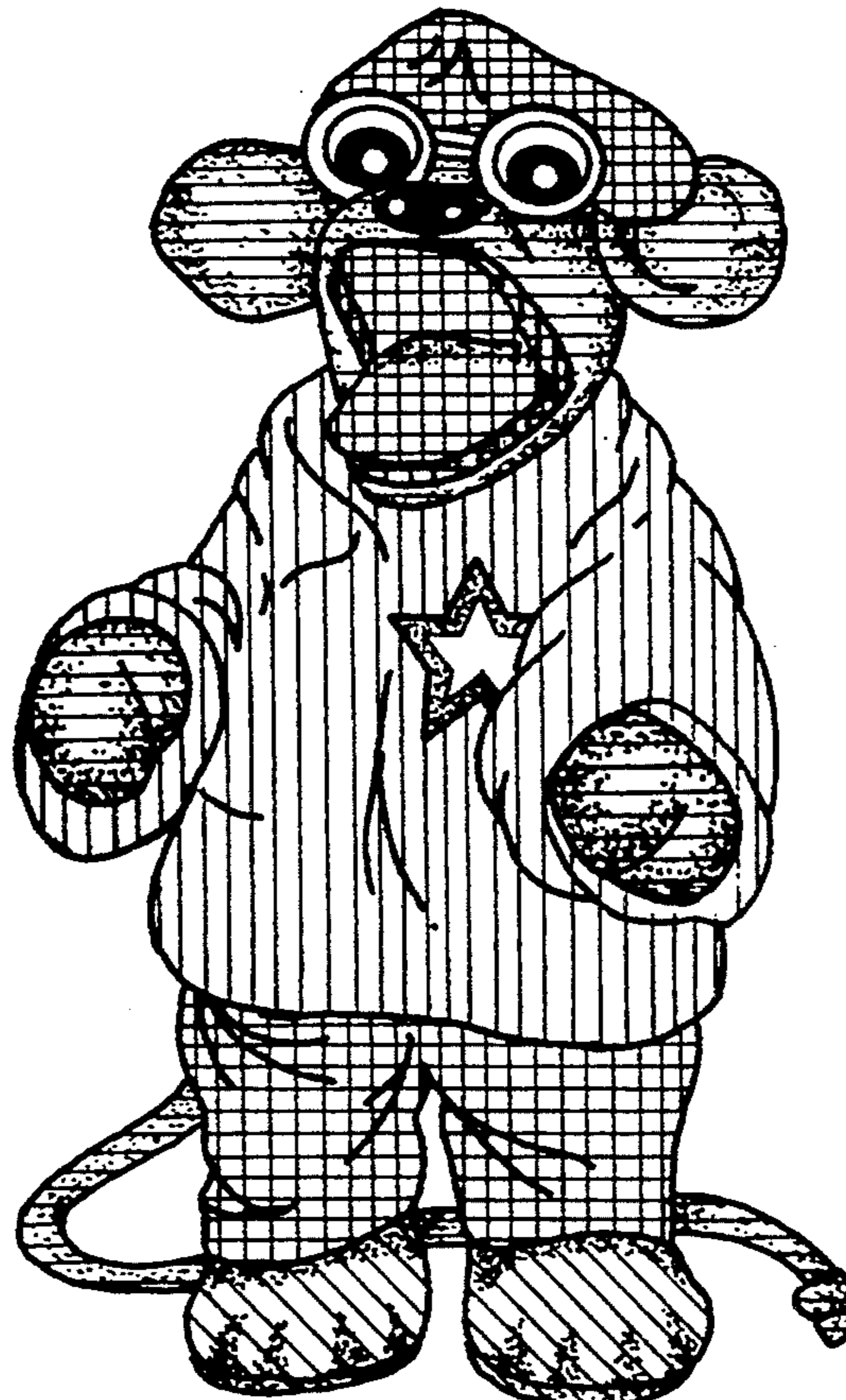
The ornamental design for a mouse figure, as shown.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the mouse figure shown in FIG. 1.



