FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the preferred embodiment of the new design;

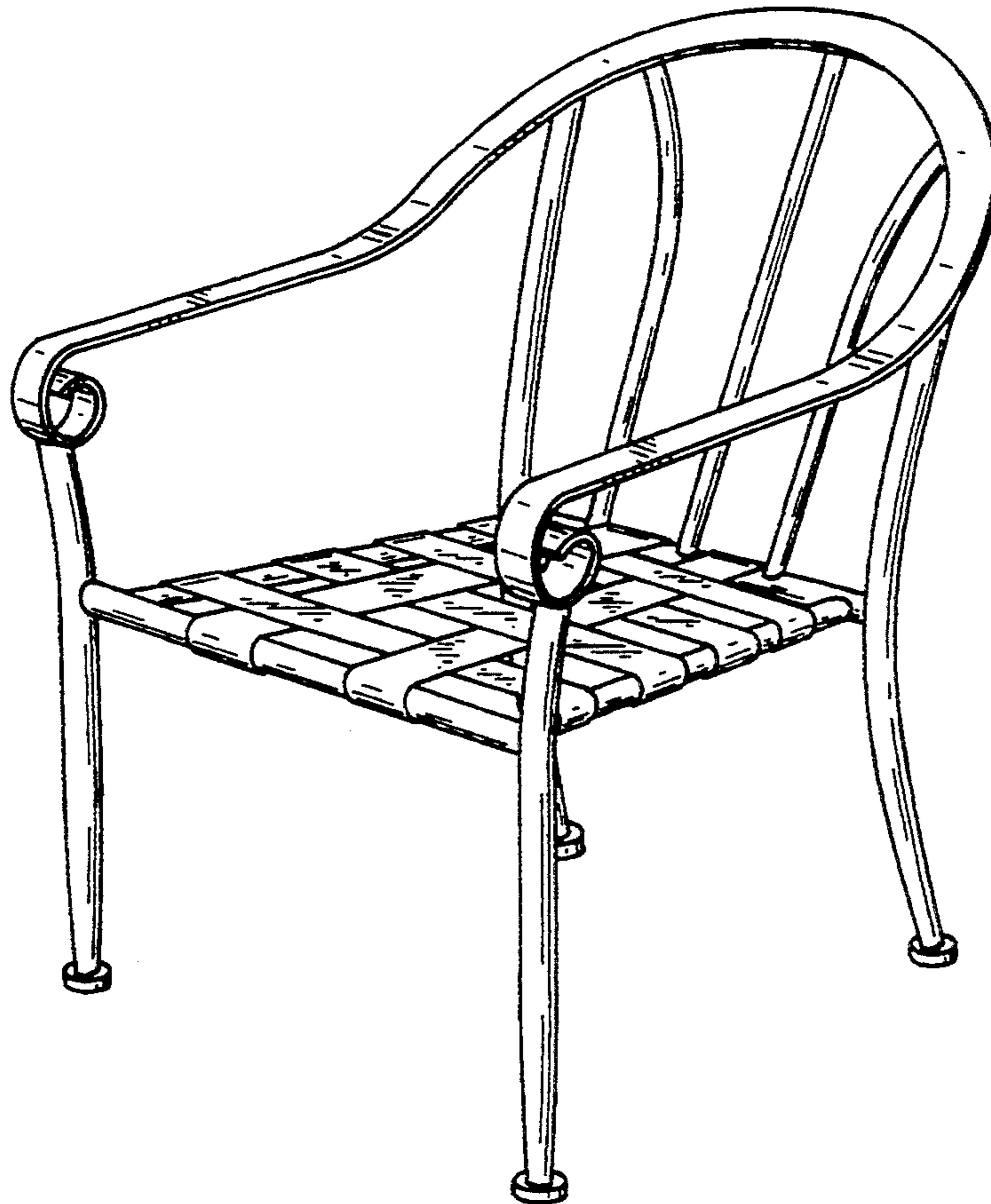
FIG. 2 is a front view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a back view of the embodiment of FIG. 1.



