FIG. 1 is a side elevational view showing one side of the handgun embodying the ornamental appearance of this invention;

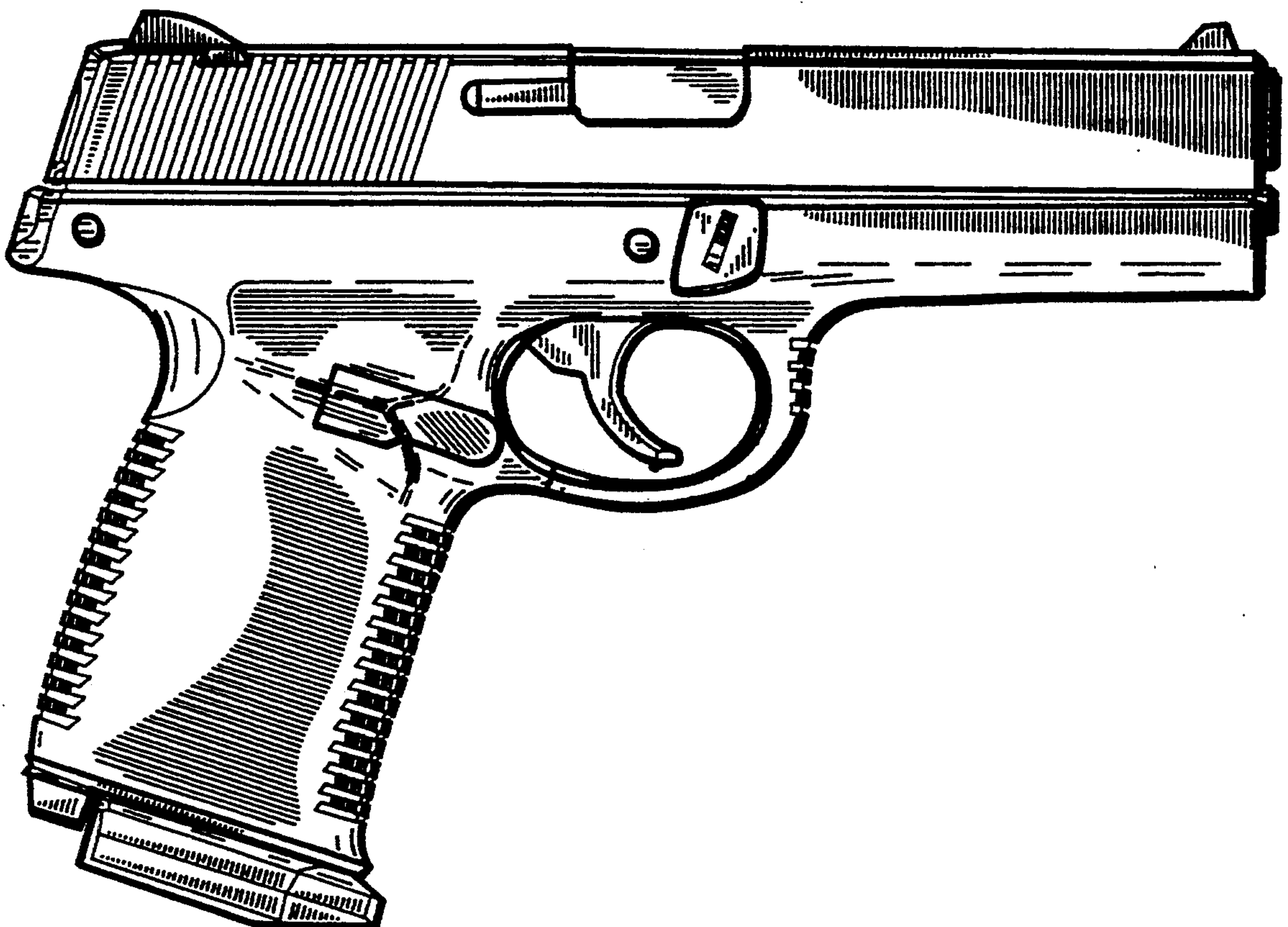
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view showing the opposite side of the handgun;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof.



