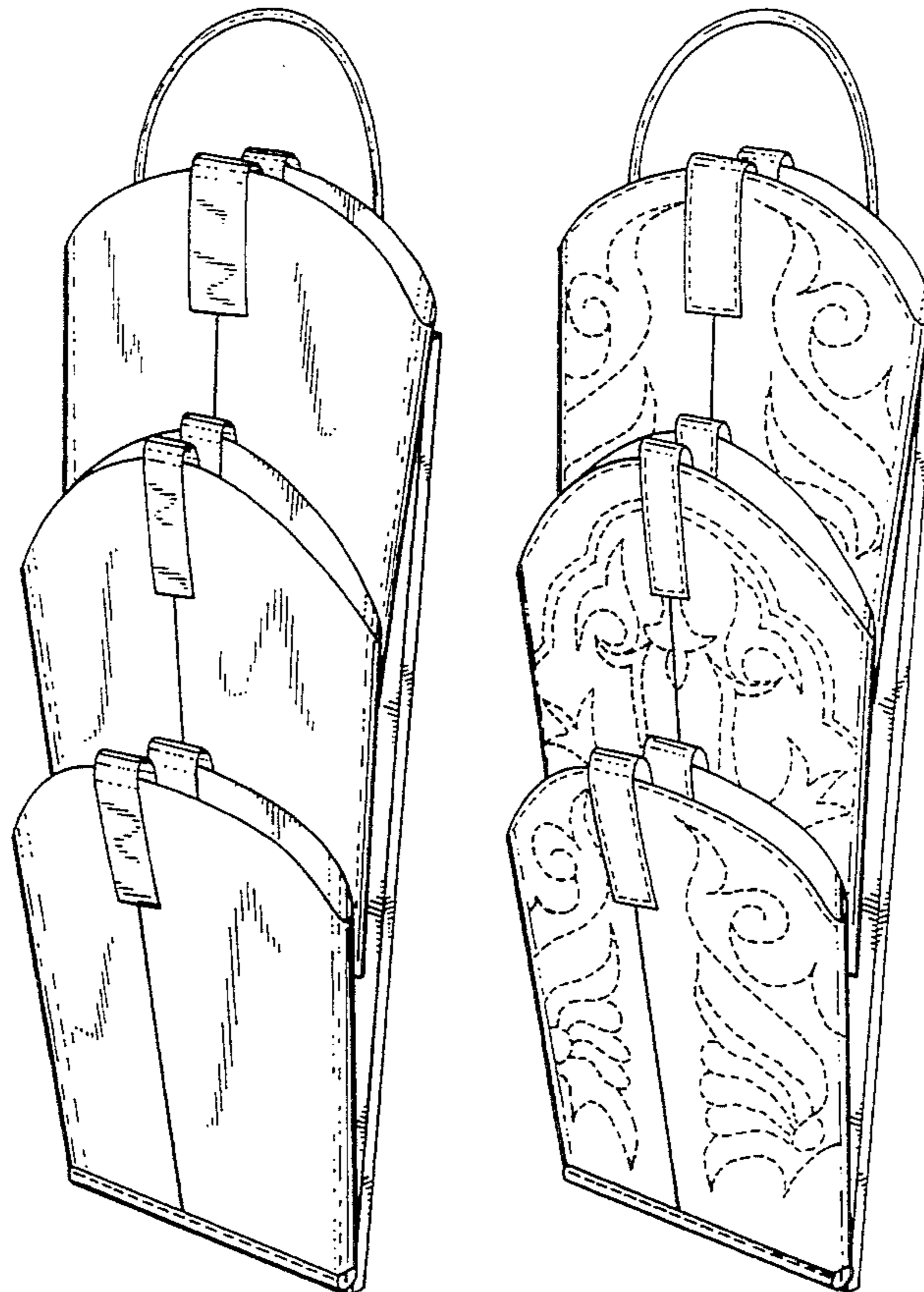
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wall-mountable holder for letters, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wall-mountable holder for letters showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of my new design;
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 13 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The dashed lines in FIGS. 8 and 10 through 13 are shown for the purpose of indicating a stitched pattern.



