FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of the multipurpose highchair of FIG. 7;

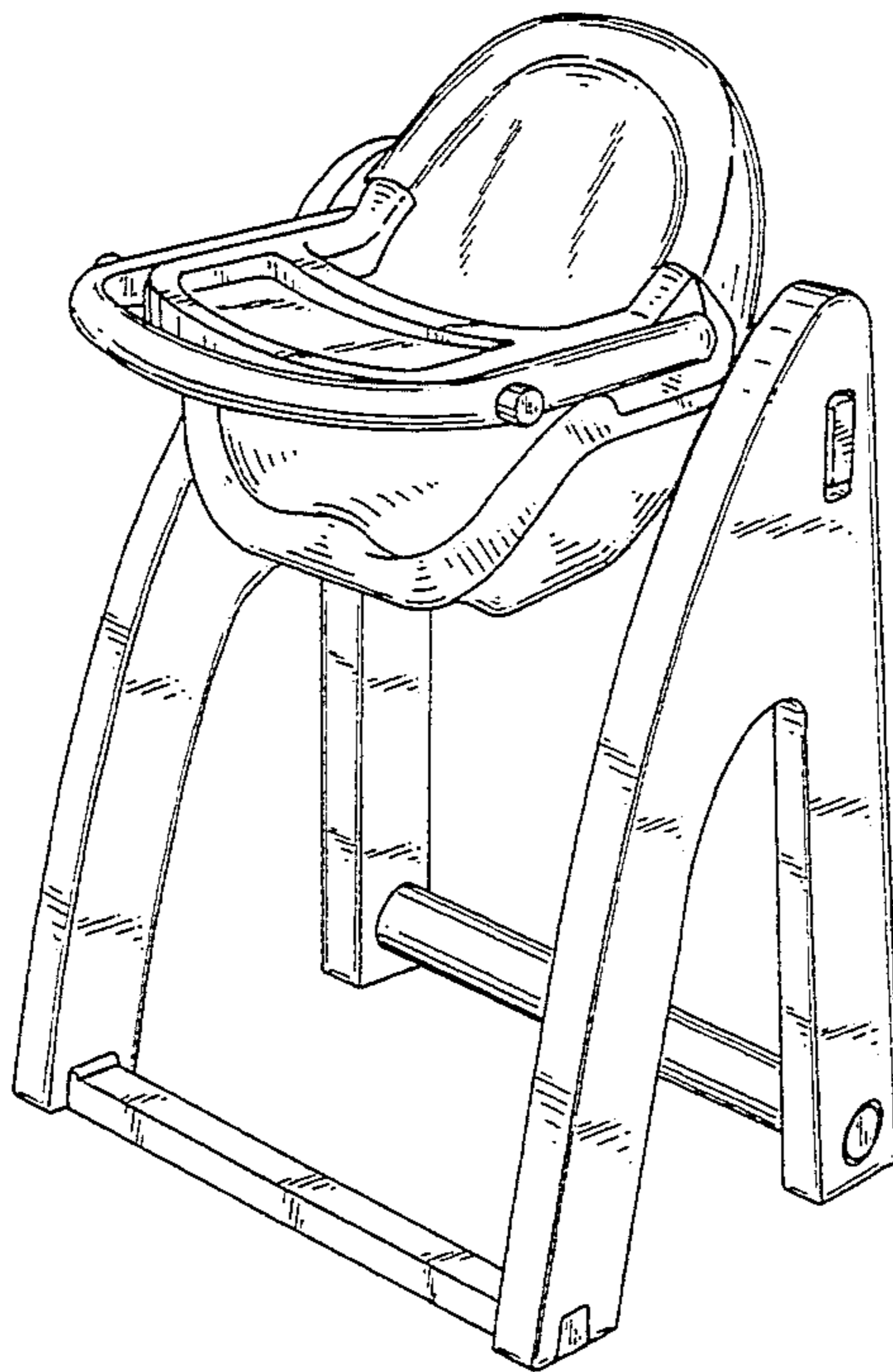
FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the multipurpose highchair of FIG. 7; and,

