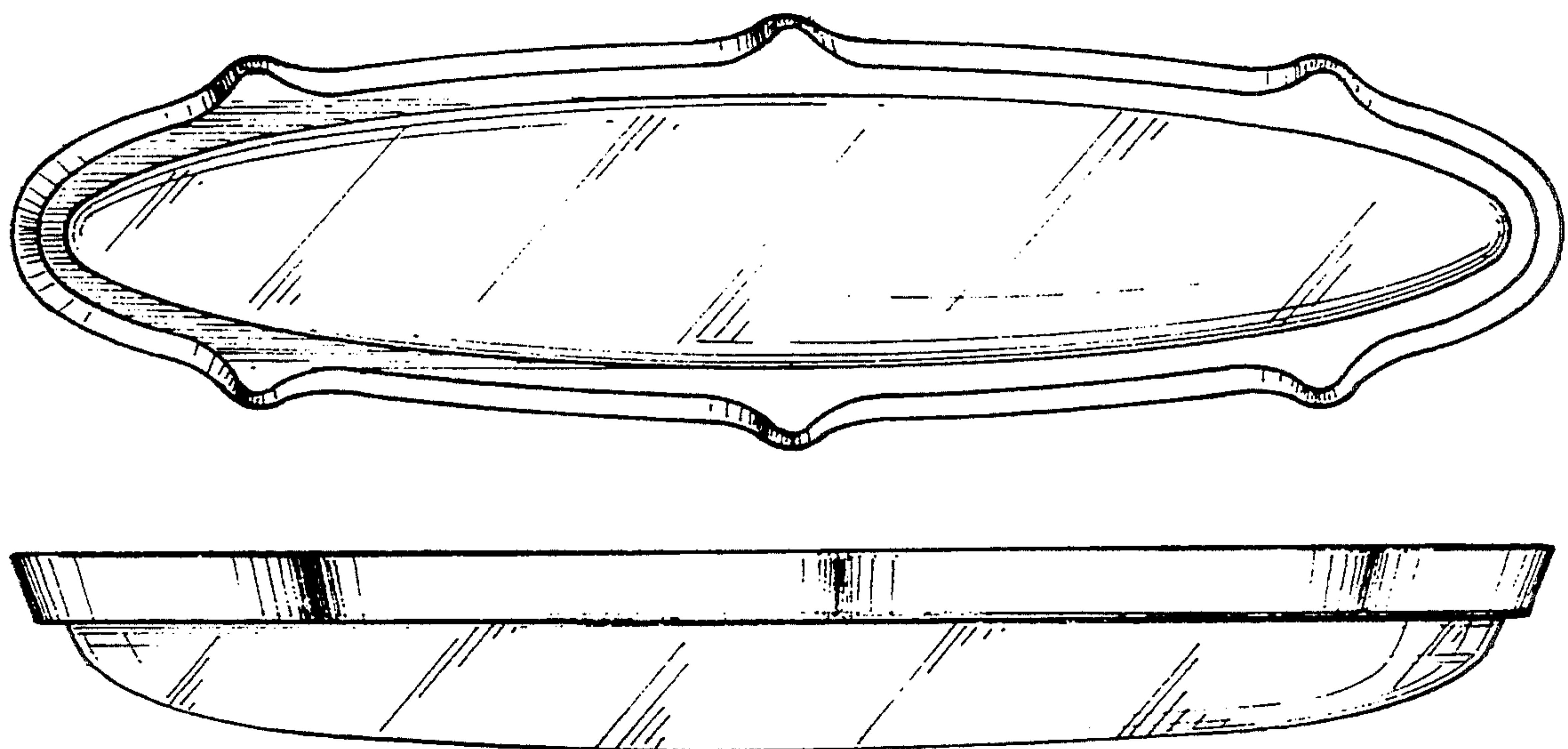

FIG. 4 is an end view of the lamp shown in FIG. 1.