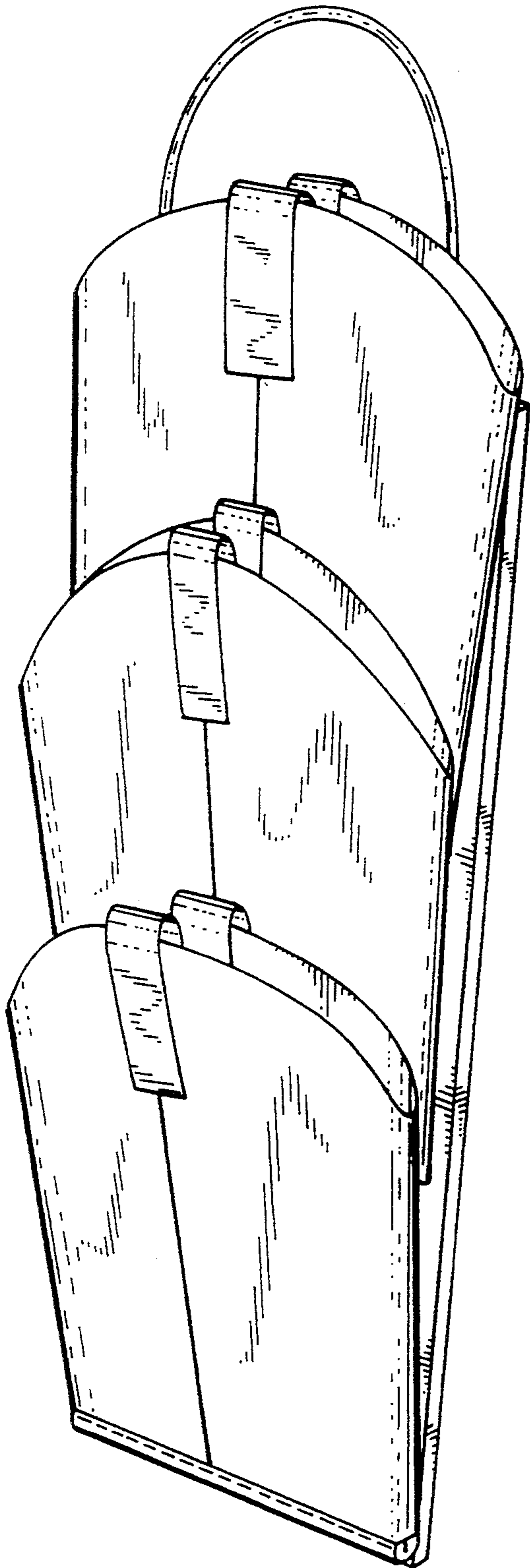

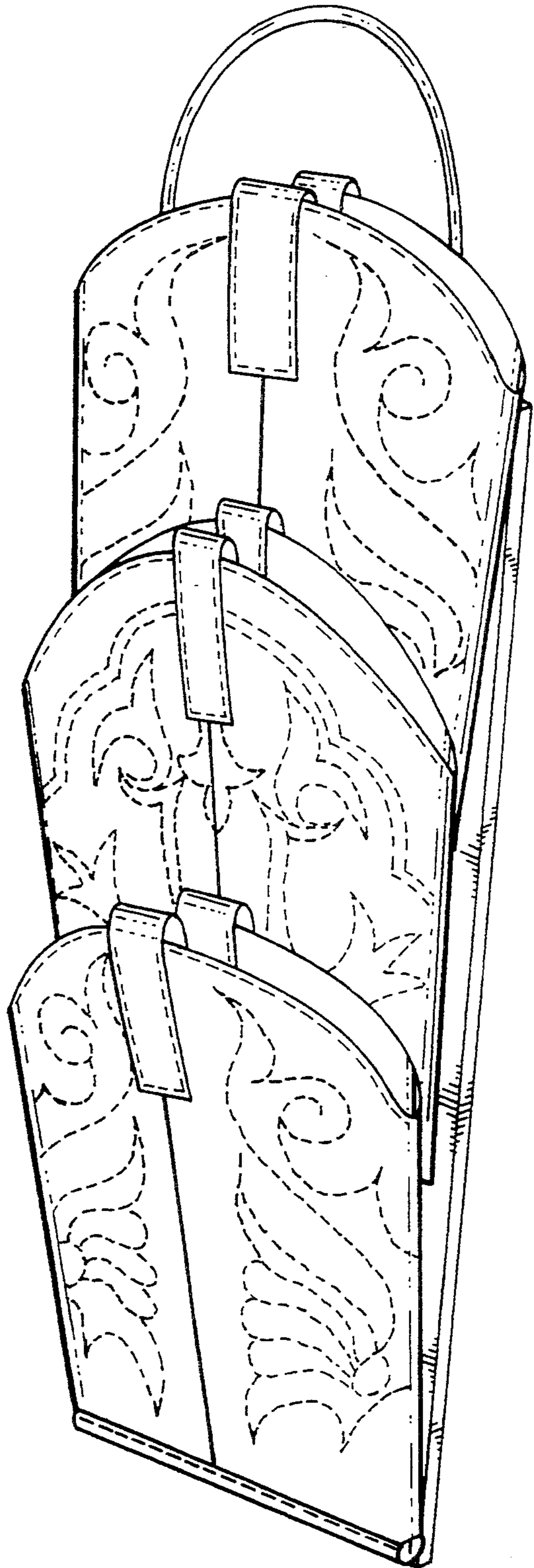