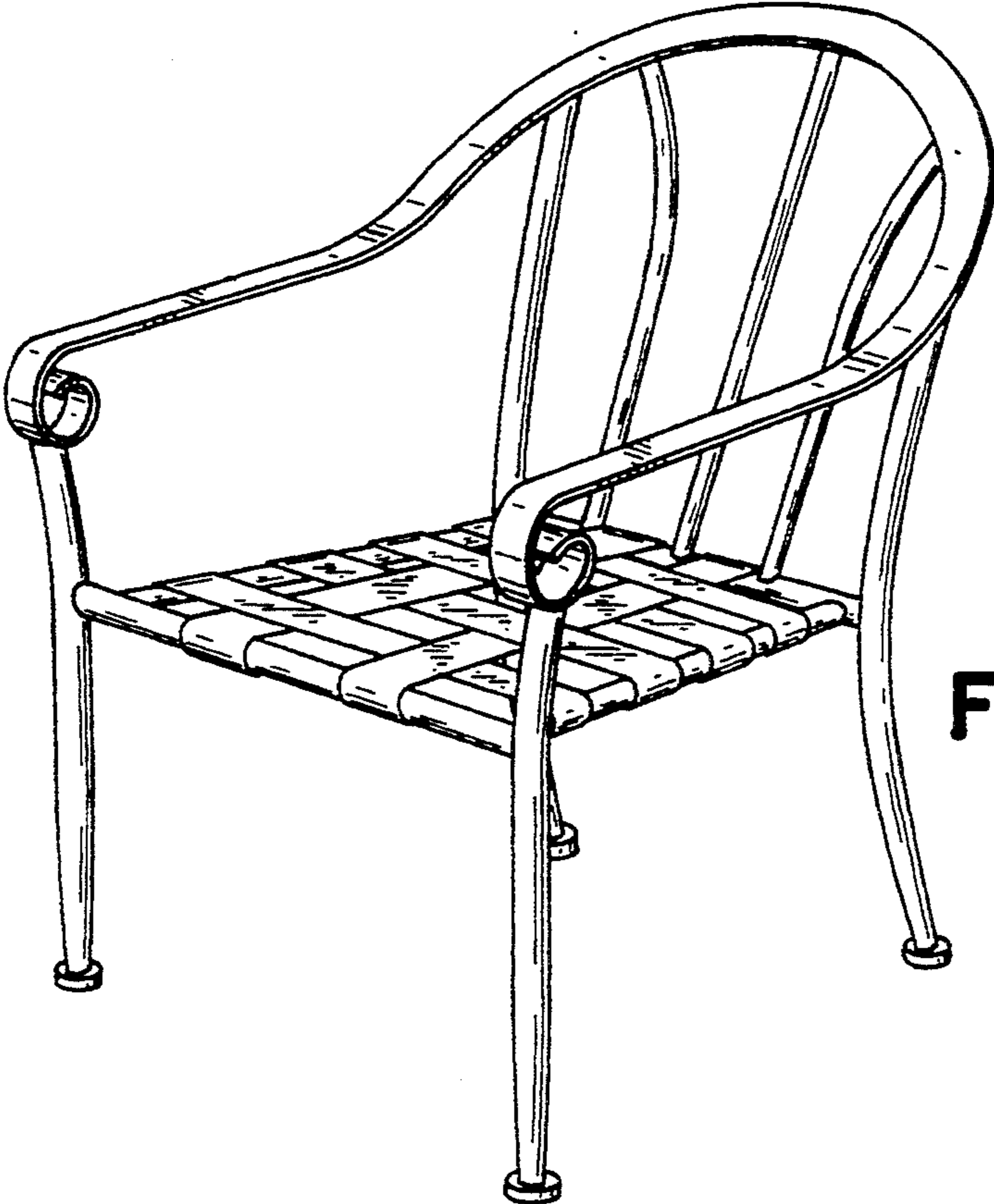

