The ornamental design for a physical exerciser, as shown and described.

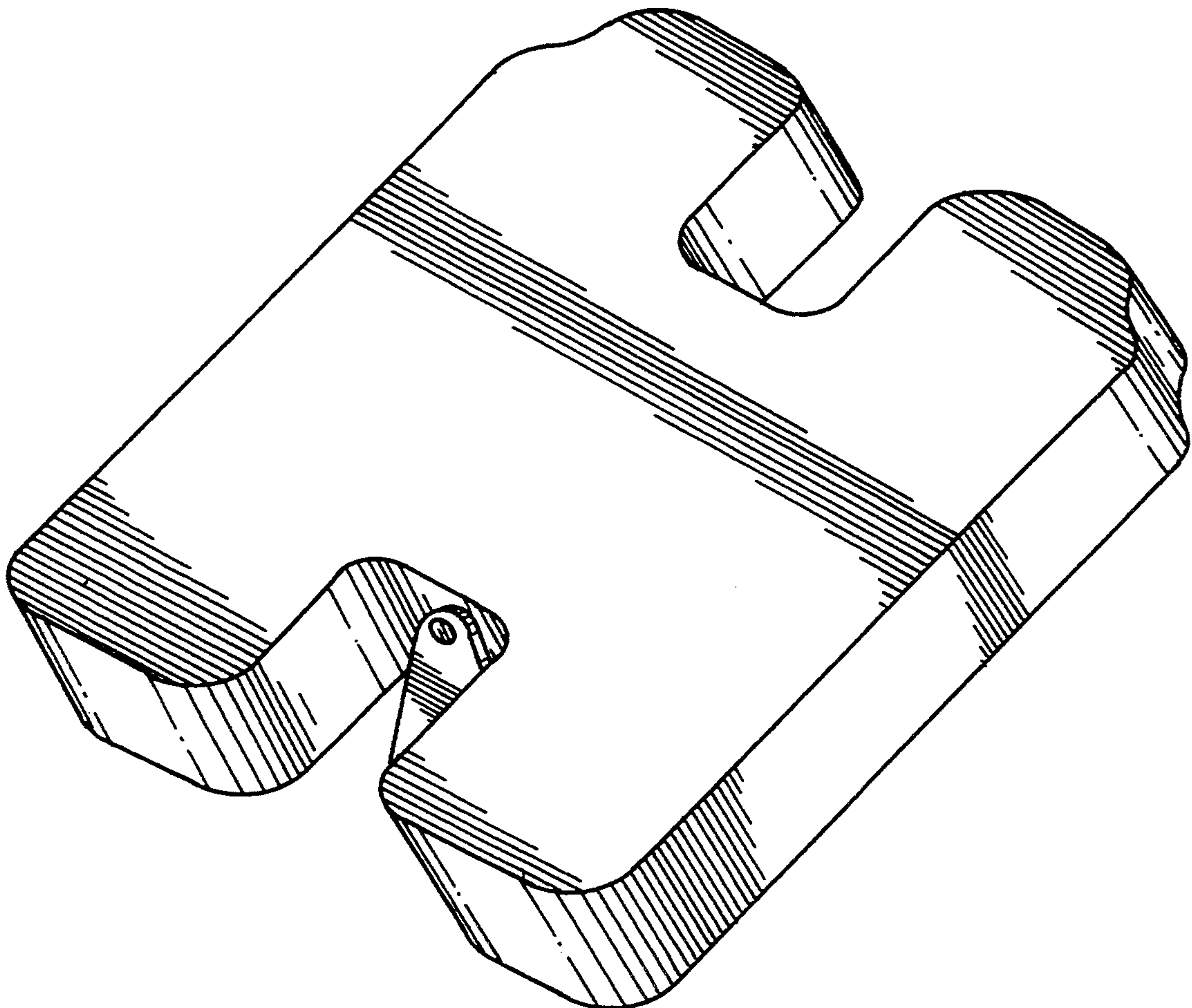
