[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf club driver head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a golf club driver head showing our new design with a broken line showing a shaft portion for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

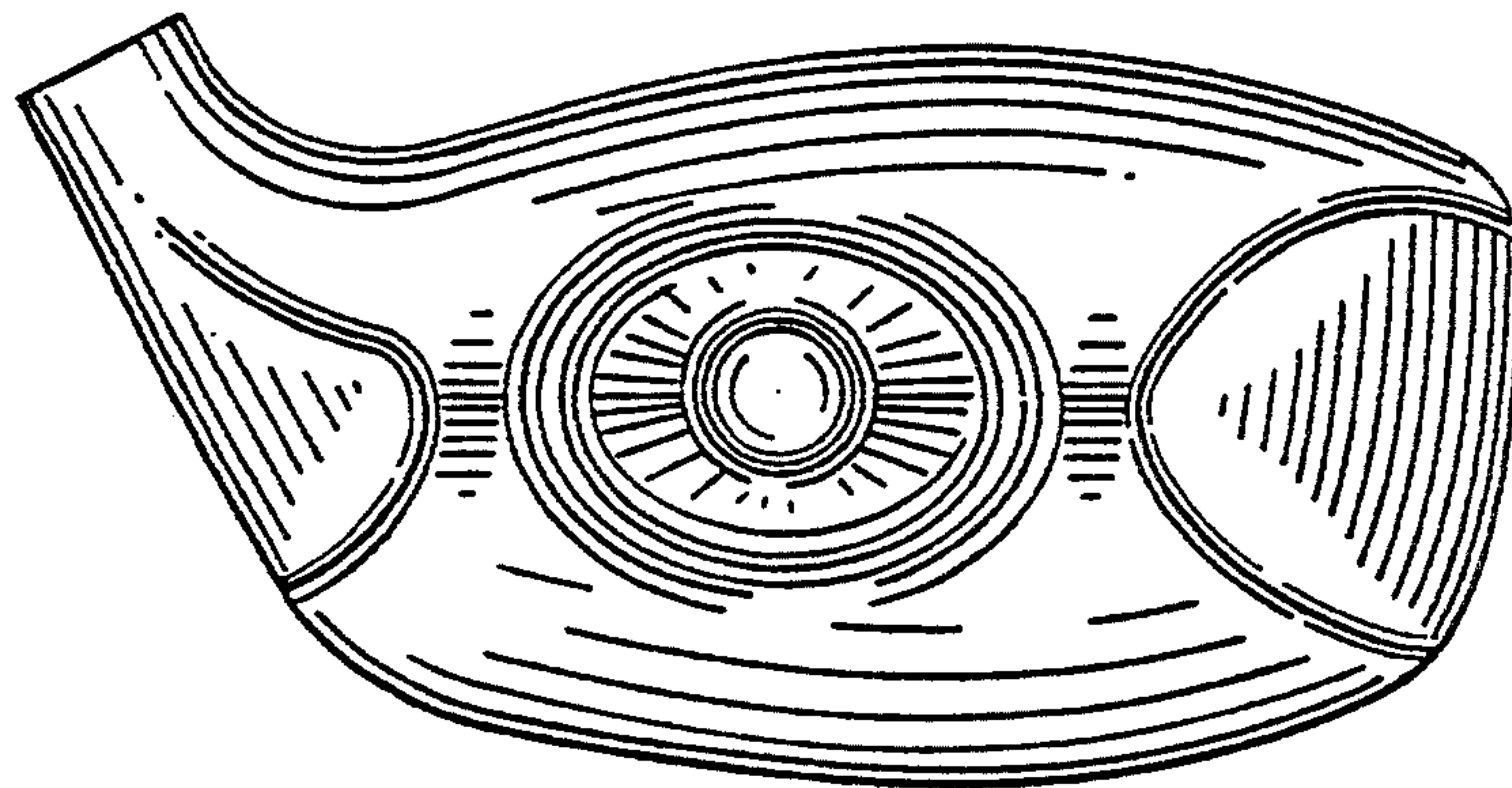

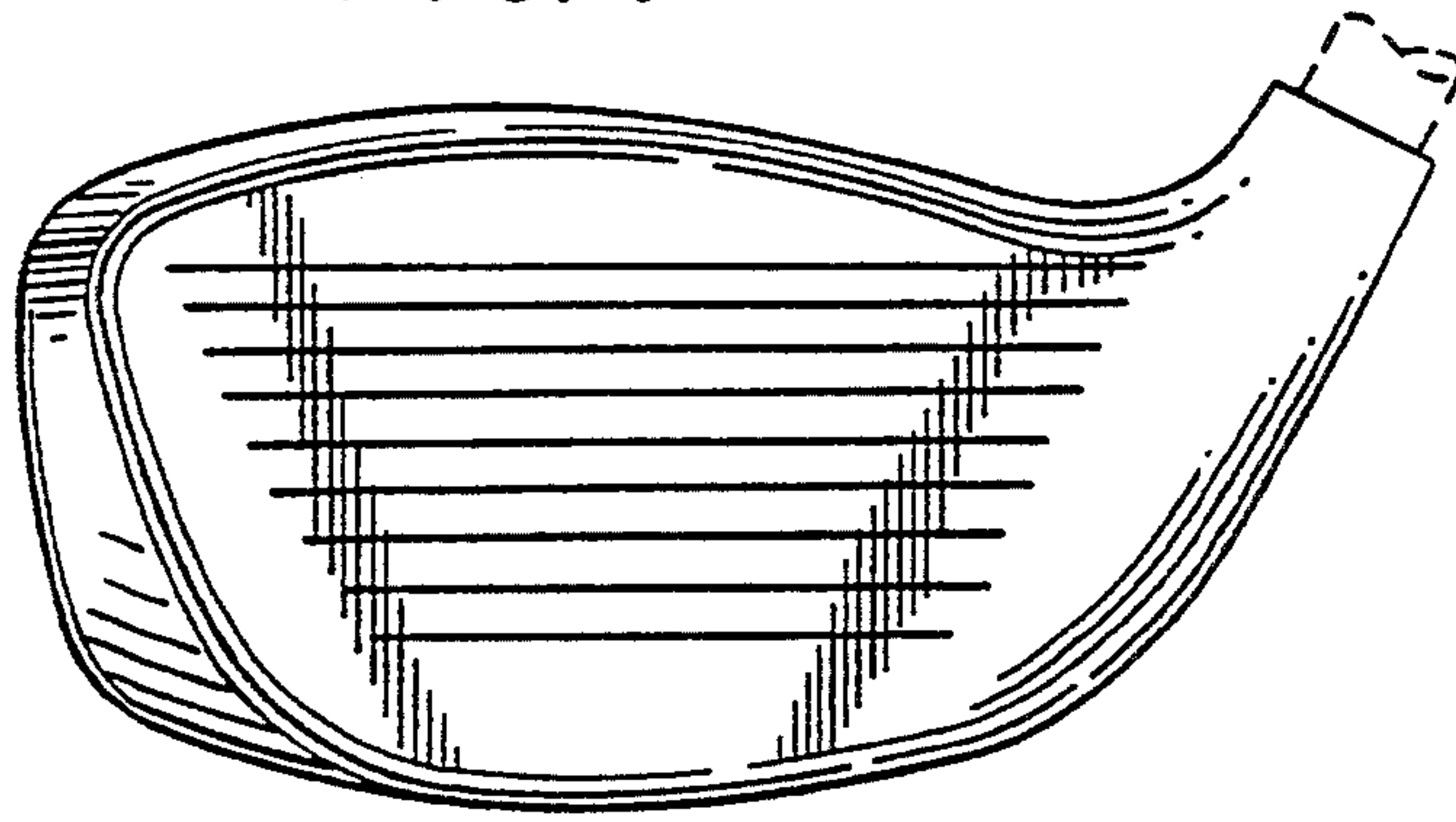