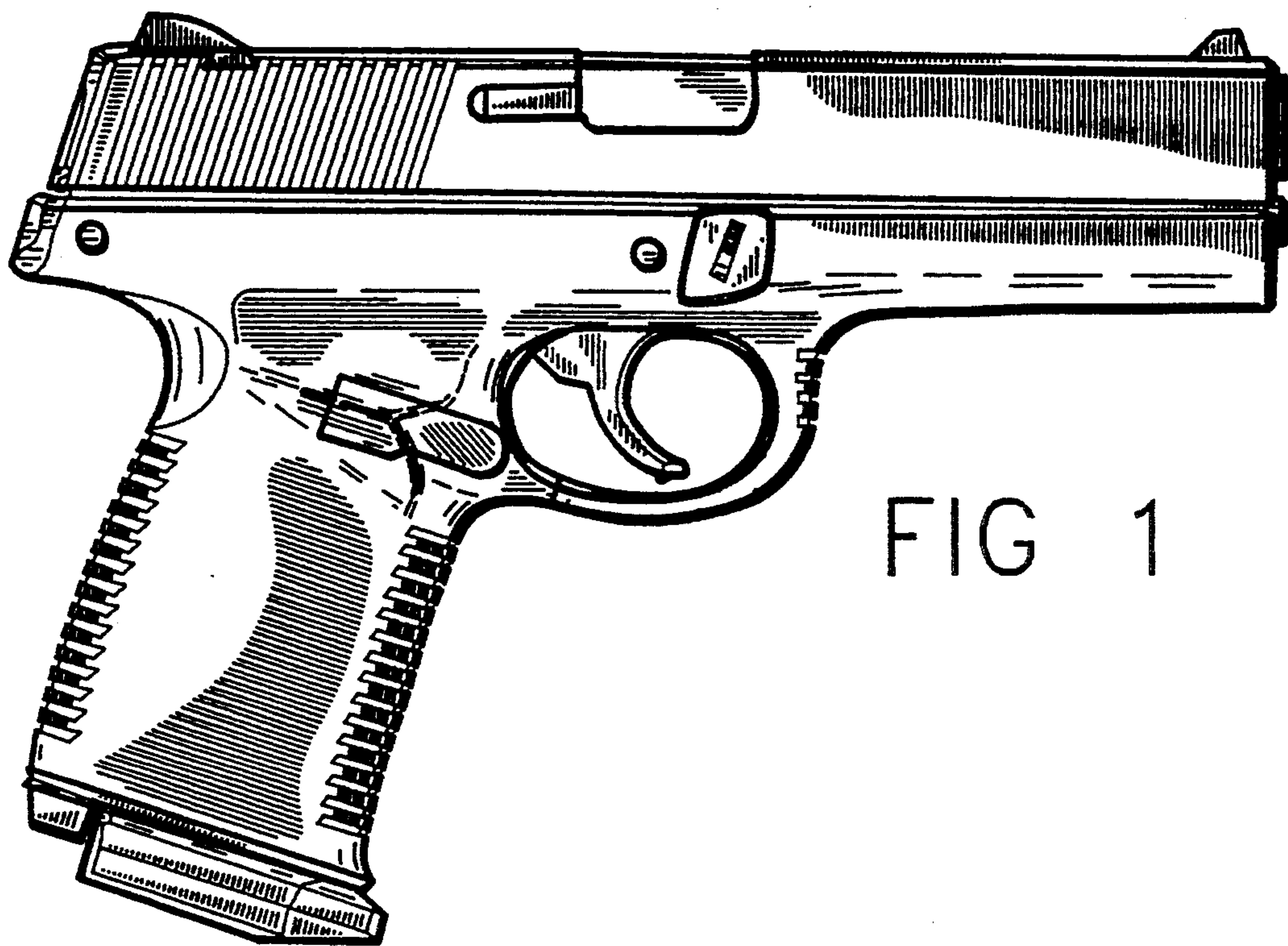

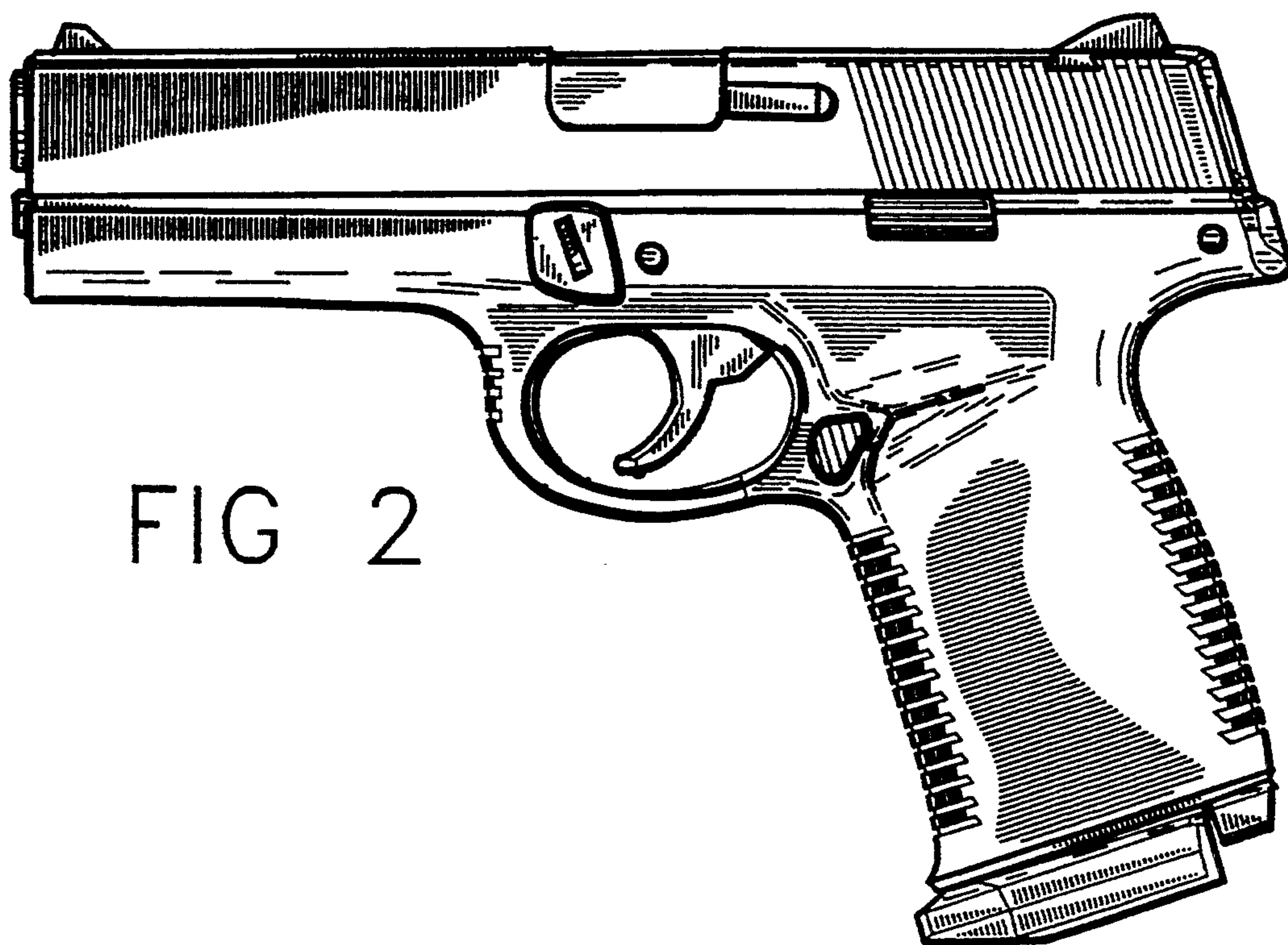