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DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and side perspective view of the physical exerciser showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



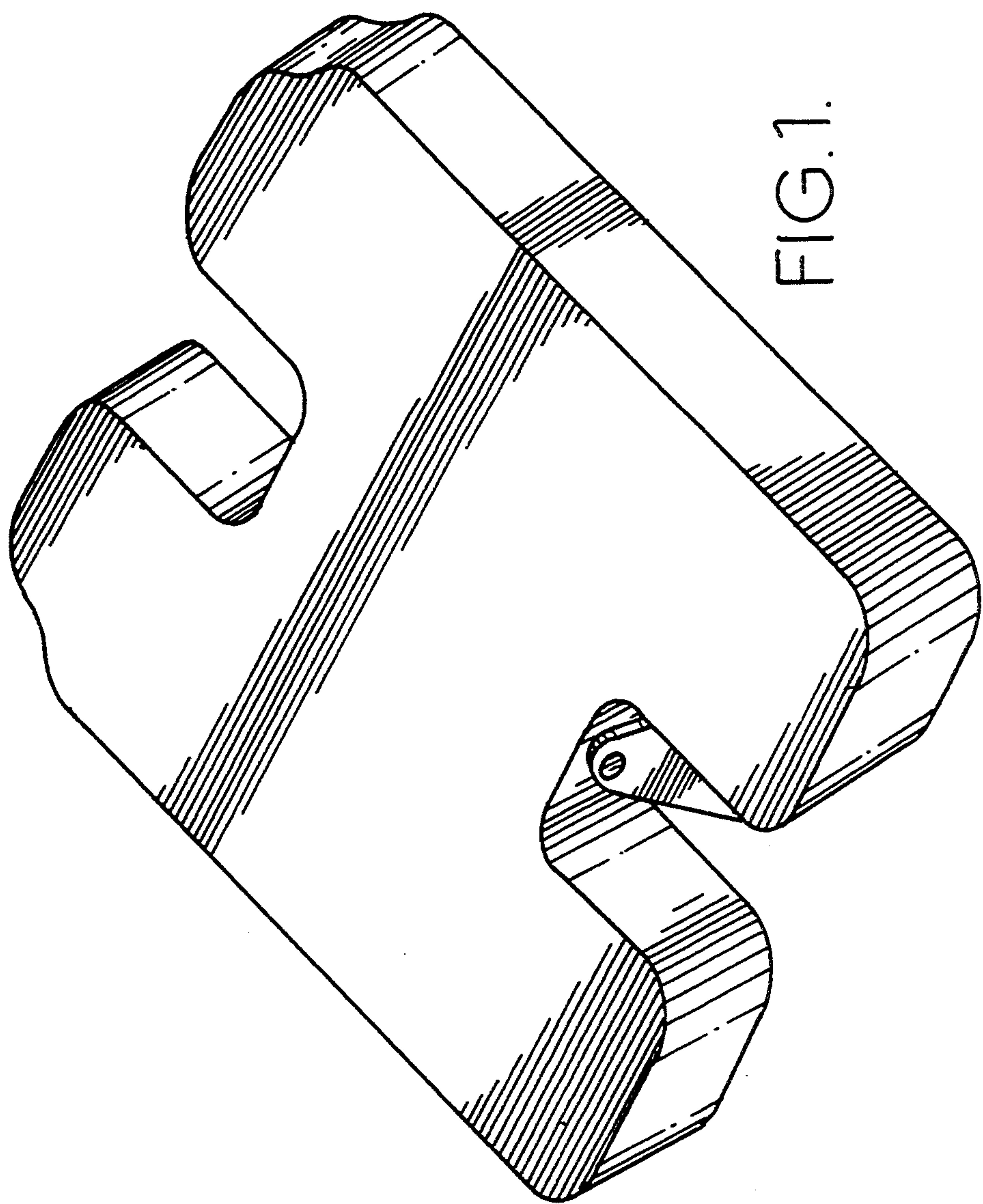

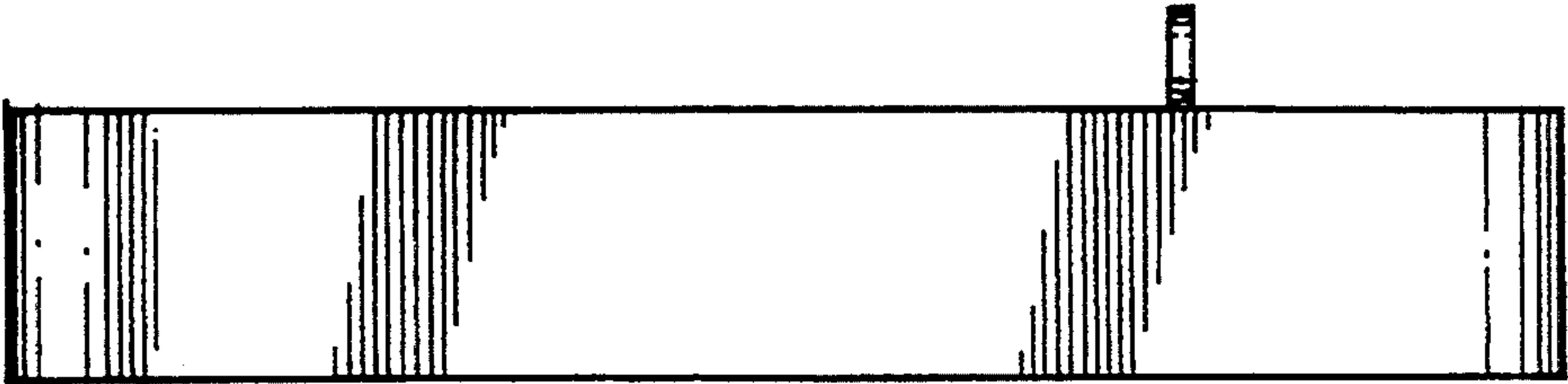