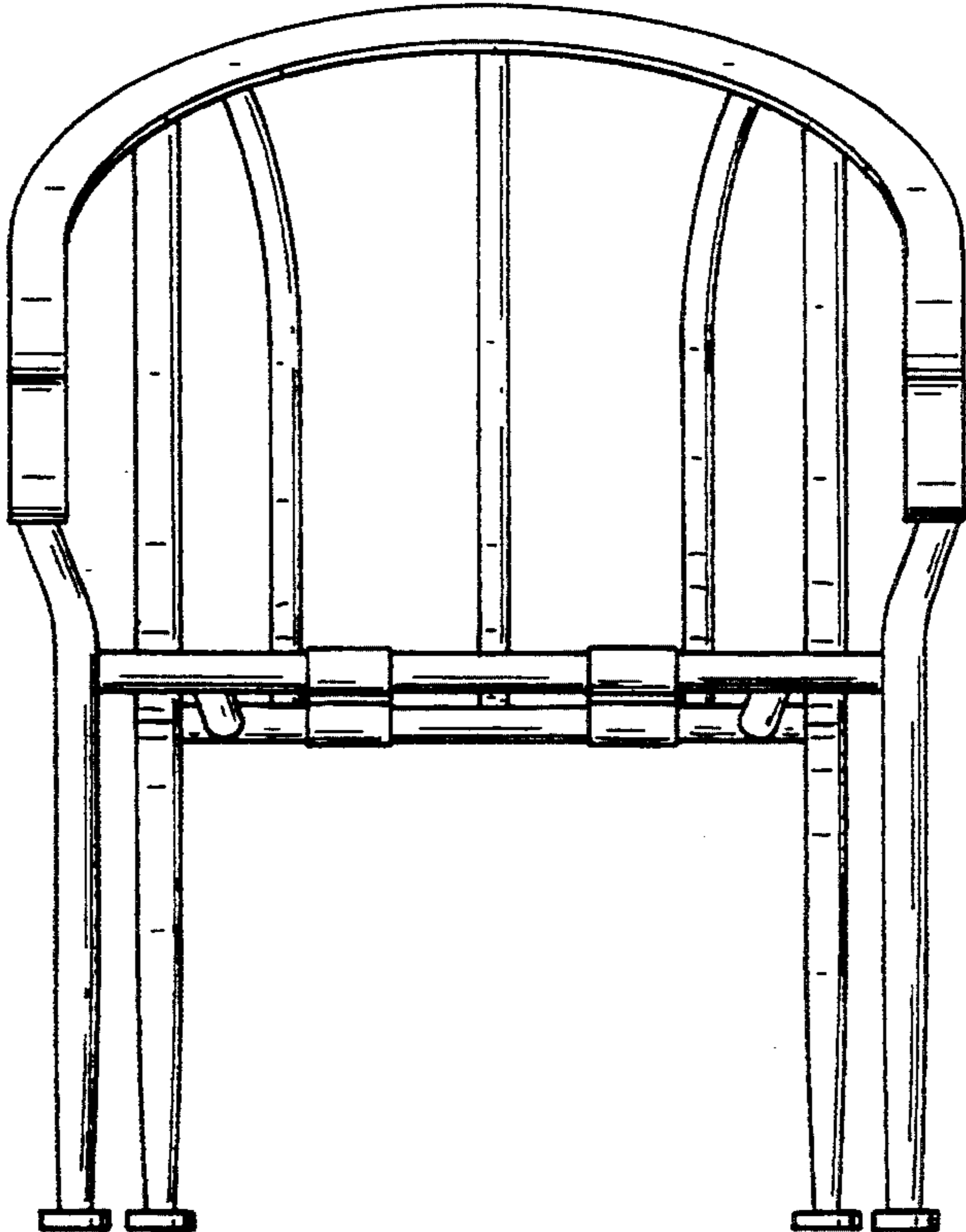