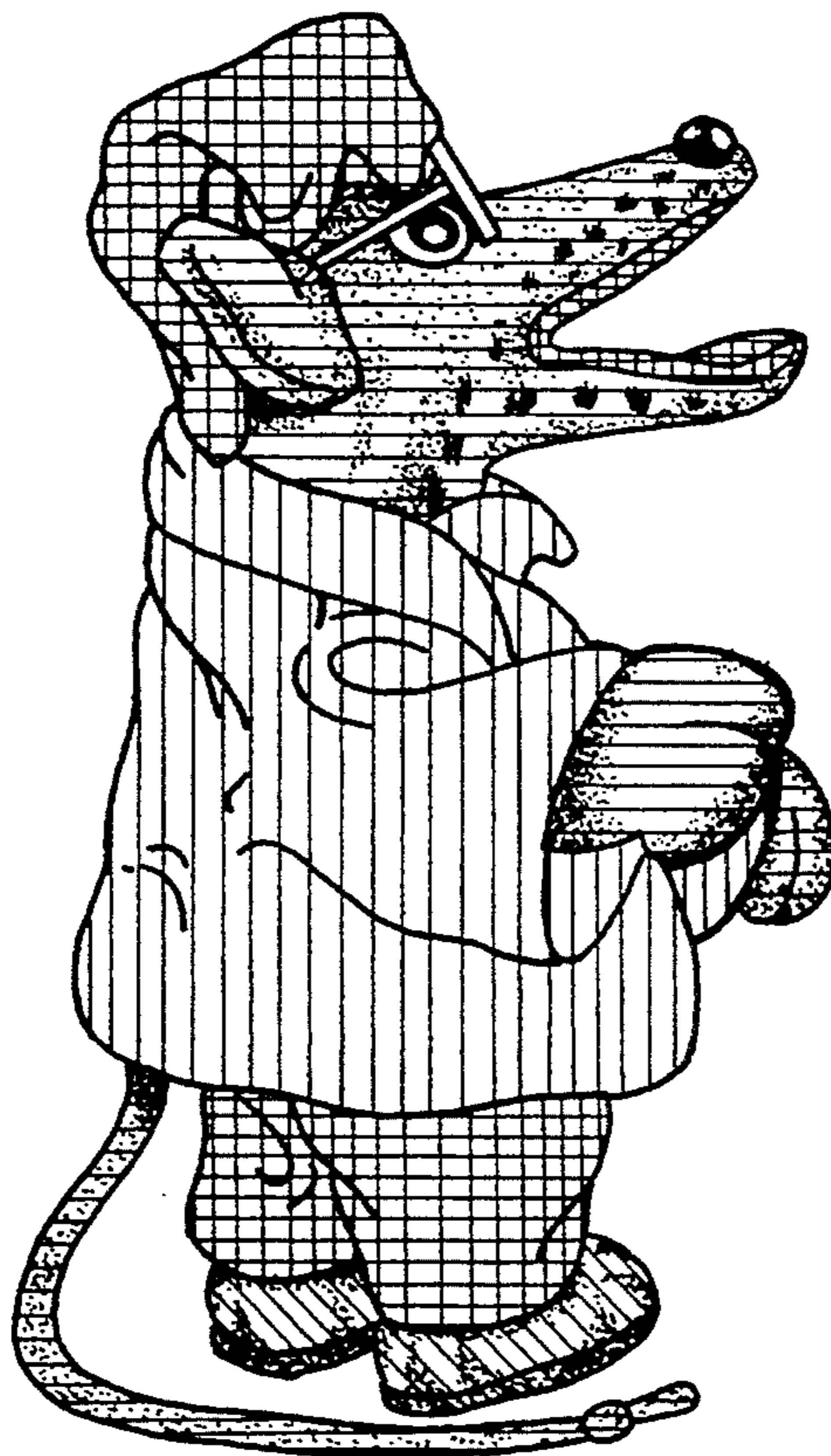