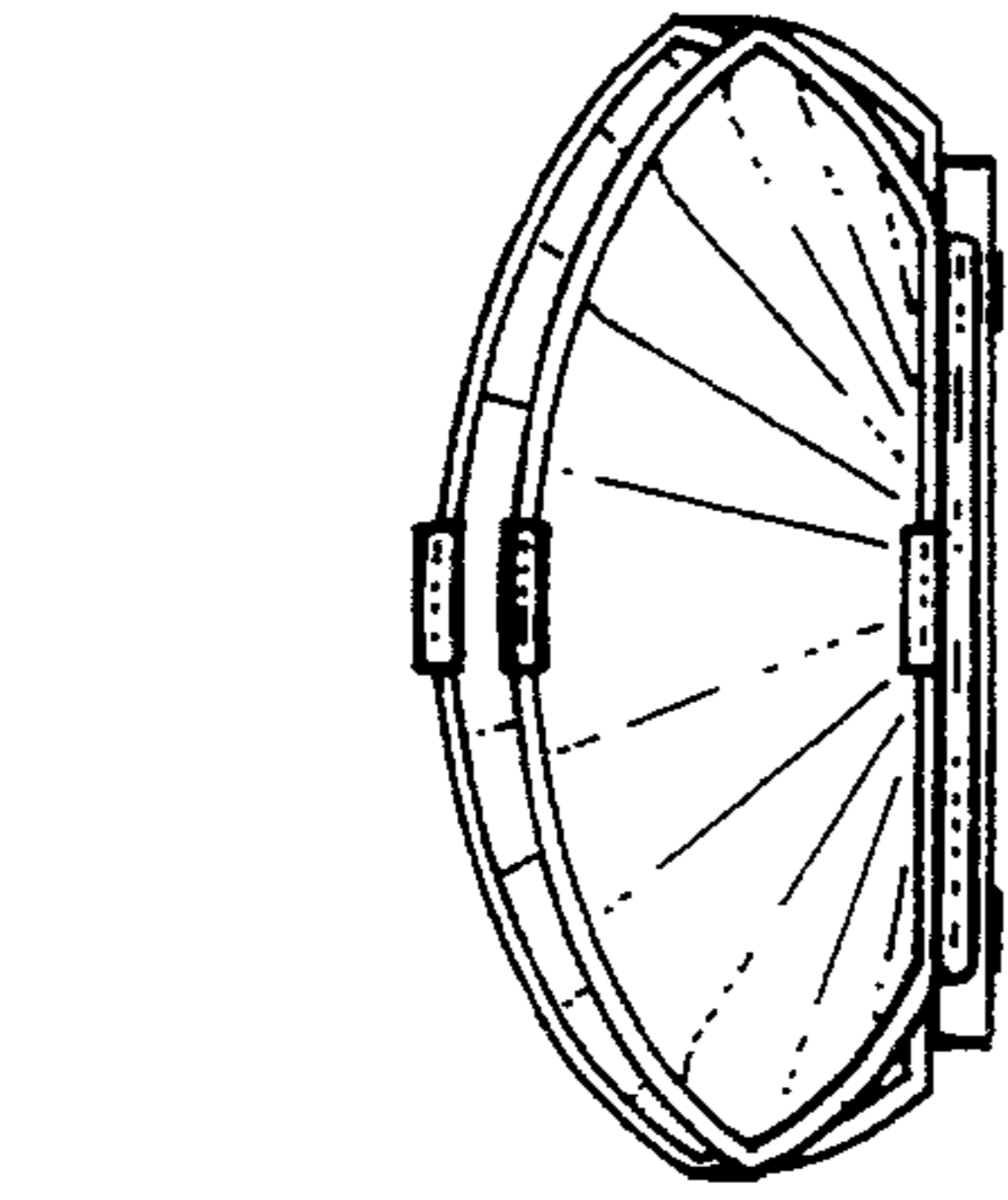

