FIG. 1 is a top view;

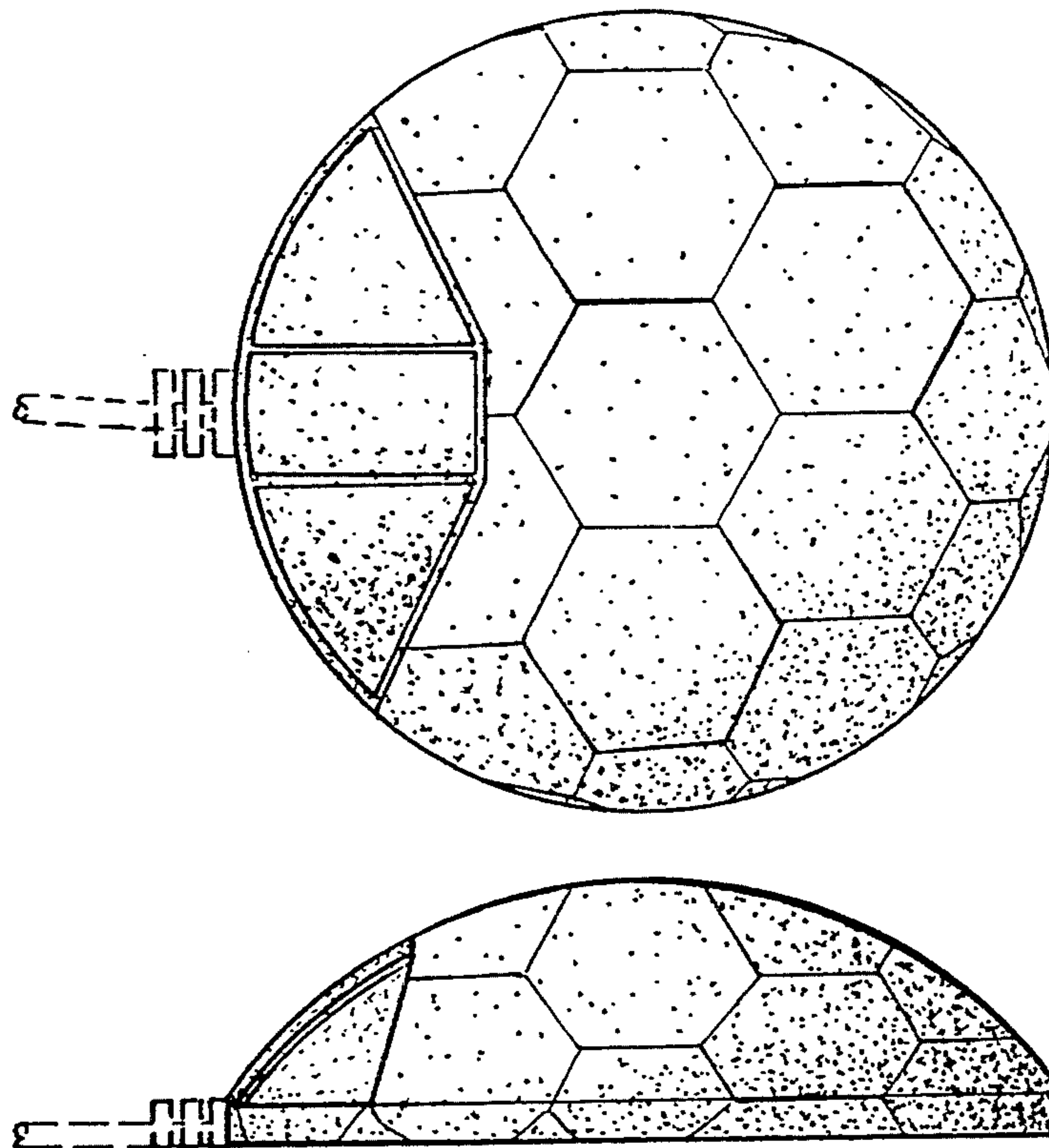
FIG. 2 is a side view, the opposite side is a mirror im-

purposes only and forms no part in the claimed design.



