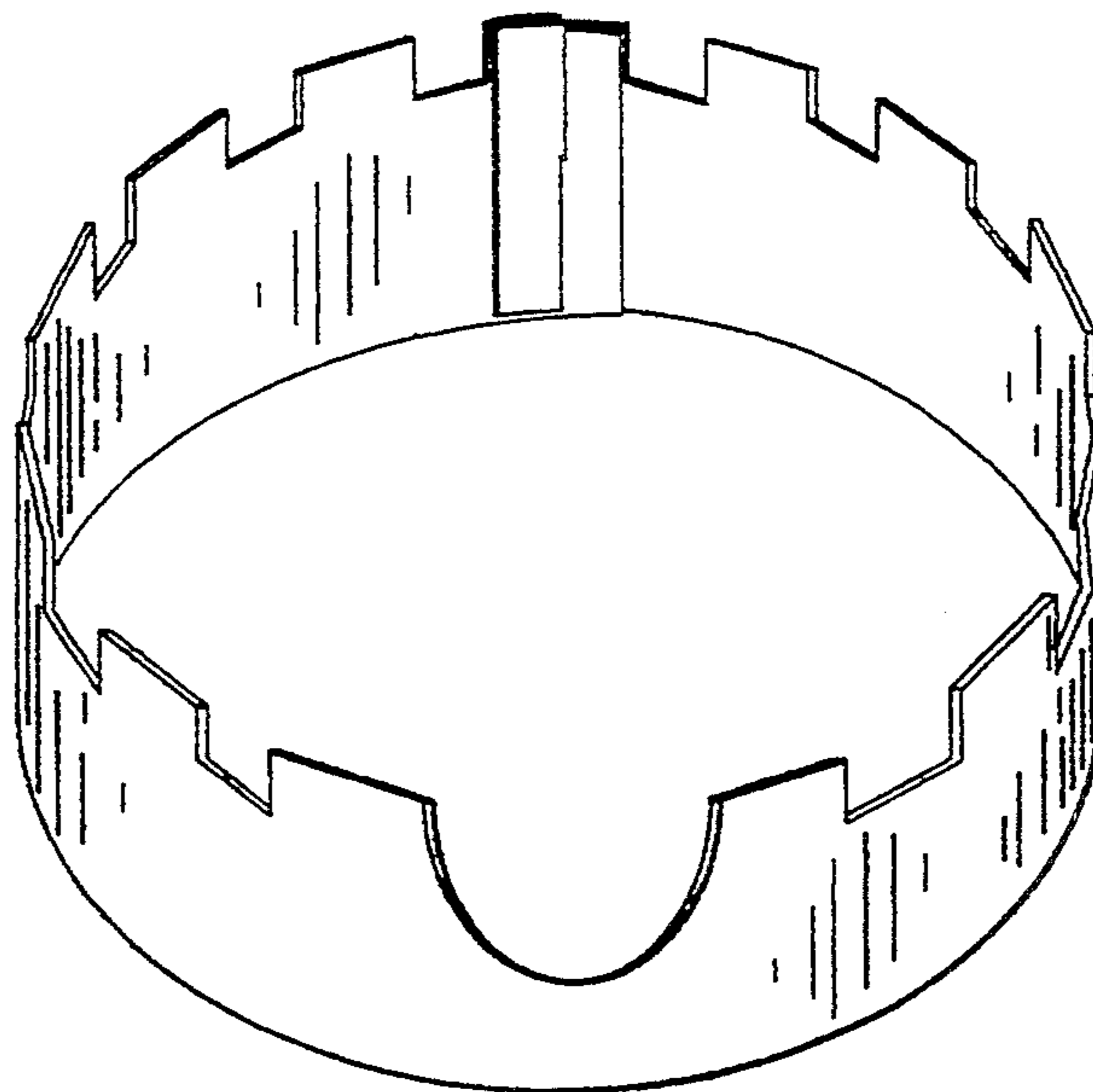

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pet bed enclosure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pet bed enclosure in a flat, uncoiled condition, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the pet bed enclosure with the ends linked; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.