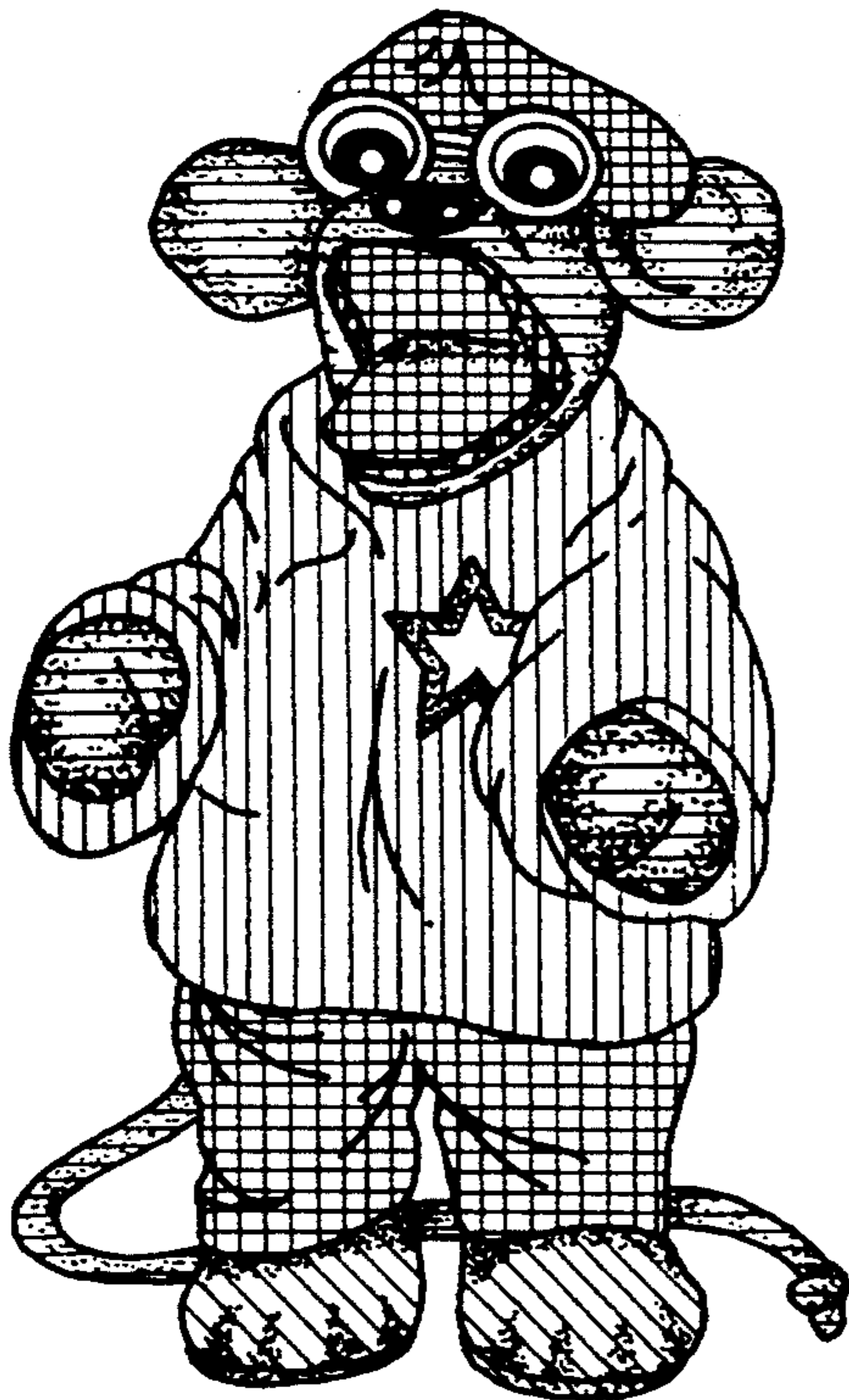

