[57] **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for a set of lottery cards, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**  
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a set of lottery cards showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof. It is understood that the claimed design is of conventional thickness.