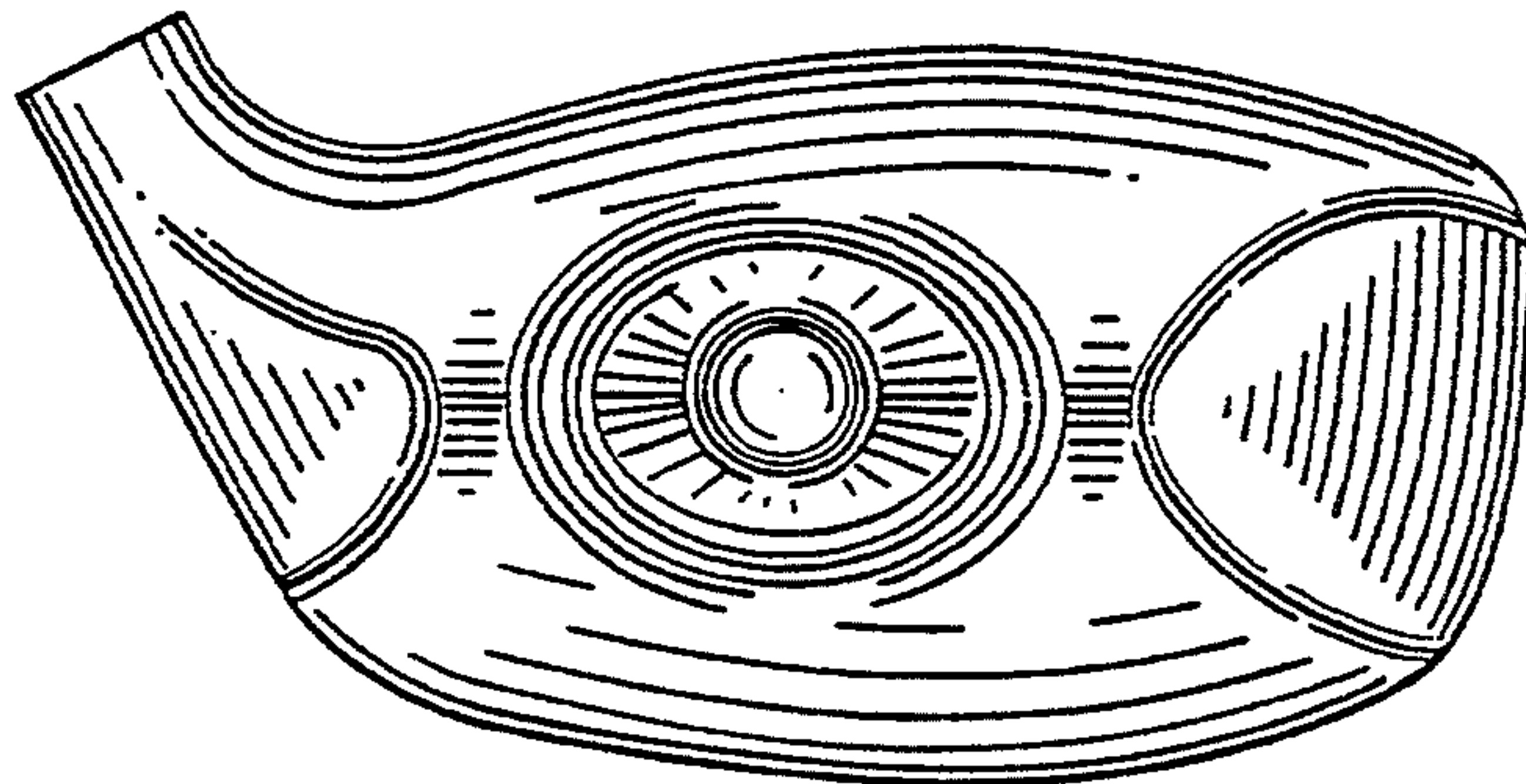

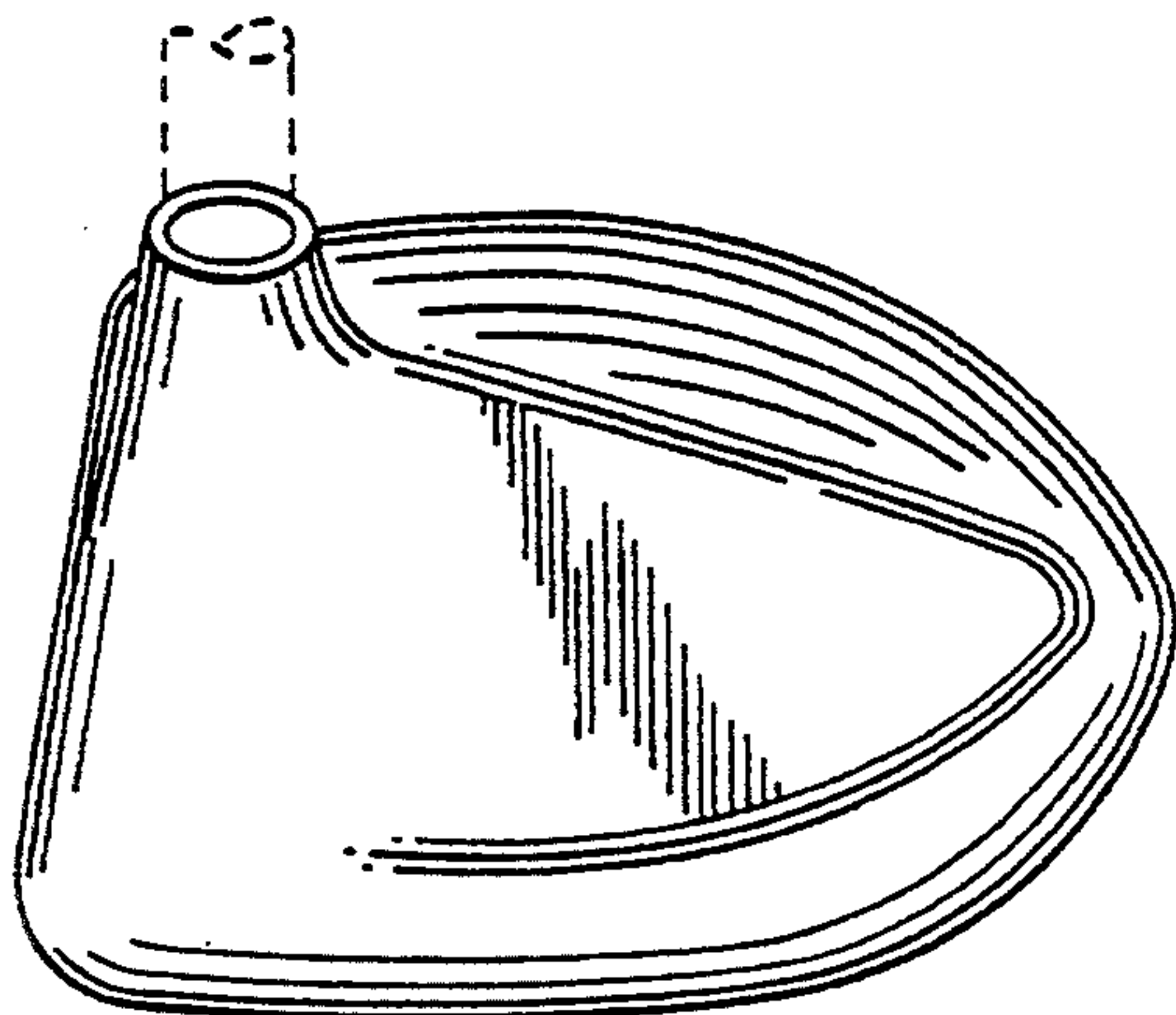