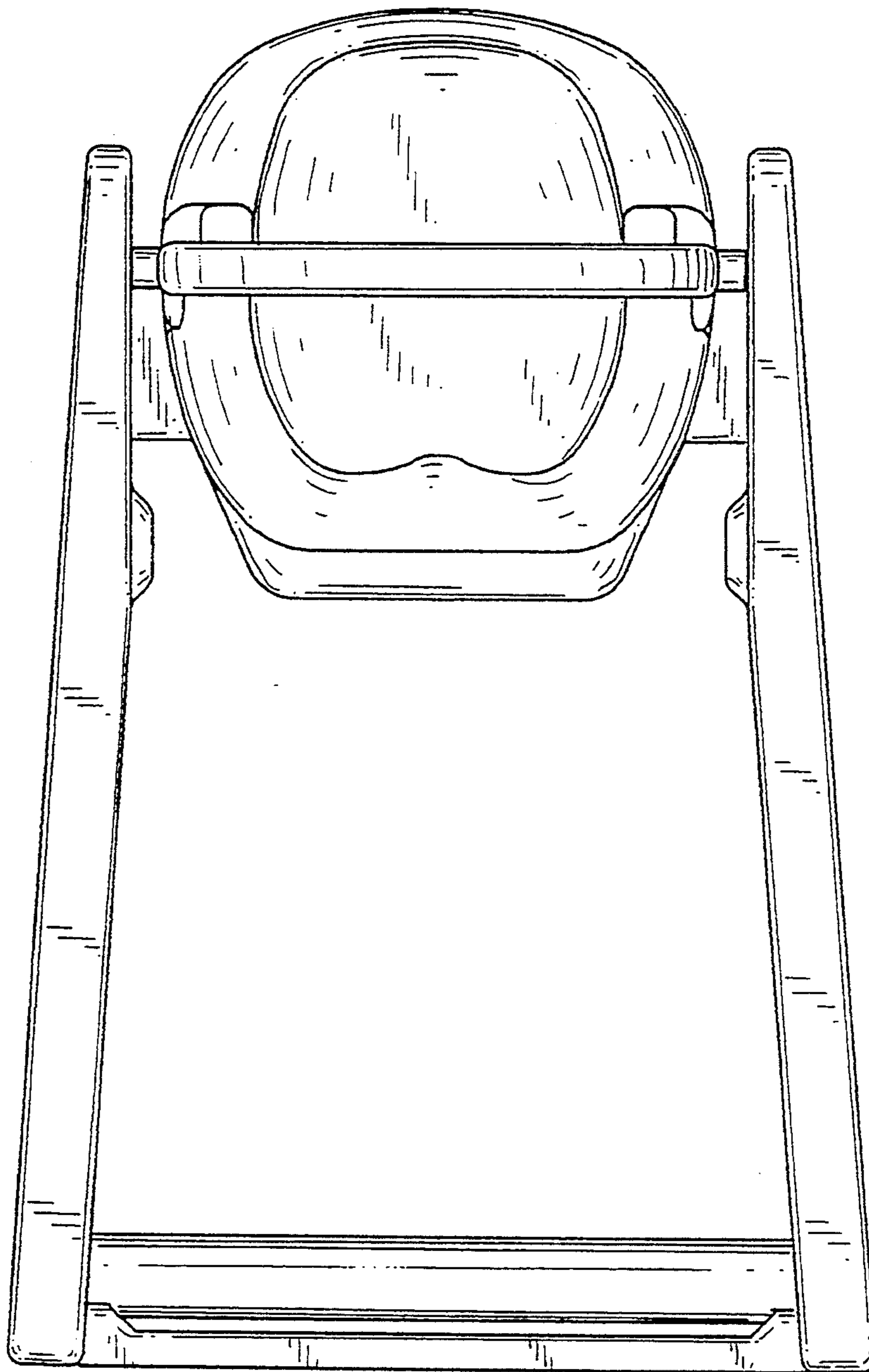

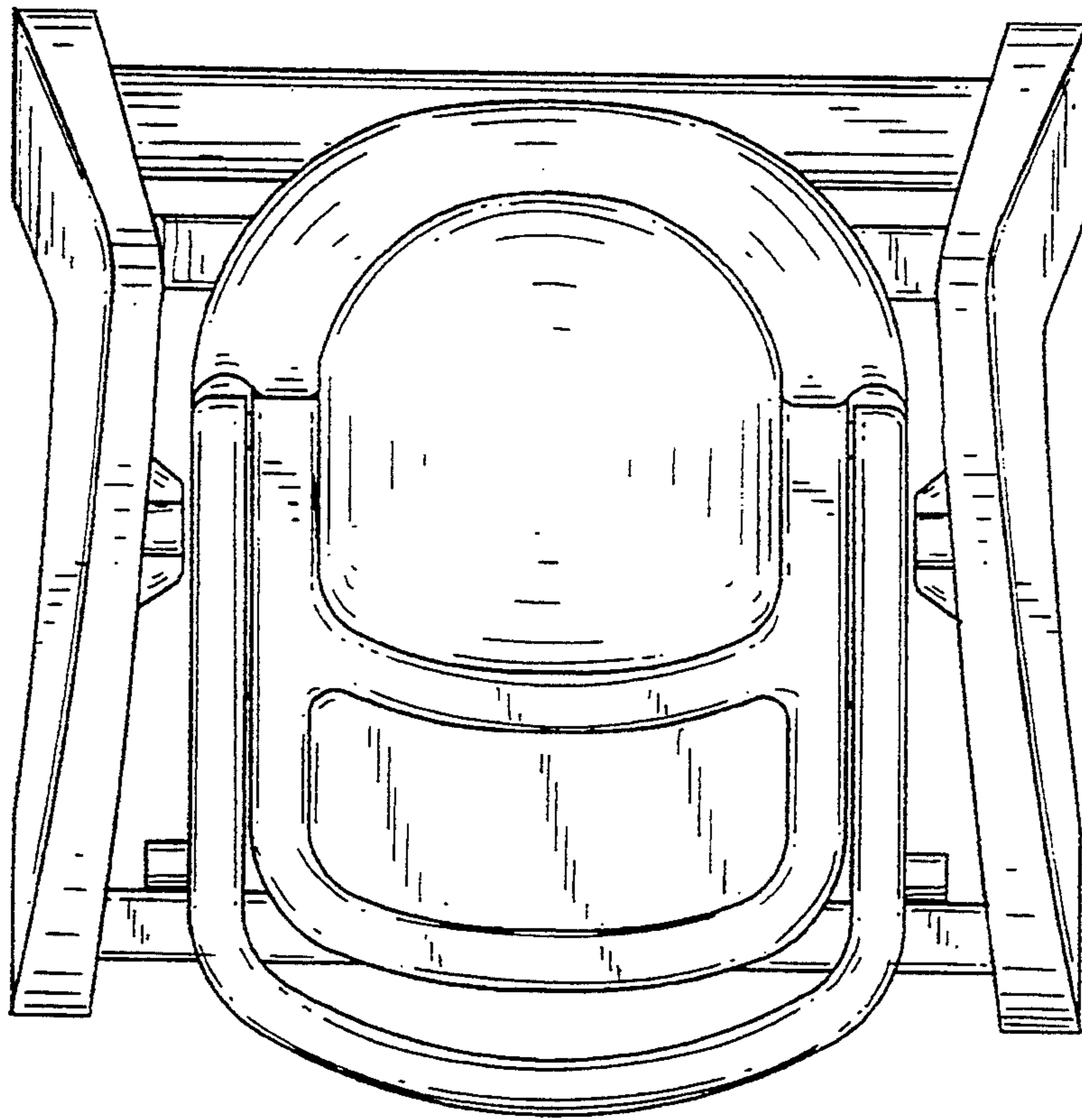

