[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a faceguard for a batter's helmet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a faceguard of a batter's helmet showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The baseball batter's helmet shown in broken lines in all views is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

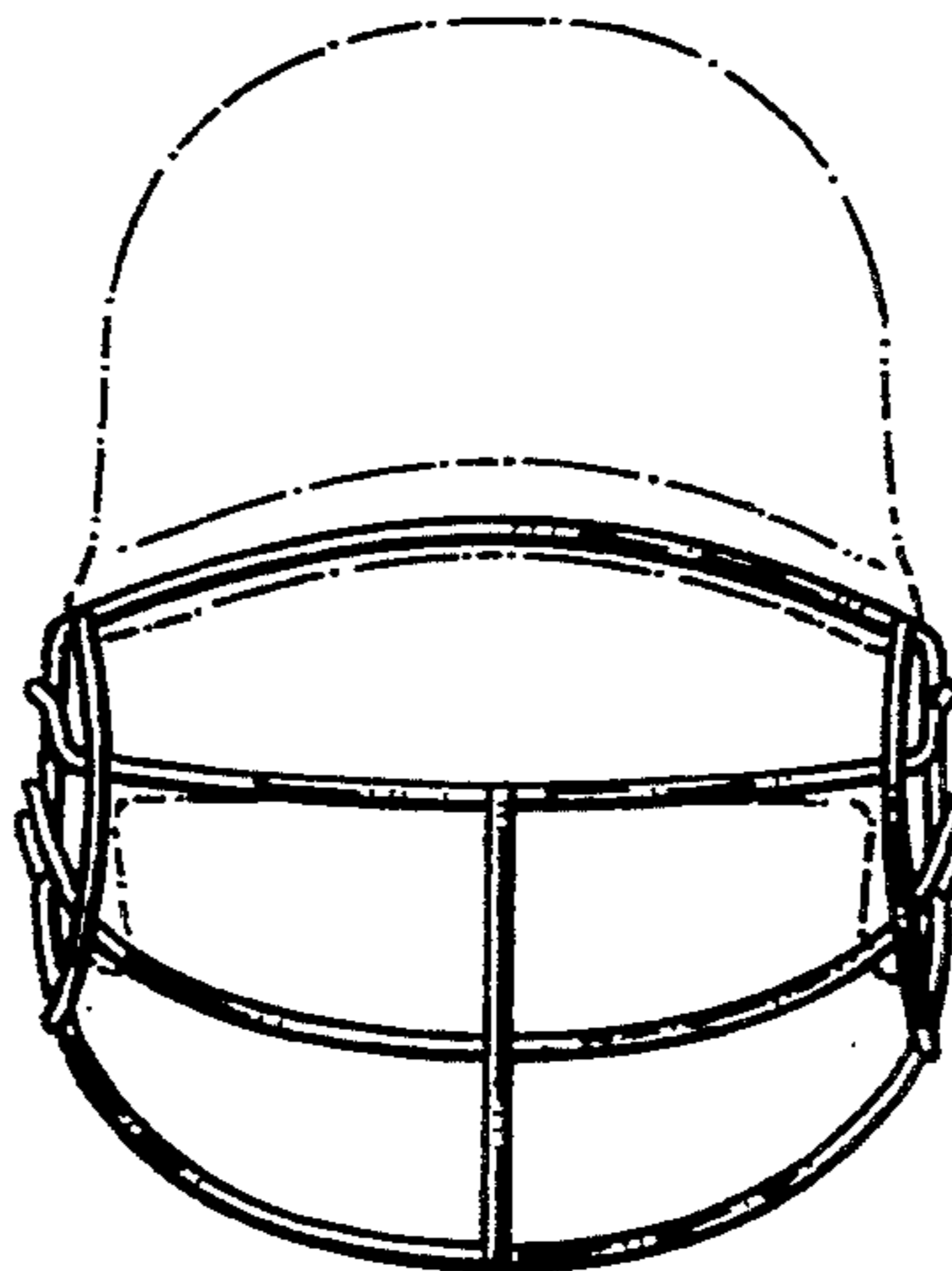
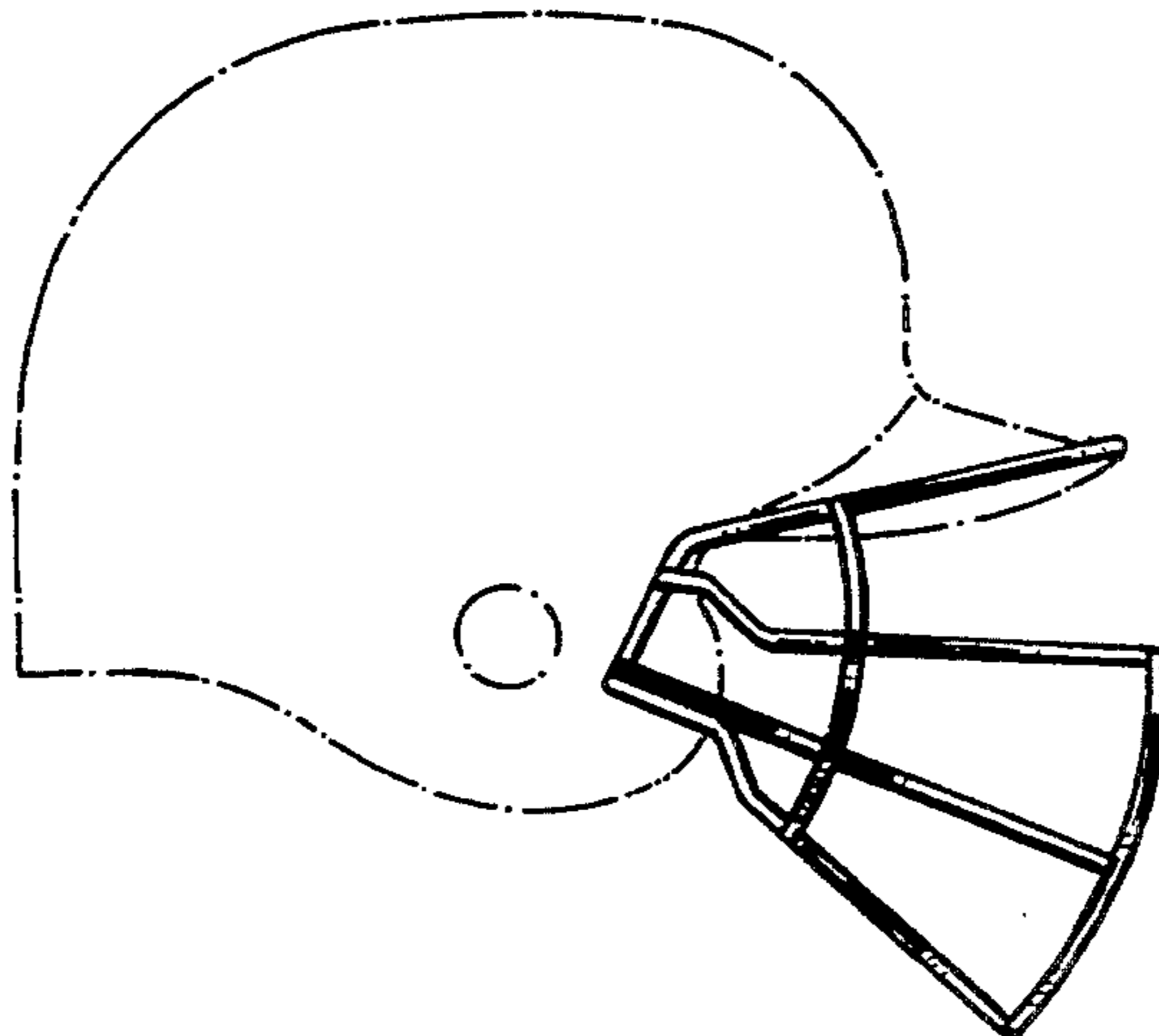