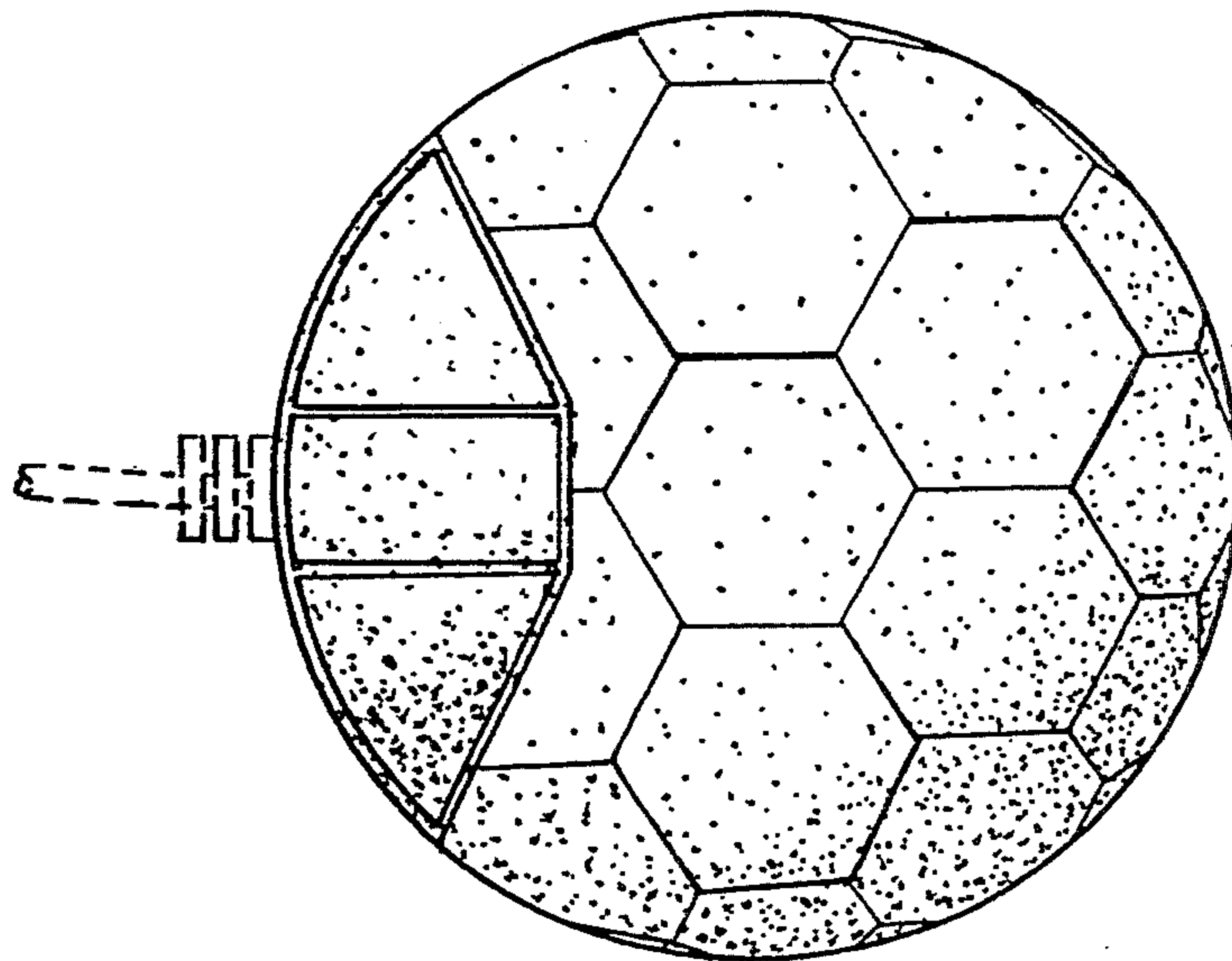

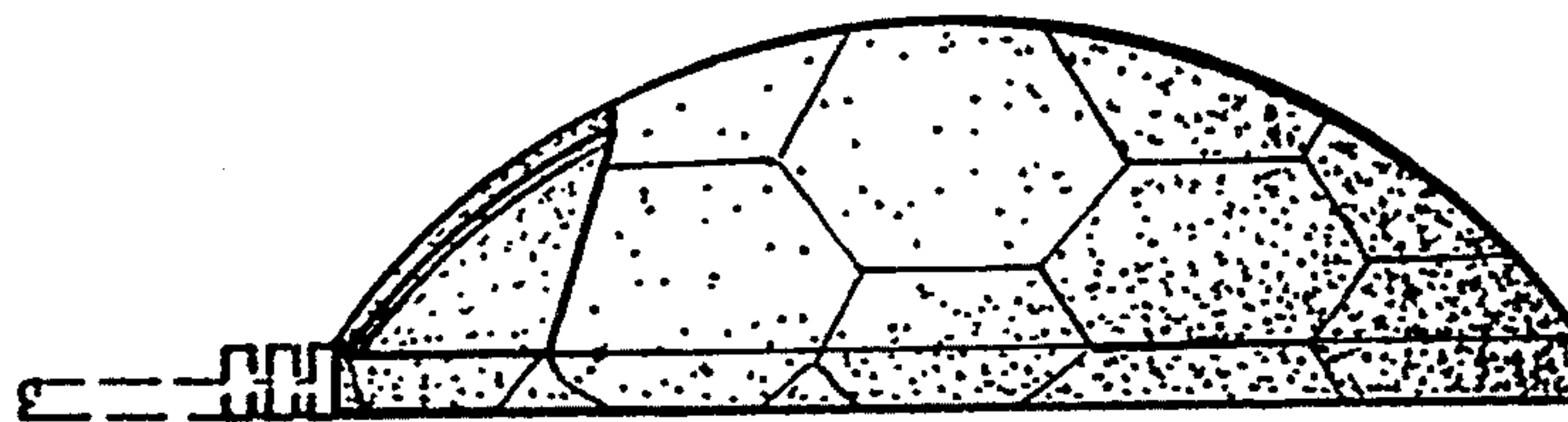

