DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front plan view of the credit card; FIG. 2 is a top and bottom elevational view FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is back plan view of the credit card of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a right and left elevational view of the credit card of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a front plan view of a second embodiment of the credit card; FIG. 6 is the top and bottom elevational view of the credit card of FIG. 5; FIG. 7 is back plan view of the credit card of FIG. 5; and, FIG. 8 is the right and left elevational view of the credit card of FIG. 5.

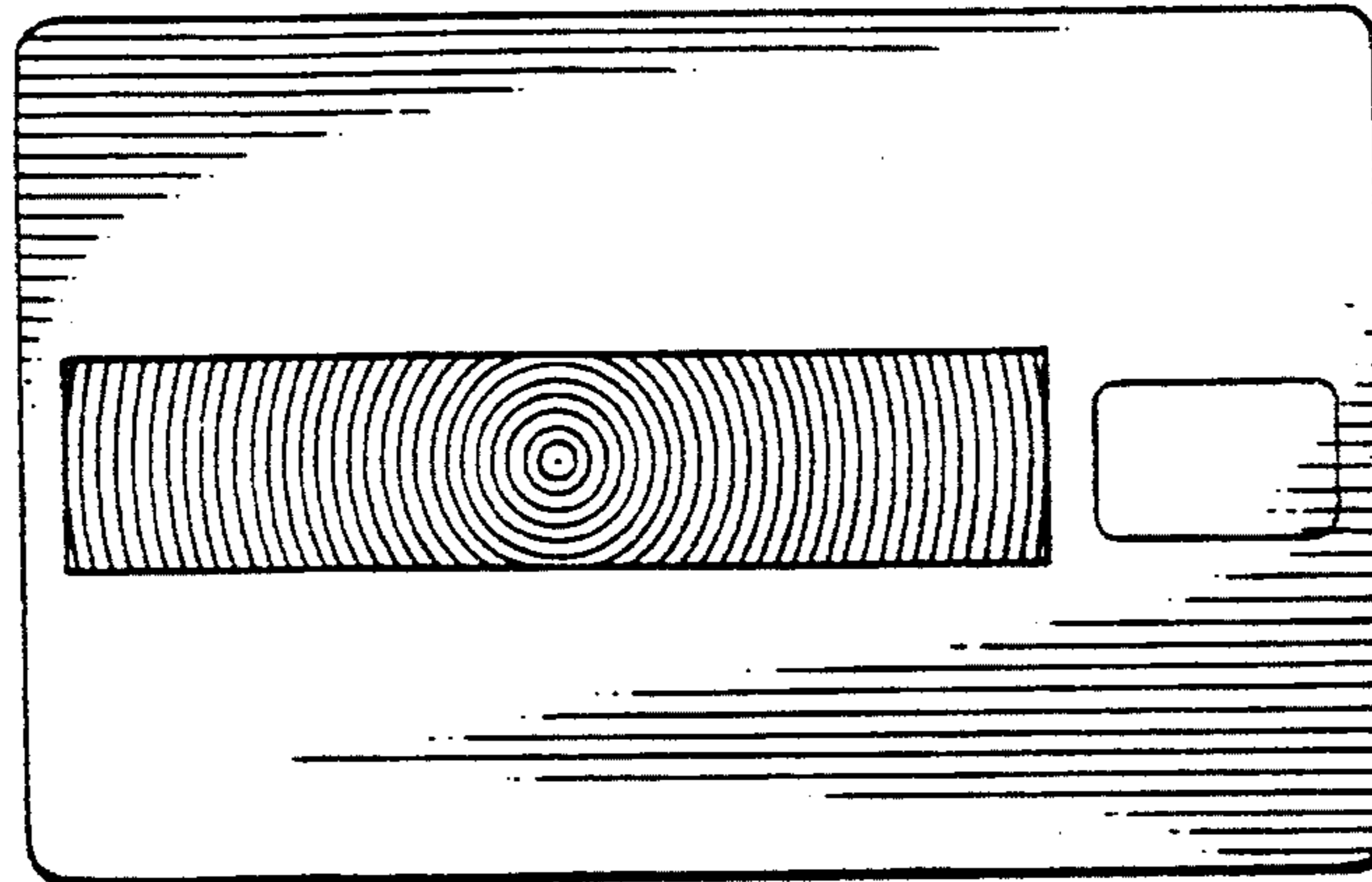

