DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a gooseneck surgical
instrument holder showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the gooseneck surgical in-
strument holder of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a right side view of the gooseneck surgical
instrument holder of FIG. 1. The left side view of the
gooseneck surgical instrument holder is a mirror image
of the right side view of FIG. 4;
FIG. 5 is an rear end view of the gooseneck surgical
instrument holder of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a end front view of the gooseneck surgical
instrument holder of FIG. 1.

design.

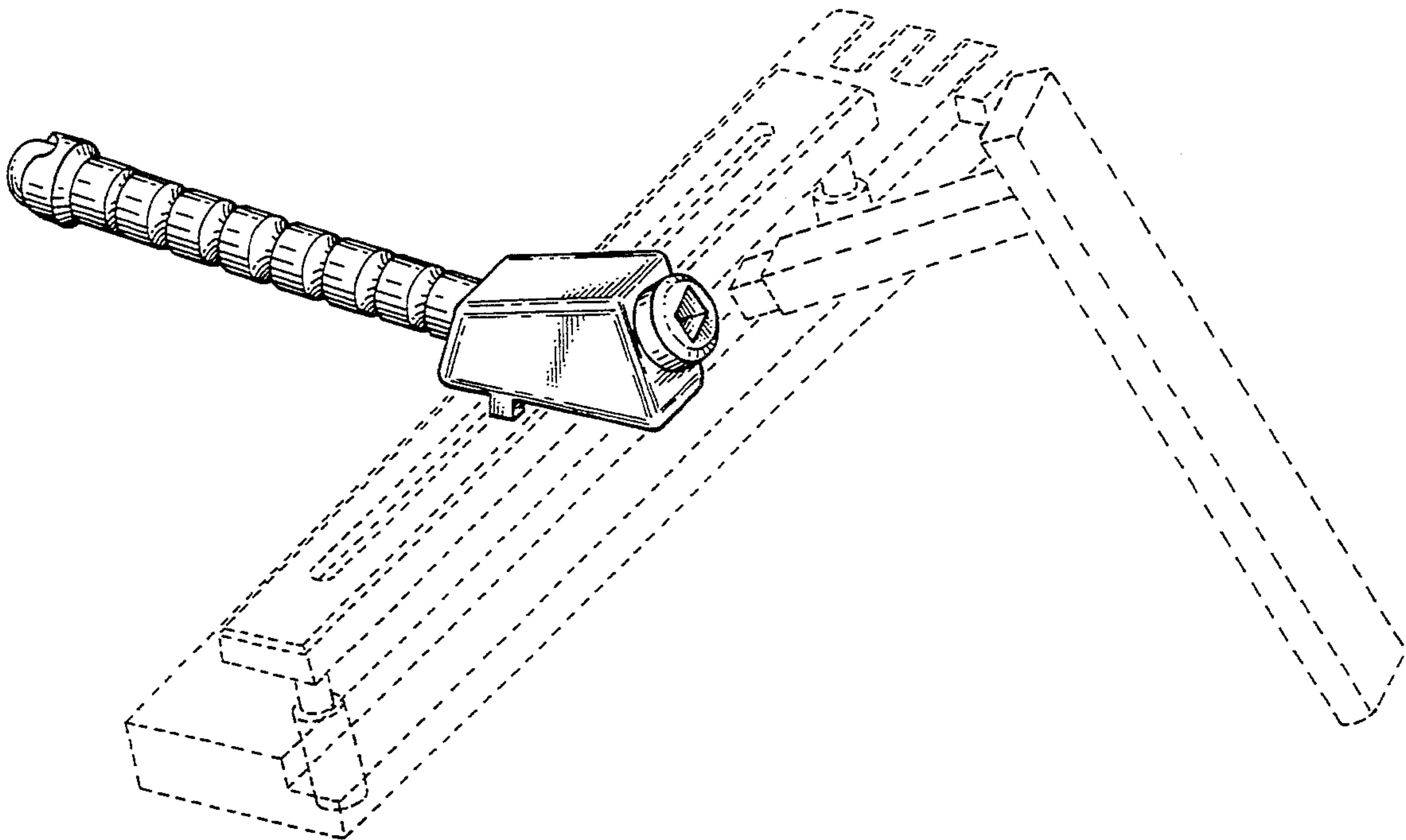
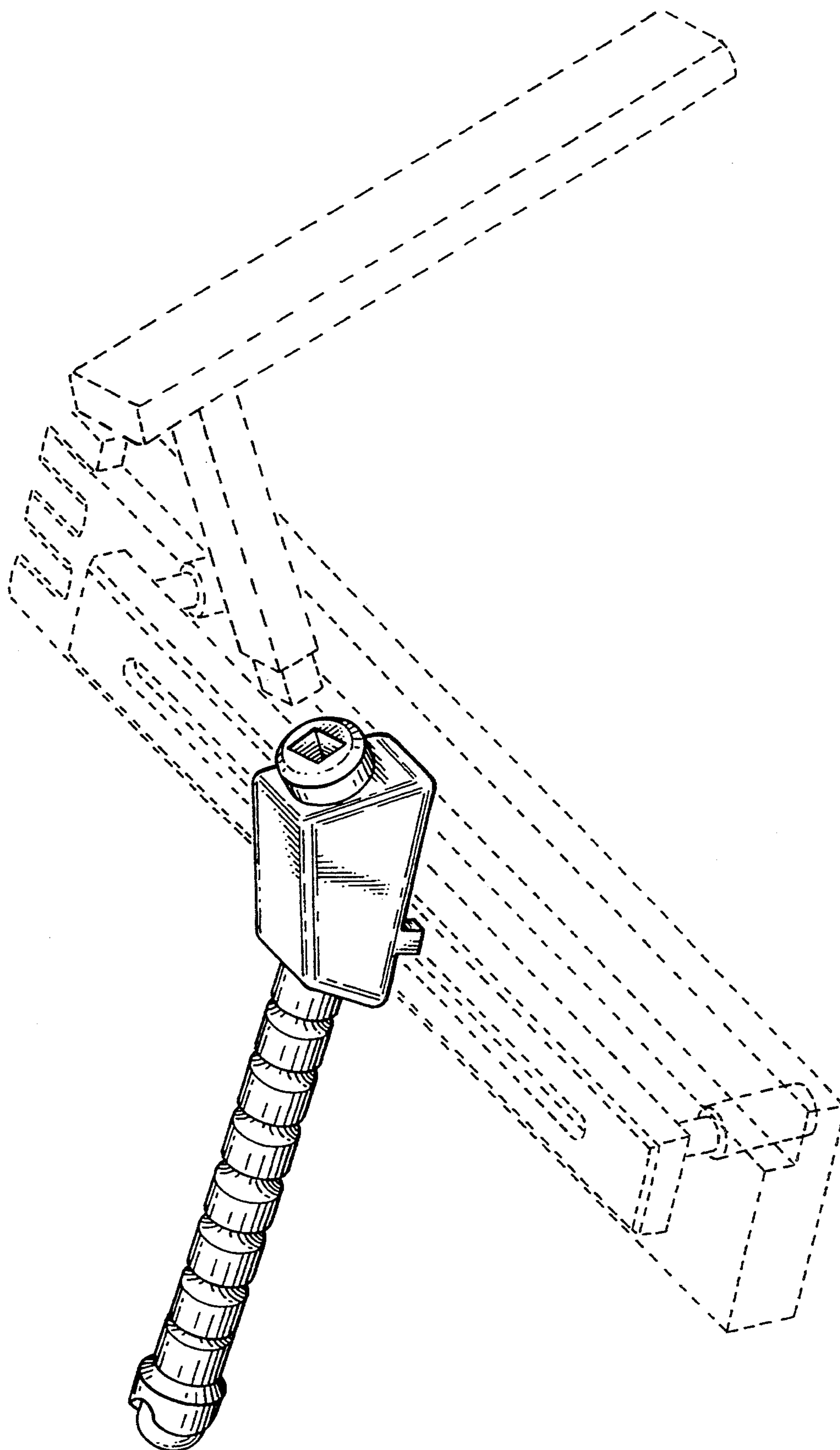

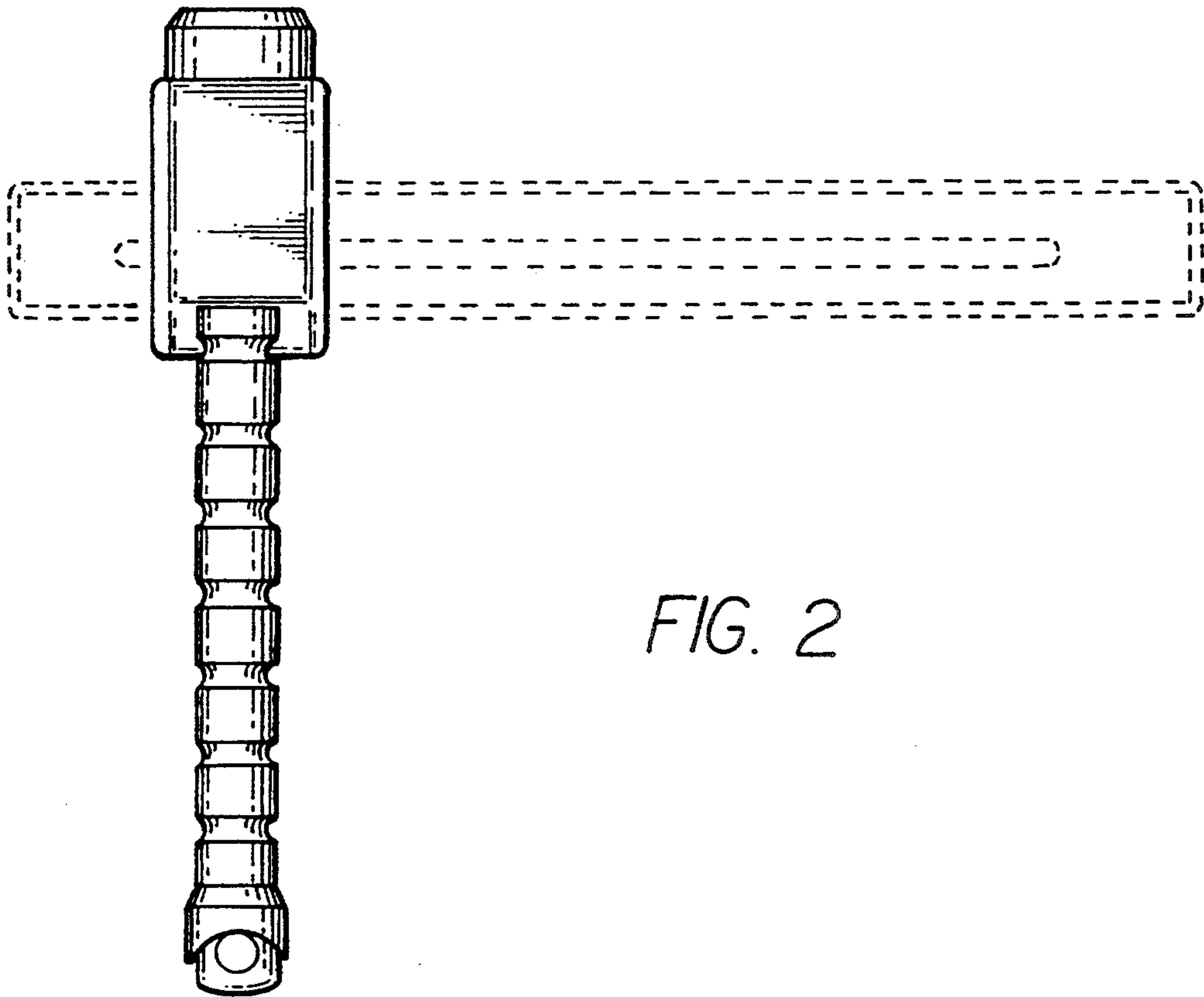