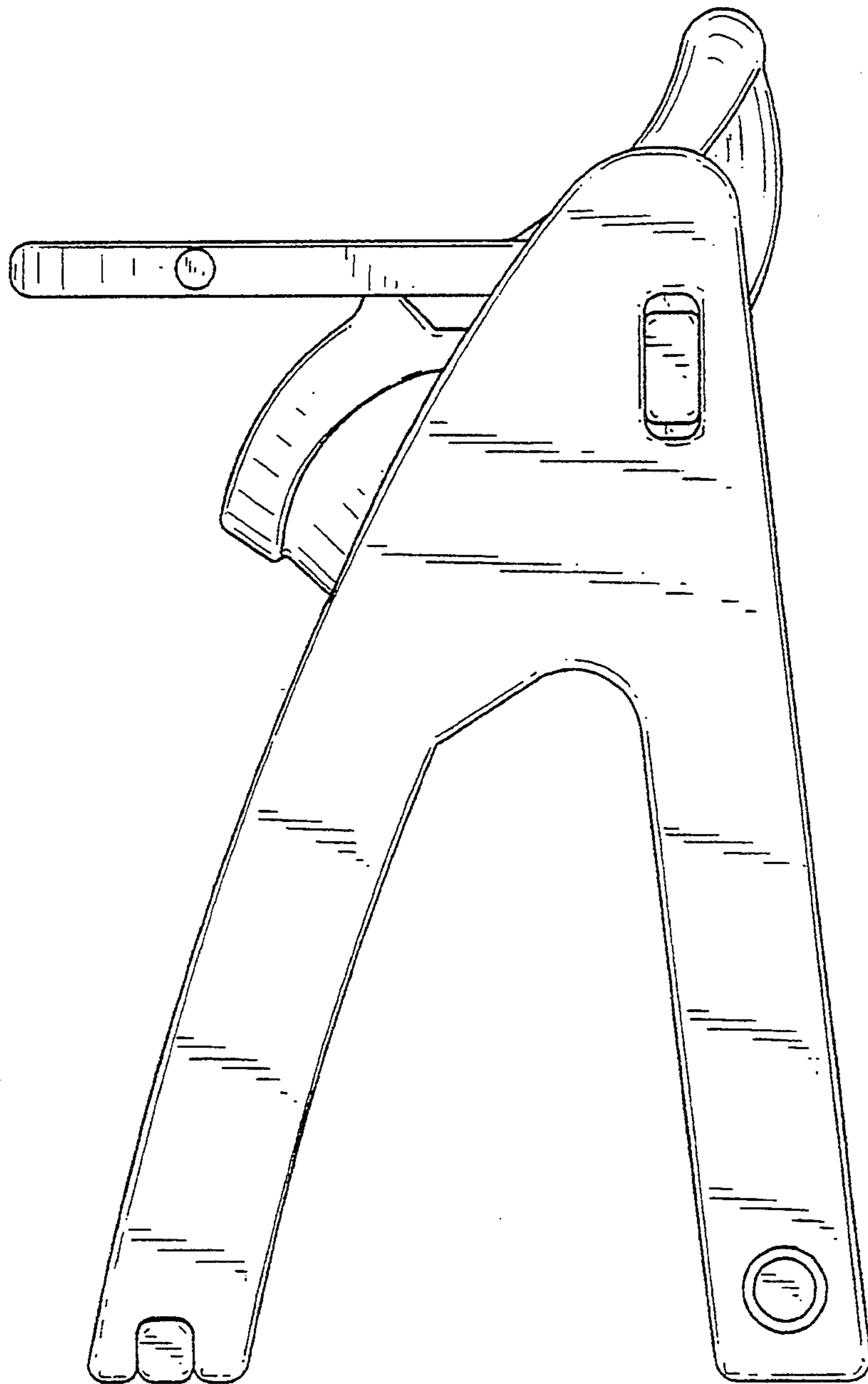

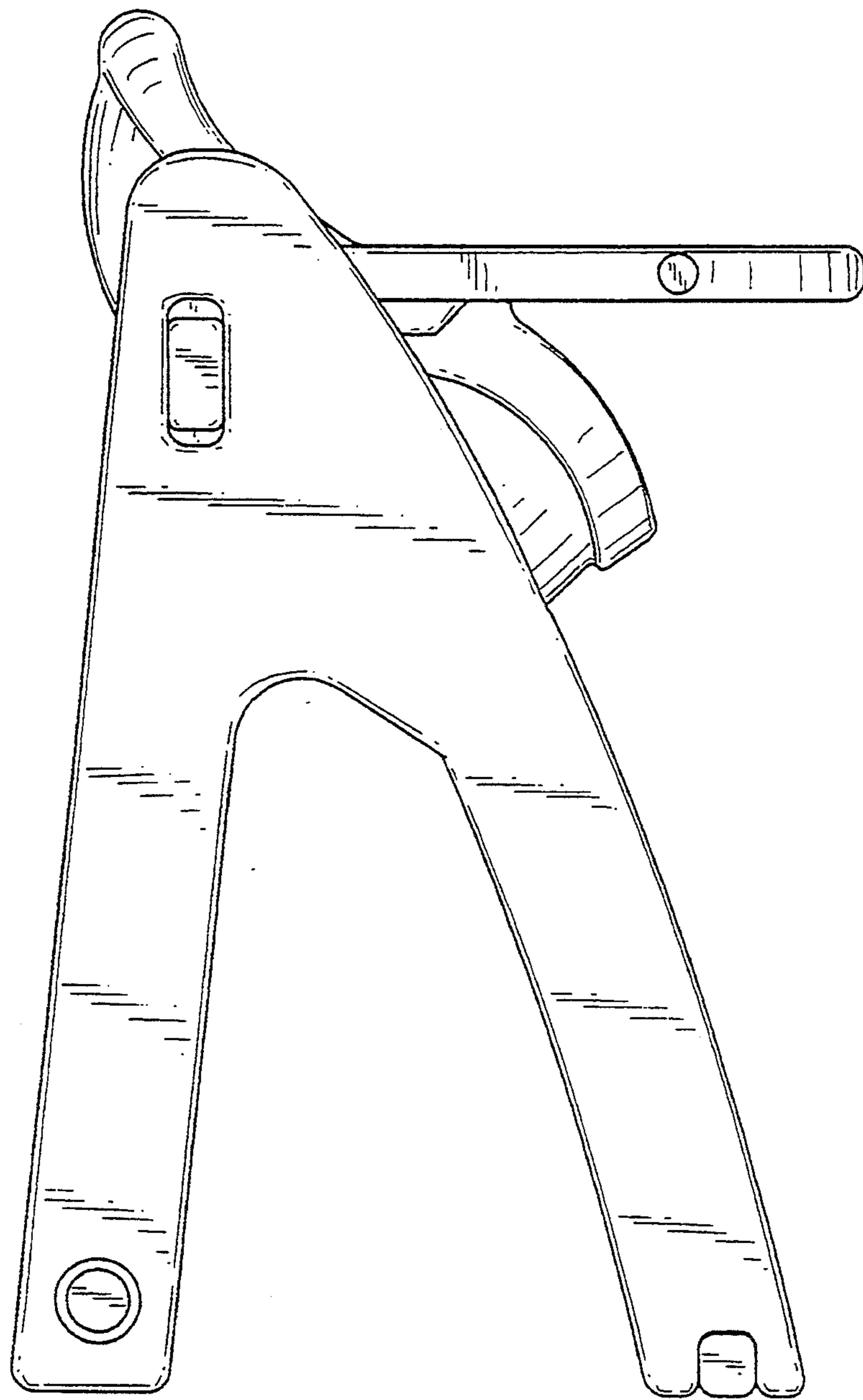

