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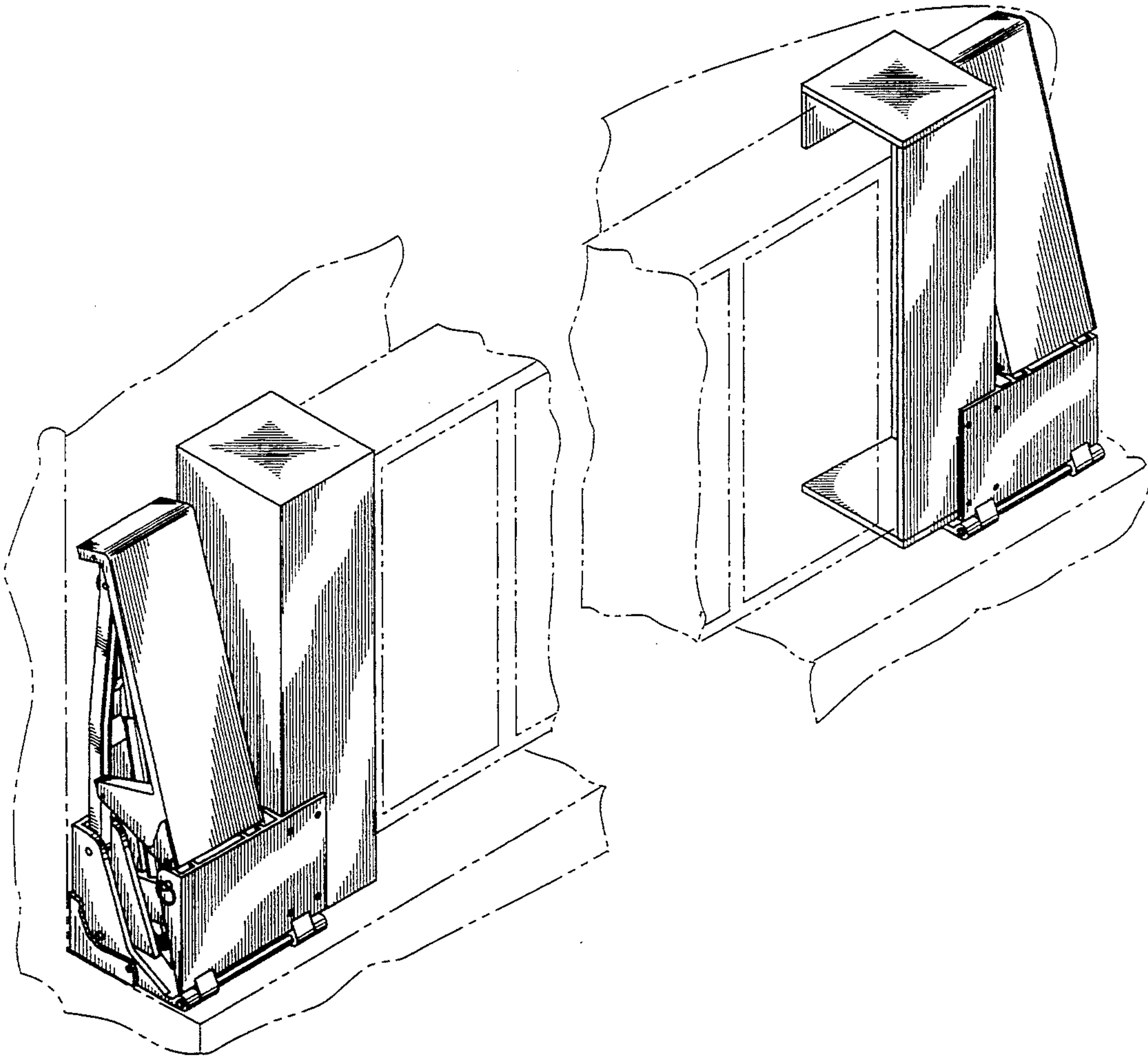
[57] **CLAIM**

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1, 3, 5, 6 and 7 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the the claimed design.



