[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a camouflage coverall, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a camouflage coverall showing our new design, the broken lines partially showing a human figure, gun, and tree trunk, being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.

The dashed lines shown on the present apparel design throughout the drawing figures represent conventional stitching.