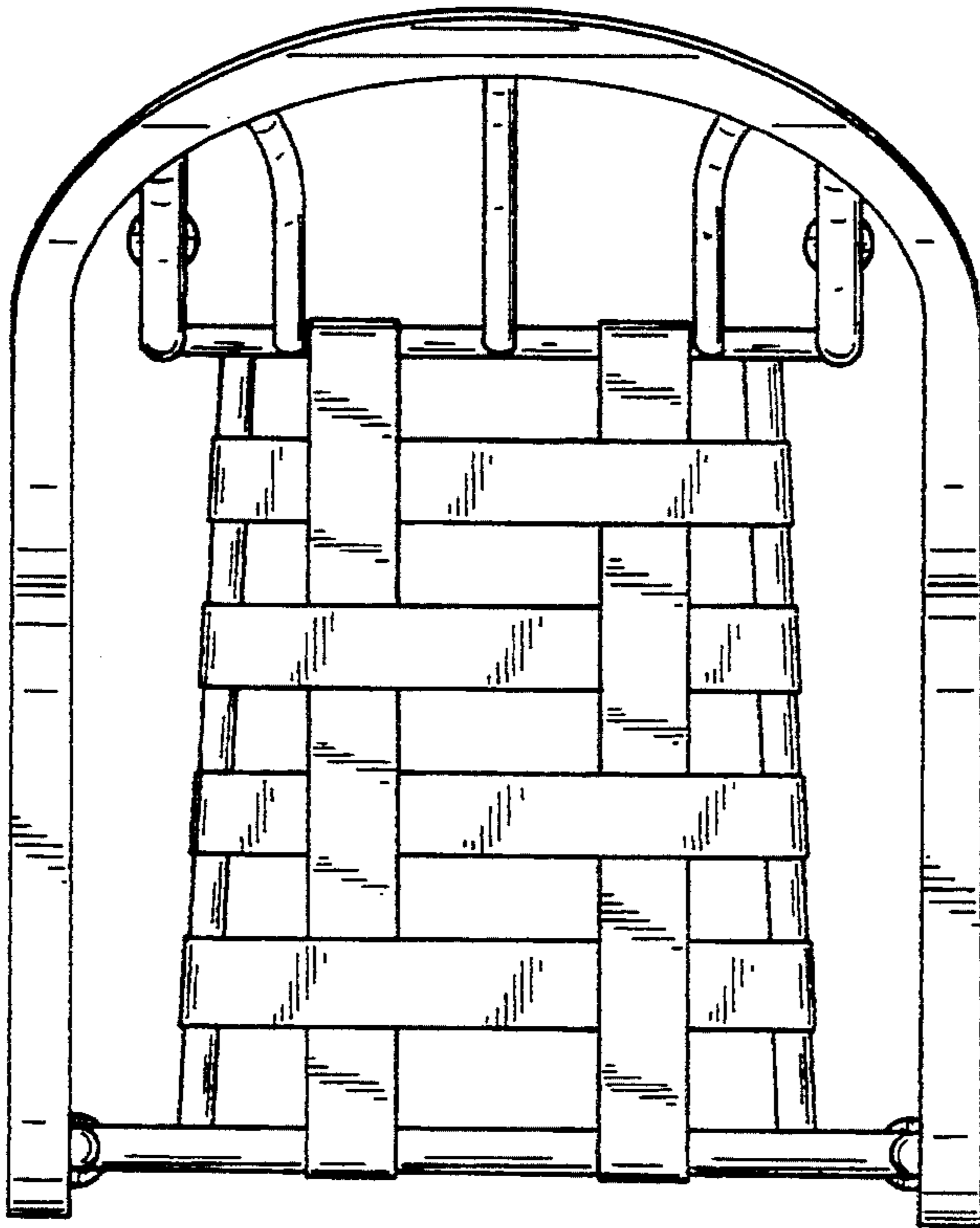