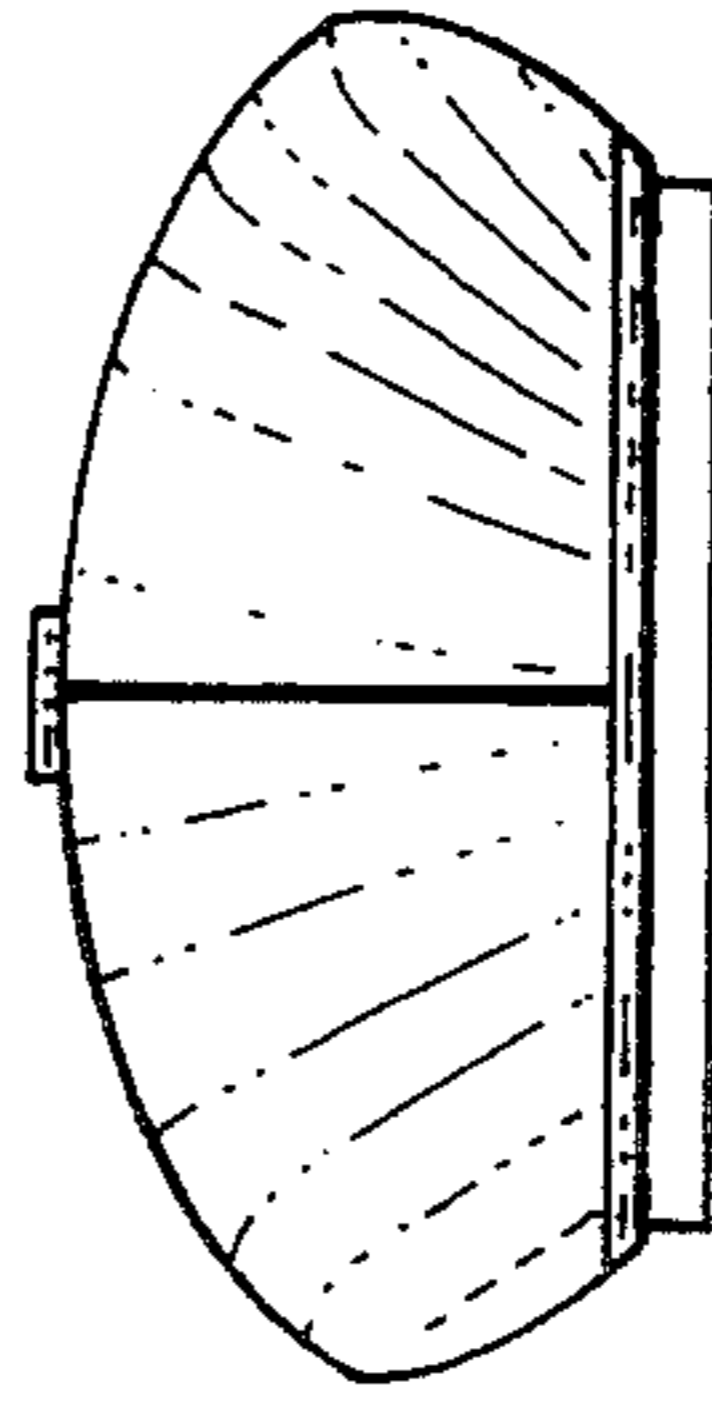

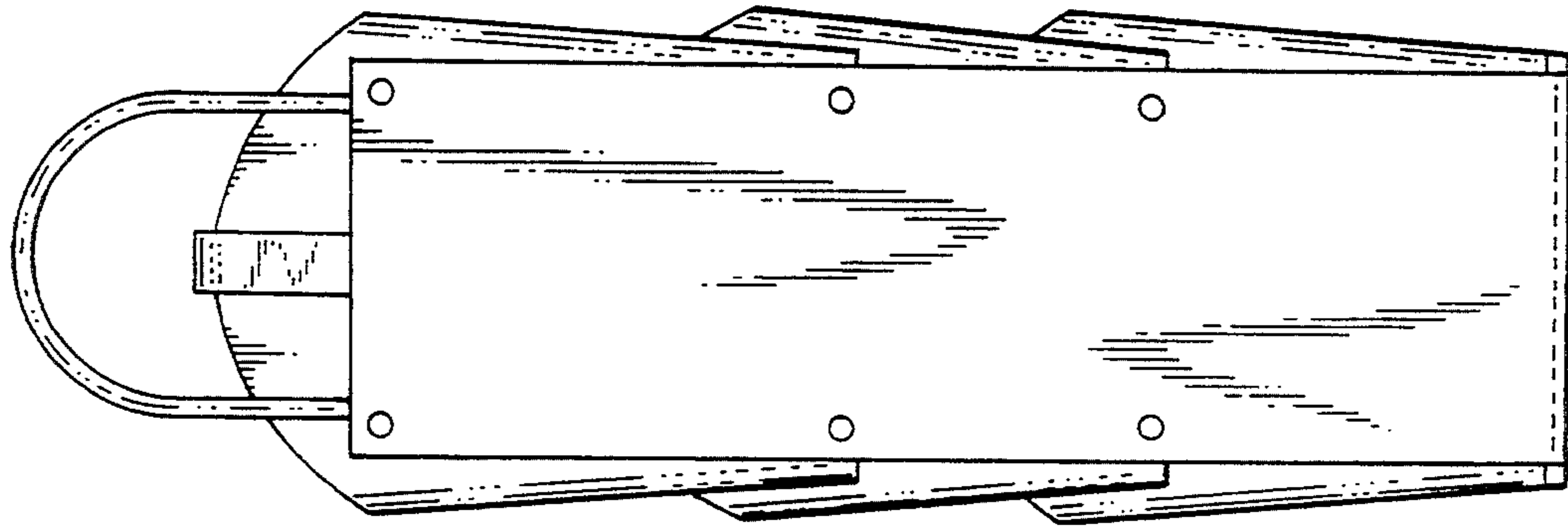

