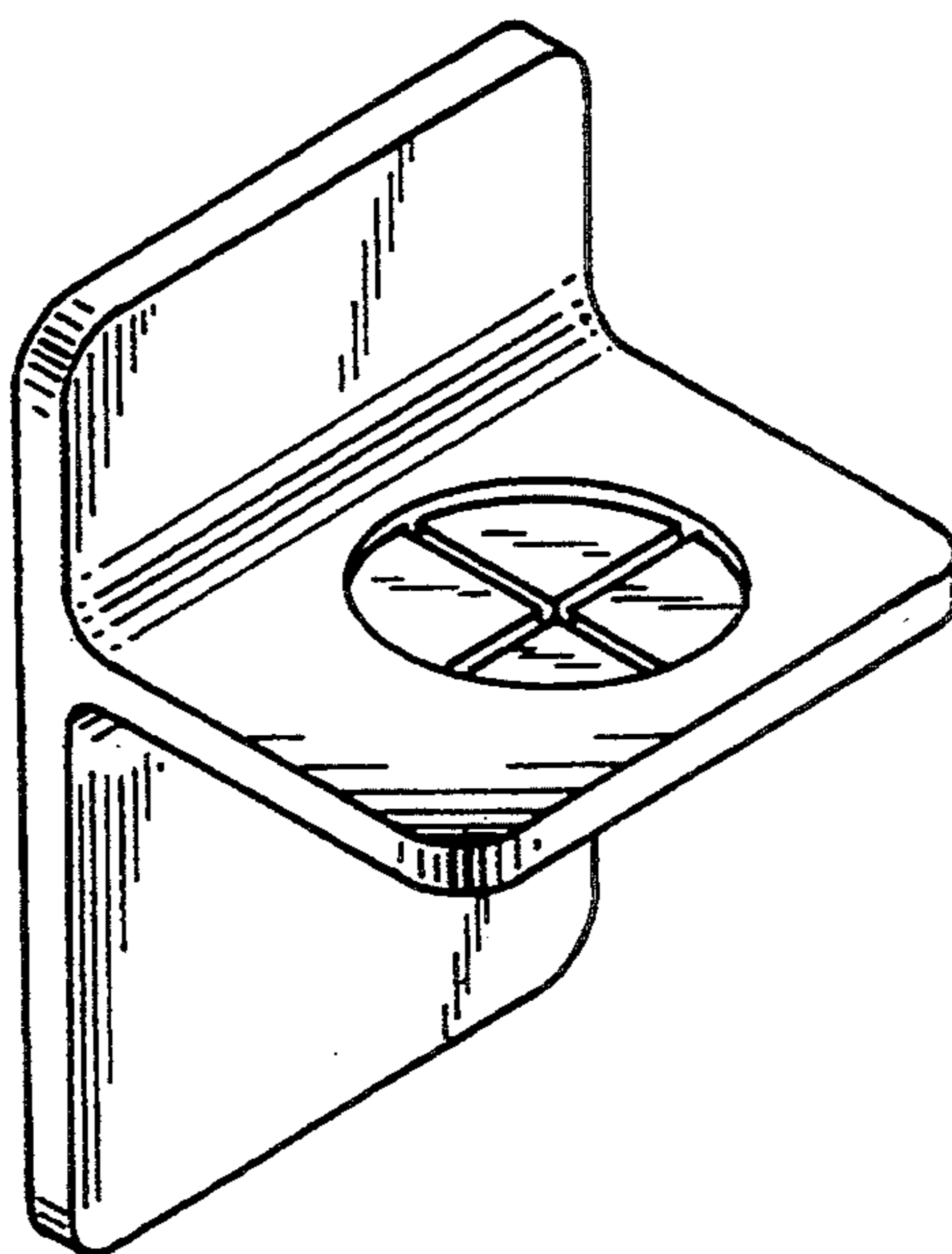
FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of a trash bag cinch as seen from the top, front and one side showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a view in bottom plan.