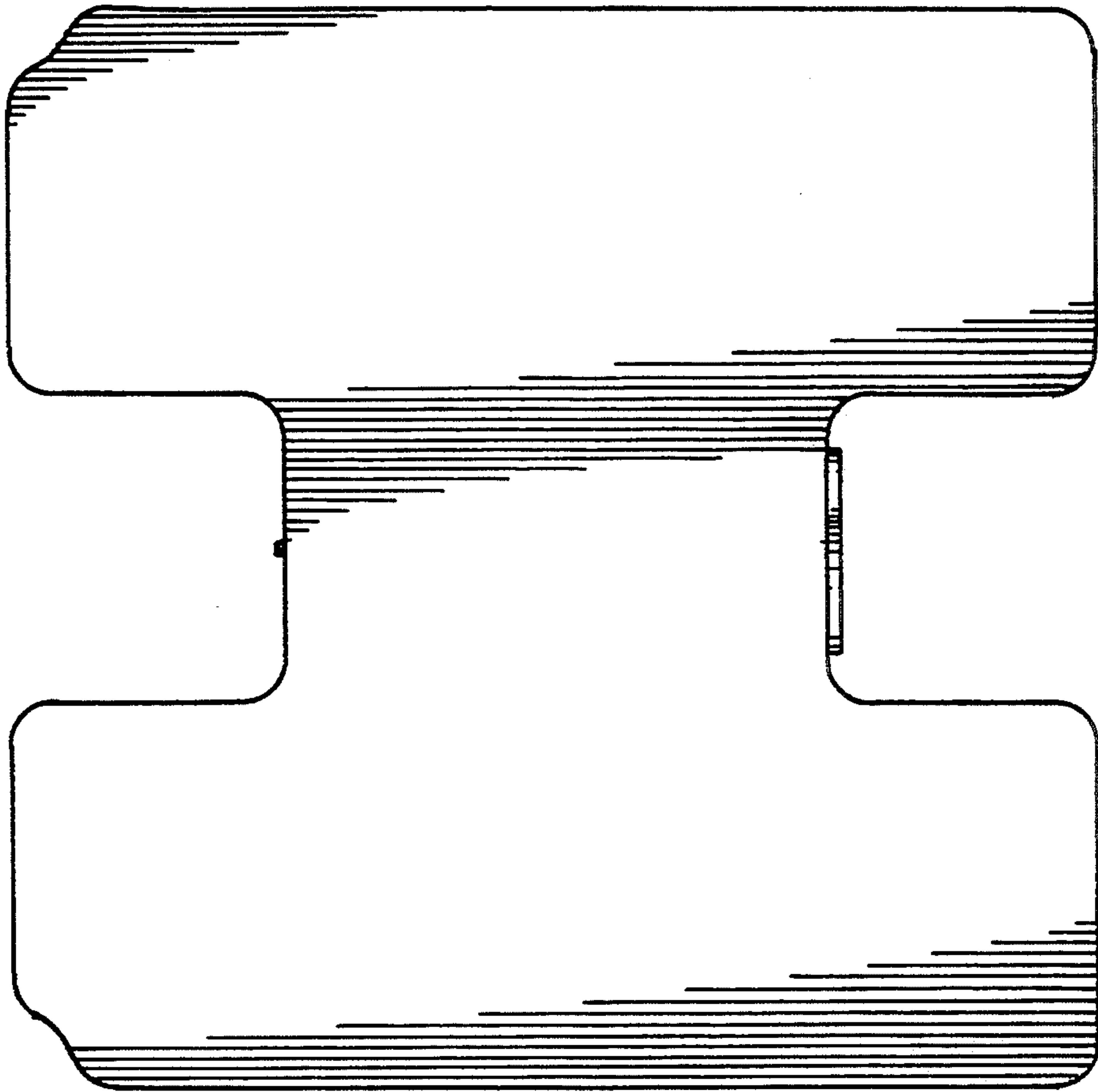

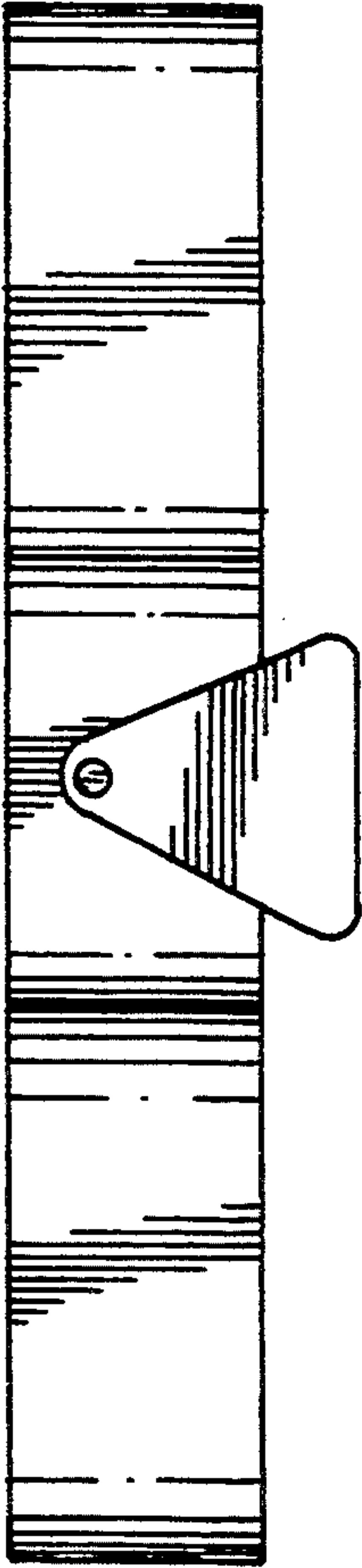
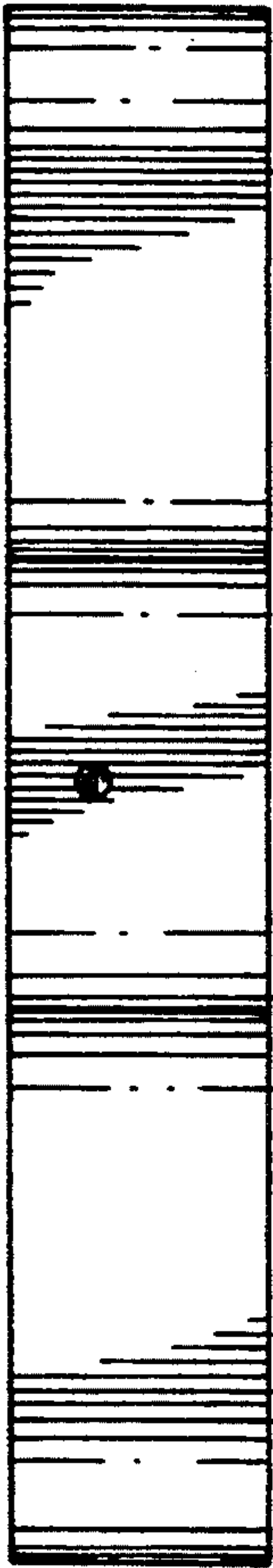