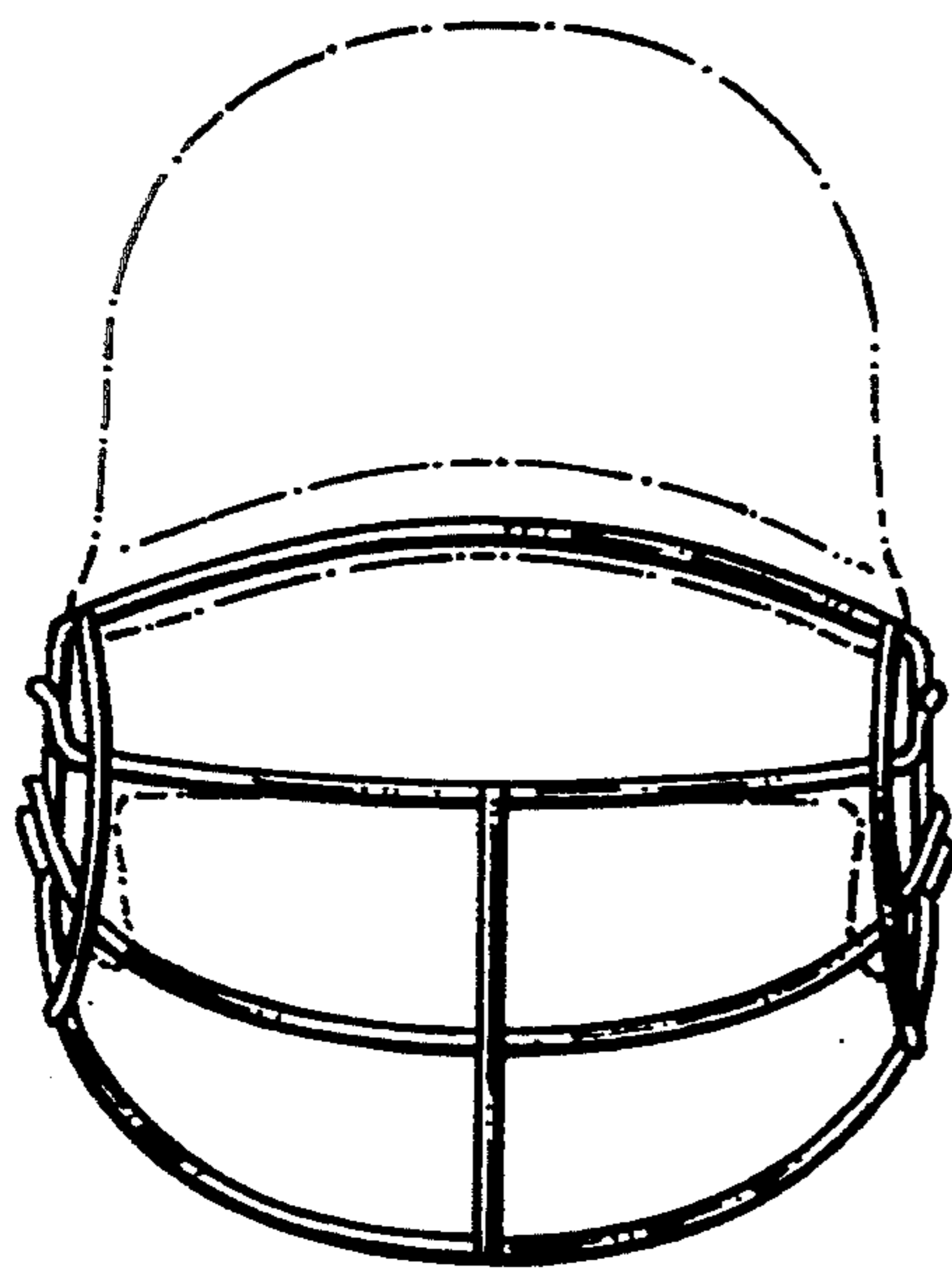
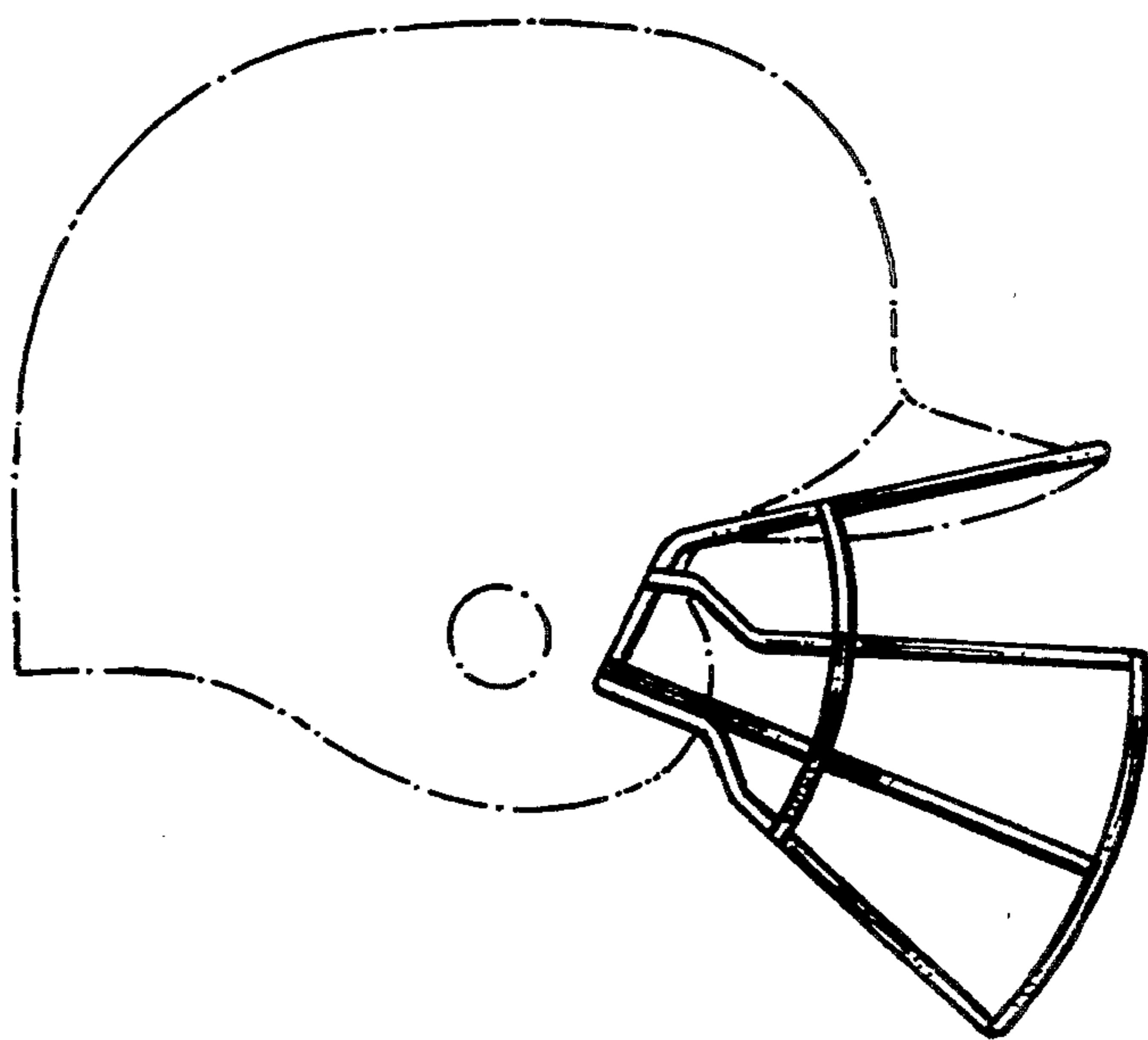