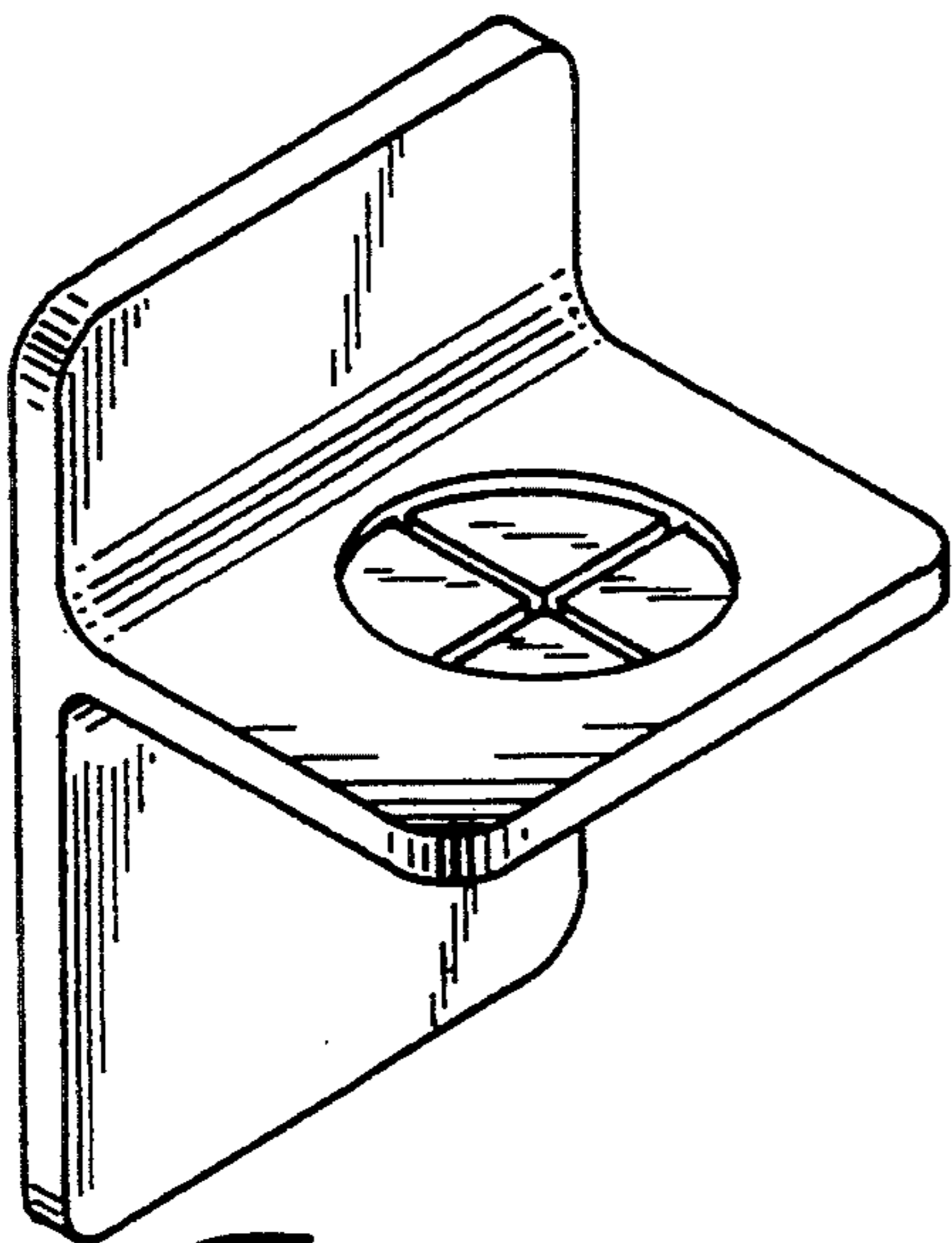