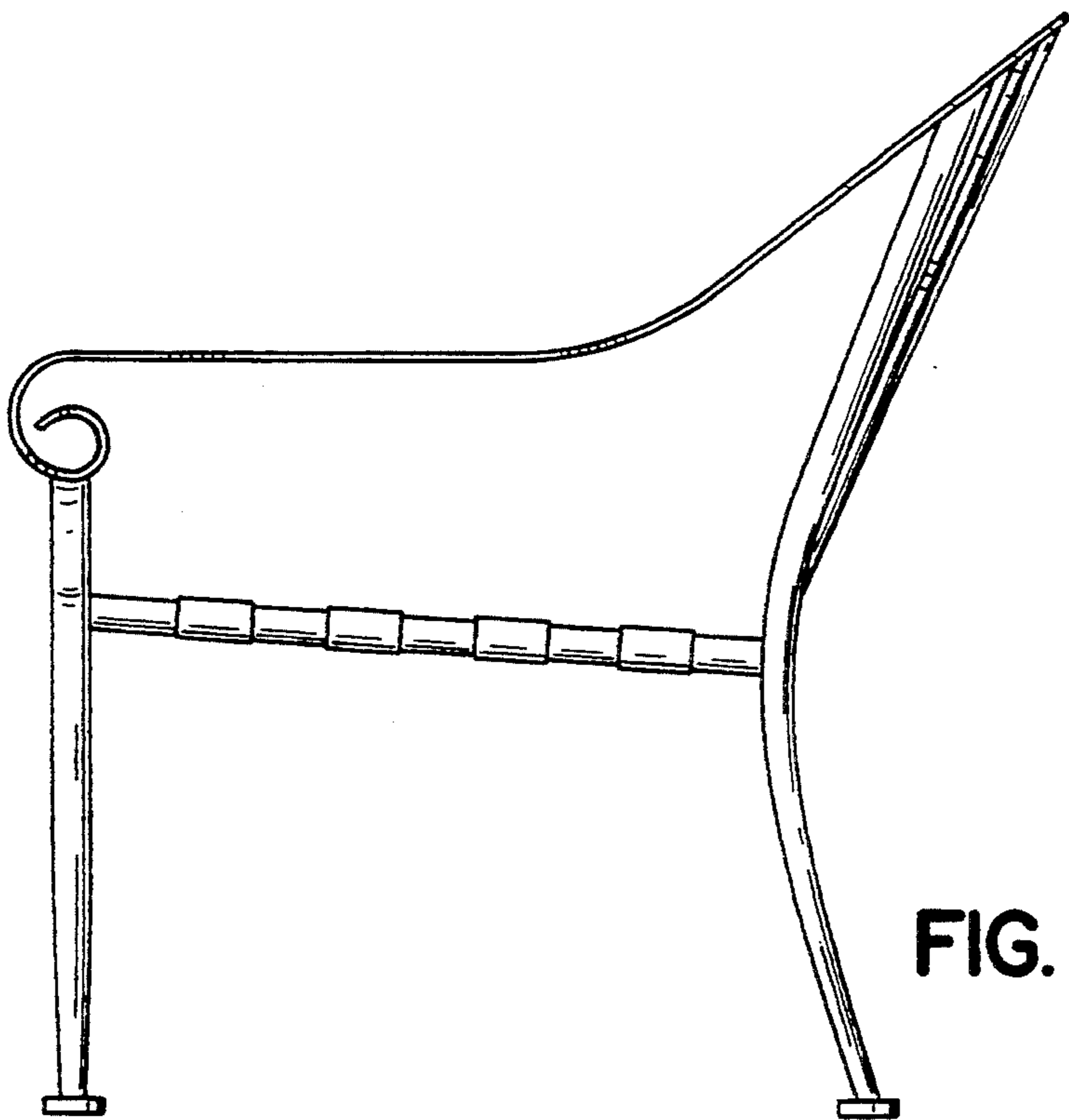

