[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ball-point pen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a ballpoint pen showing my new design with the writing tip retracted; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view with the writing tip extended; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3; and, FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

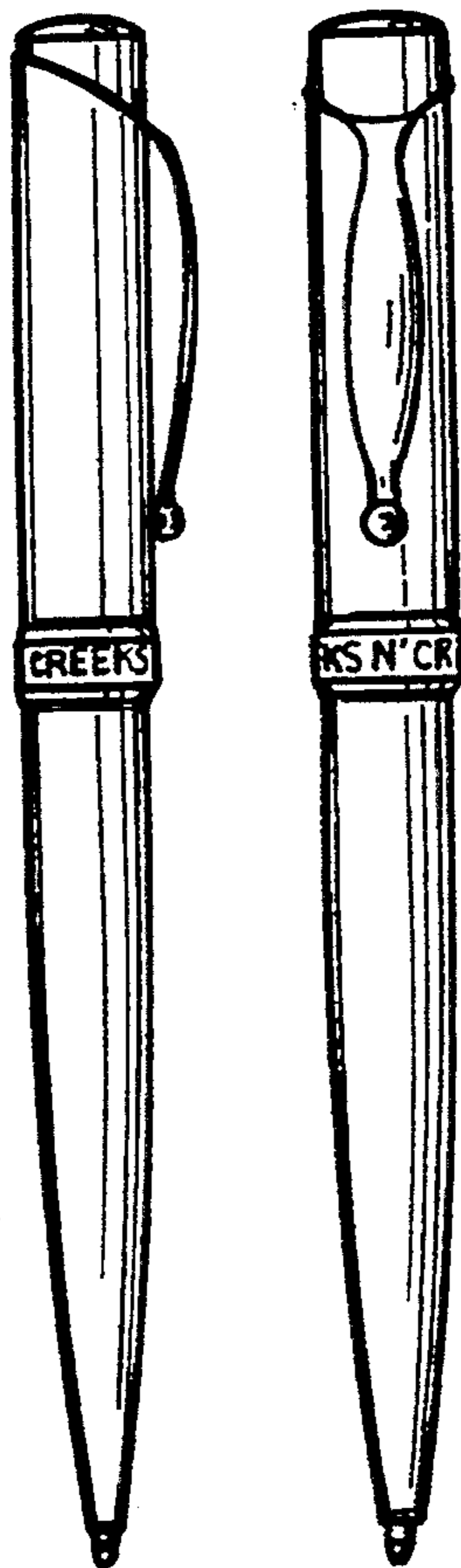

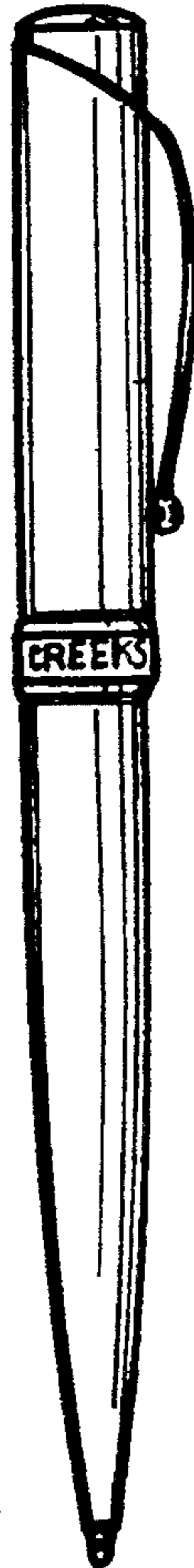