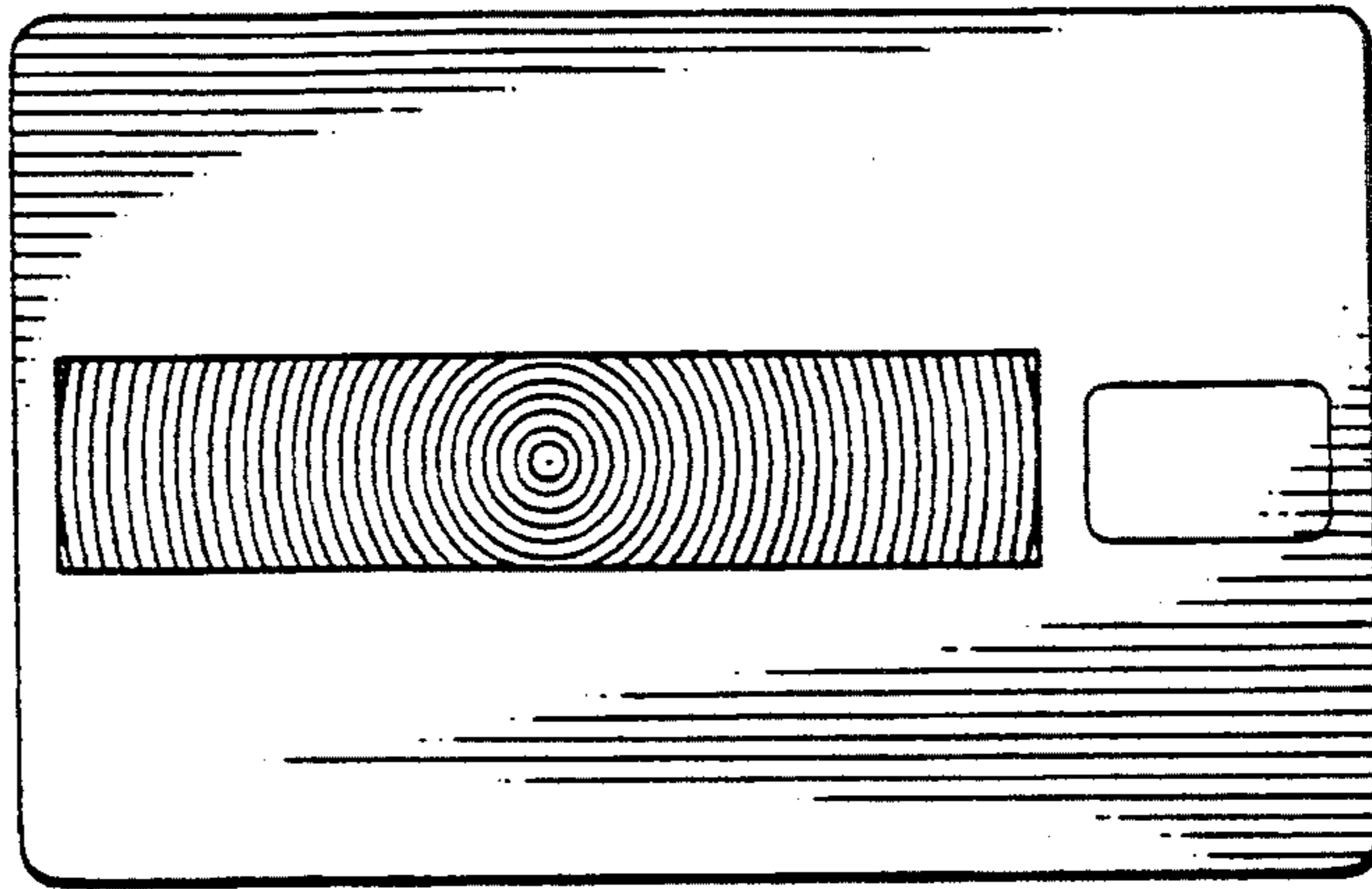

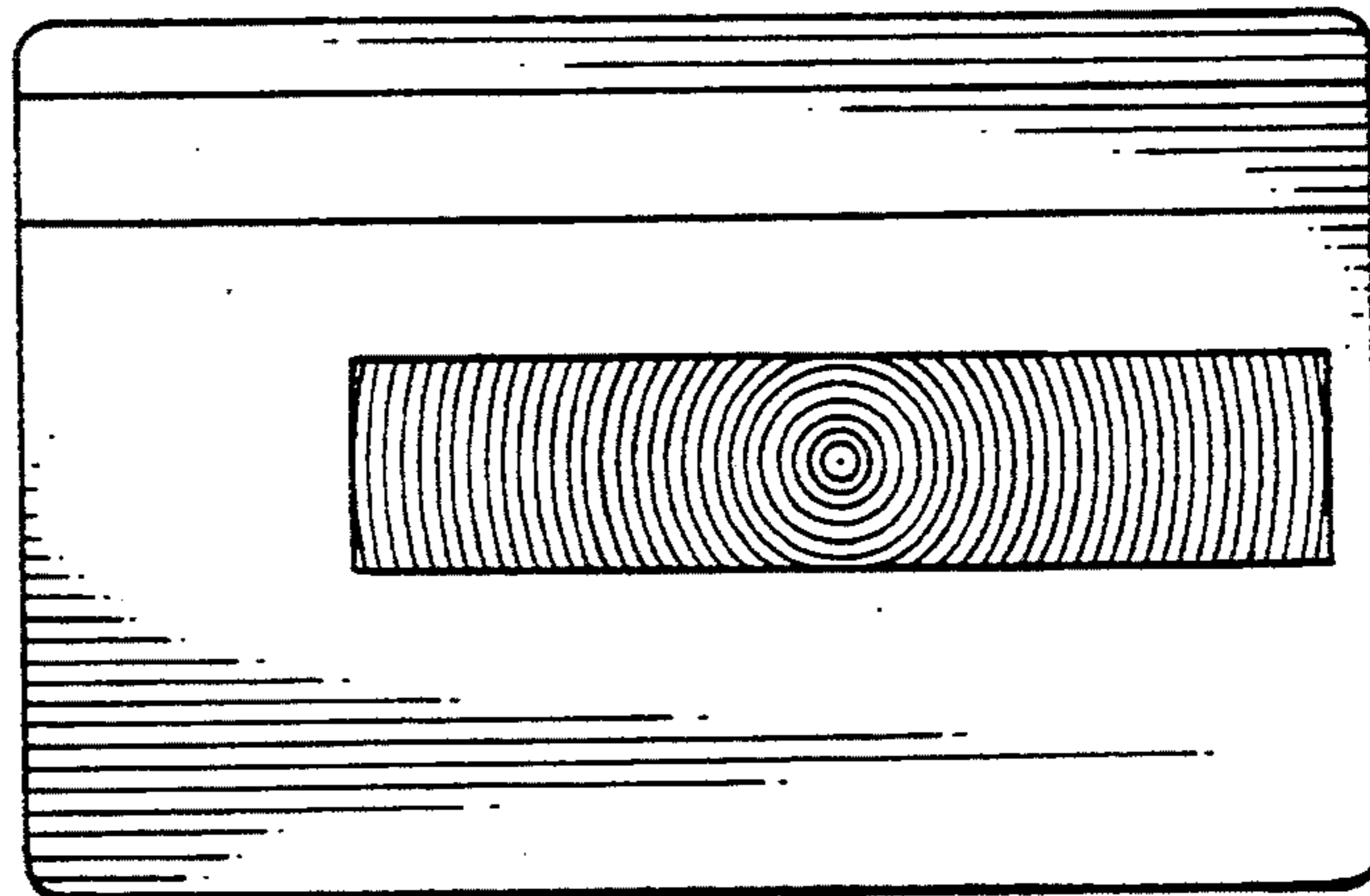

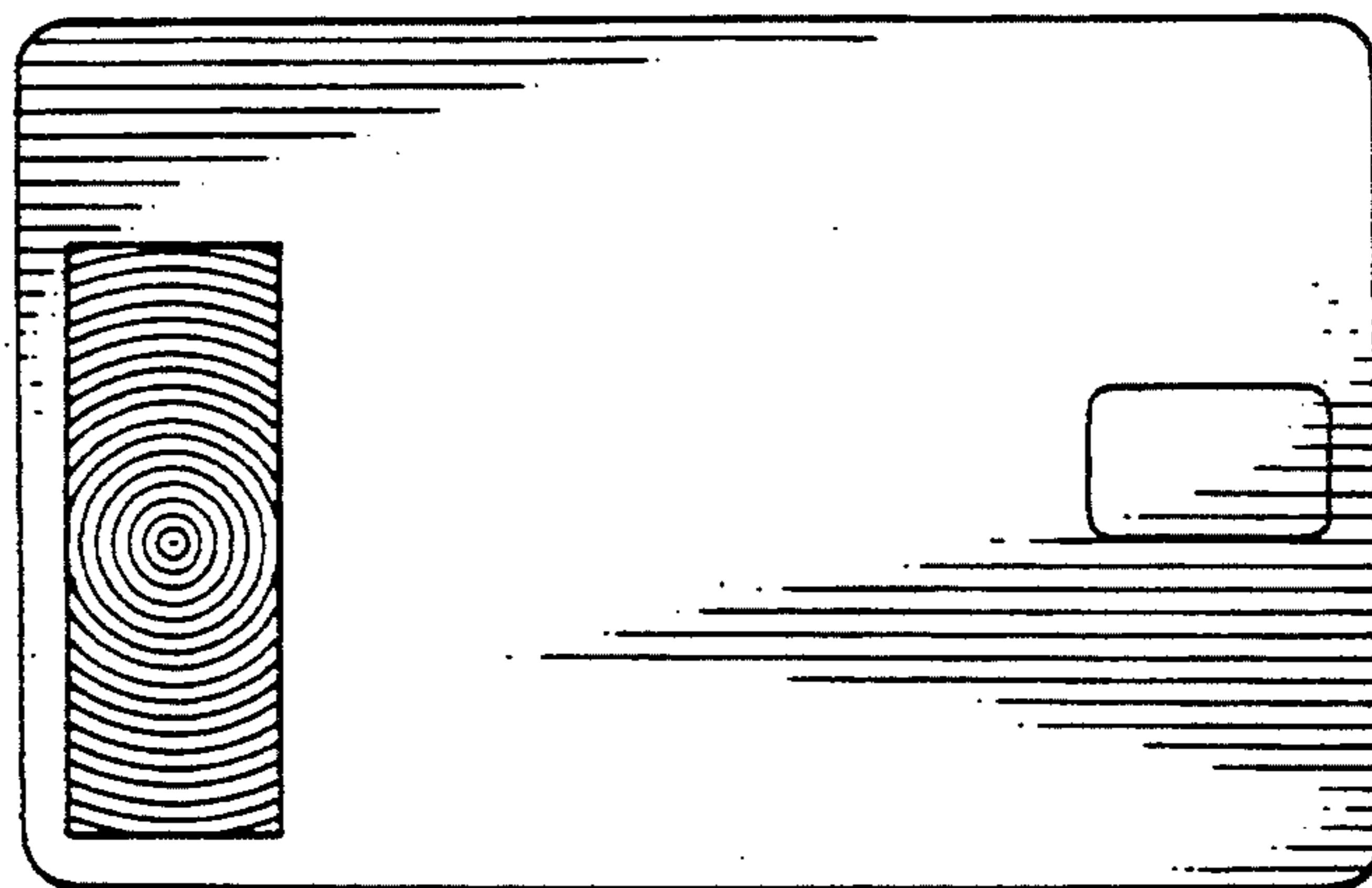

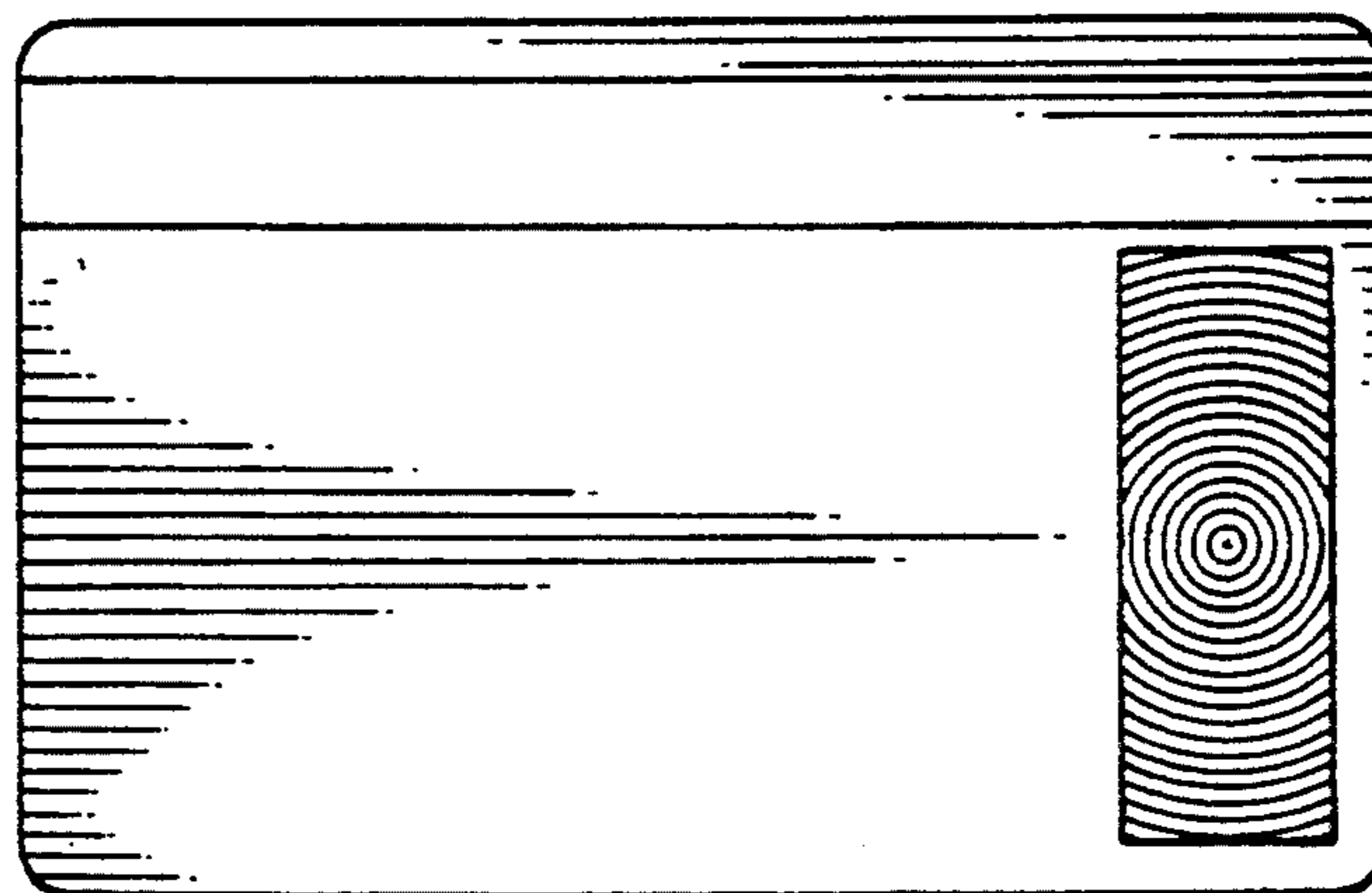
