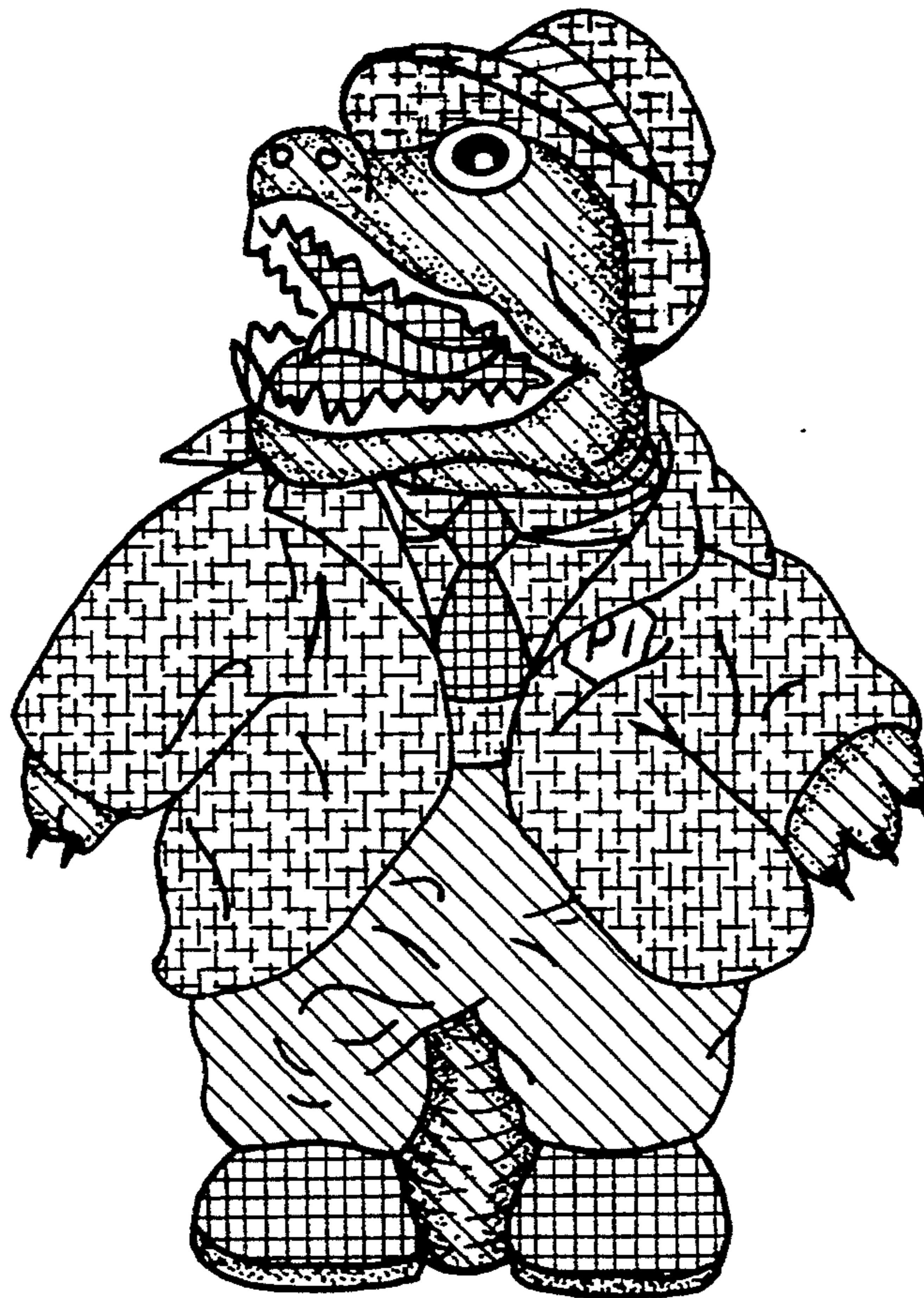

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an alligator figure, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an alligator figure in a sitting position, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the alligator figure shown in FIG. 1 but in a standing position and, FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the alligator figure shown in FIG. 1 but in a standing position.