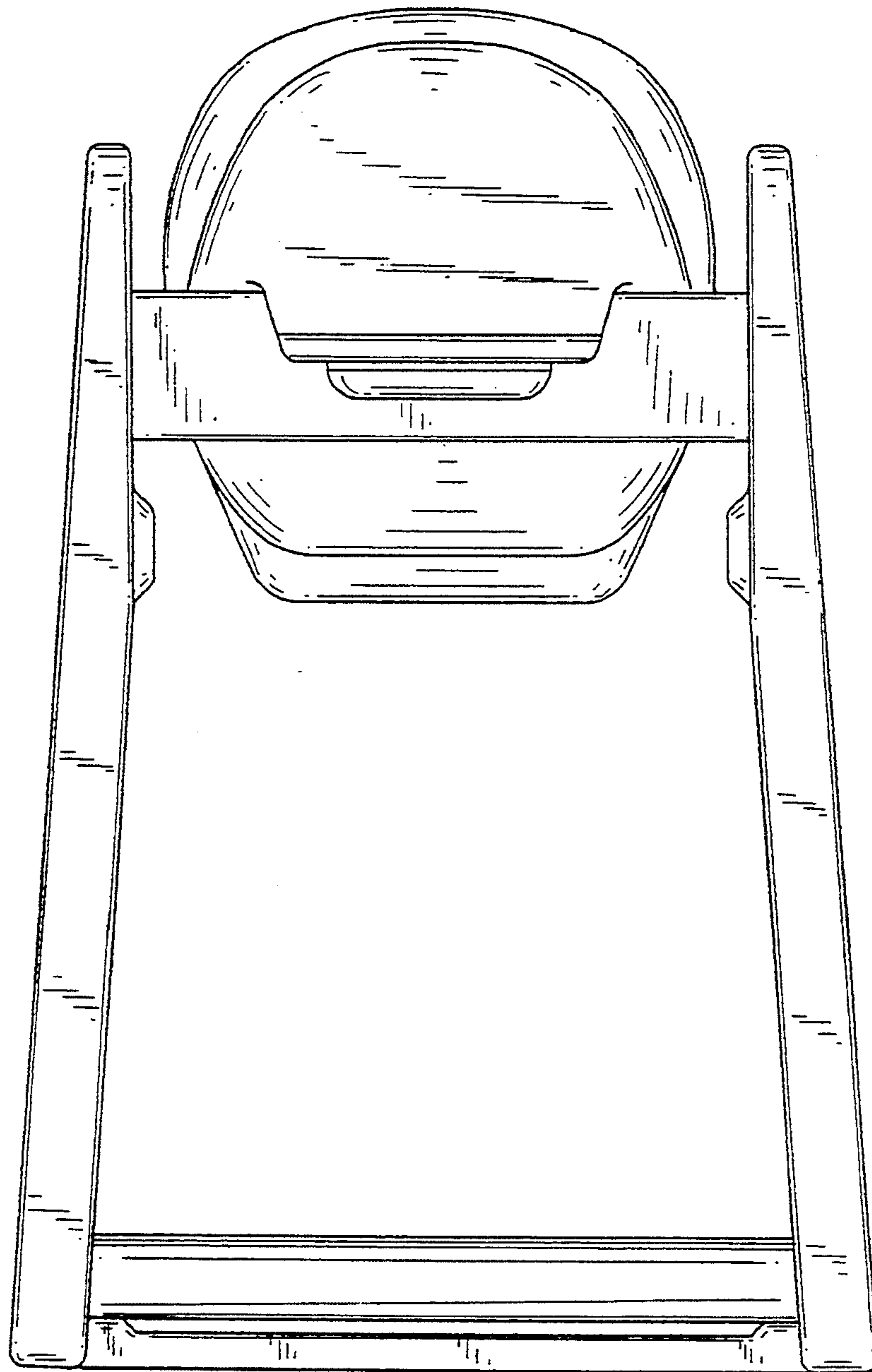

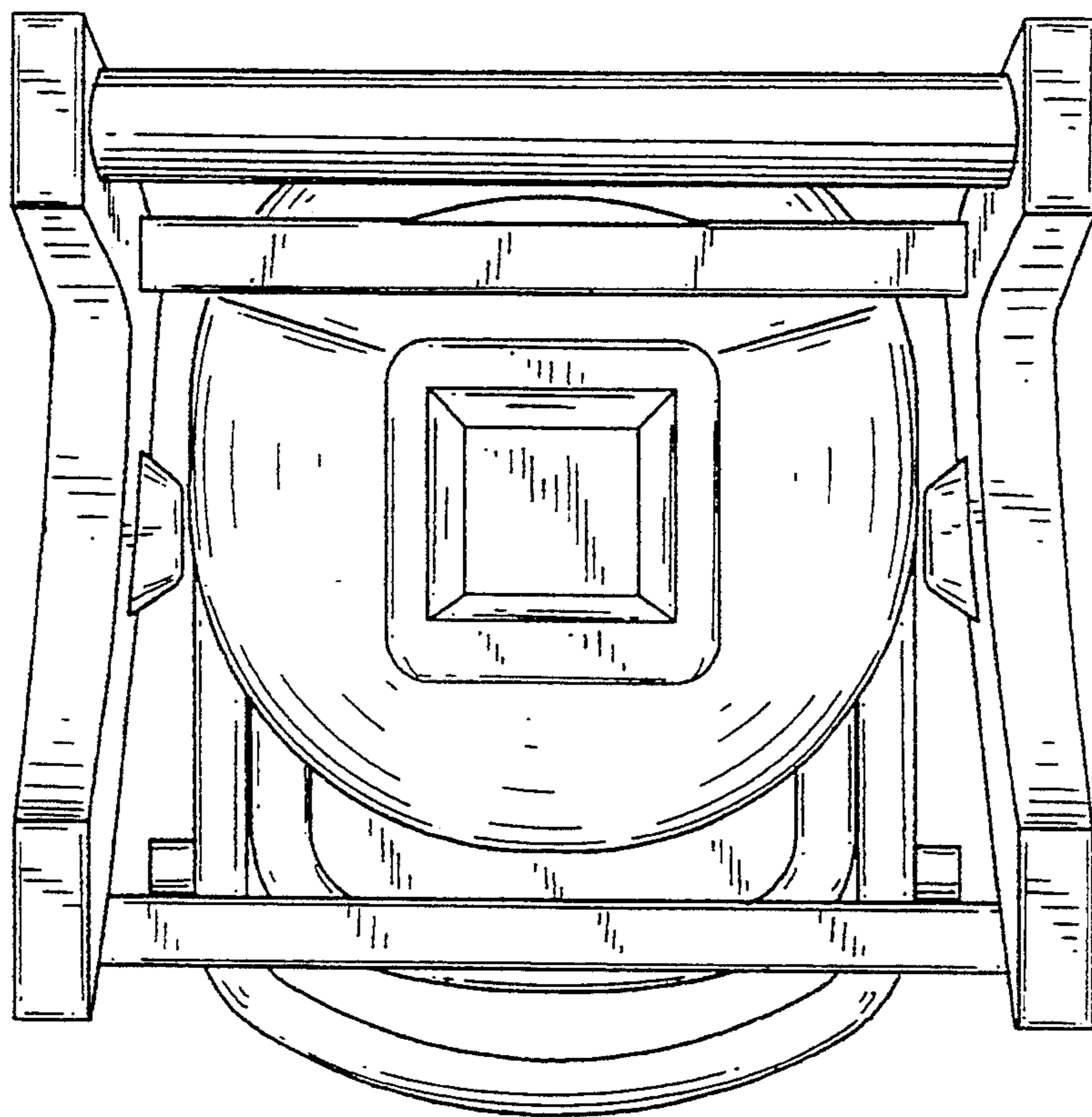