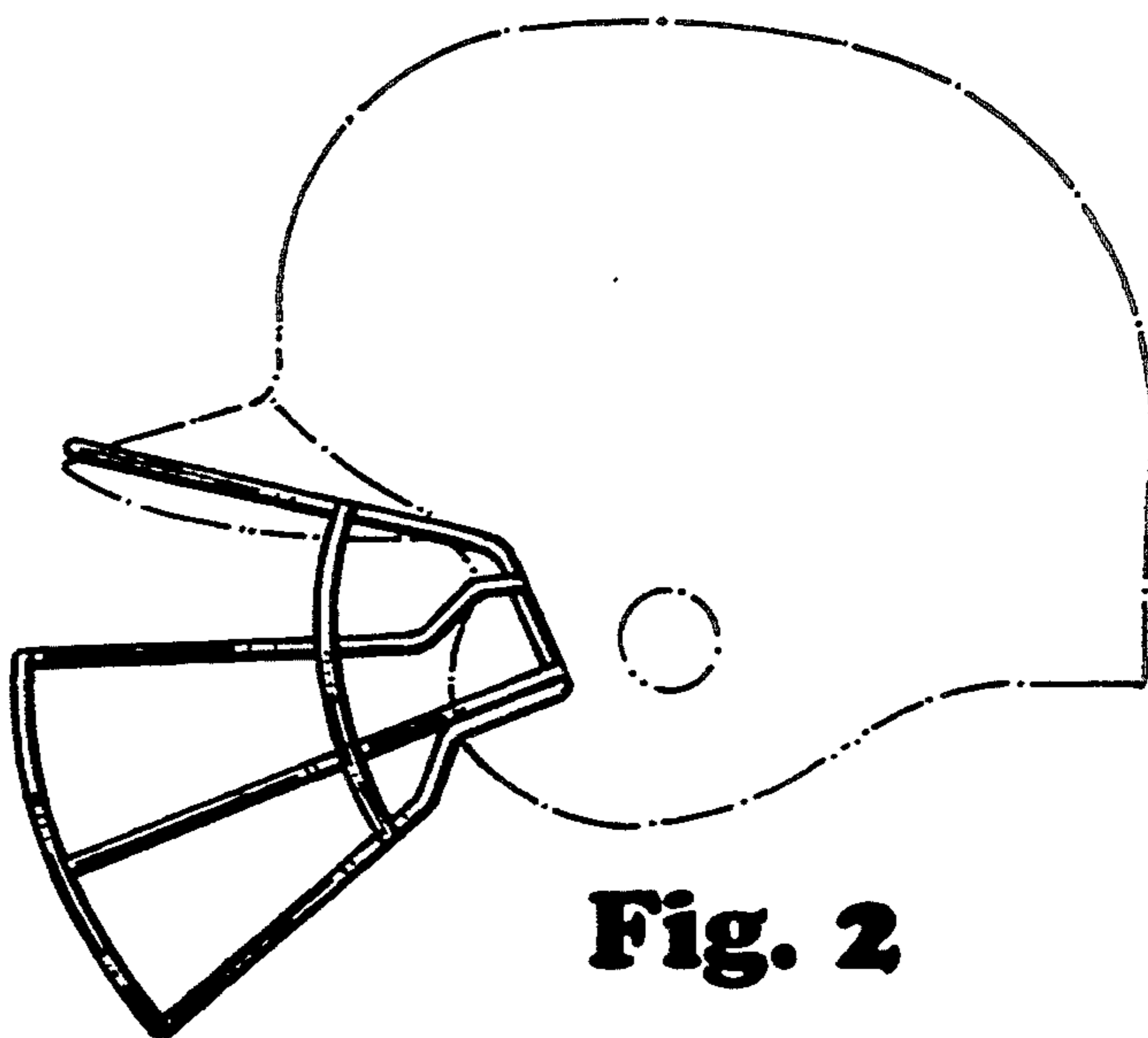
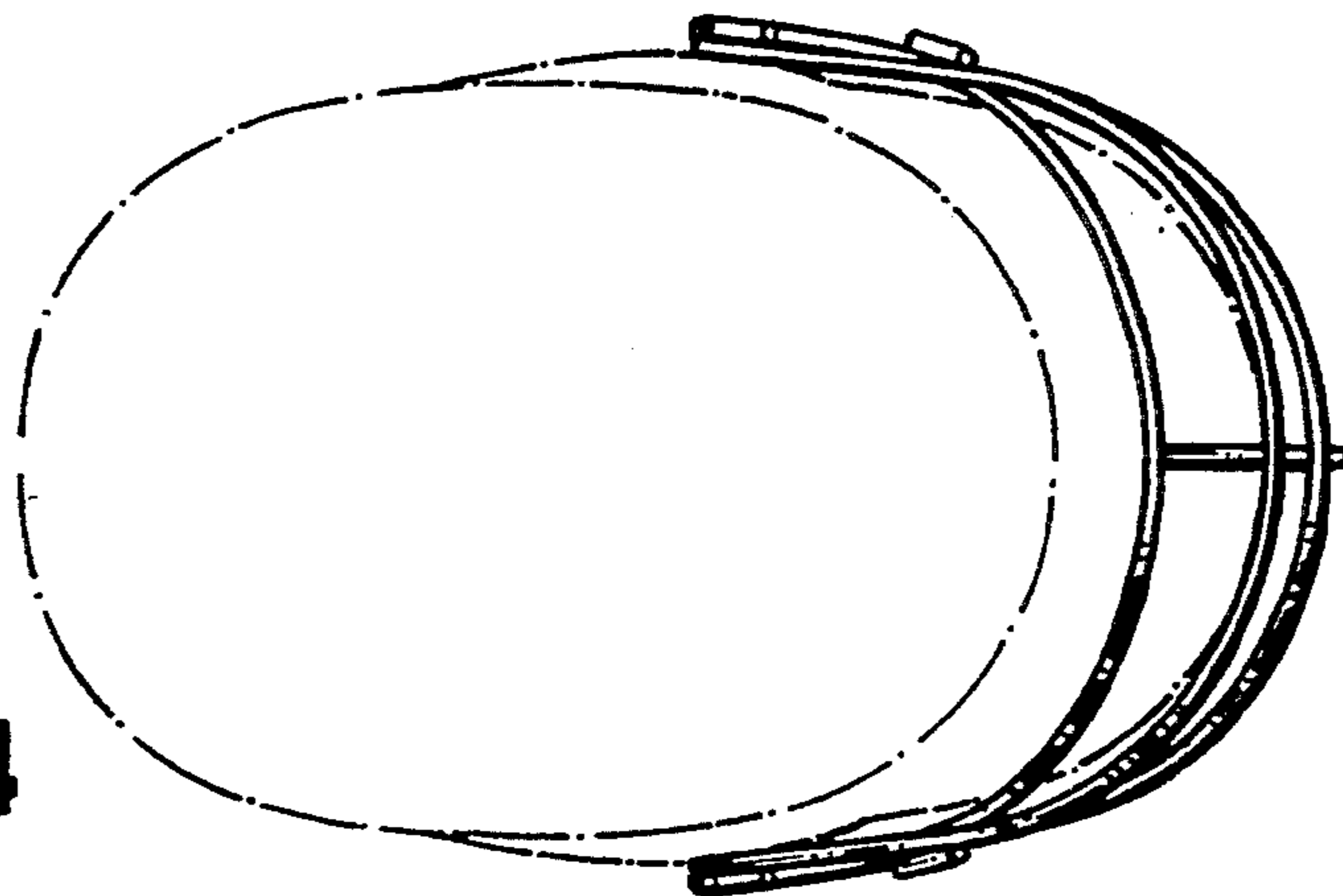

