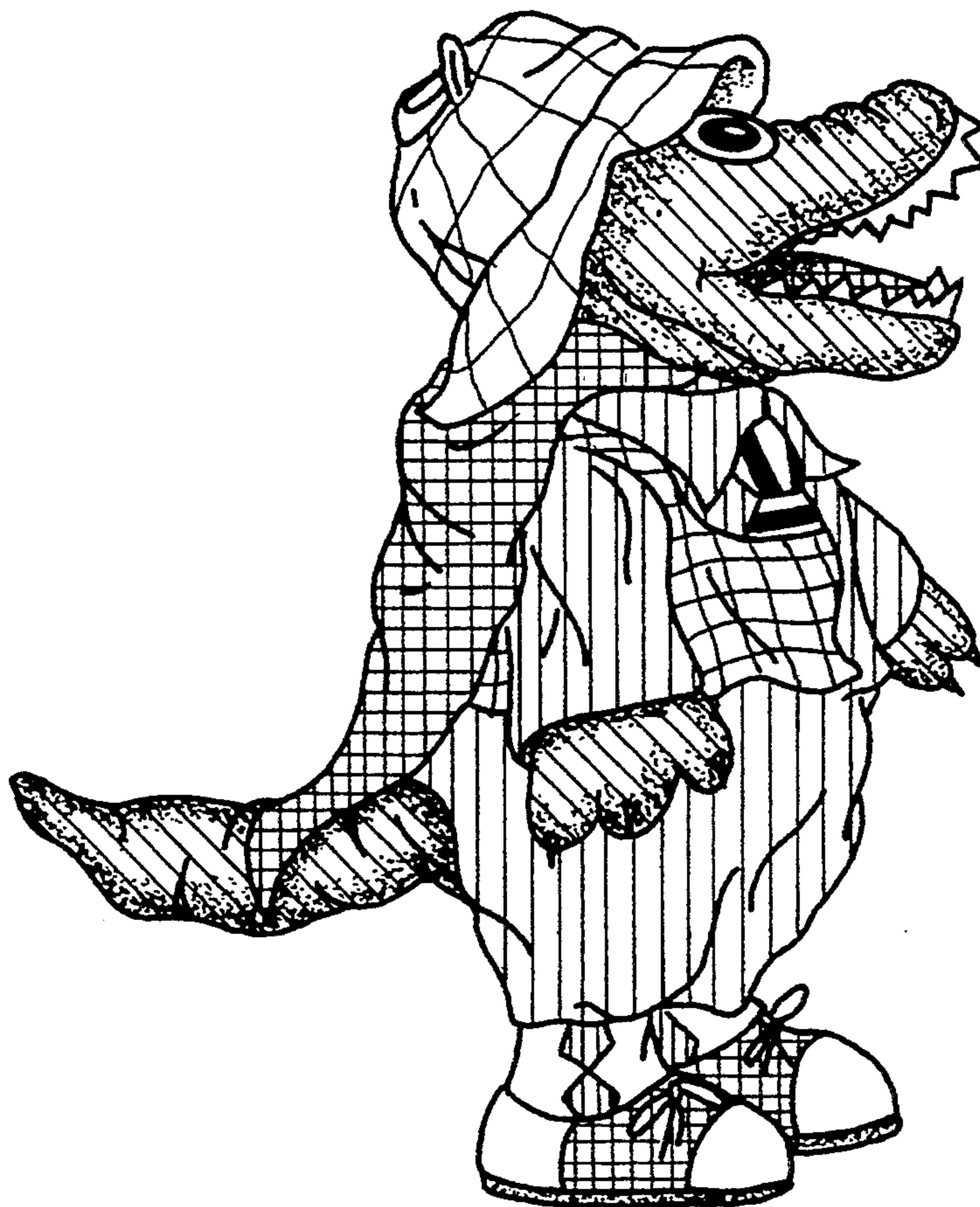

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the alligator figure shown in FIG. 1.