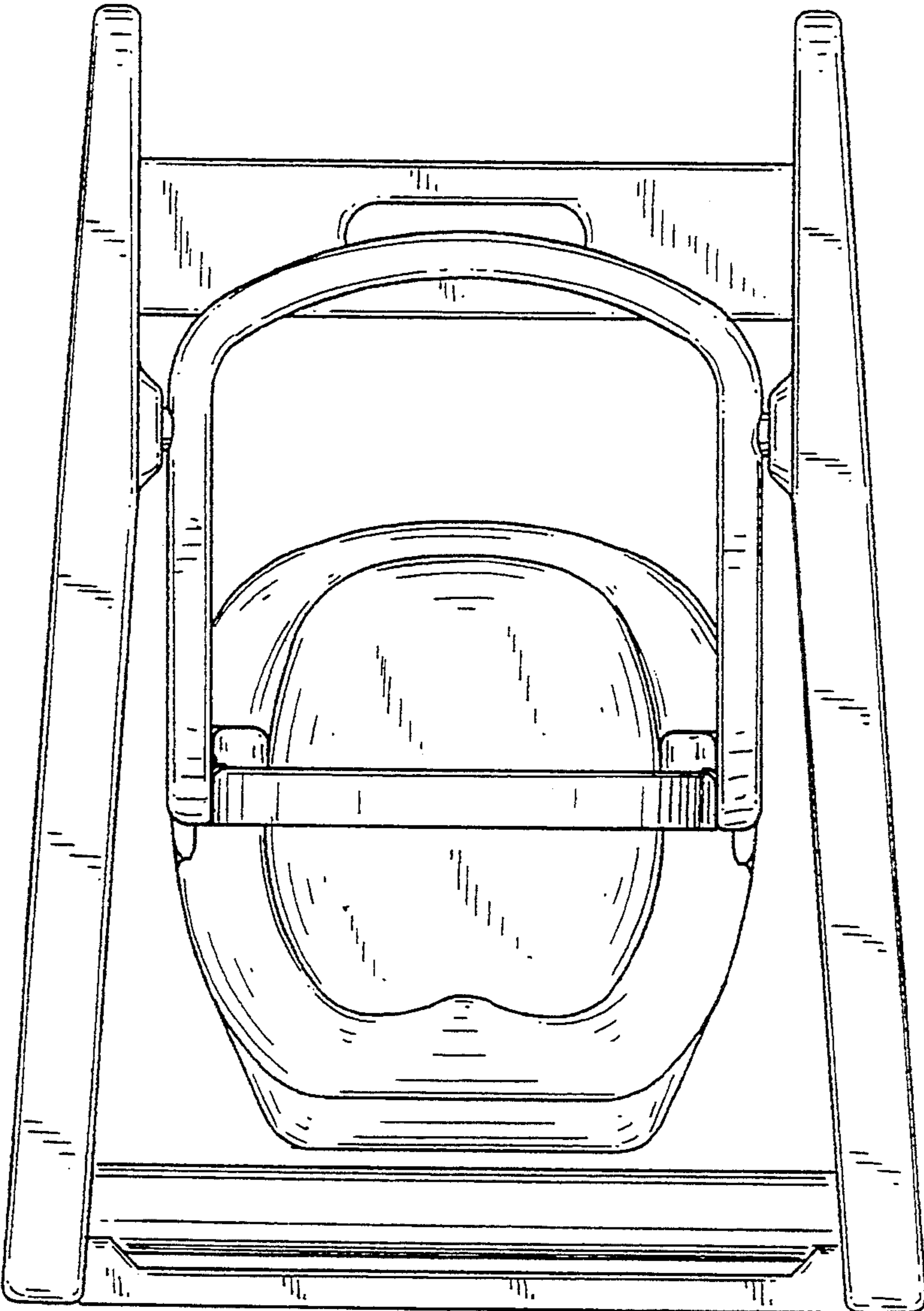

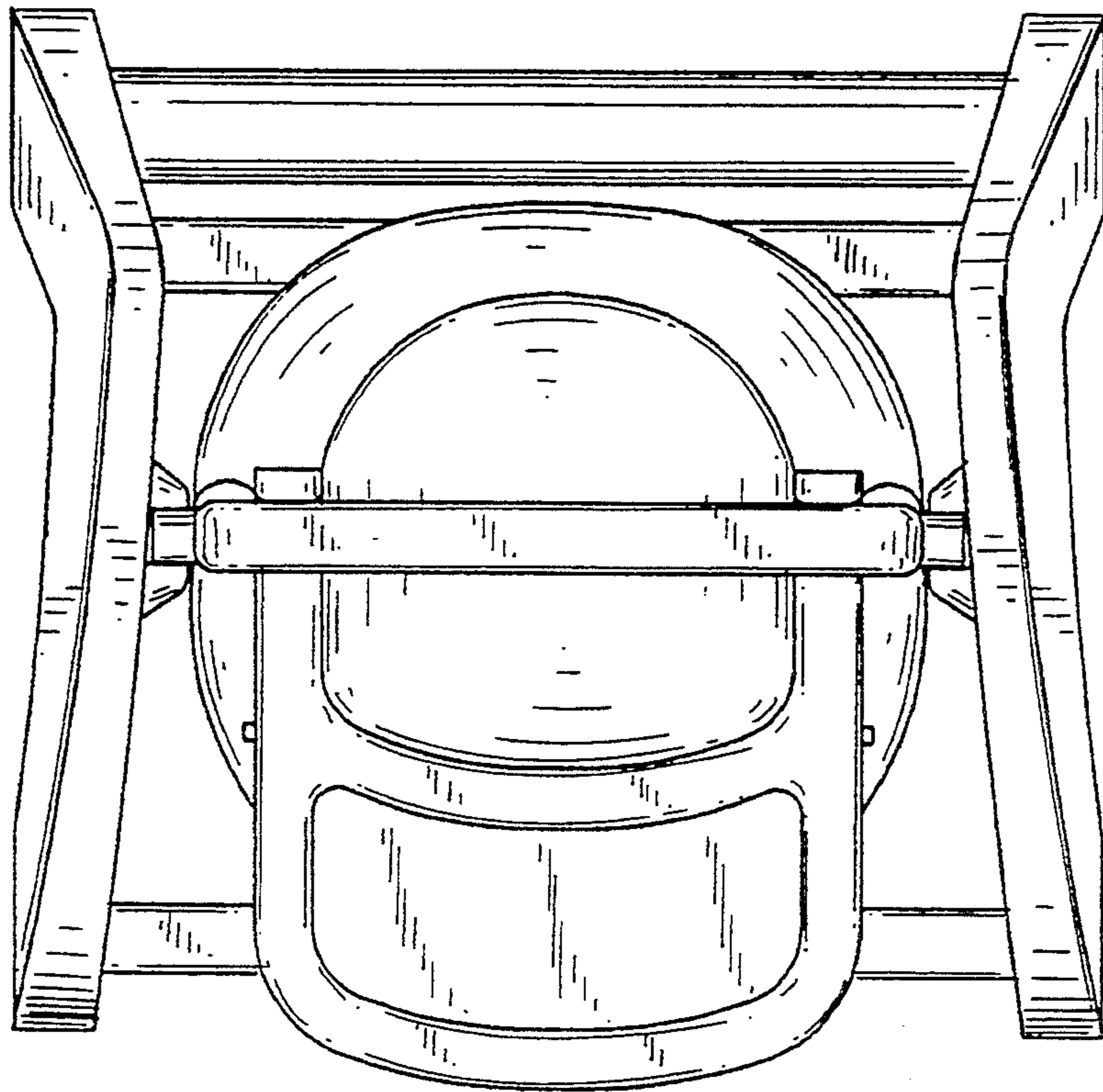