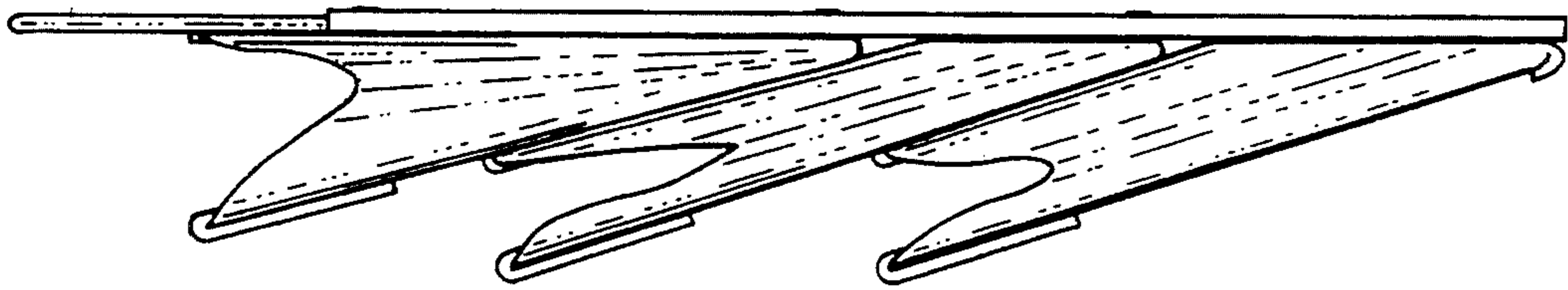

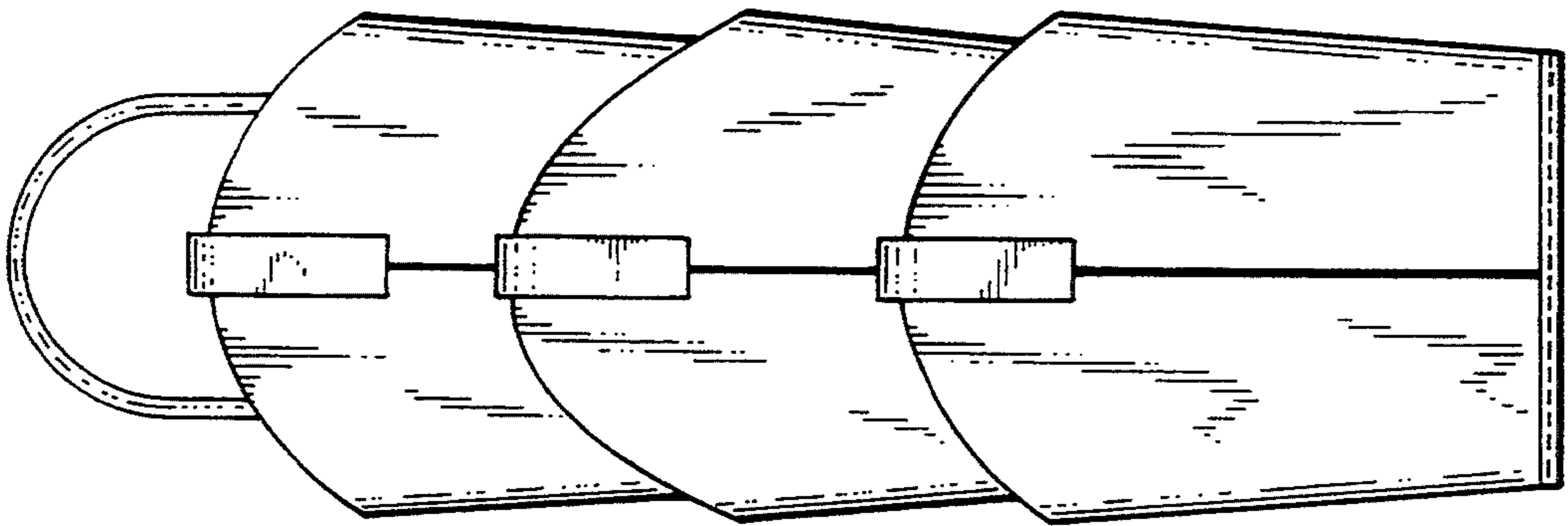