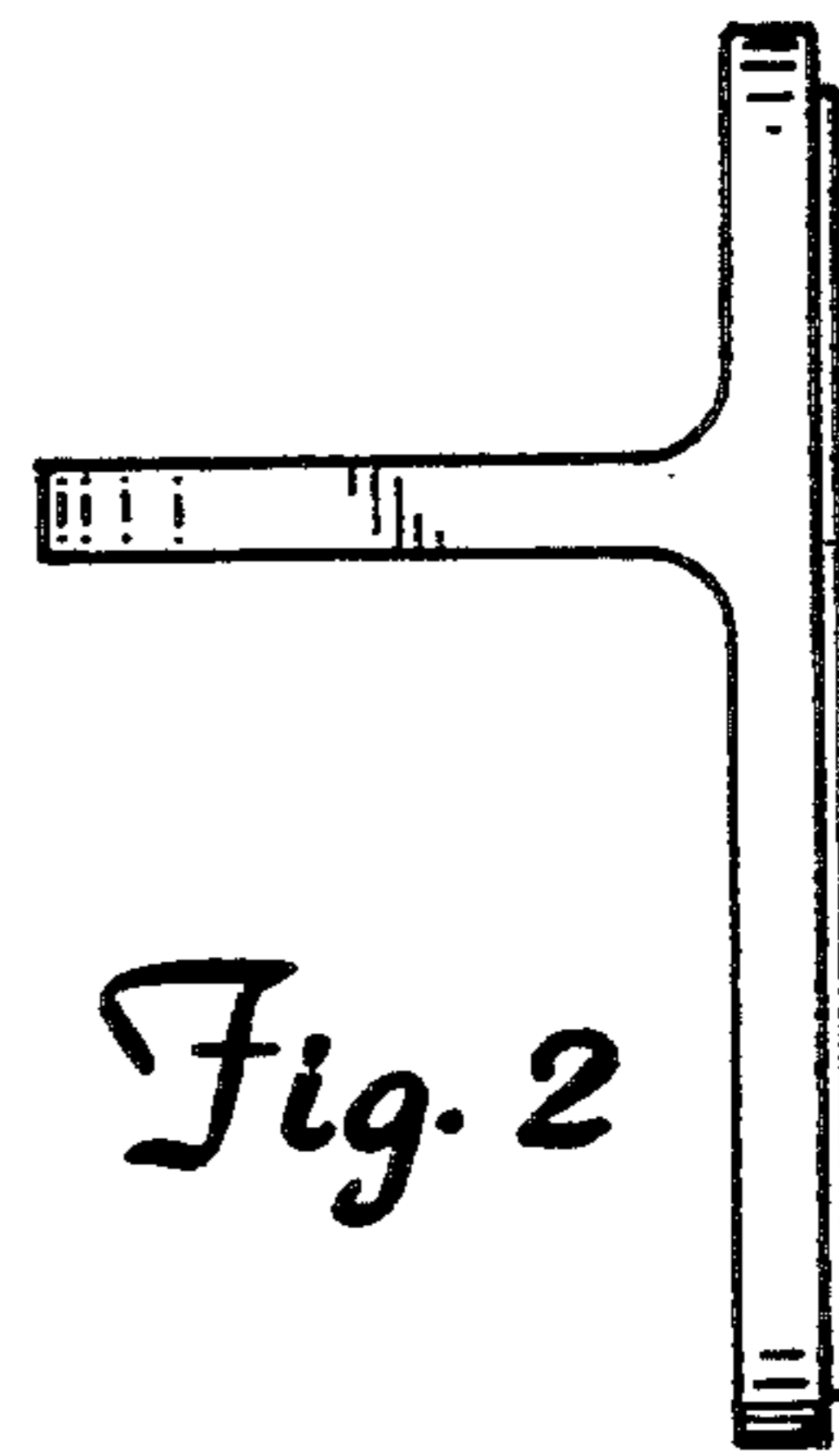