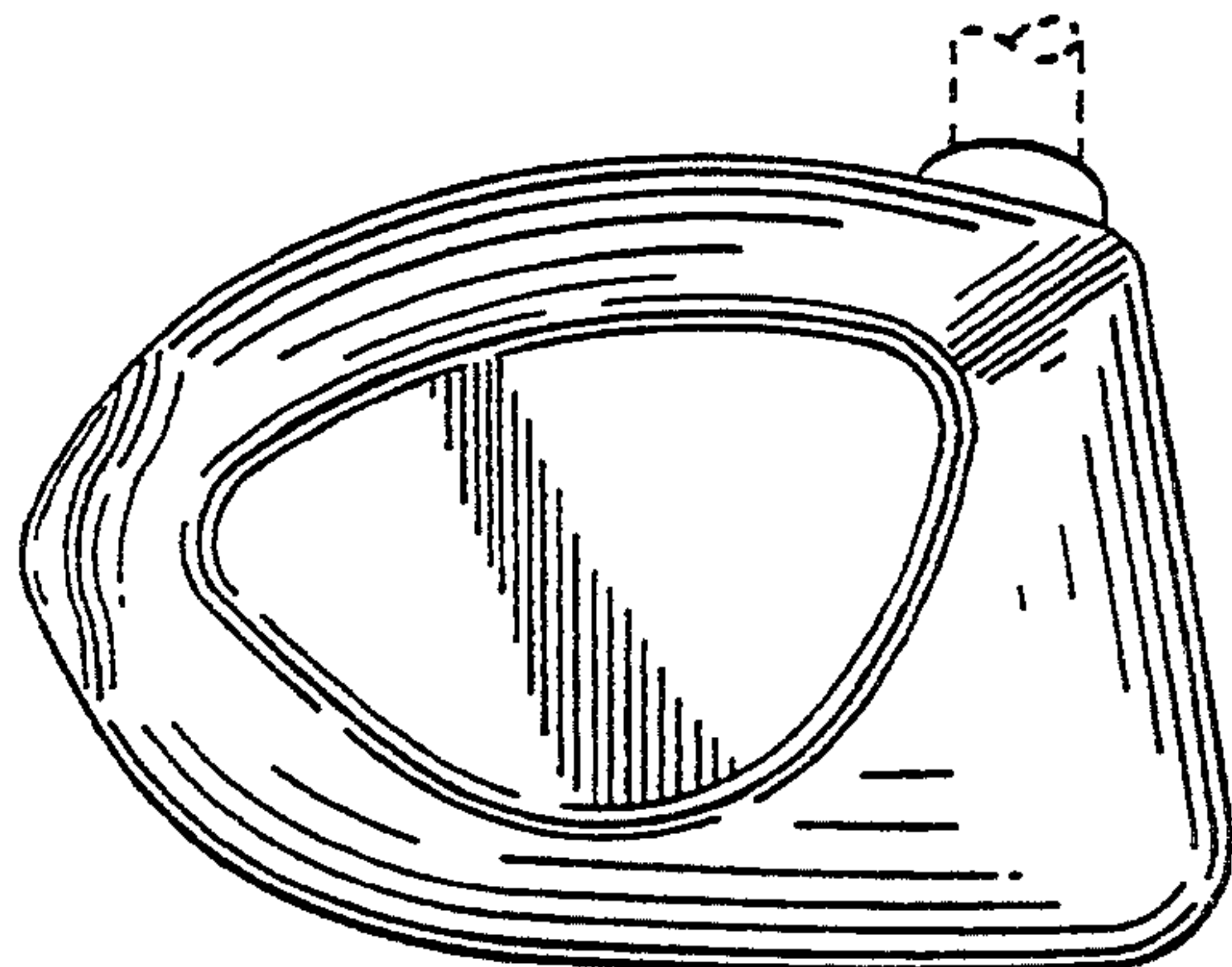

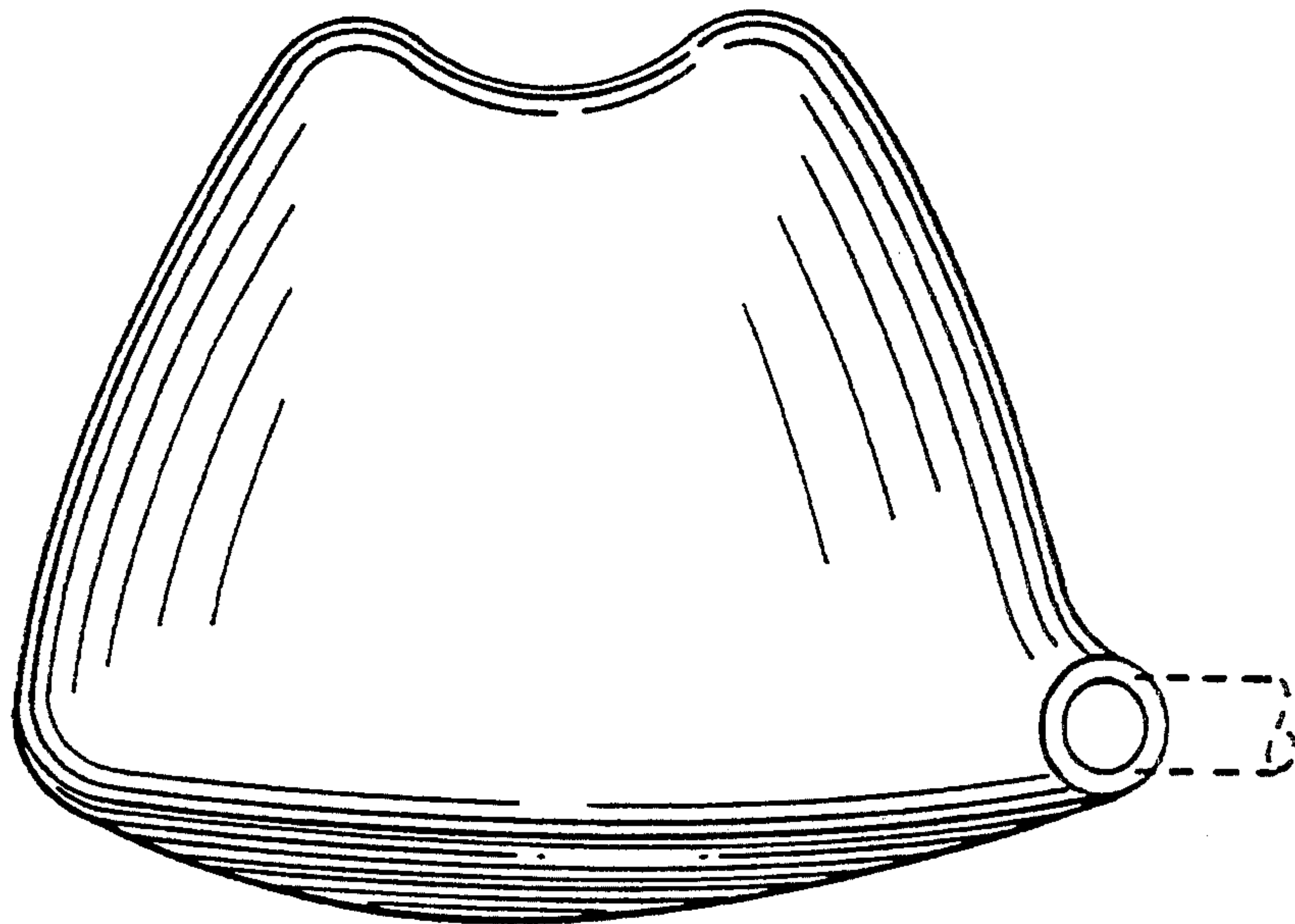