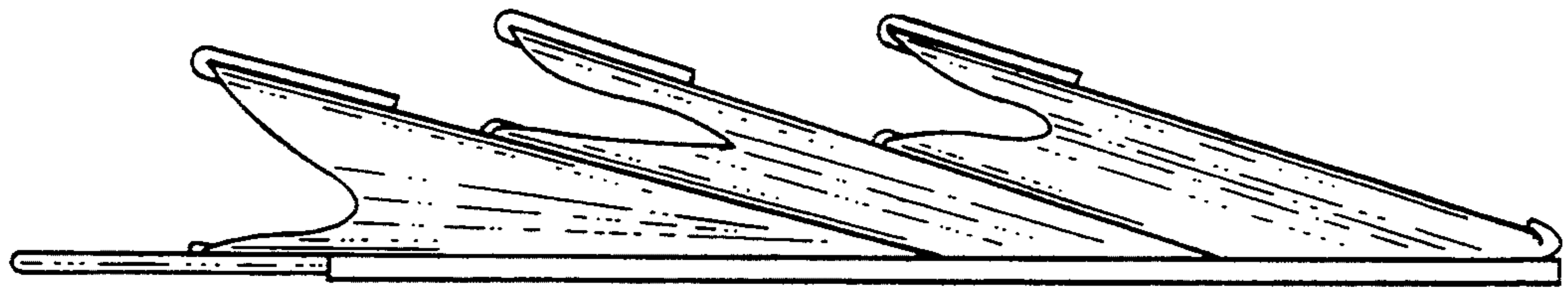

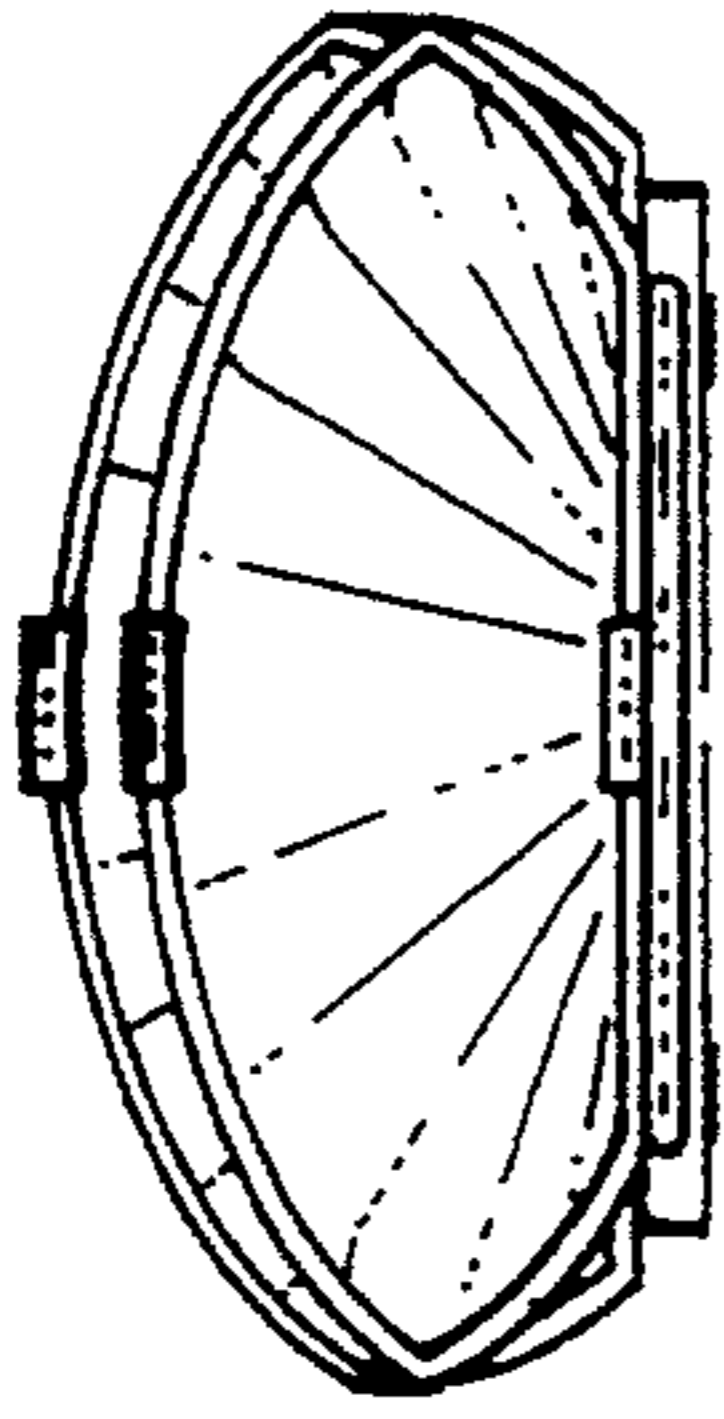