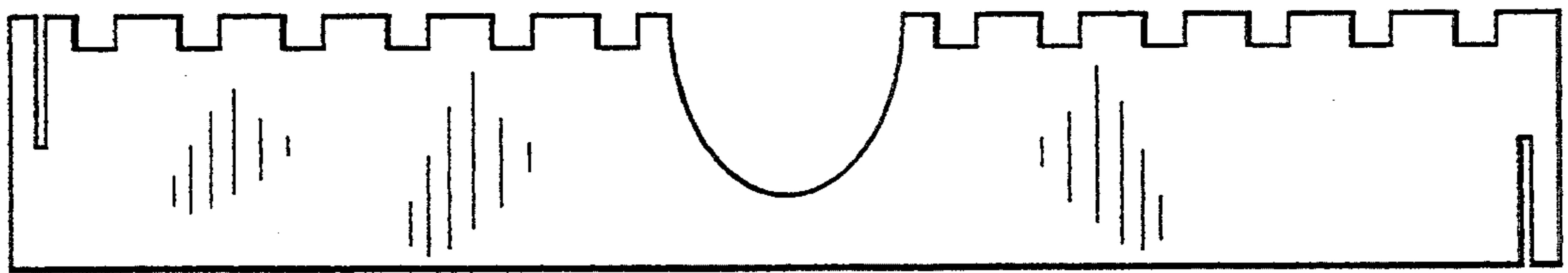