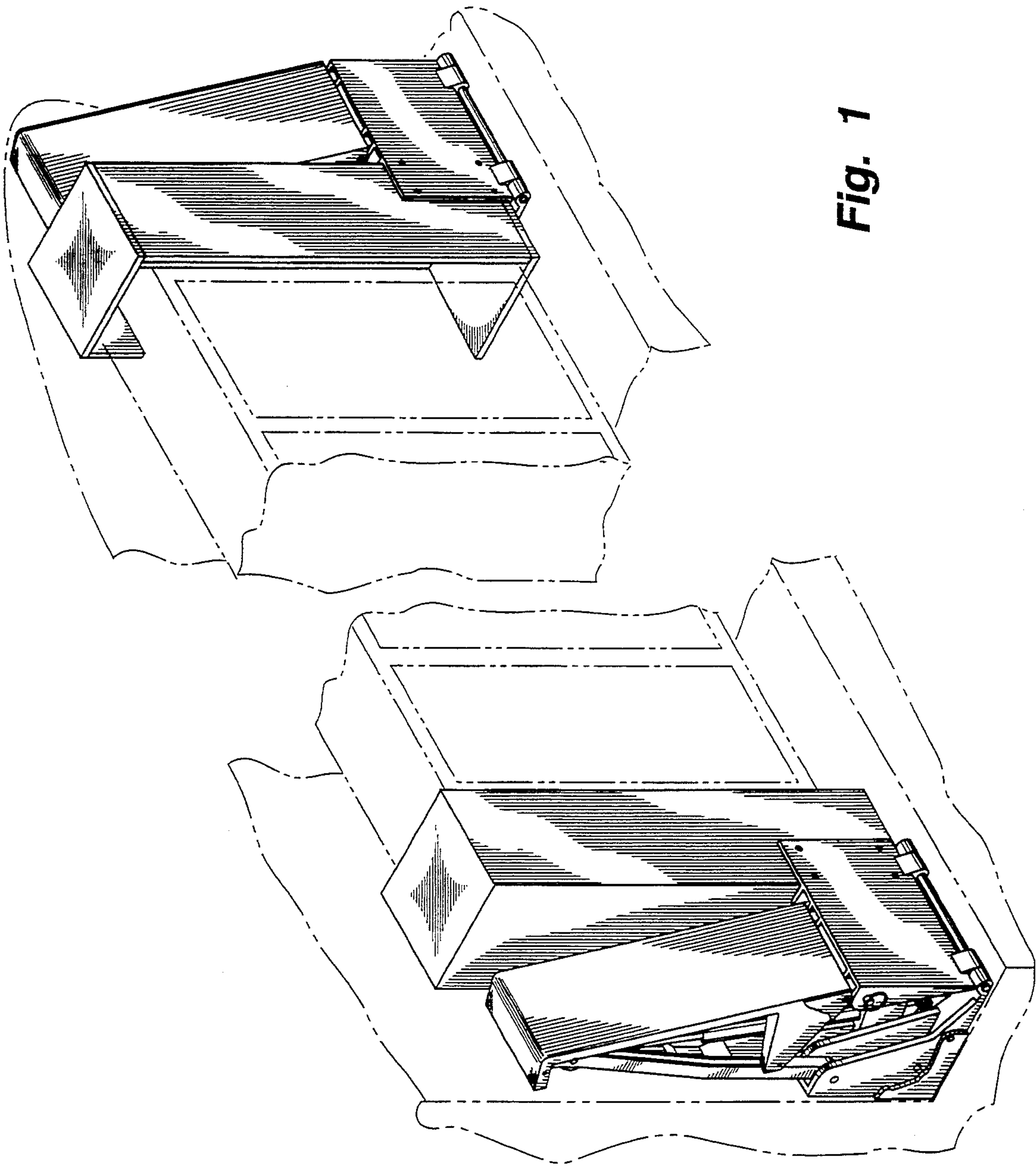