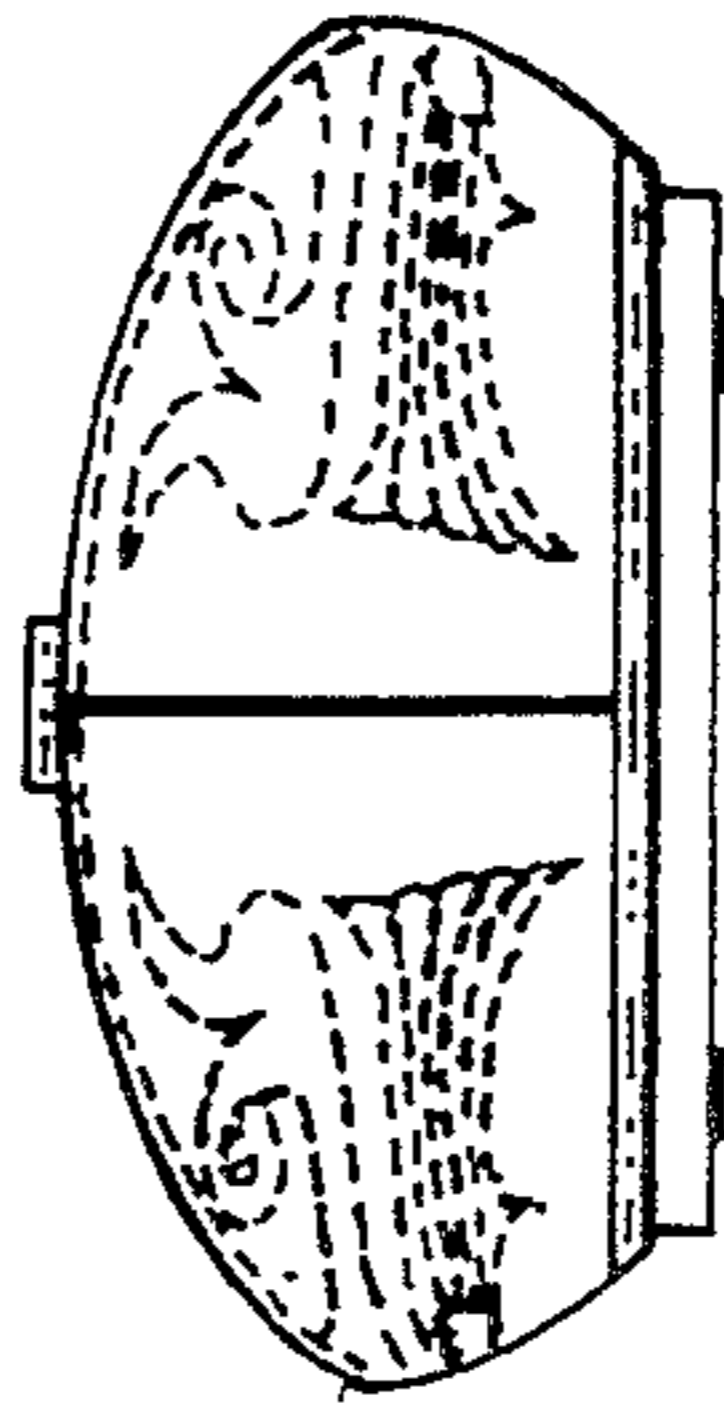