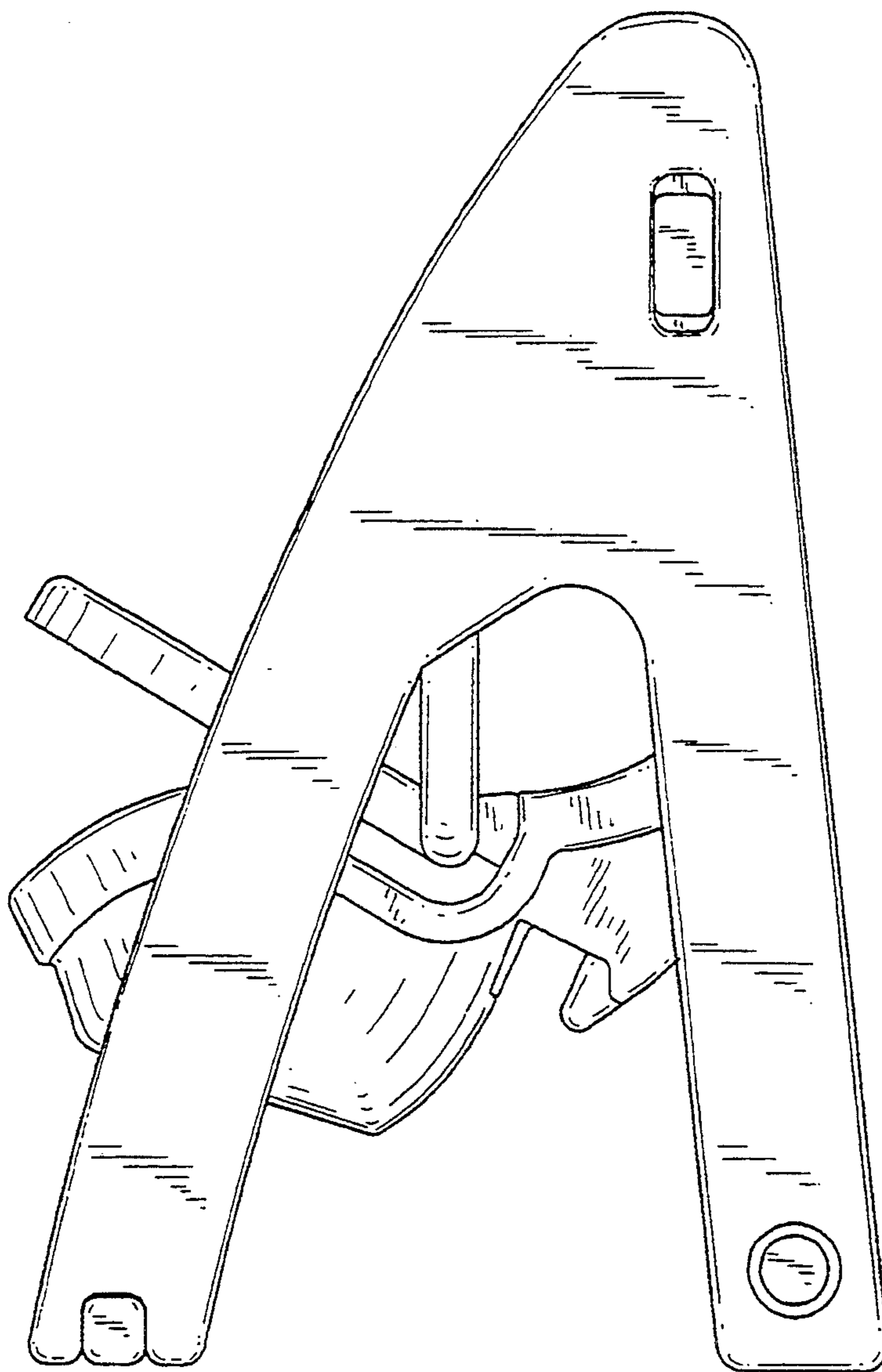

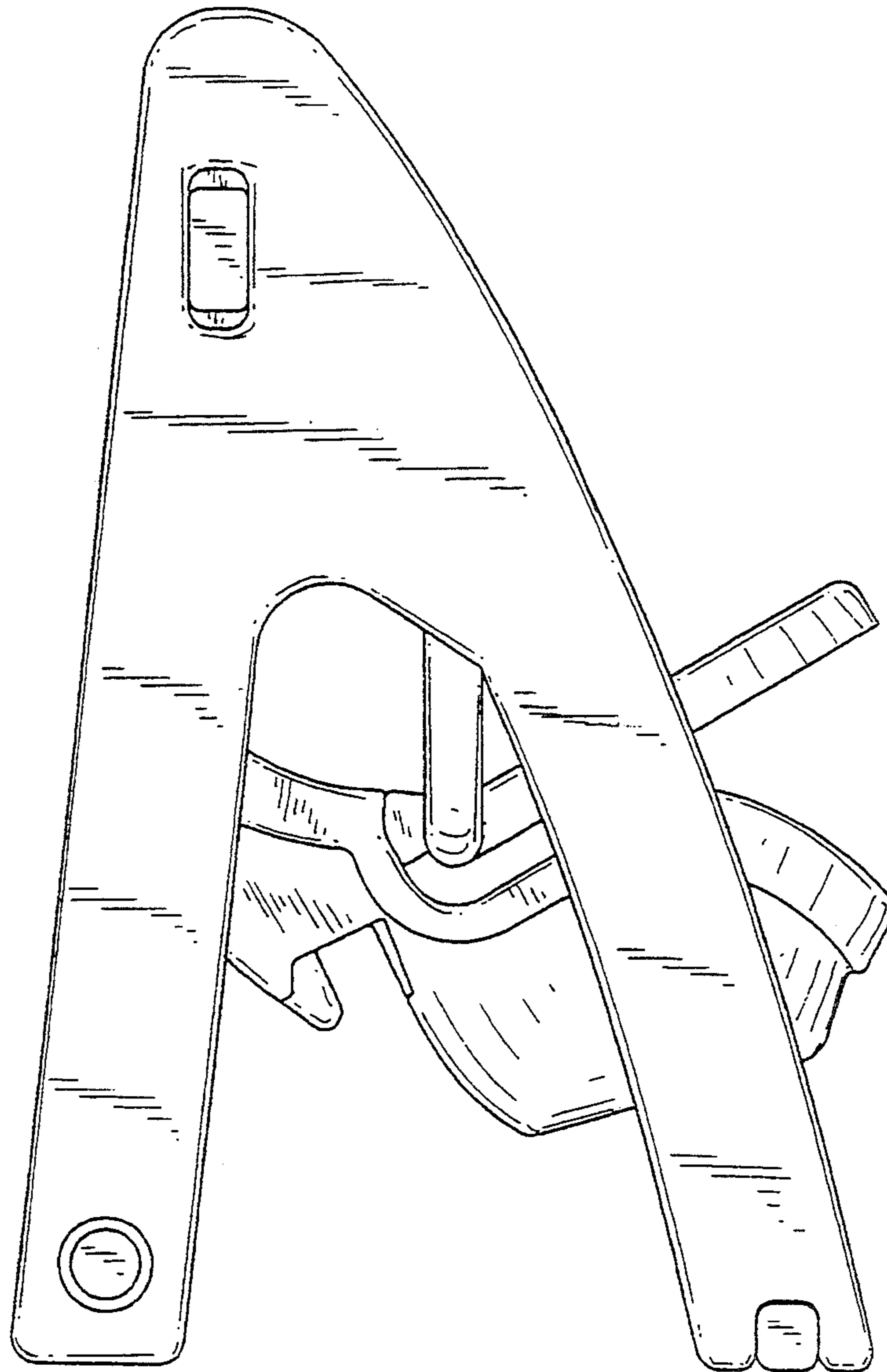