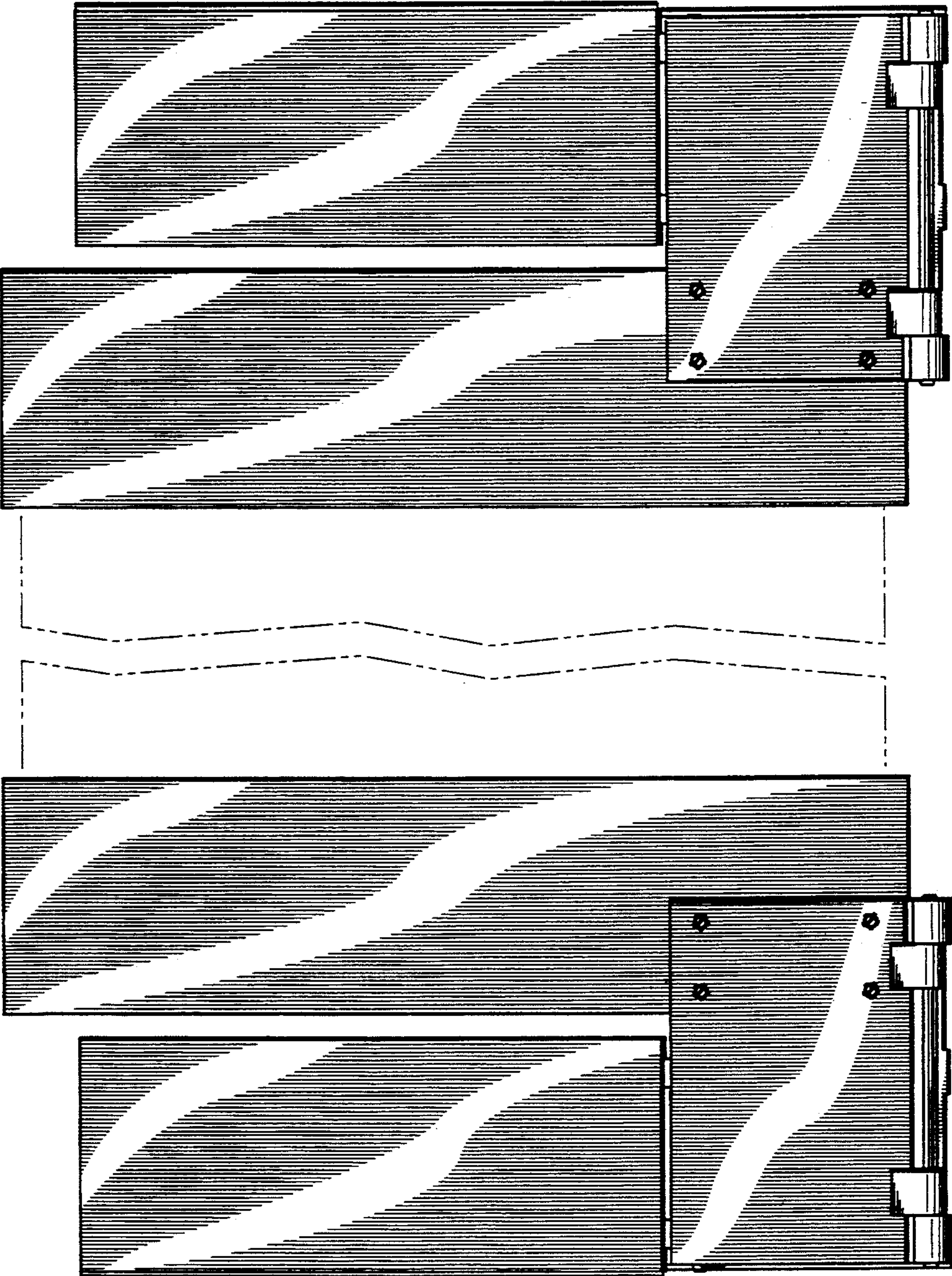

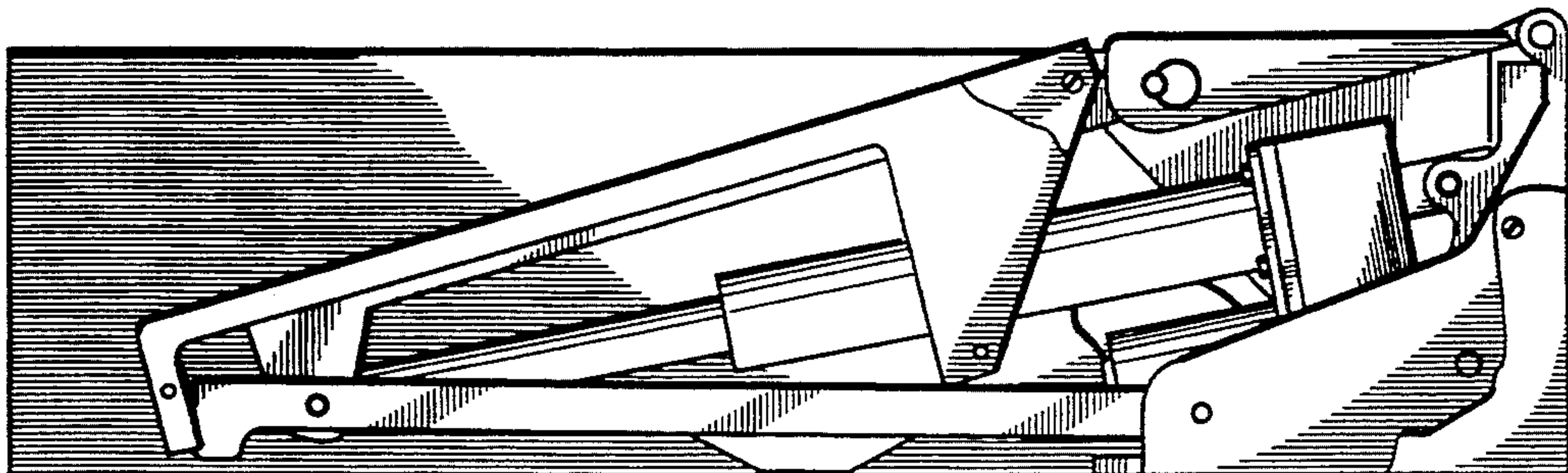