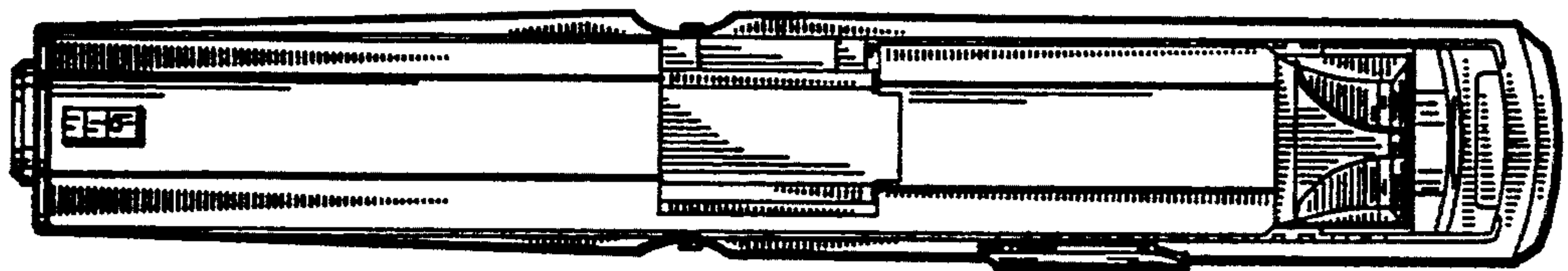