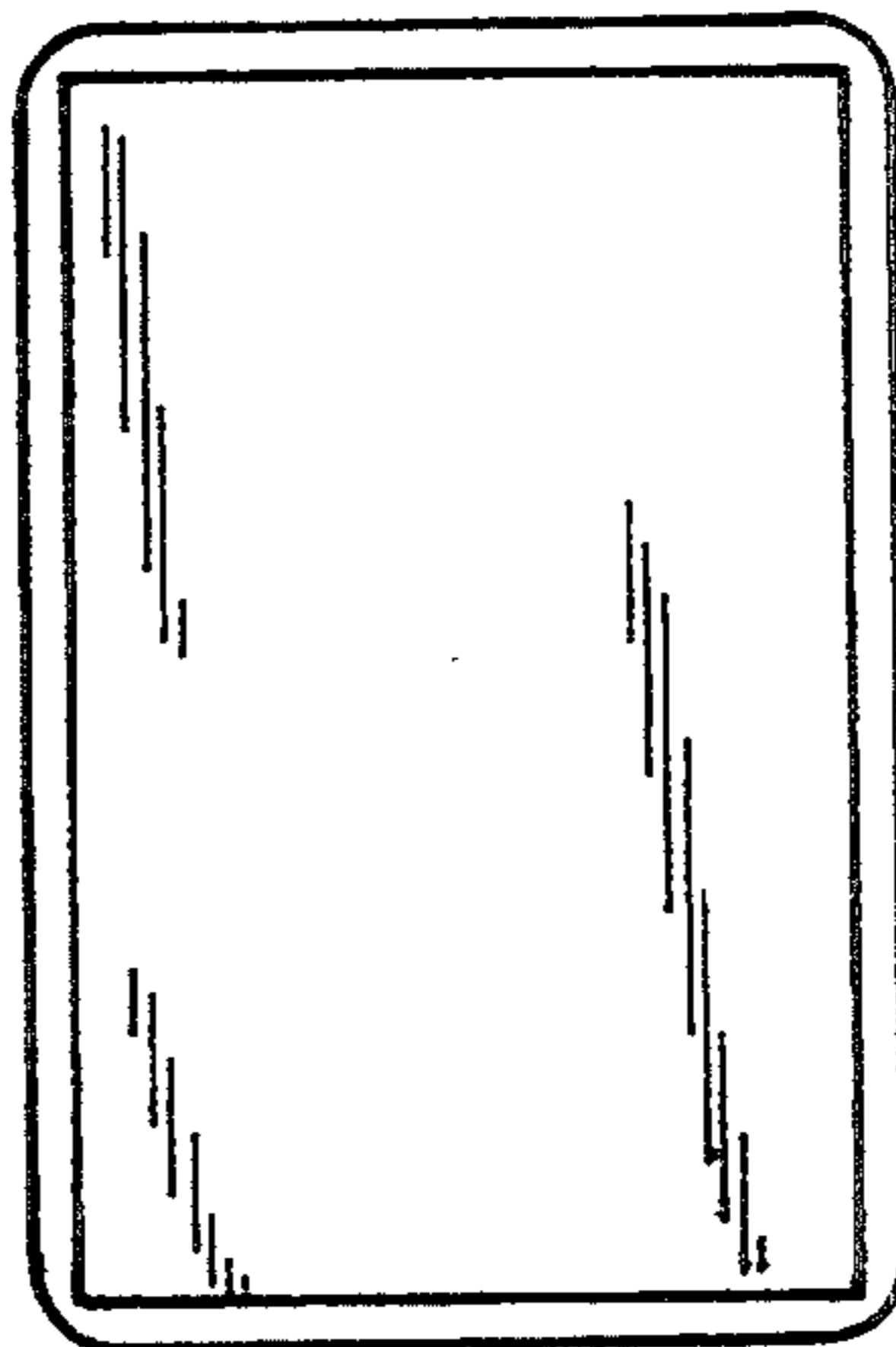