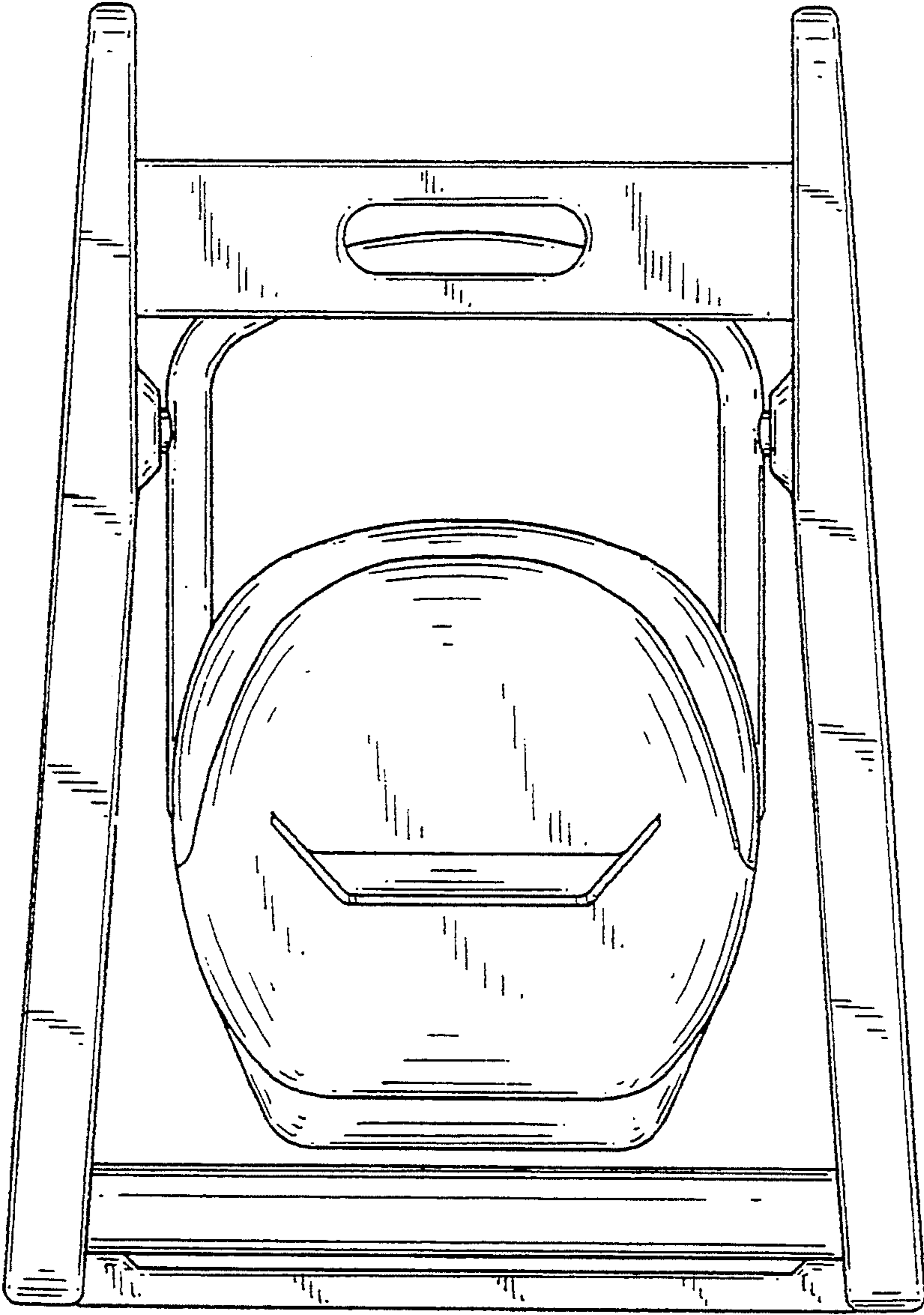

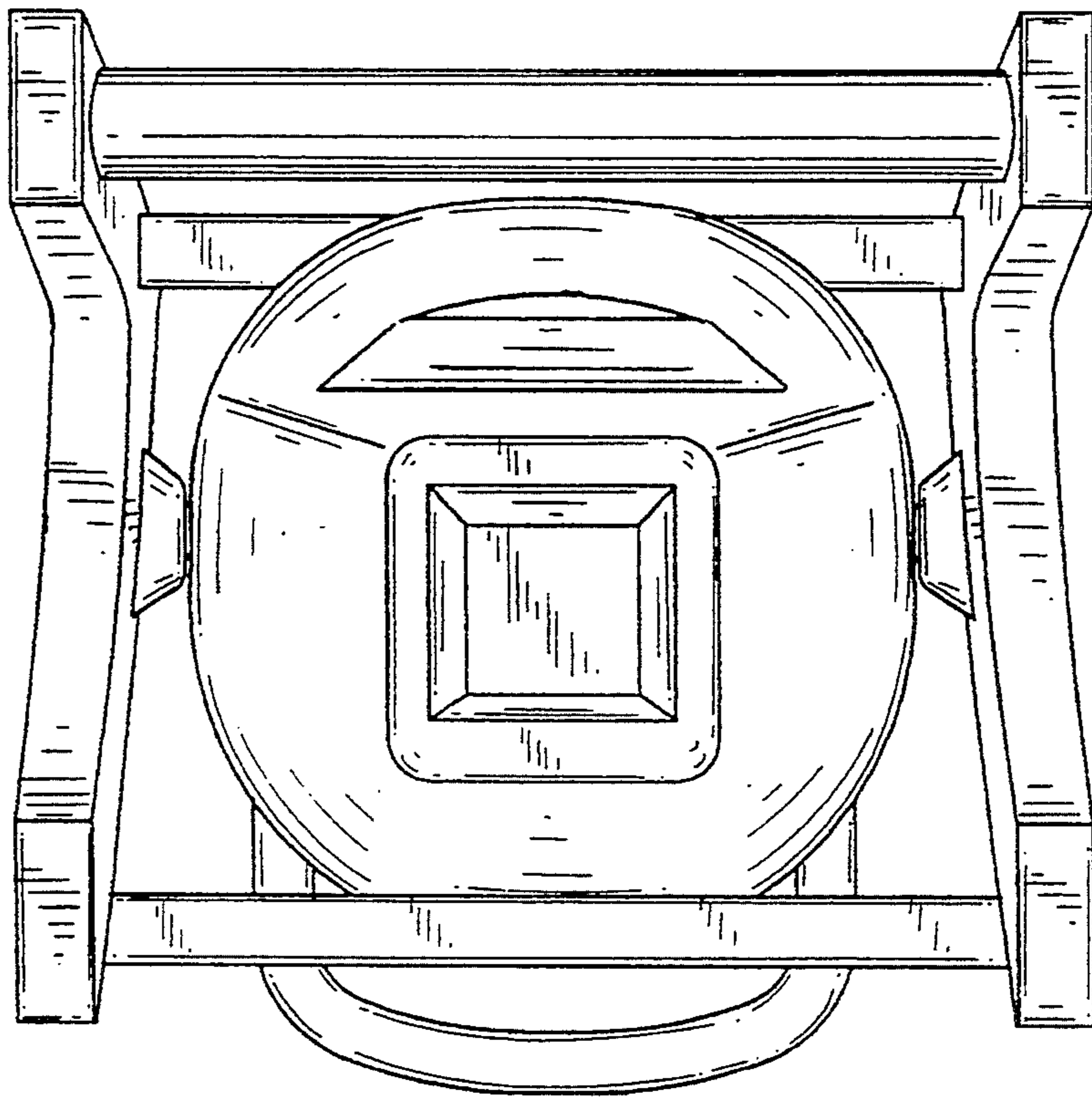