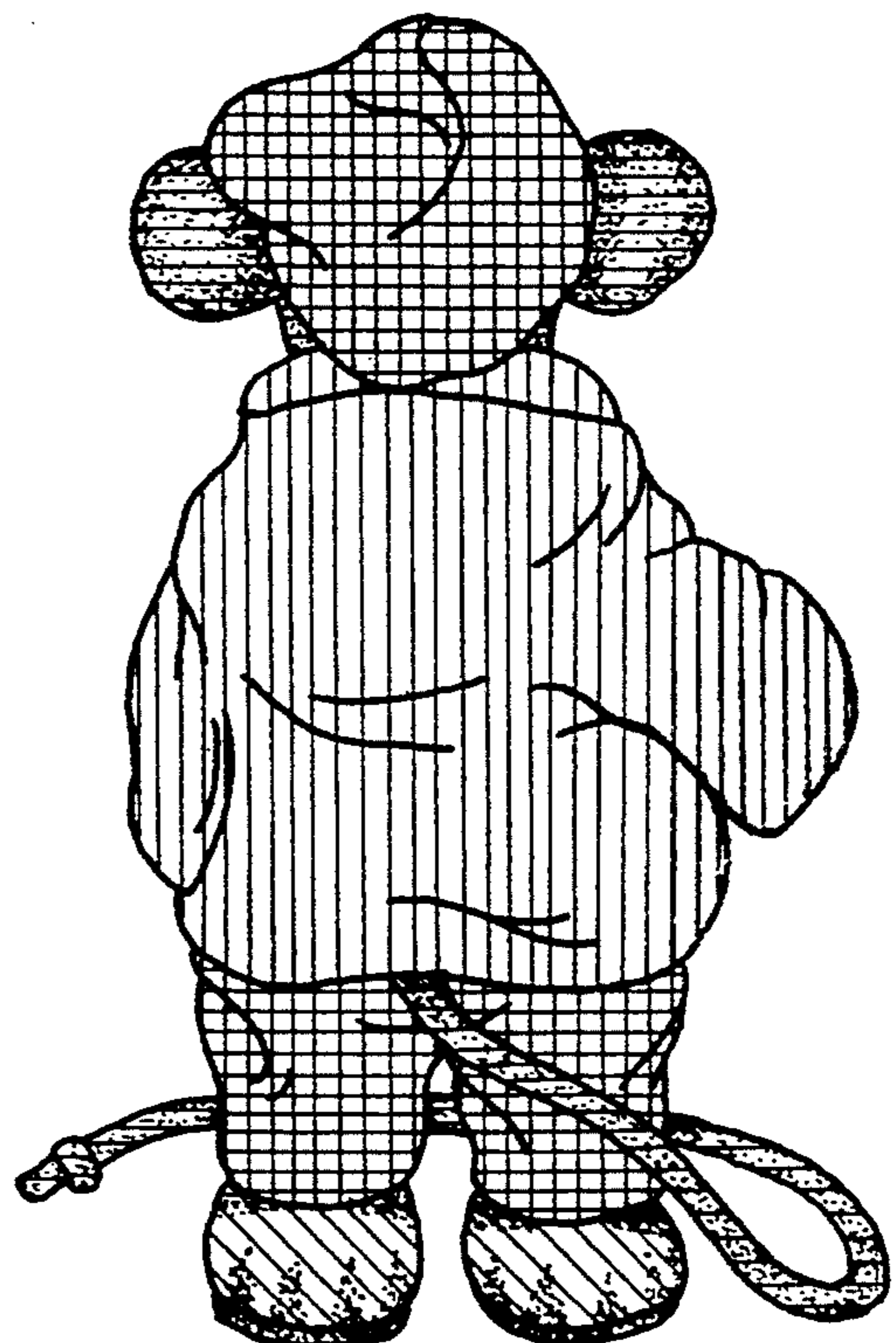