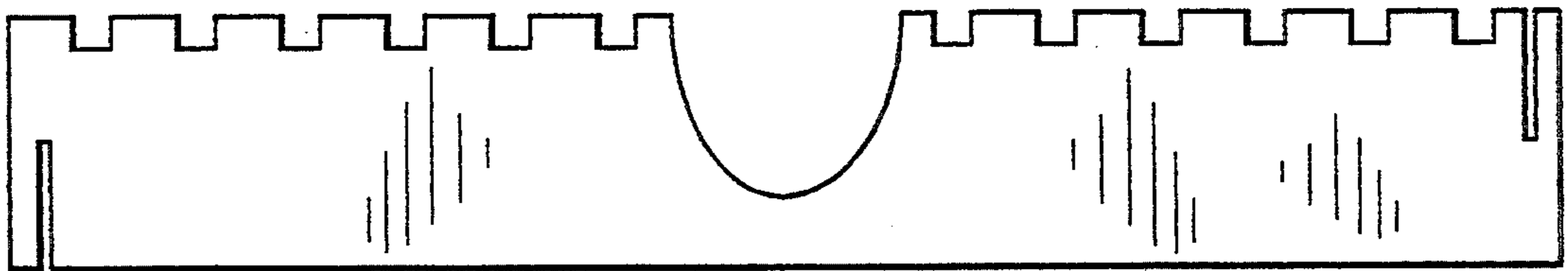

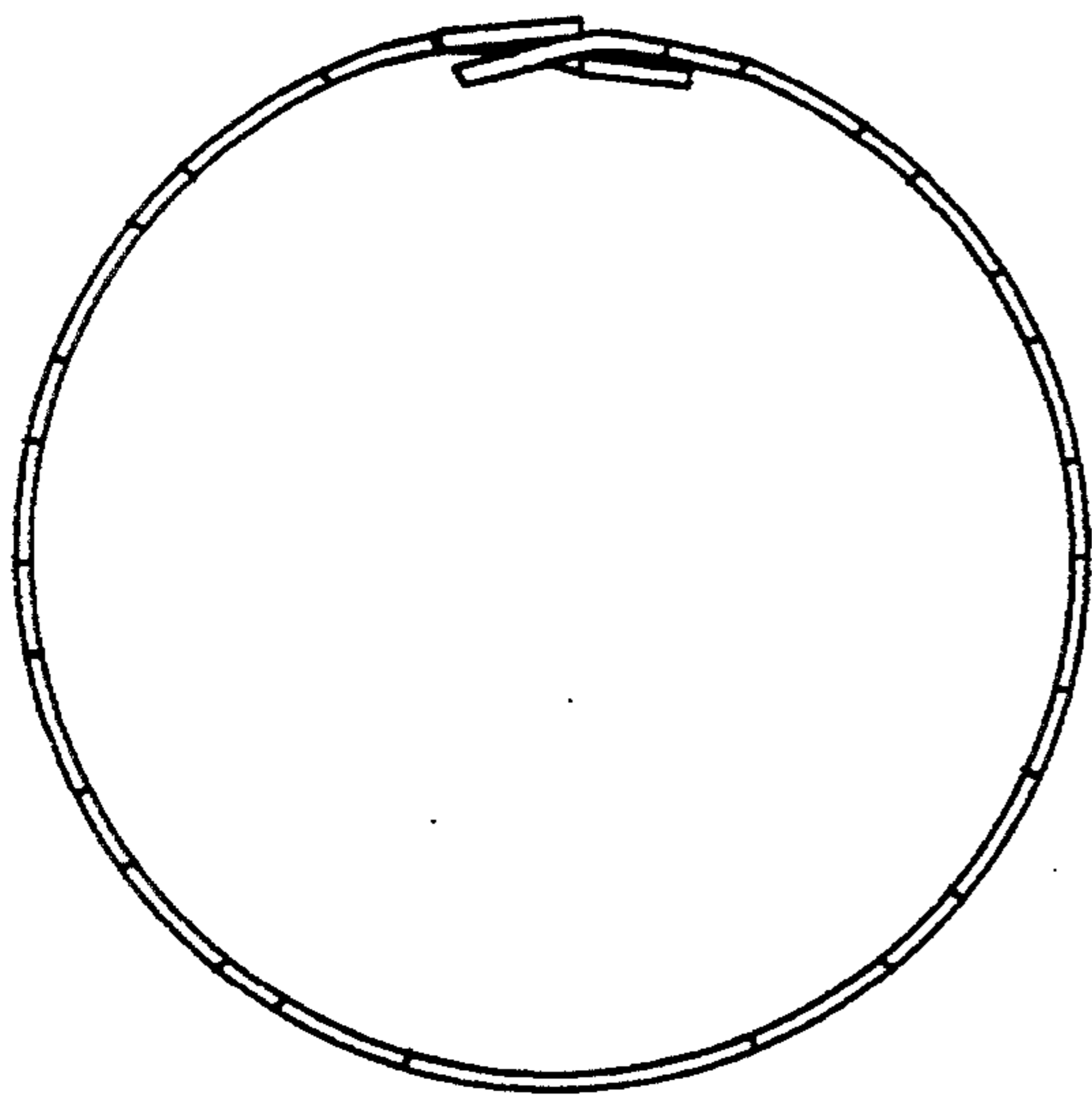

