FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a glass oil lamp; FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the glass oil lamp; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the glass oil lamp; FIG. 4 is a fragmentary cross-section view taken in the direction of line 4—4 of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a side elevation view of a second embodiment of glass oil lamp; and, FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the second embodiment of glass oil lamp.

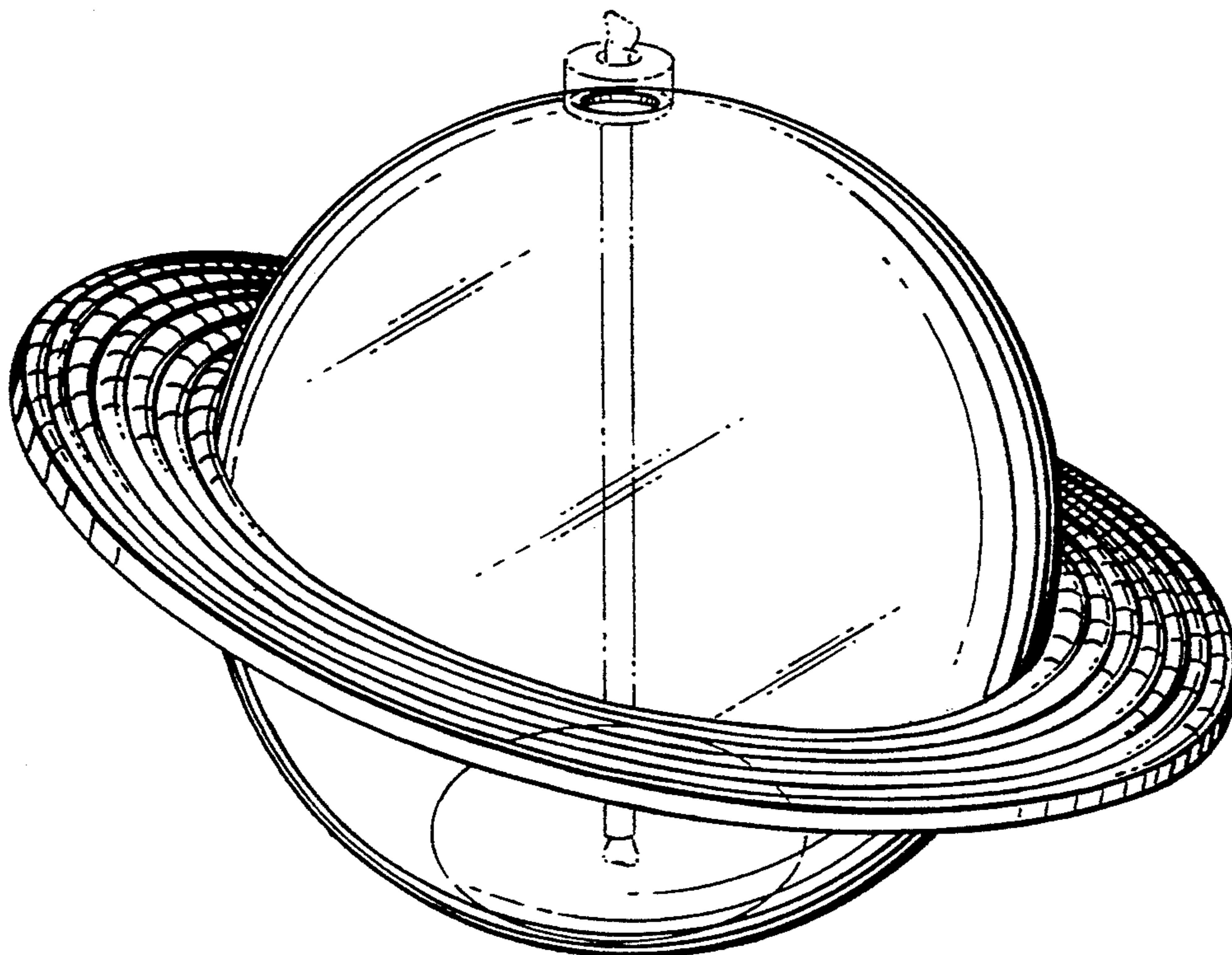

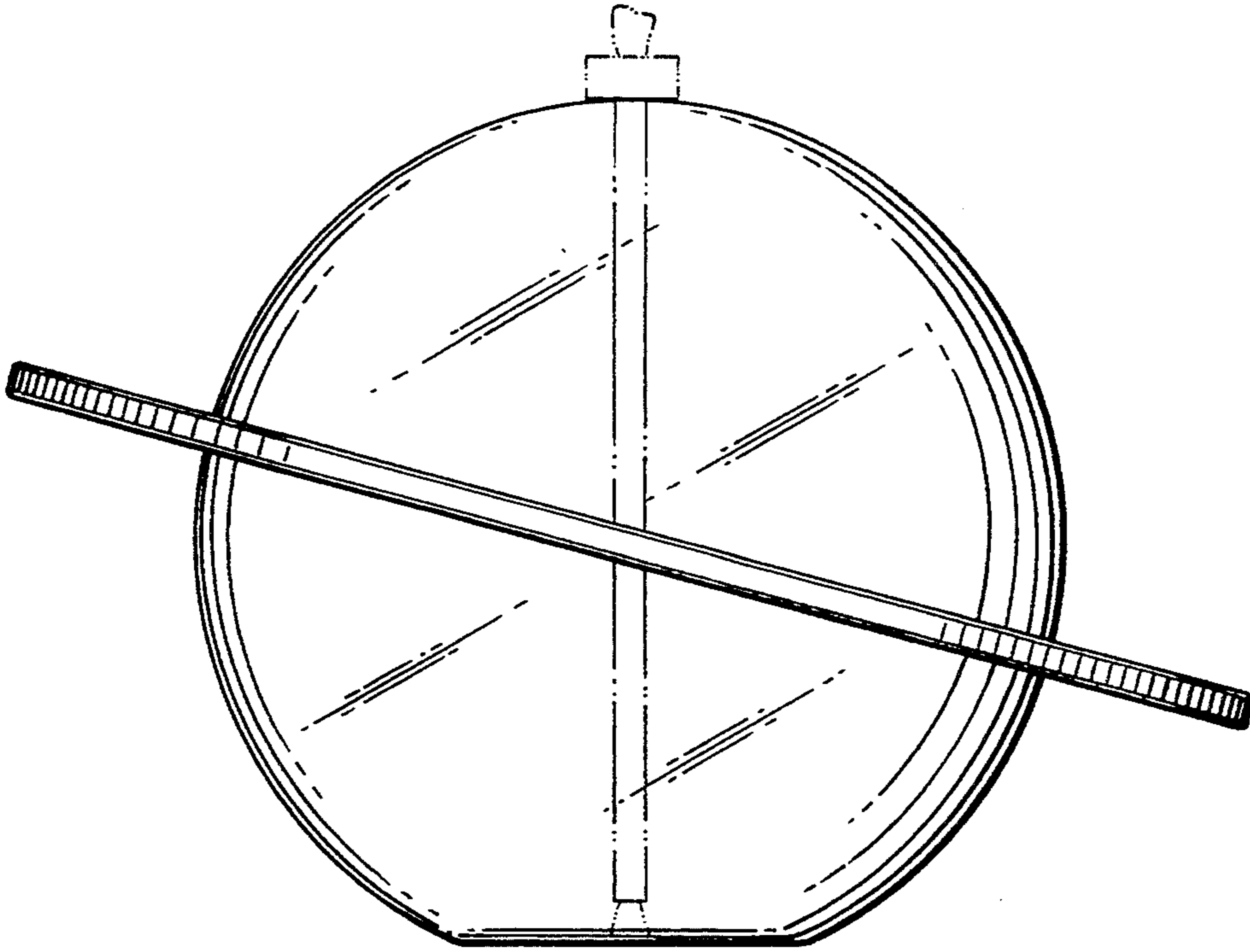