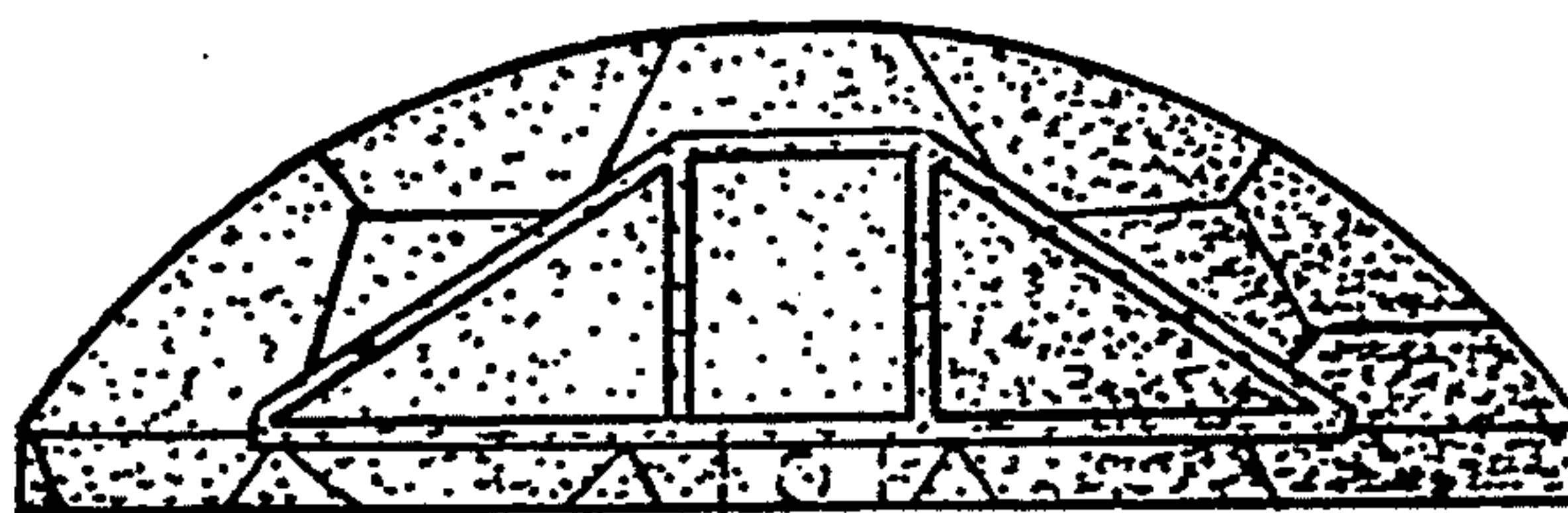

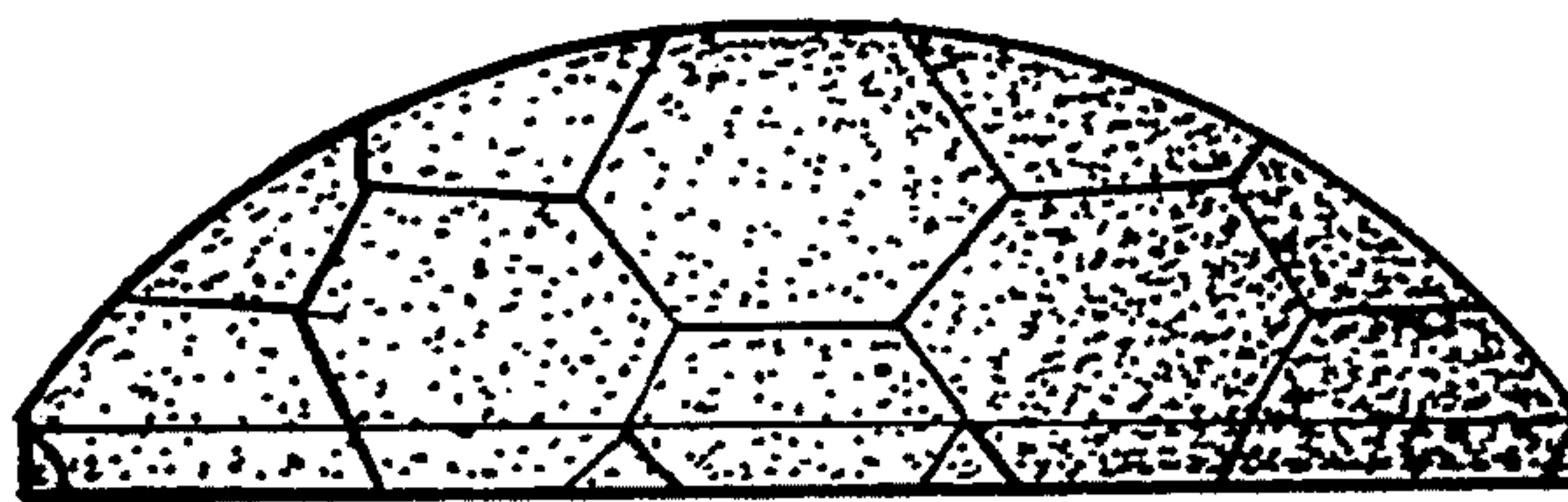