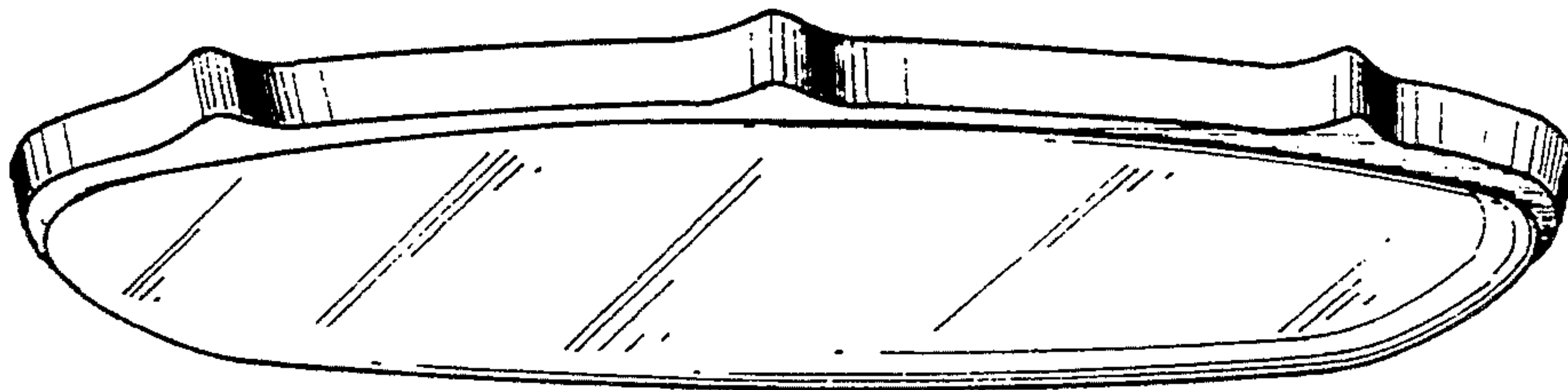

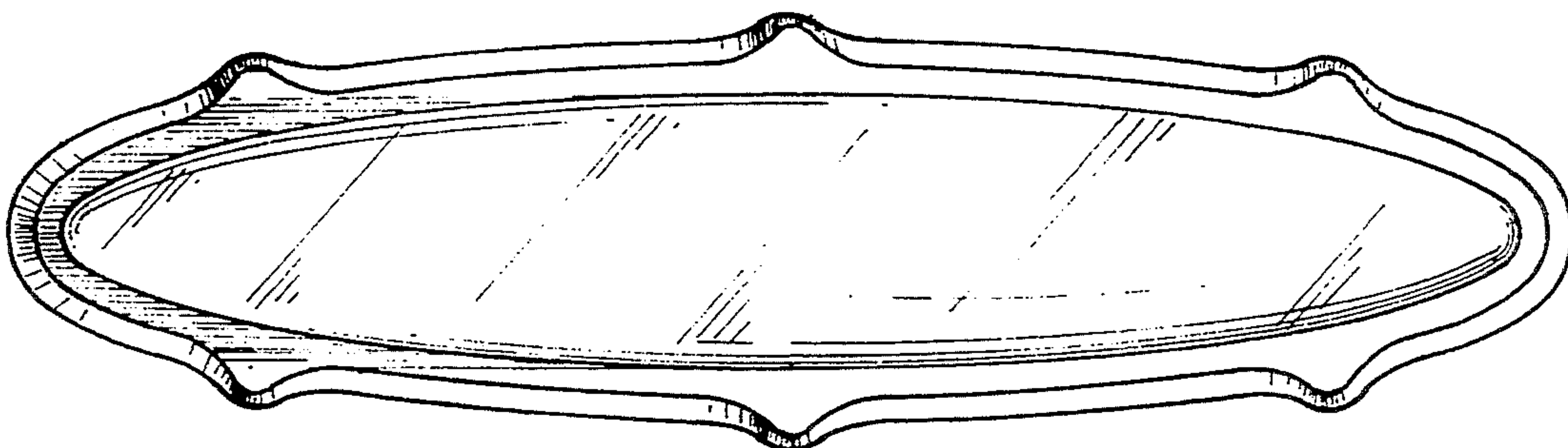

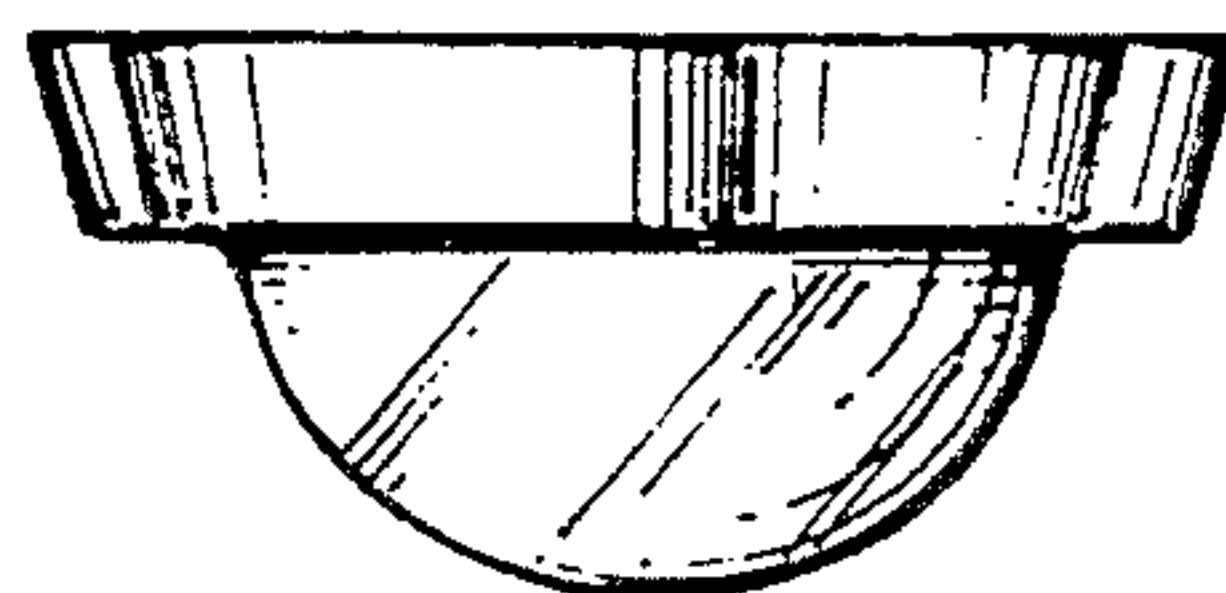