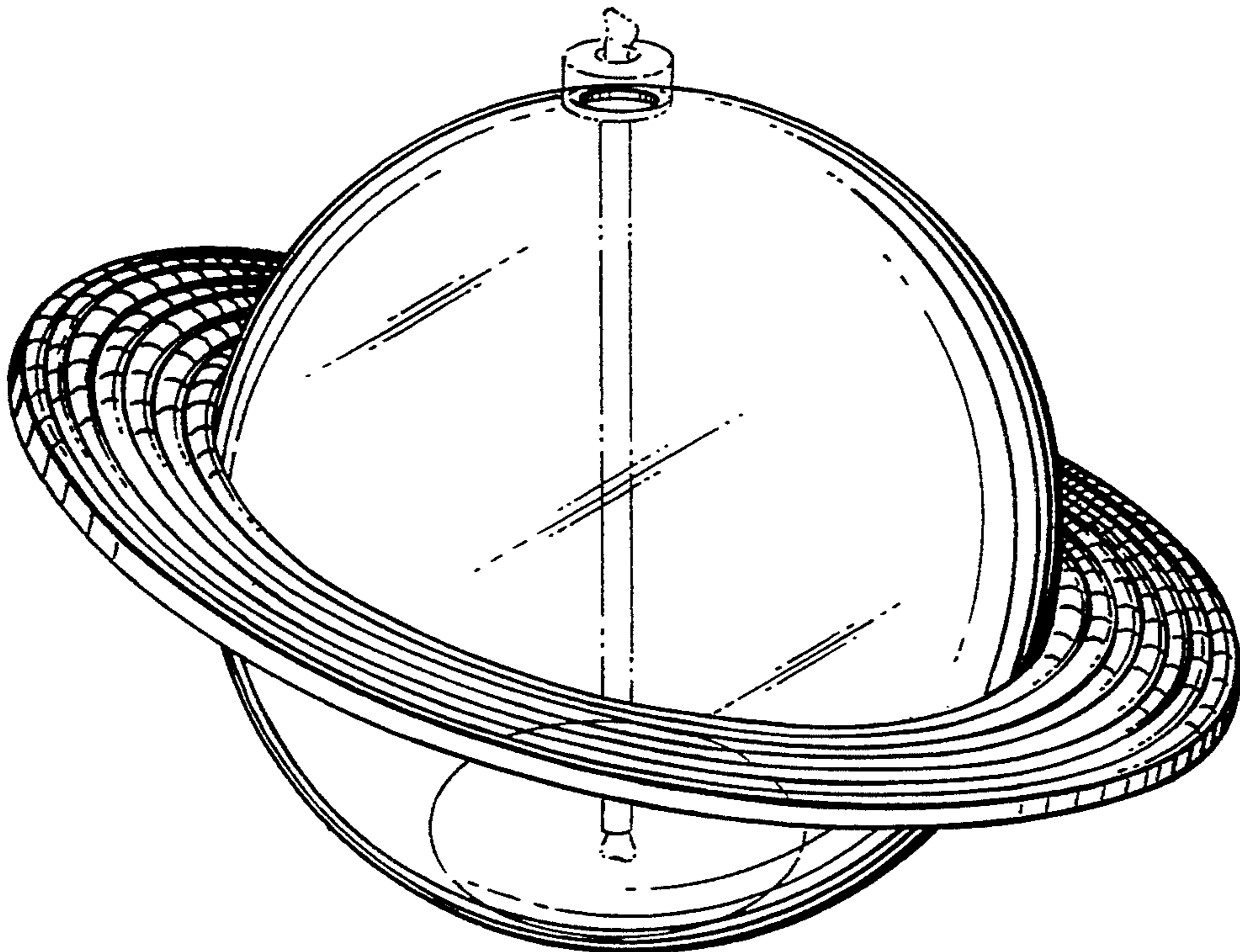

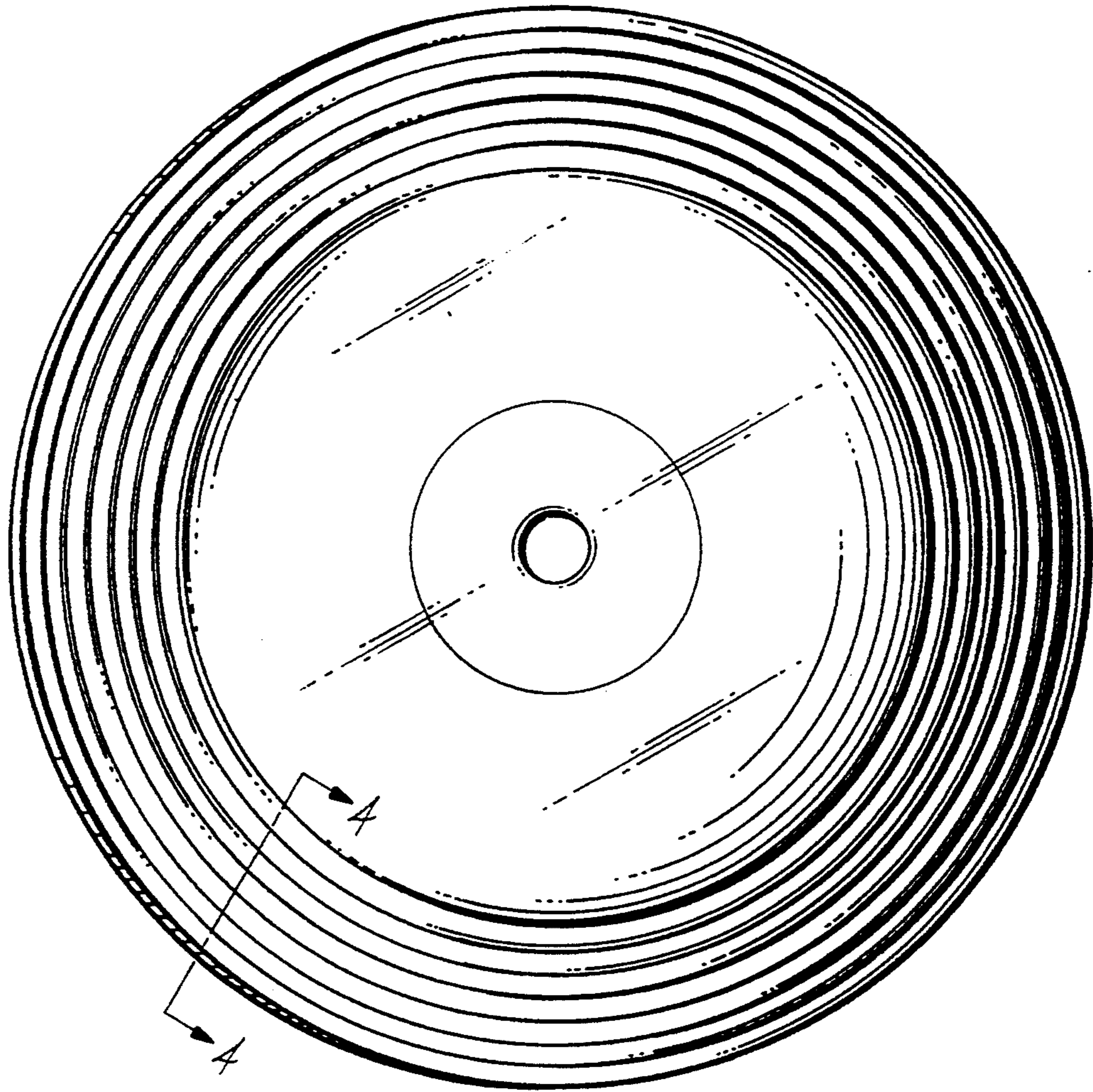

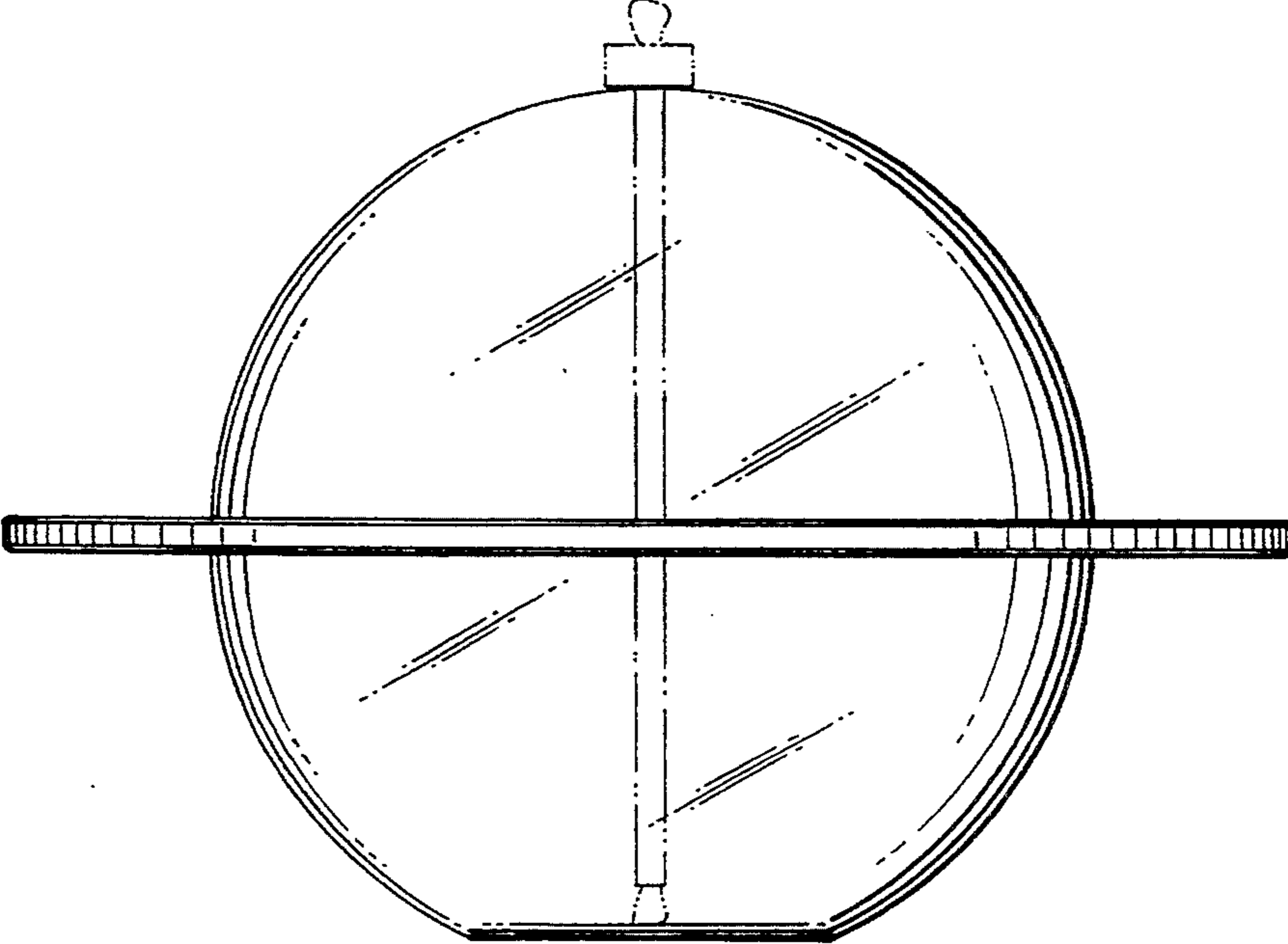
