FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a coin sorter embodying our new design;


FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,