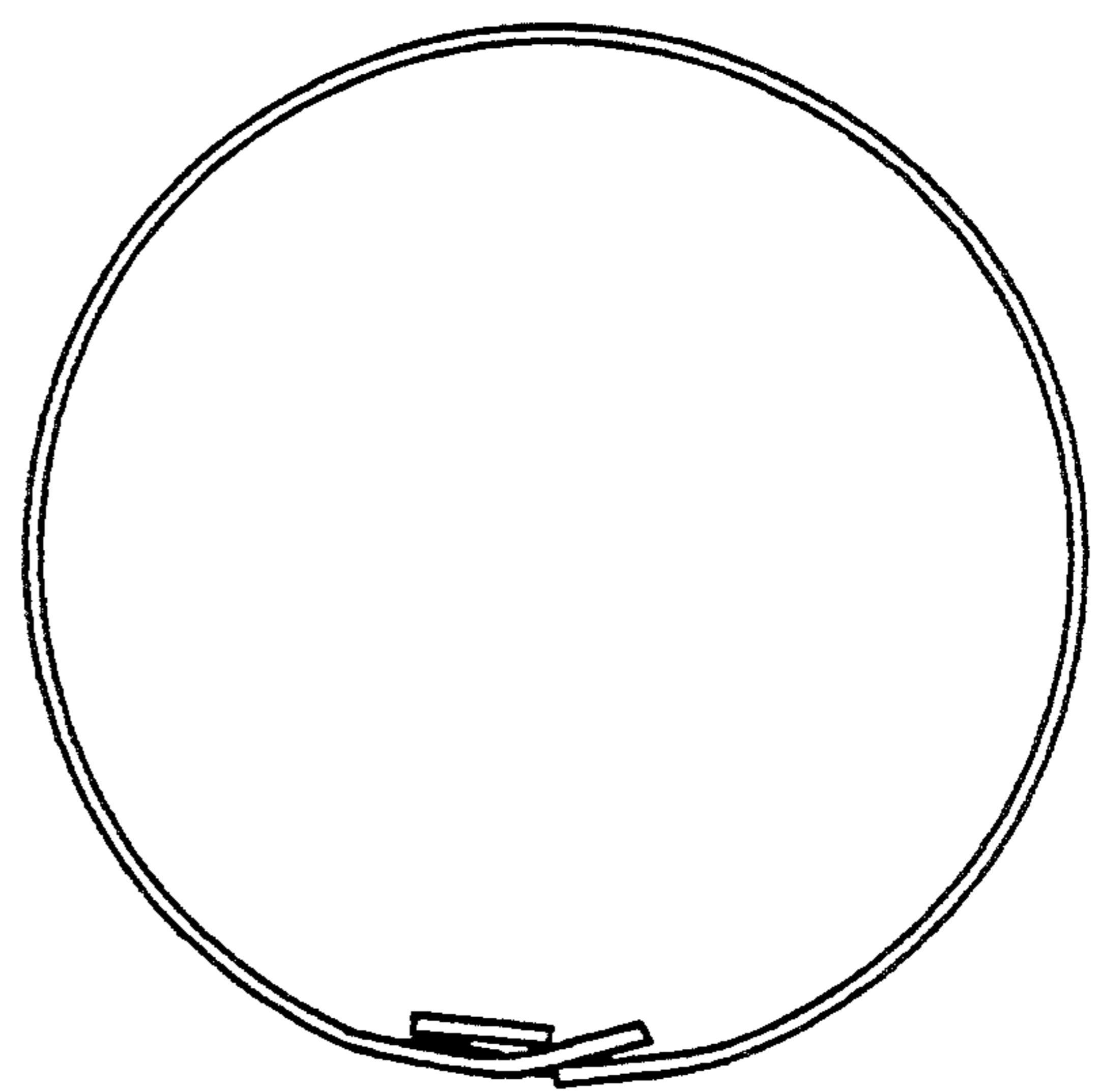