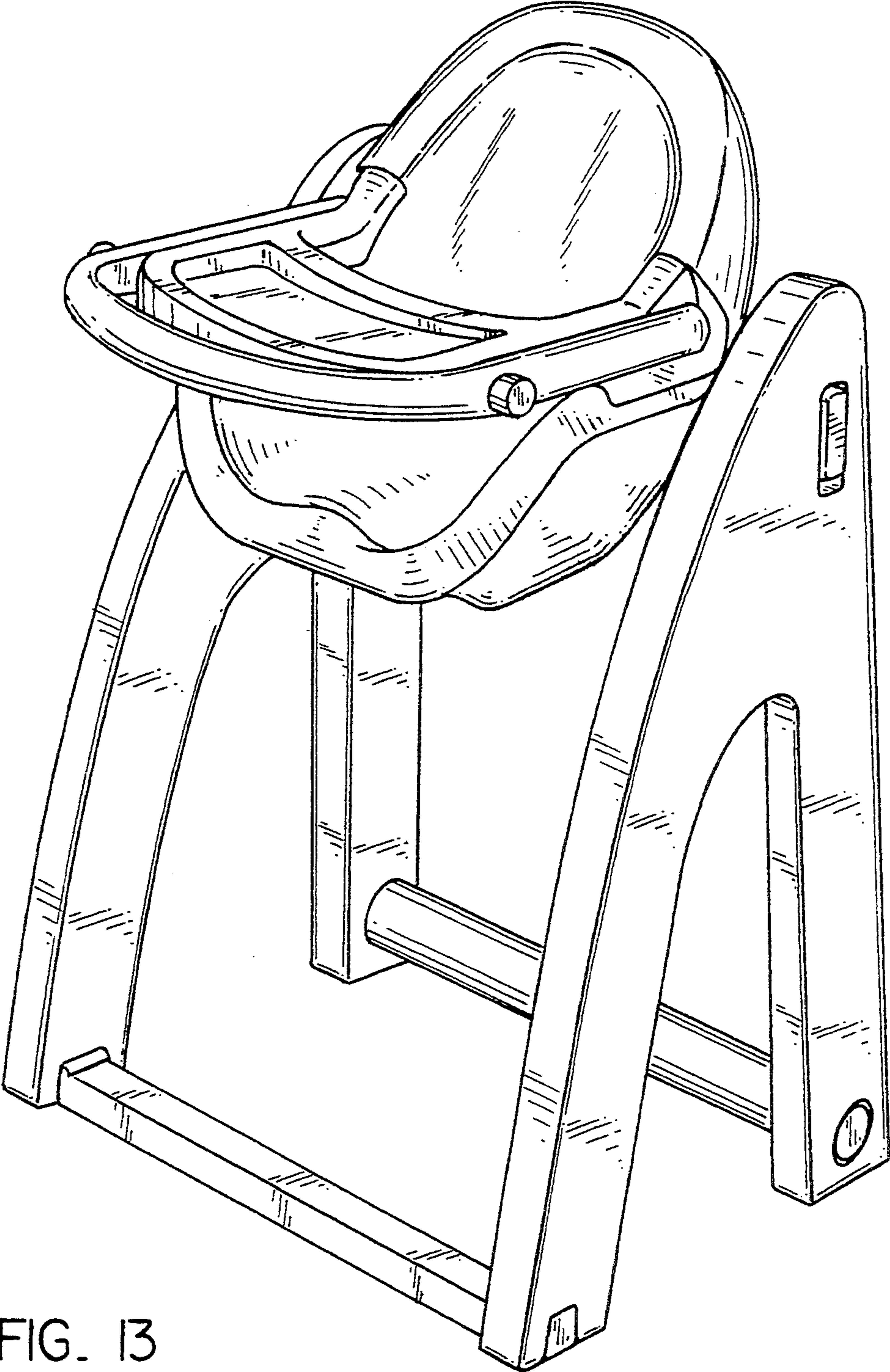

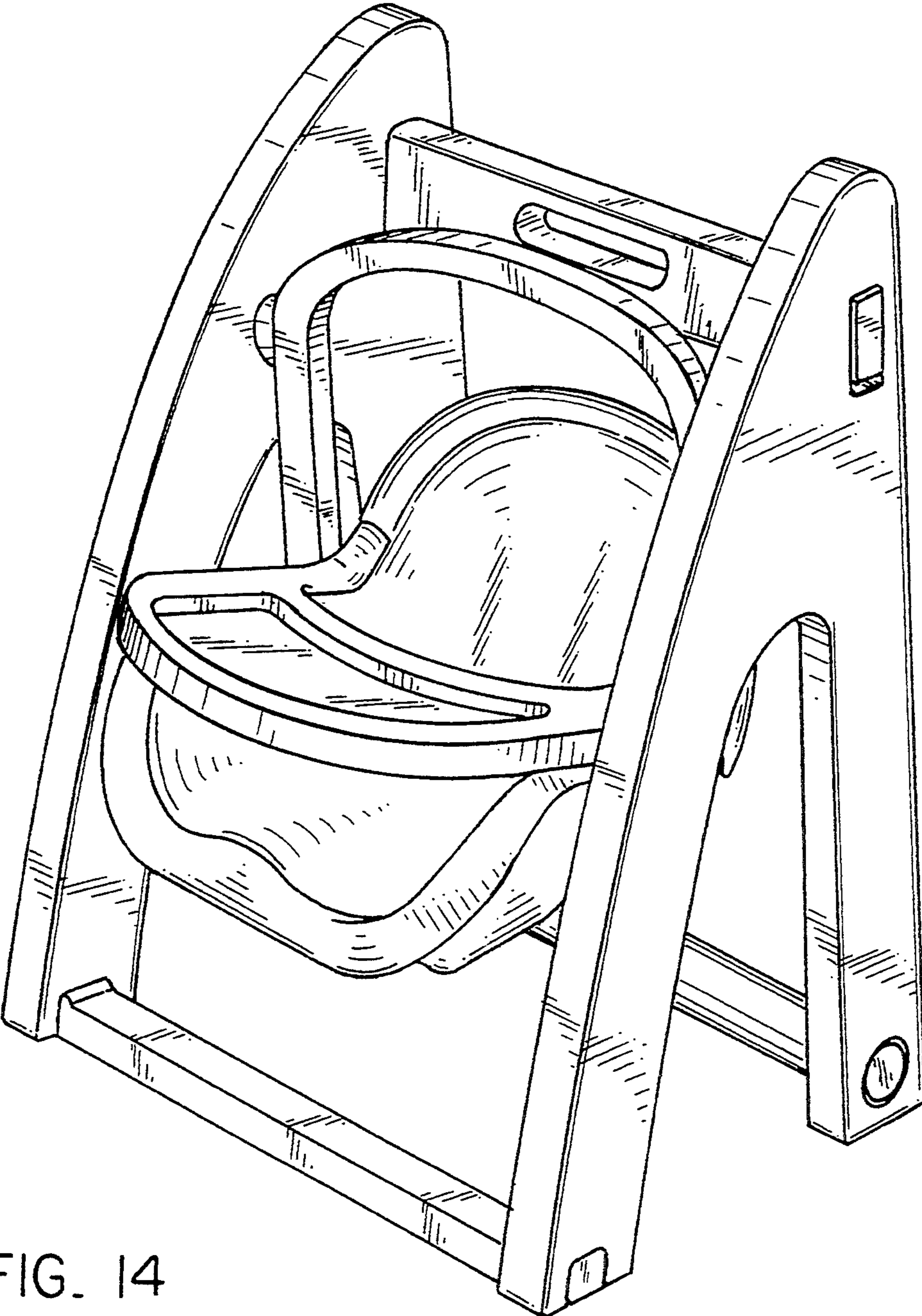