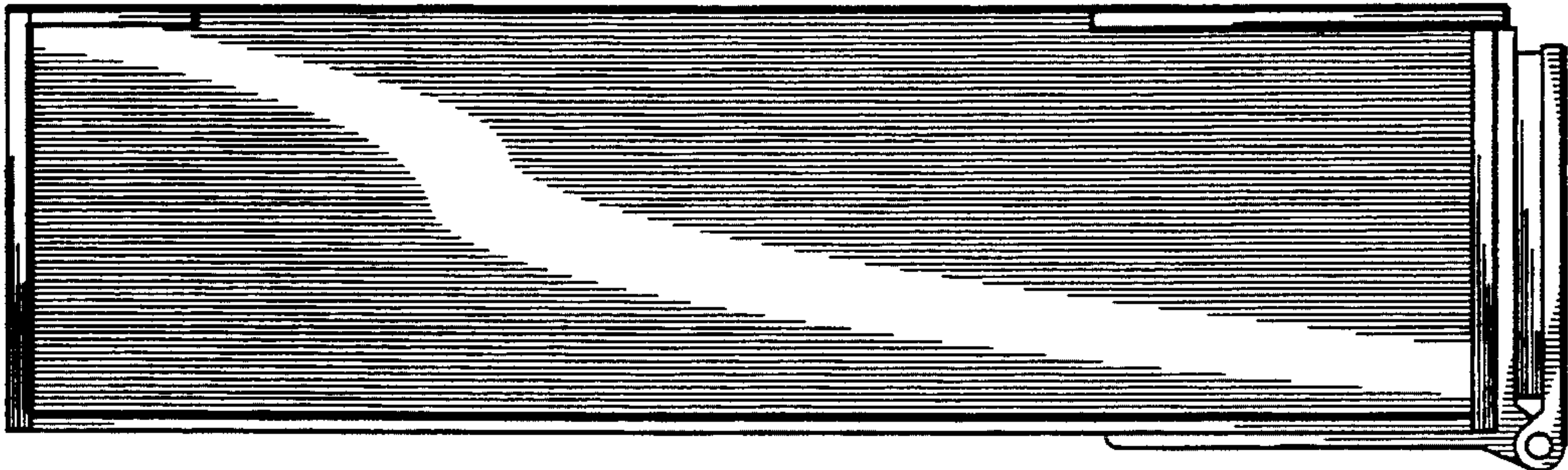

