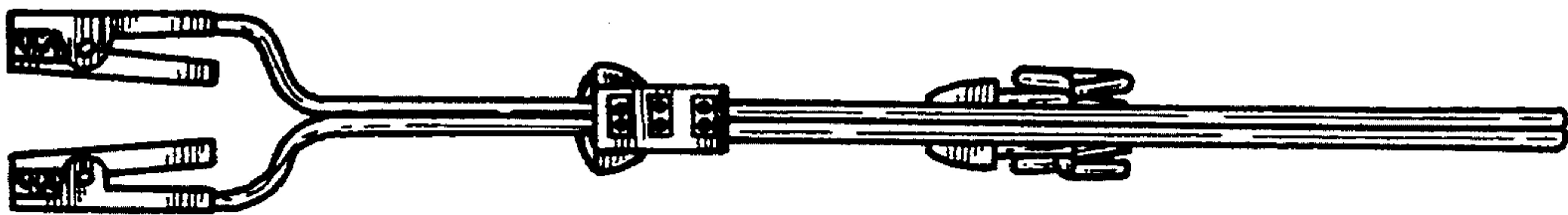

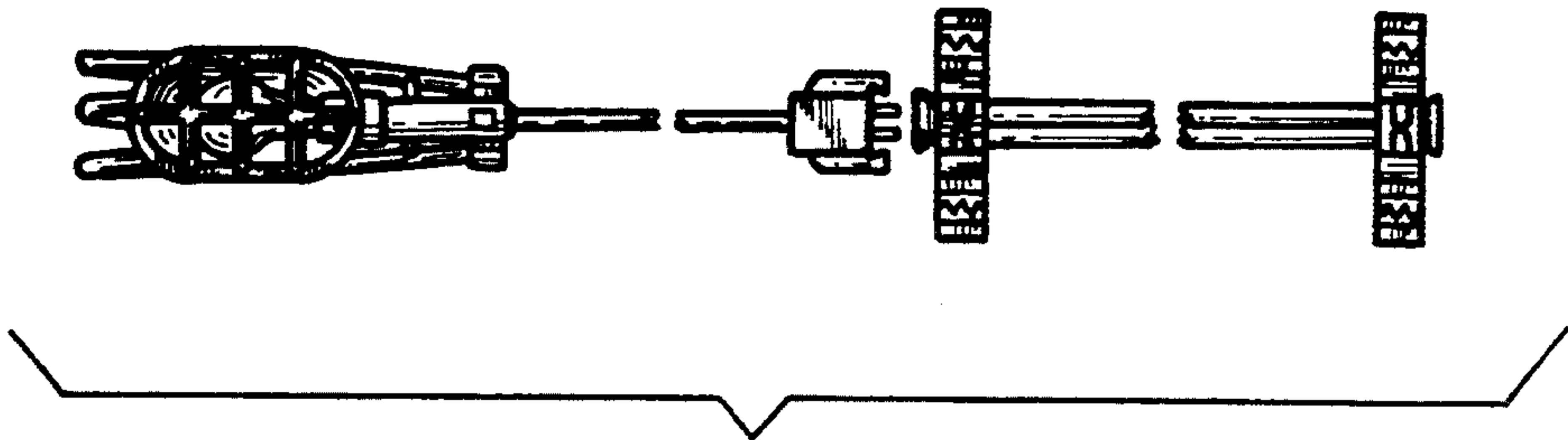

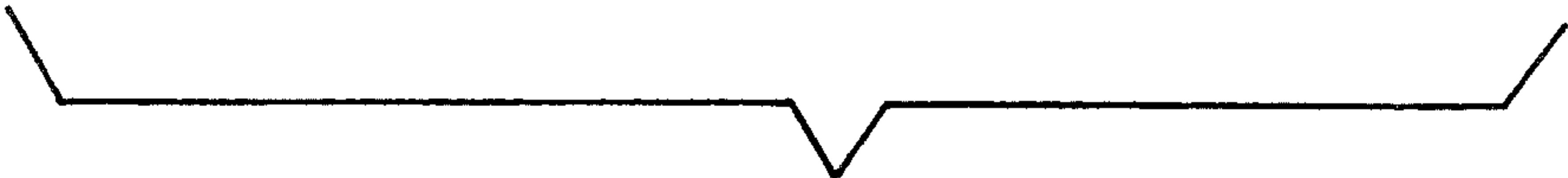
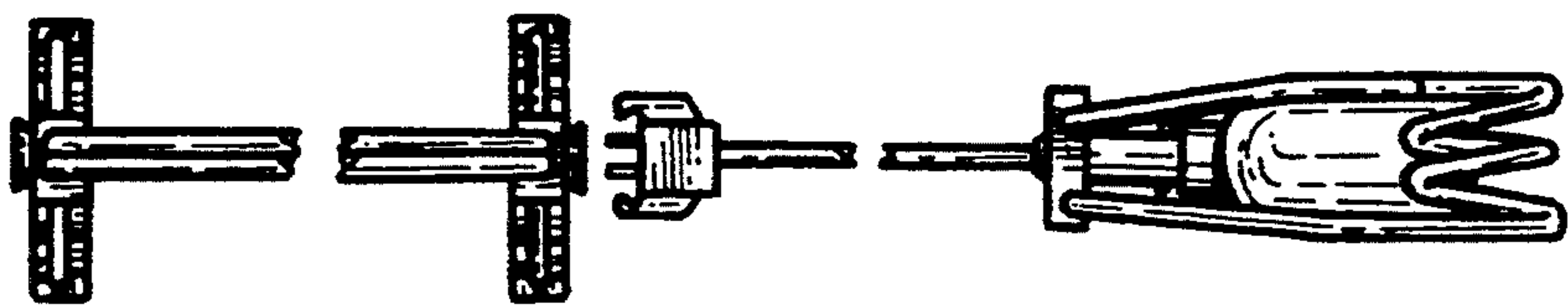
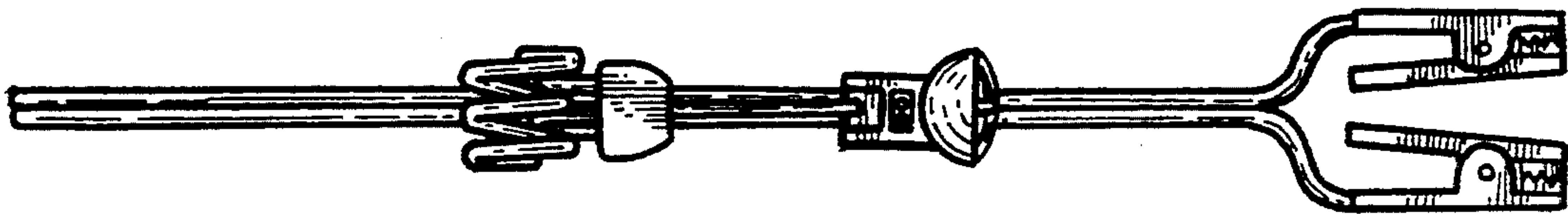