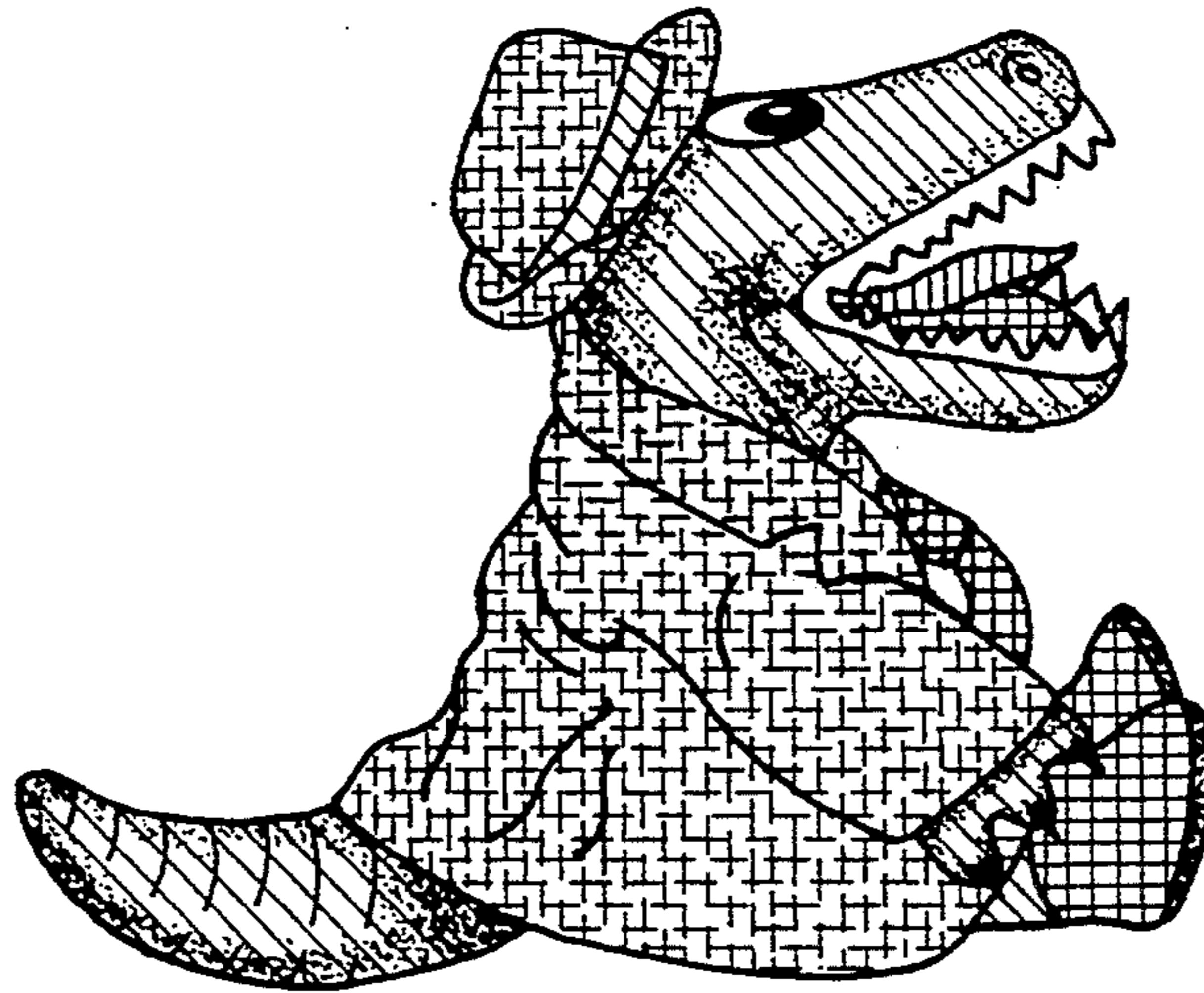