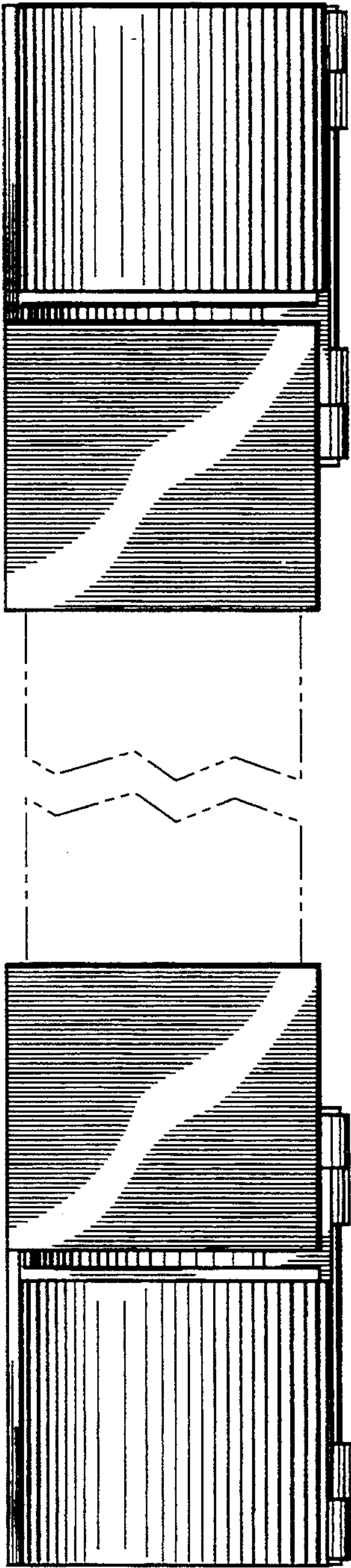

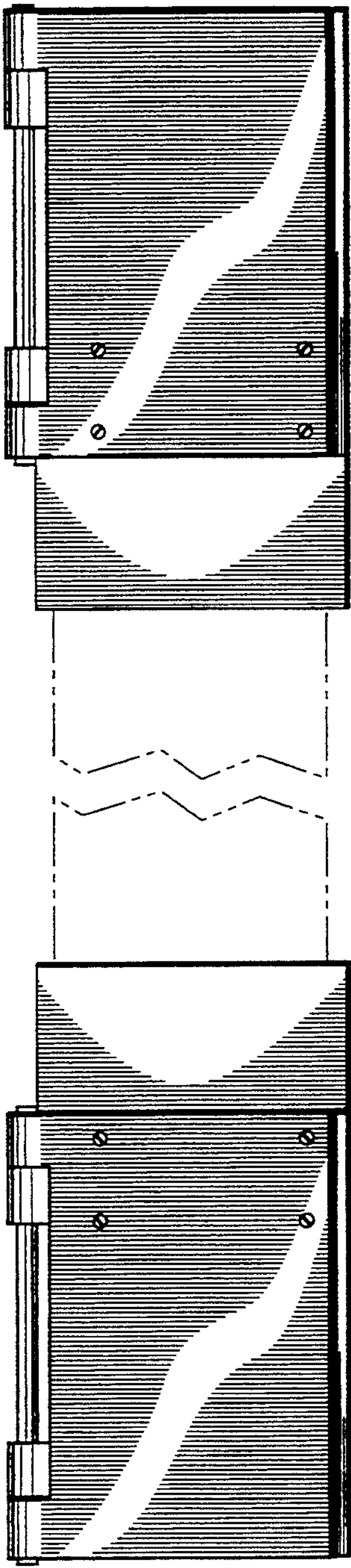