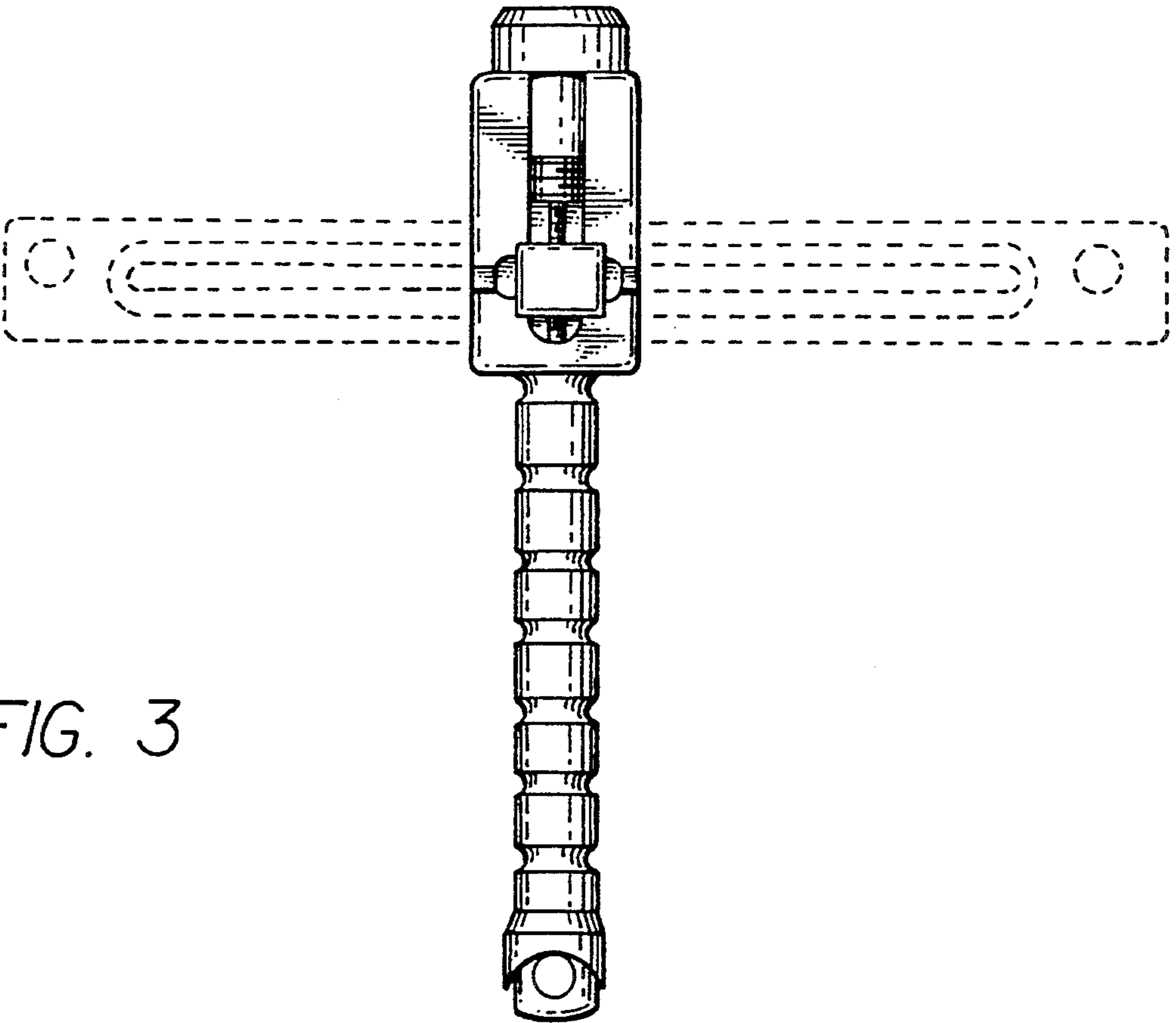

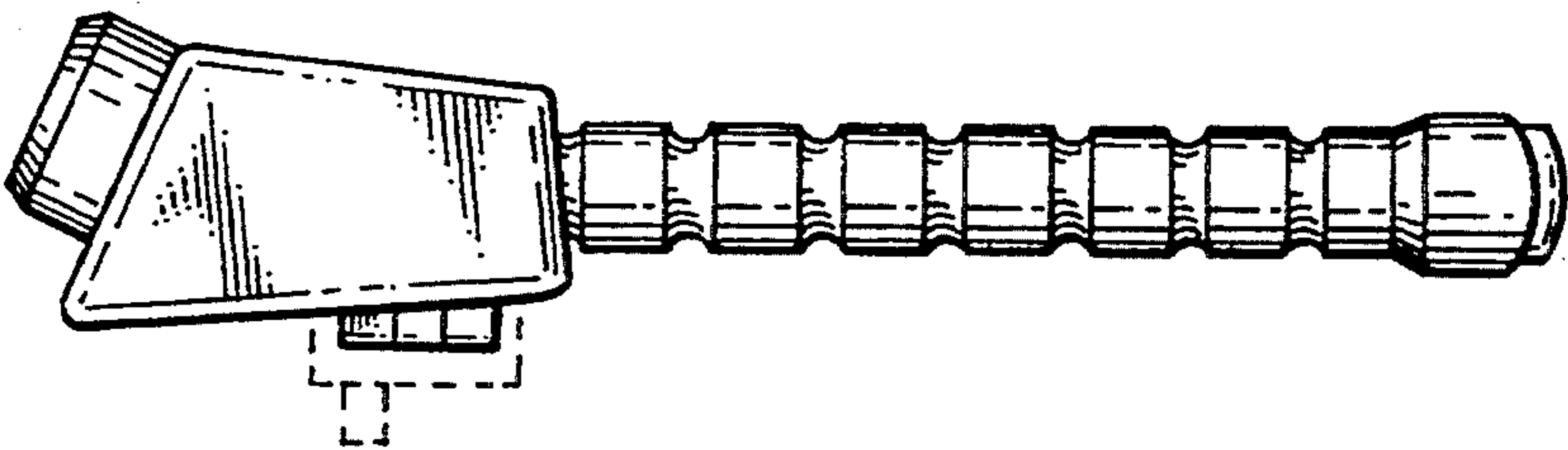

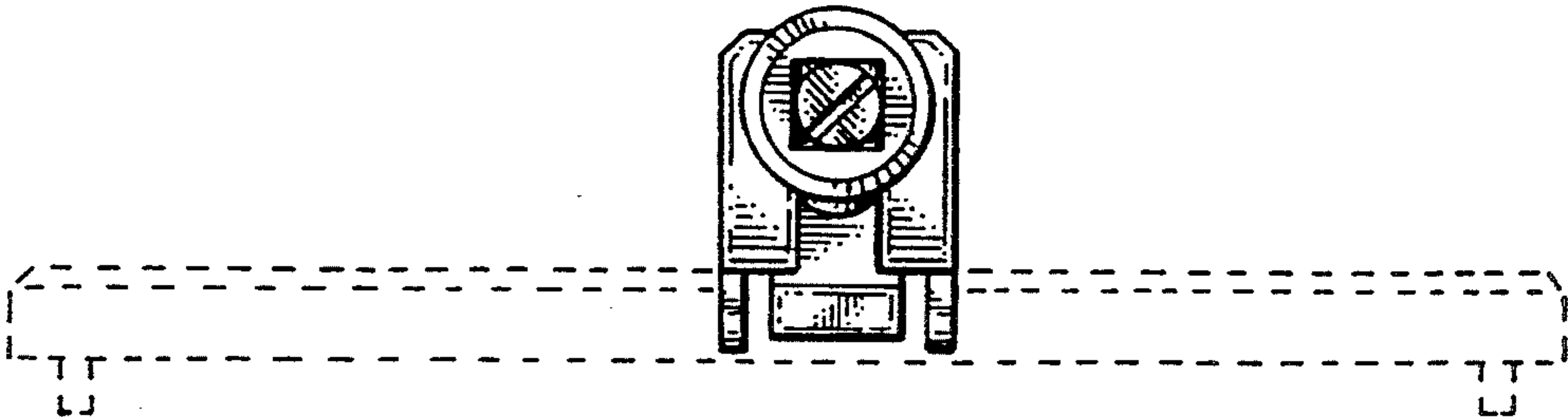

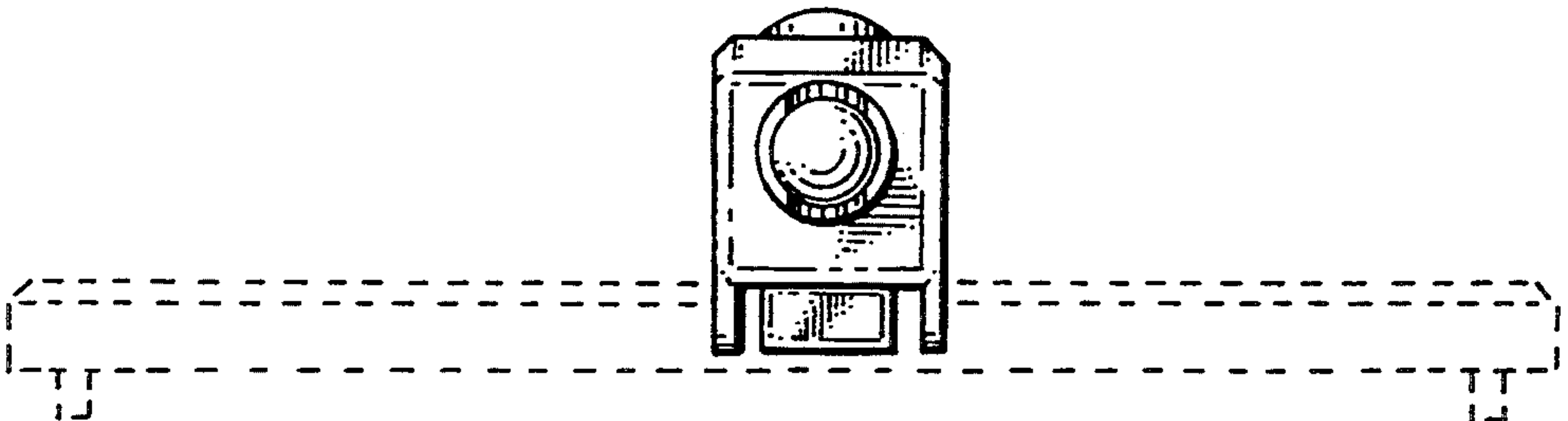