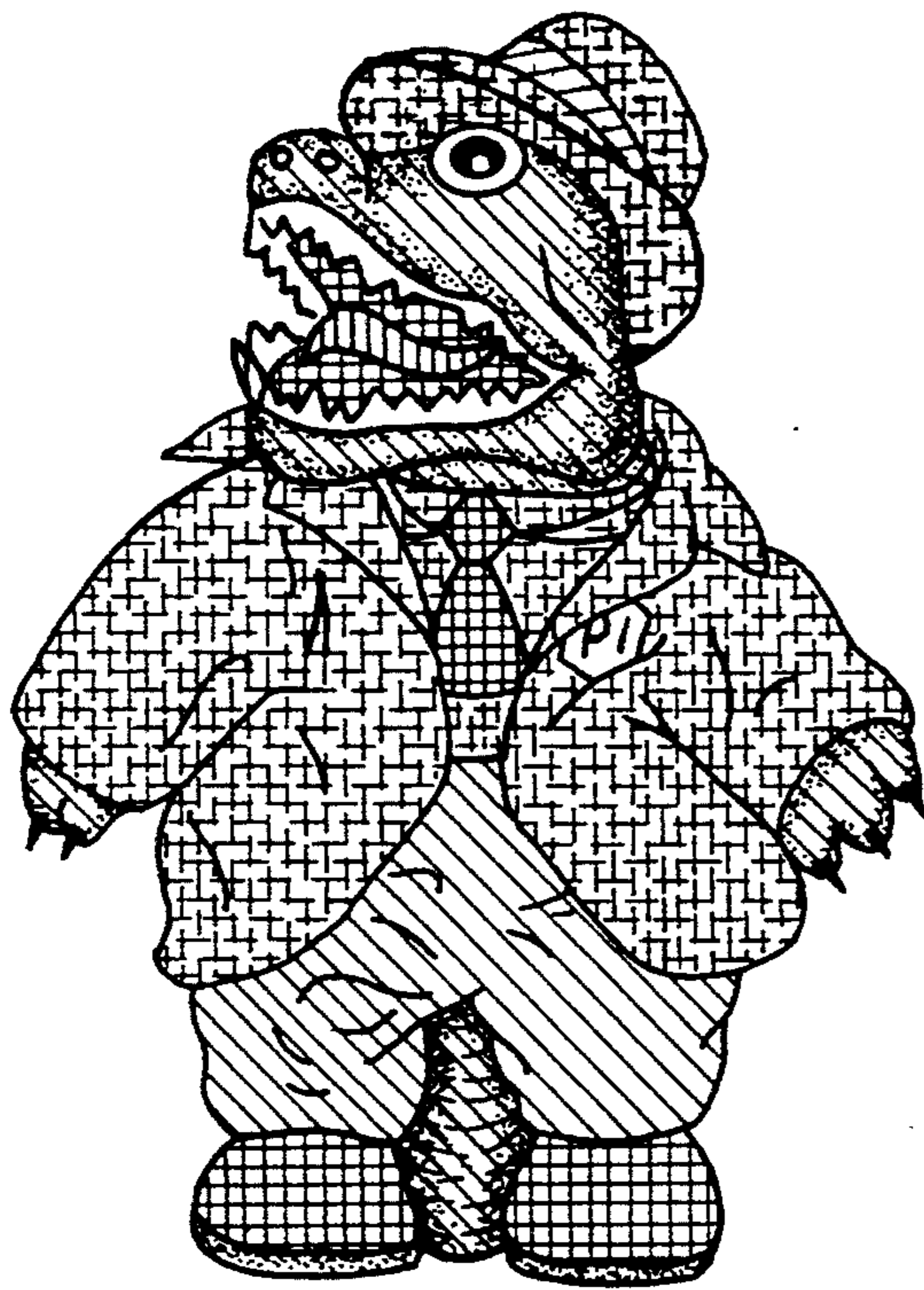