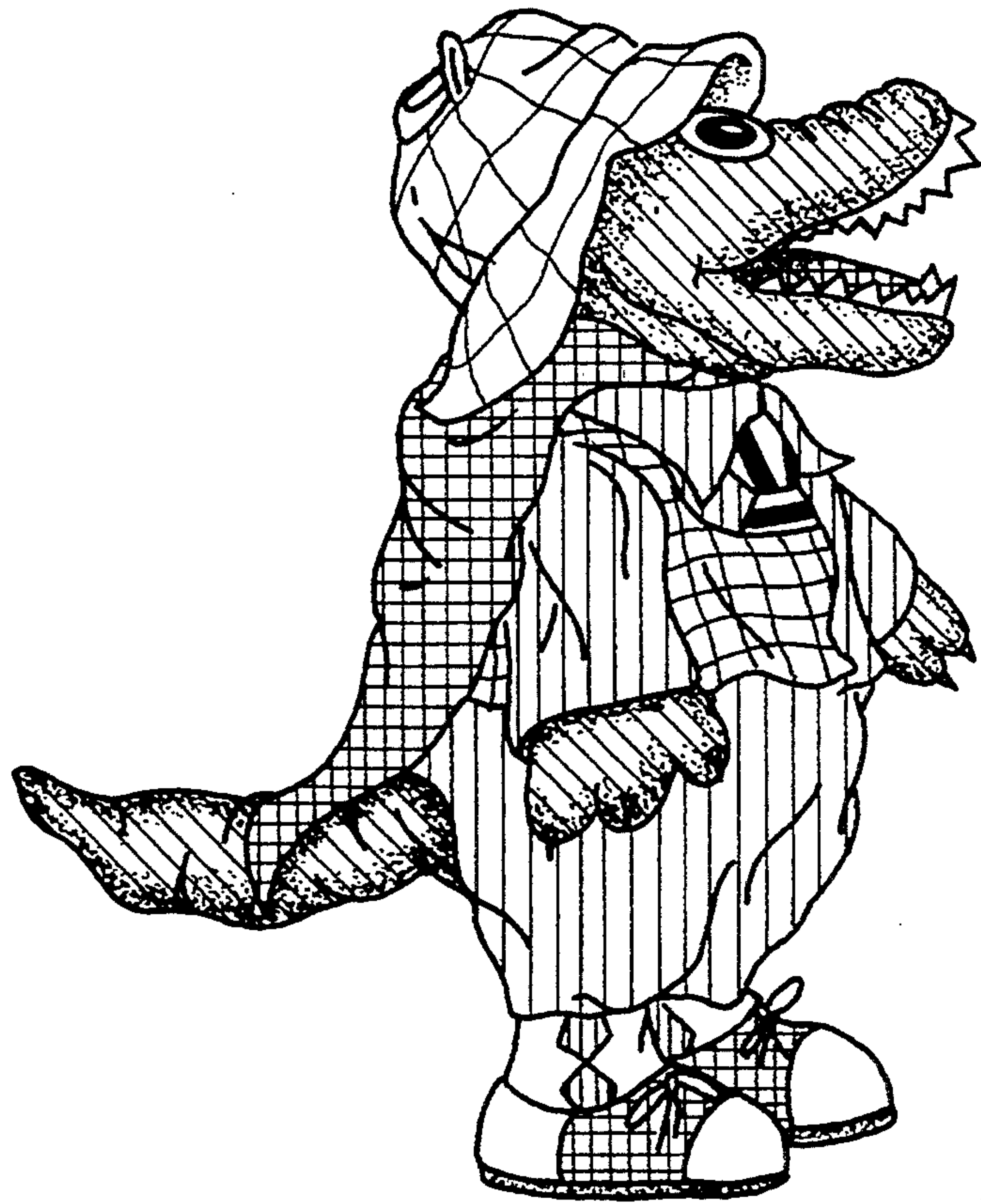