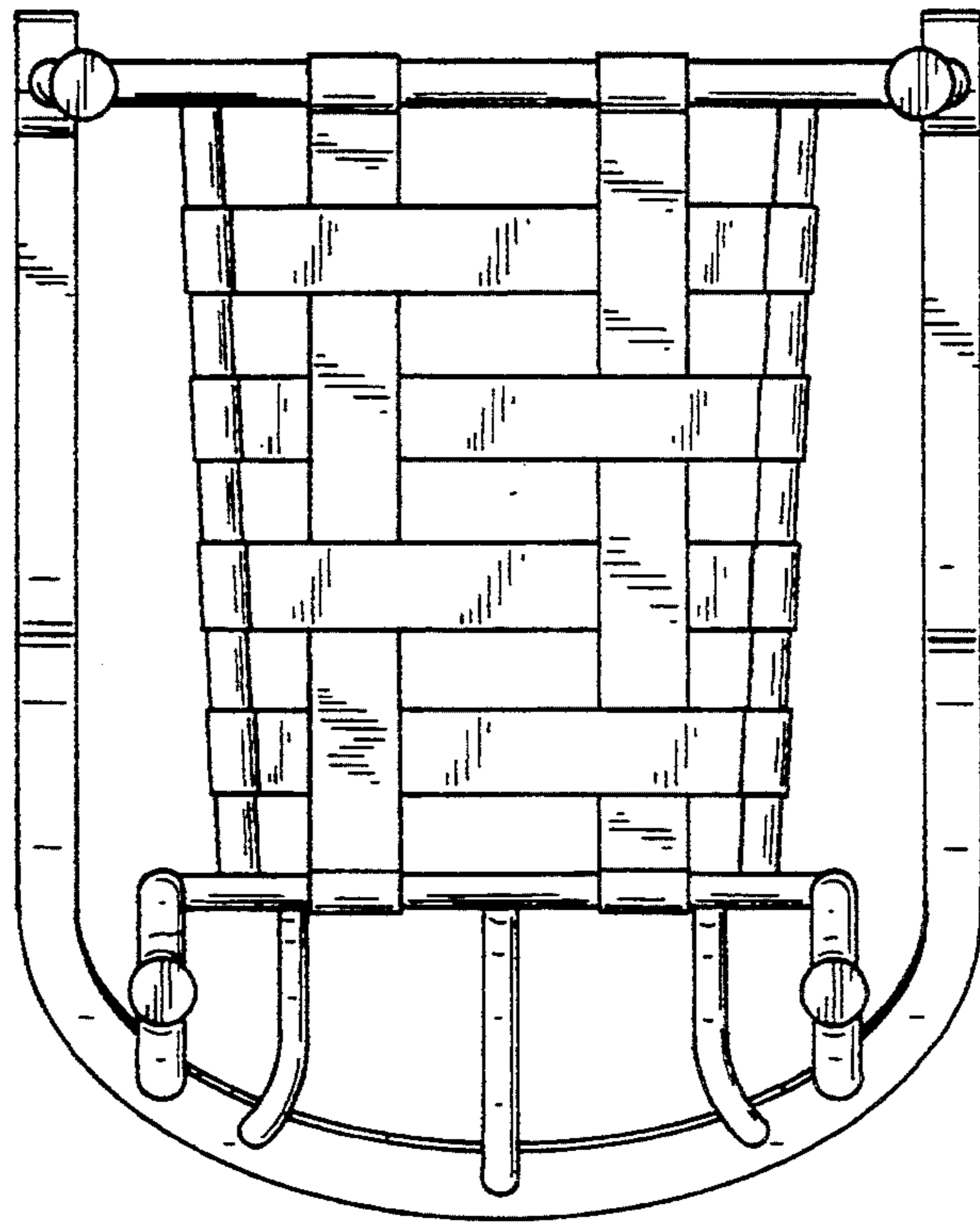