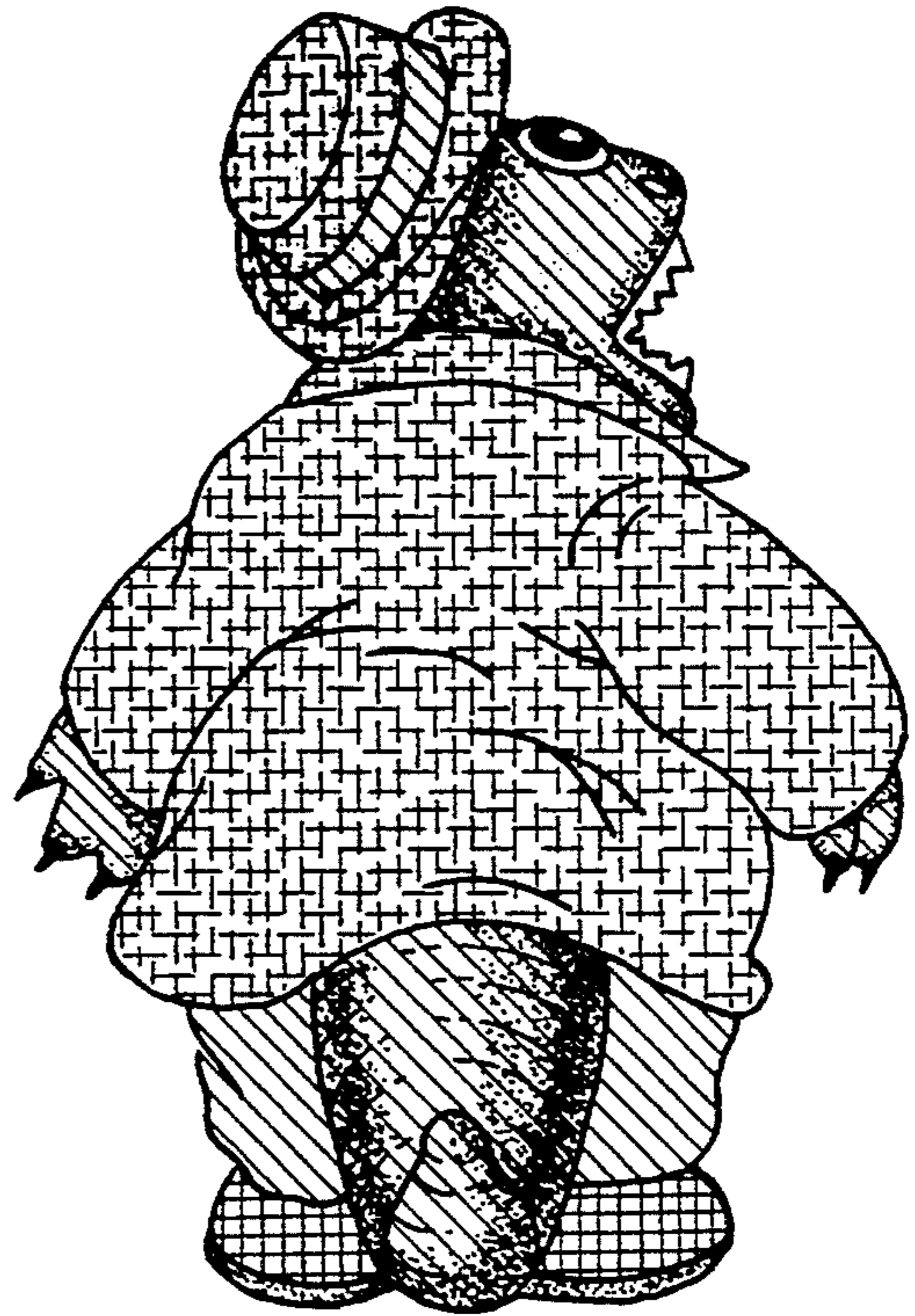