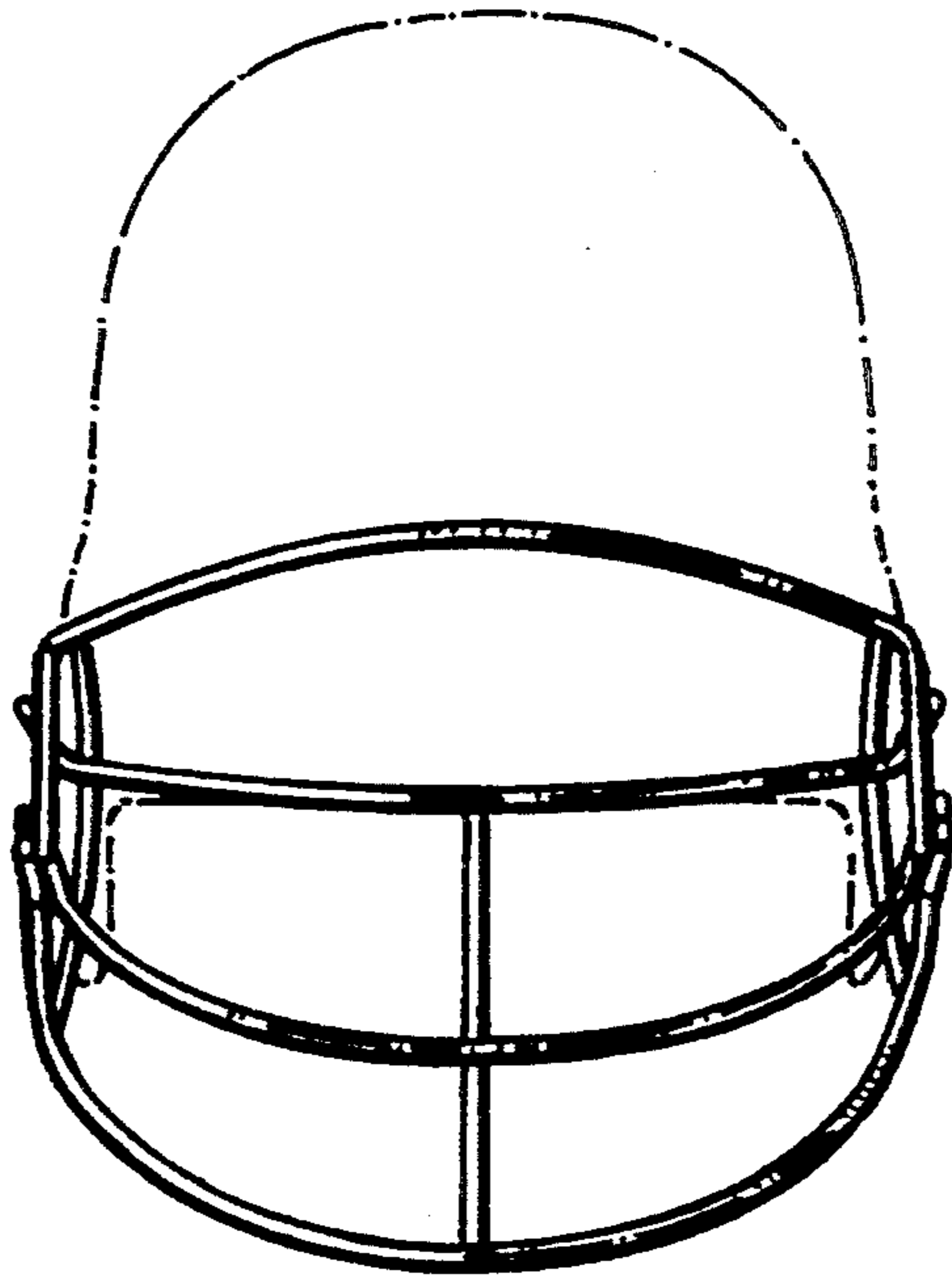

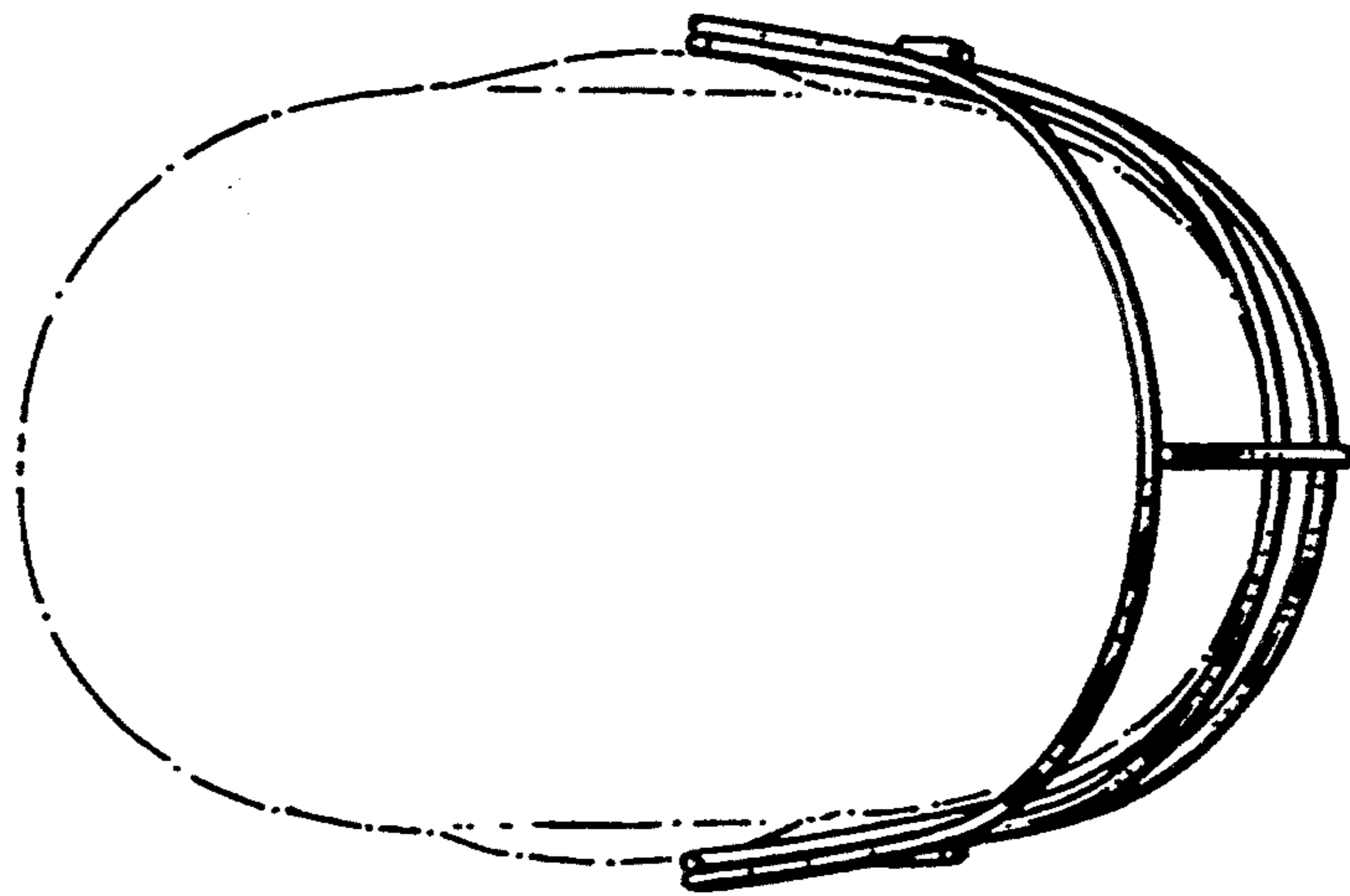