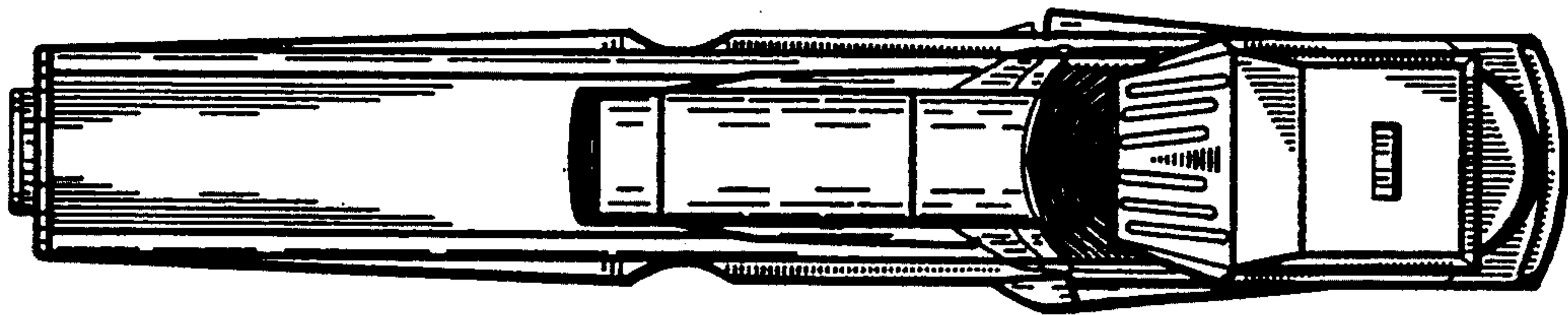

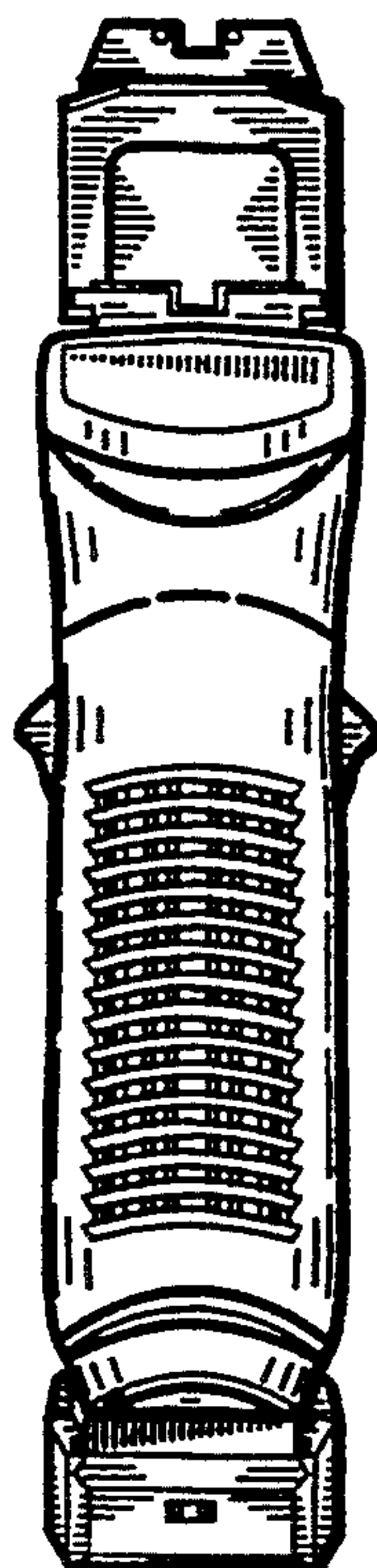