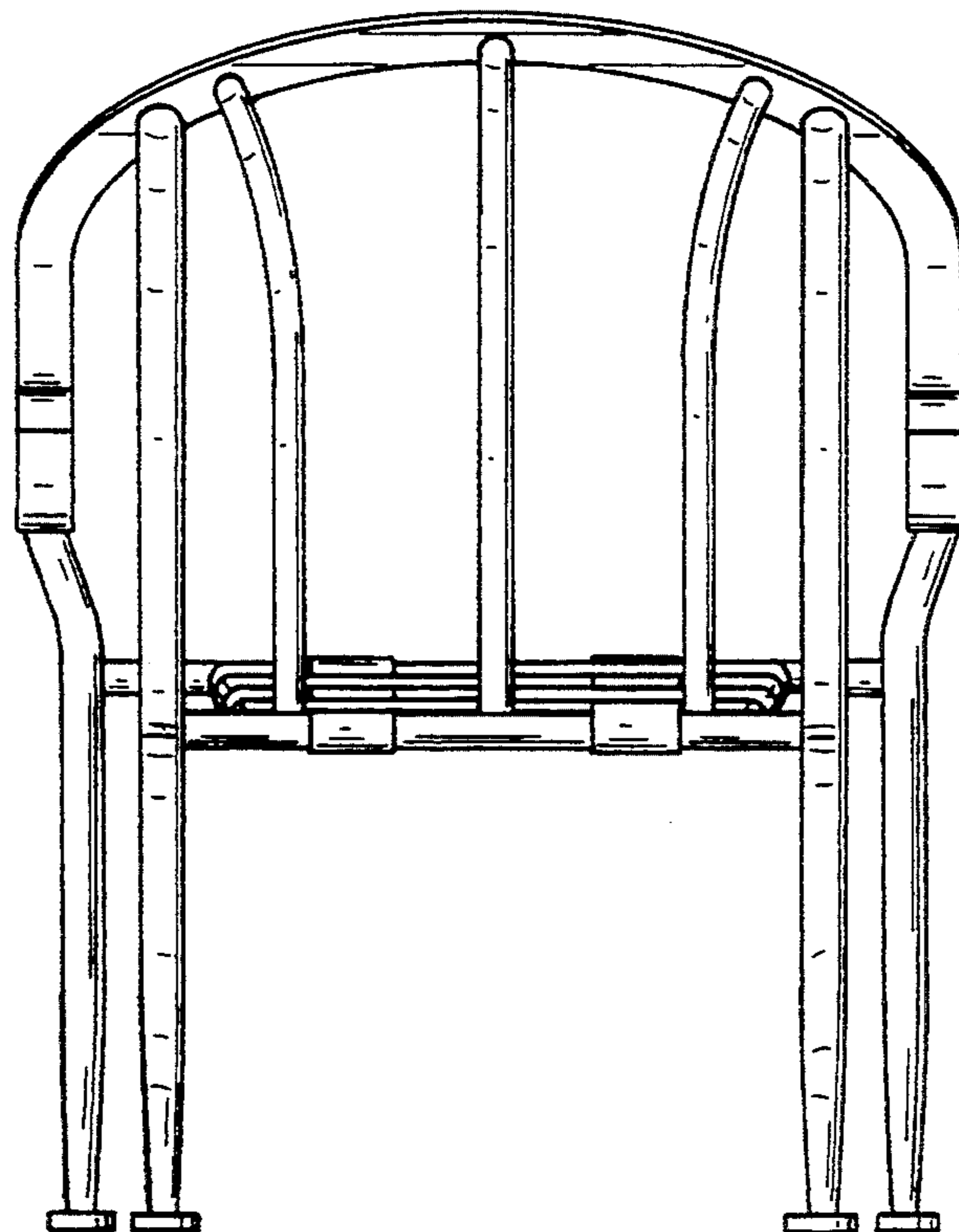