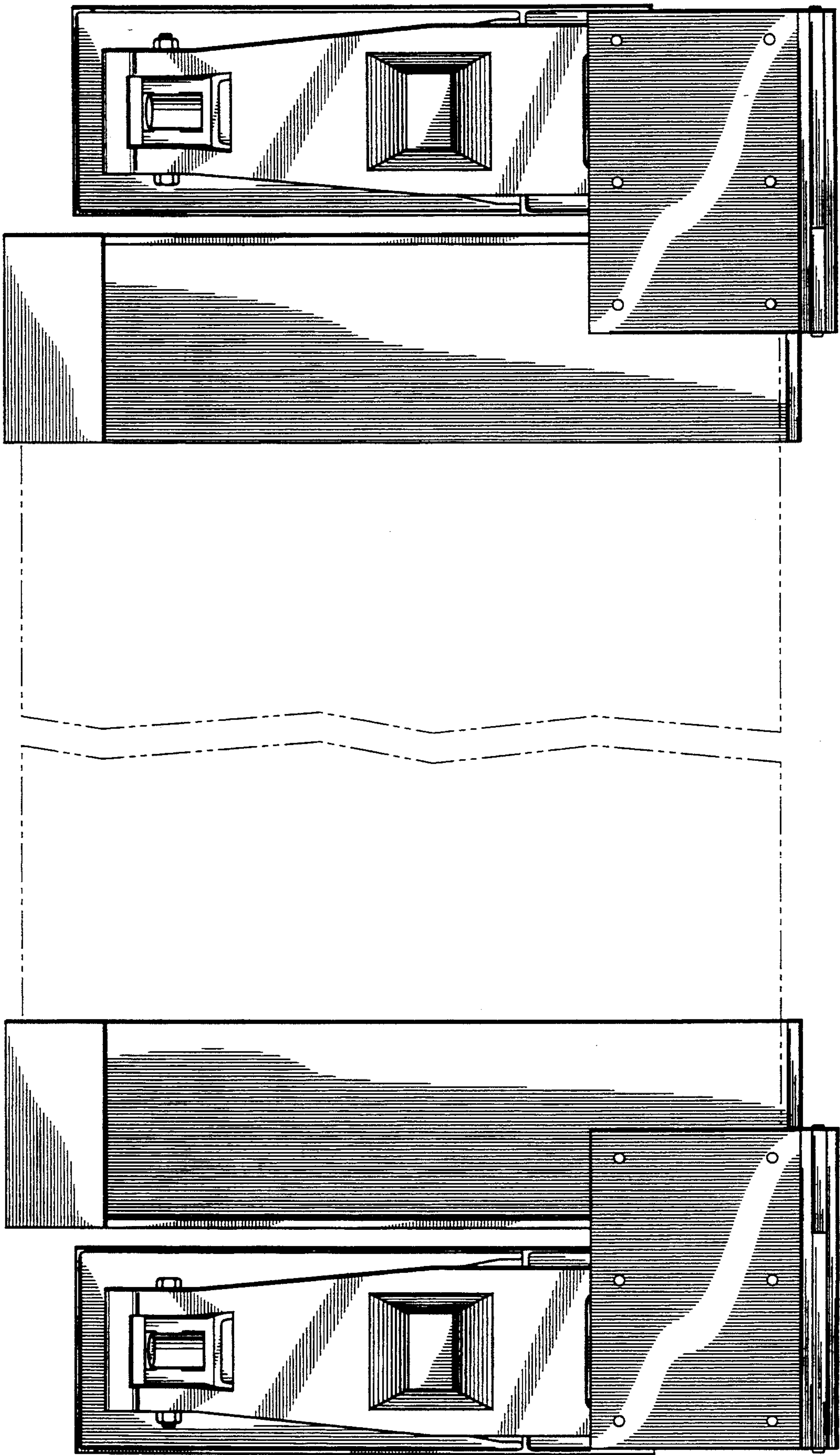
