#### CLAIM

The ornamental design for a nasal medicine inhaler, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view, as viewed from the right side, of a nasal medicine inhaler in the closed condition, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view, as viewed from the right side, of the nasal medicine inhaler shown in the open condition;


FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear, right side and left side elevational views being identical thereto;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view thereof.













FIG. 2 FIG. 3 FIG. 4





FIG. 6 FIG. 7












