[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an exterior lighting fixture depicting a Canadian goose, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of the exterior lighting fixture depicting a Canadian goose;

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the lighting fixture depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the lighting fixture depicted in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a top view of the lighting fixture depicted in FIG. 1.