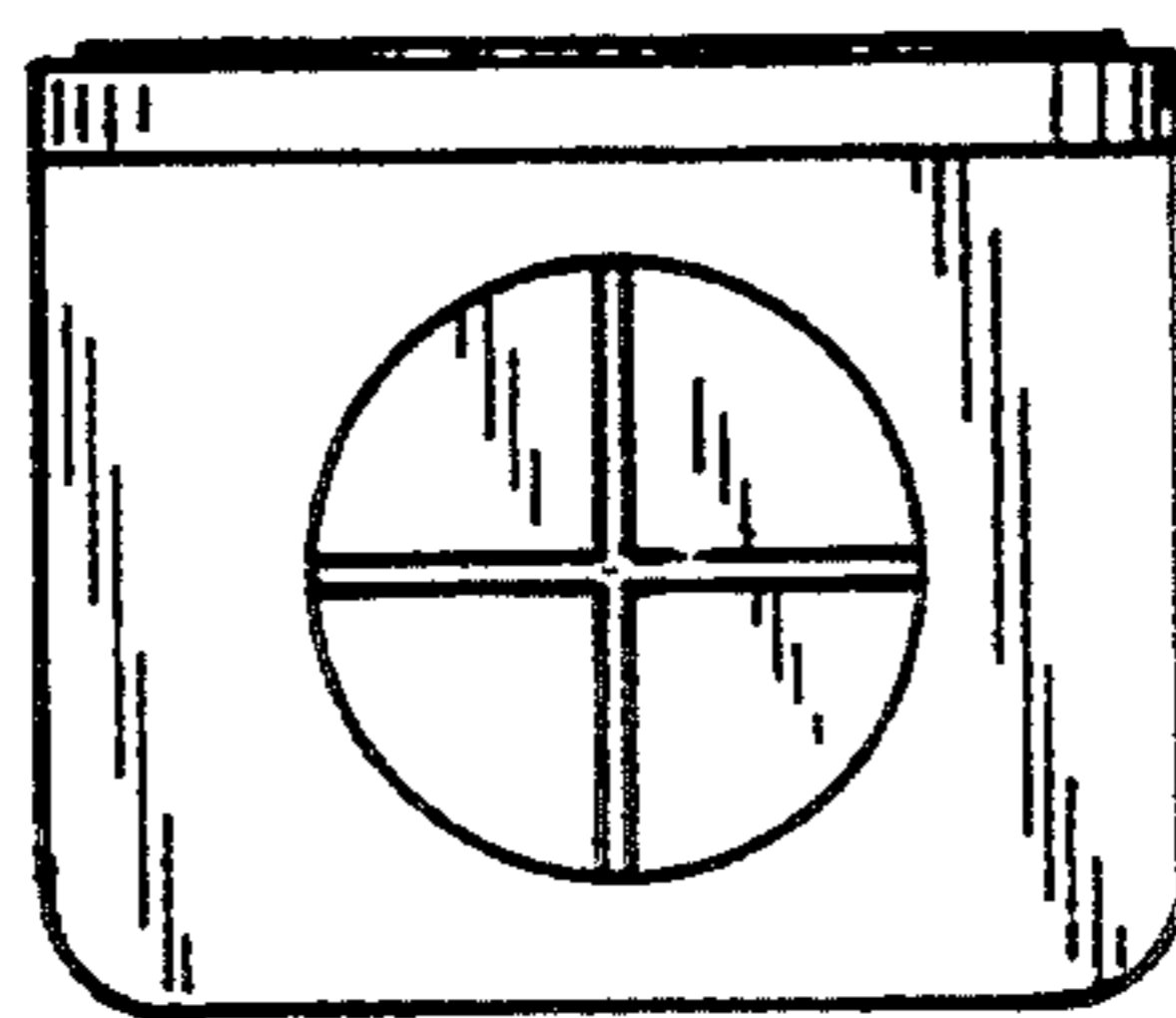