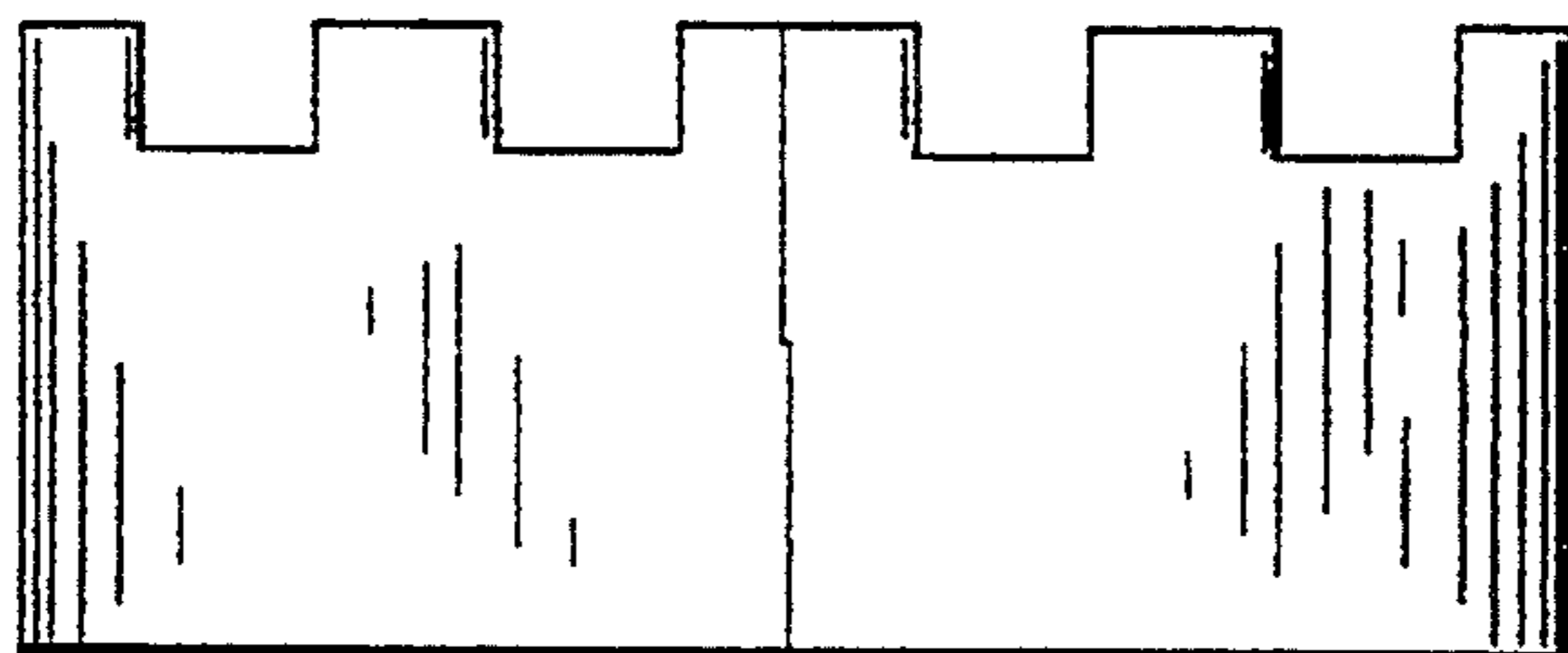

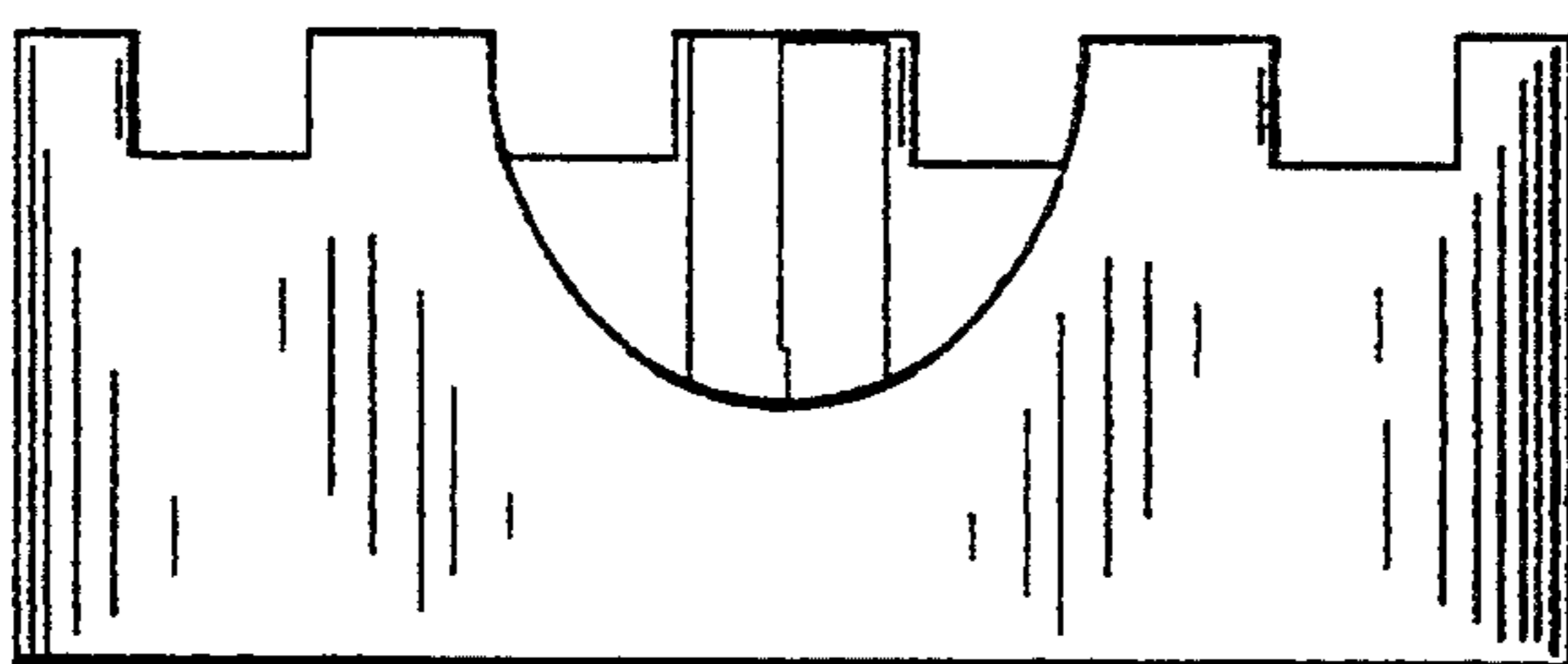