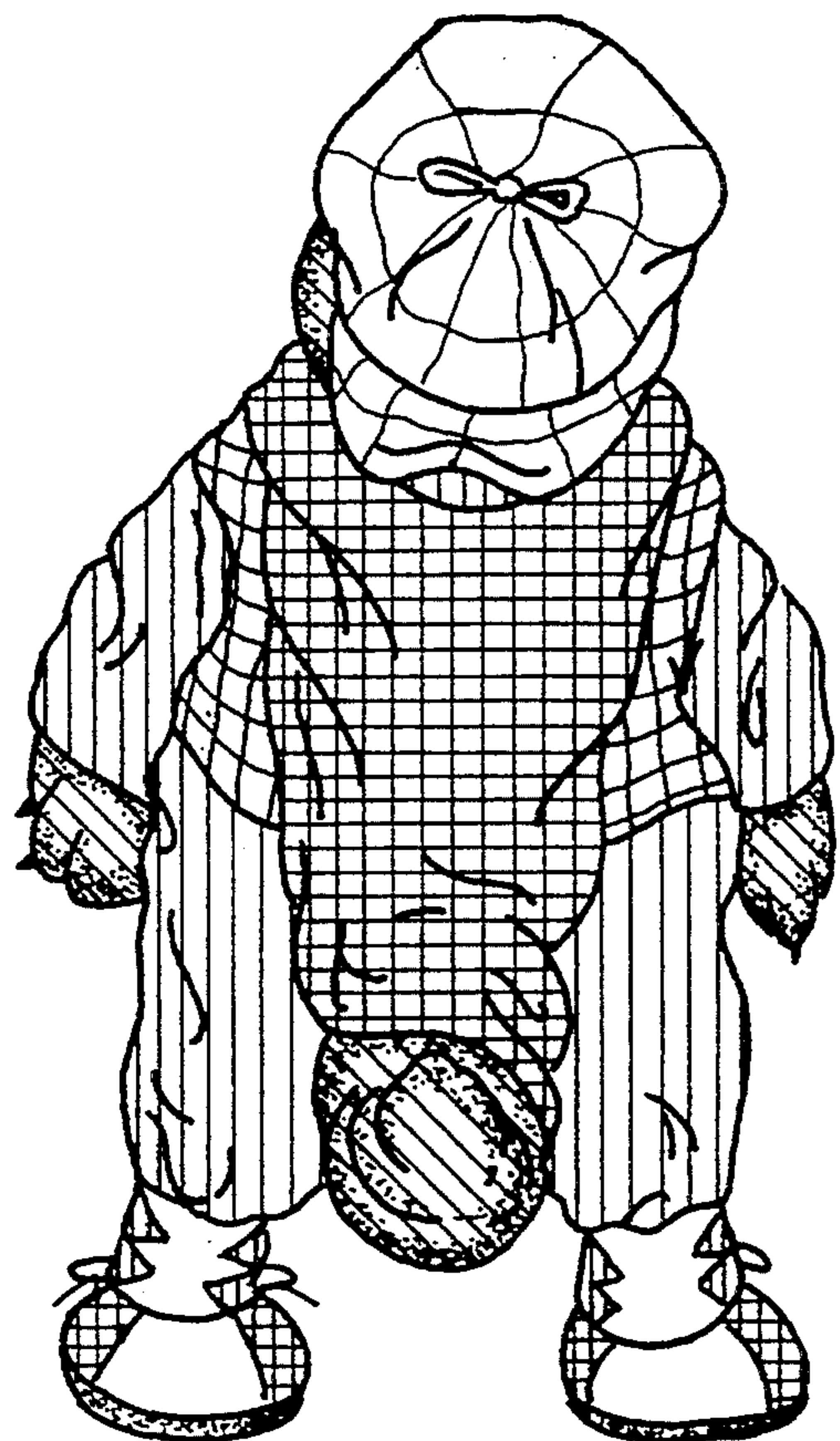