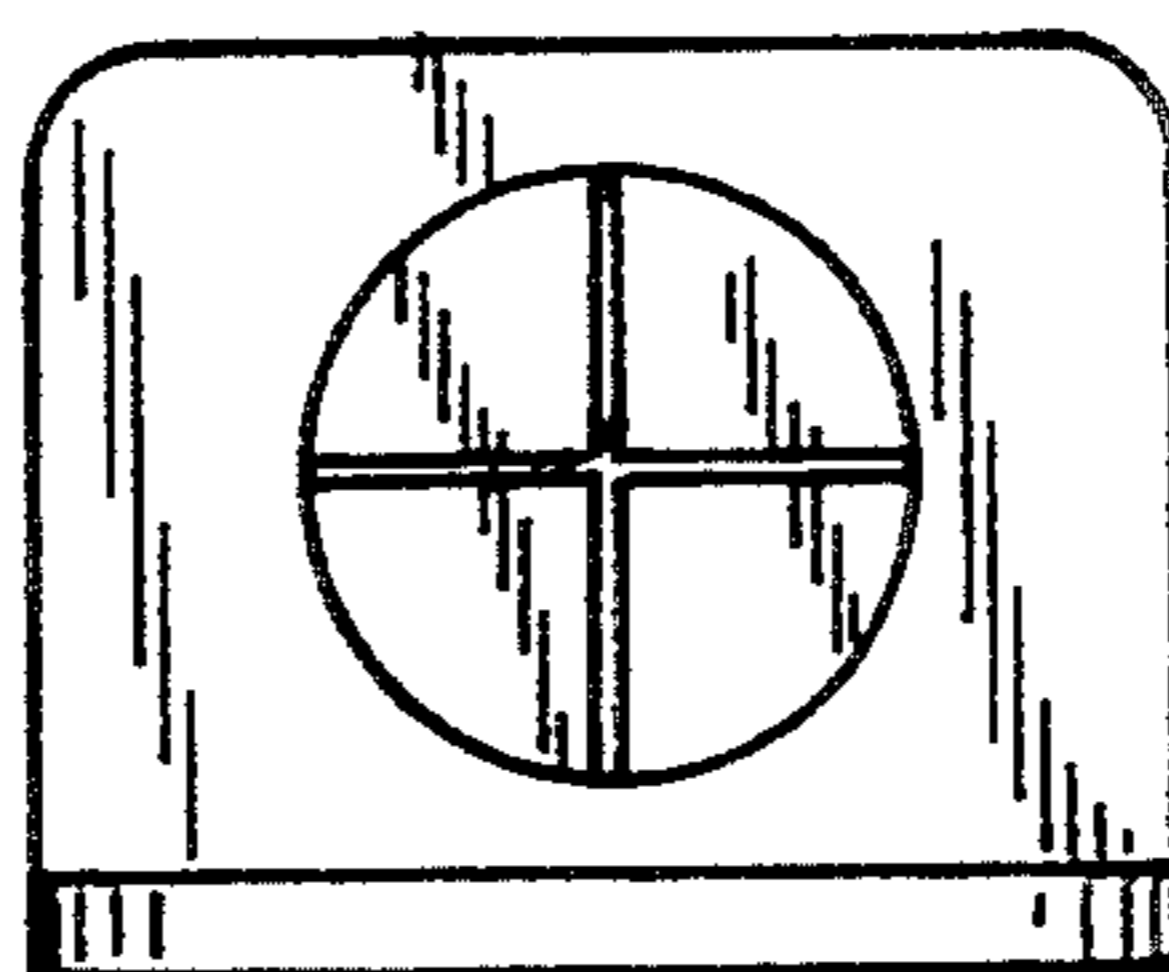