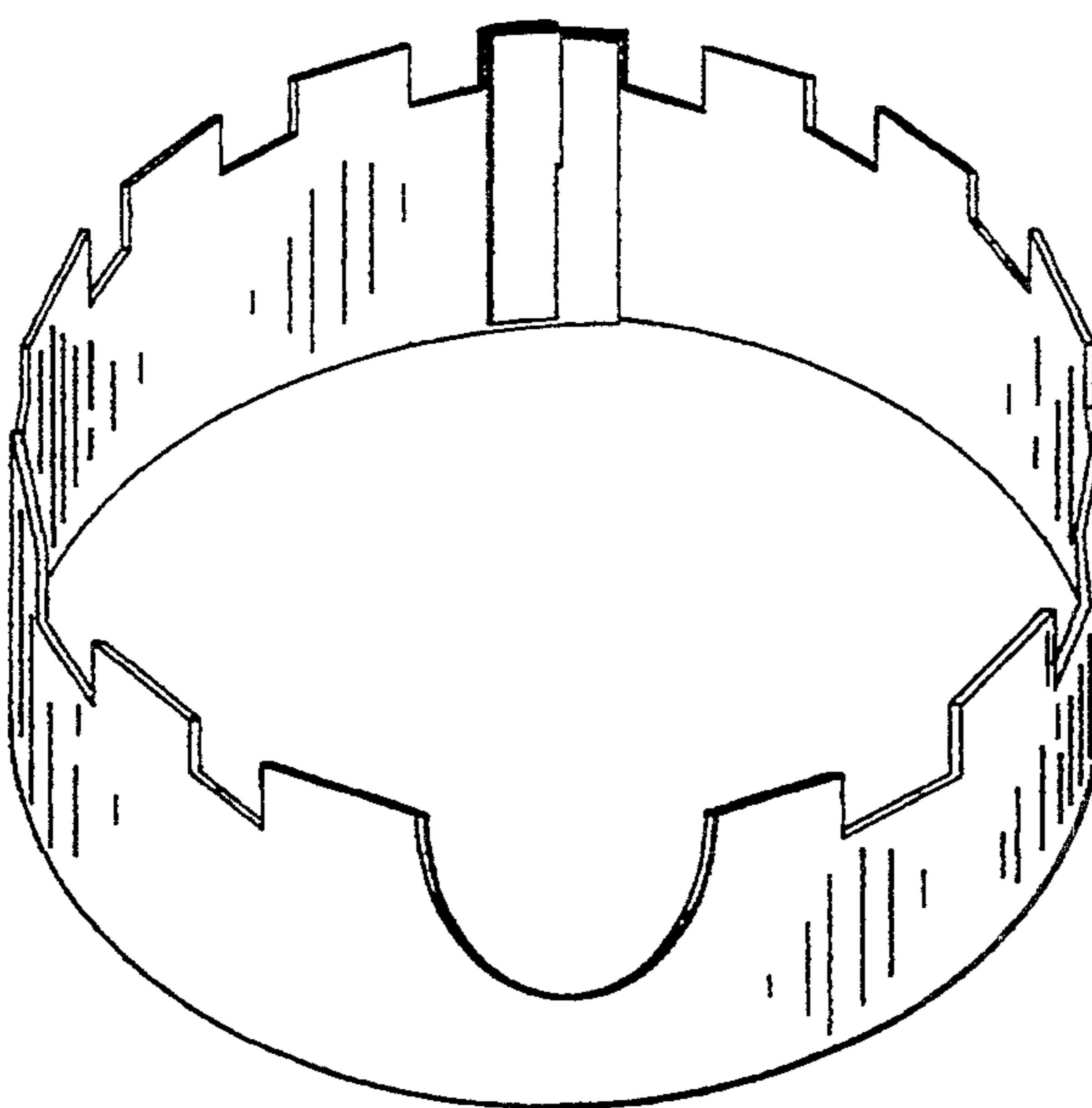