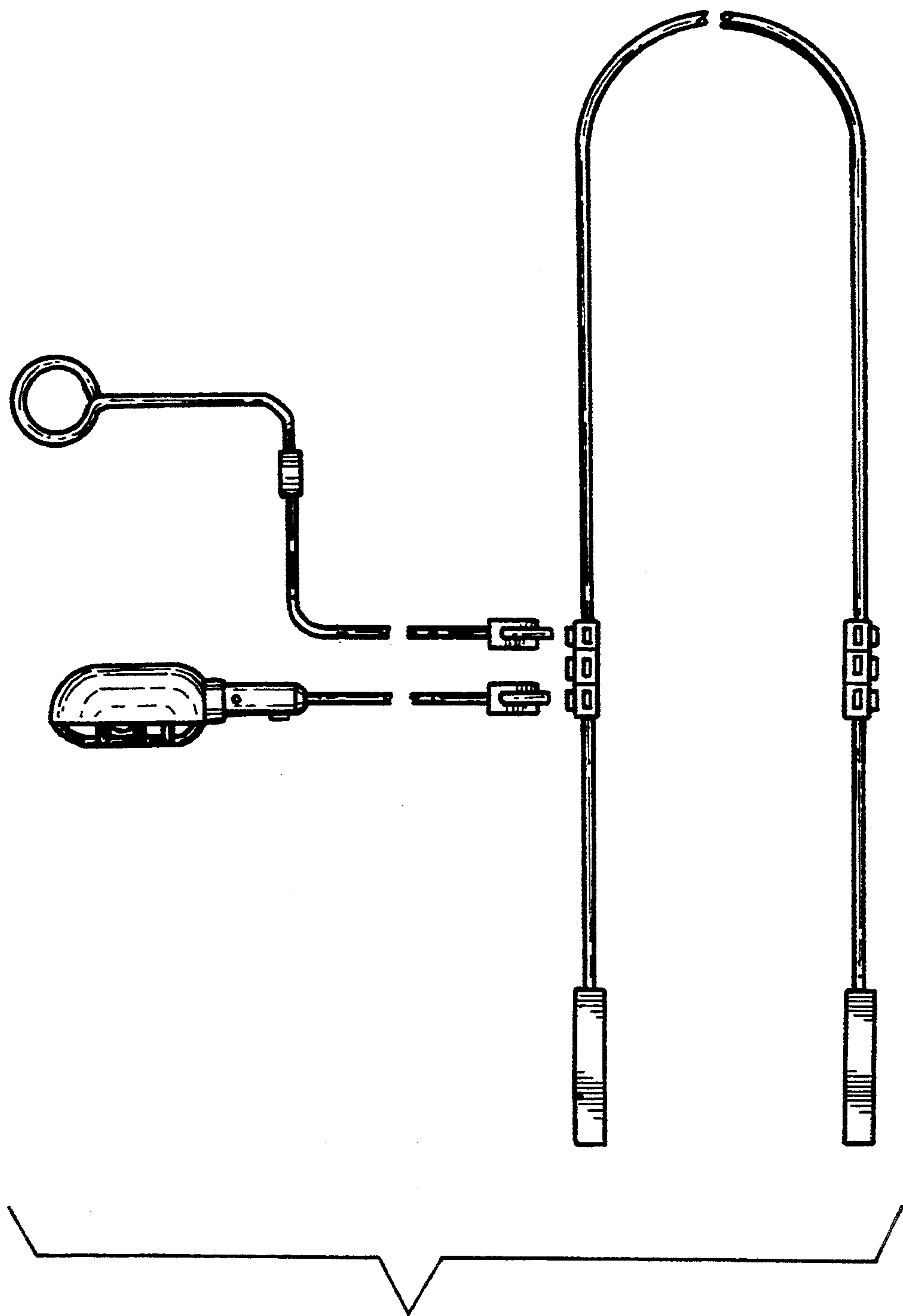
