[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a head of a putter-type golf club, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a head of a putter-type golf club showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the face of the putter head of FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a top view of the putter head of FIG. 2;


FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the sole portion of the putter head of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the rear of the putter head of FIG. 2;


FIG. 6 is a toe-end view of the putter head of FIG. 2; and,


