CLAIM

The ornamental design for a a football helmet-shaped barbecue grill, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a barbecue grill showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the lower portion thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the lower portion thereof;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of the lower portion thereof;


FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the lower portion thereof; FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the lower portion thereof;


FIG. 12 is a front elvational view of a second embodiment thereof;

FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of the lower portion of the of the second embodiment; and,

FIG. 14 is a side elevational view of the second embodiment thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

The other side of the grill shown in FIG. 1 is symmetrical to the side shown in FIG. 3, and the other side of the second embodiment of FIG. 12 is symmetrical to the side shown in FIG. 14. The view of FIGS. 7-11 and 13 are shown separate for clarity of illustration.