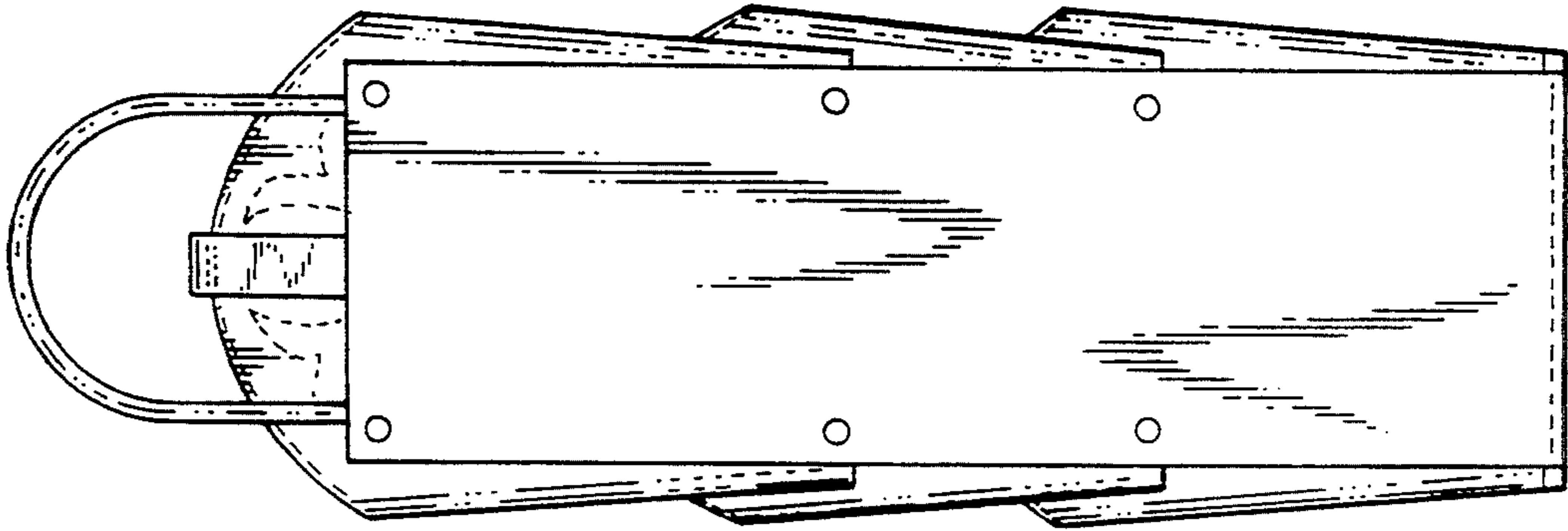

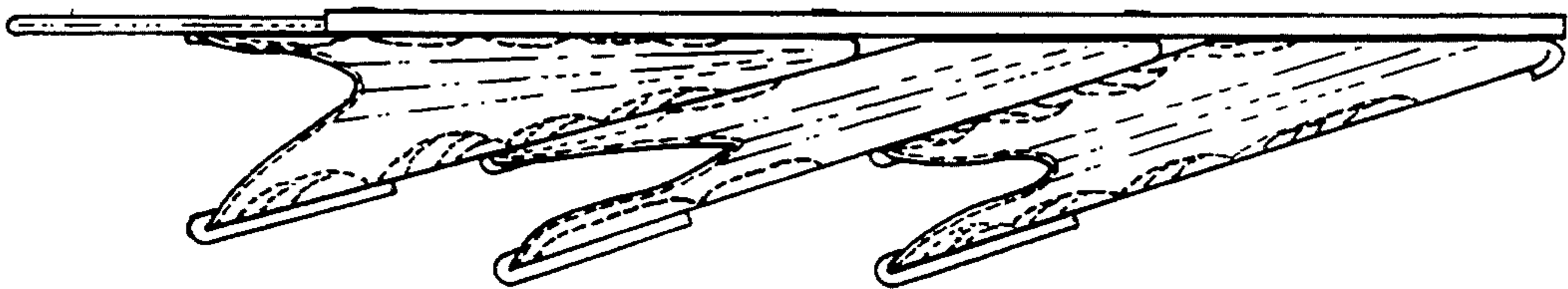

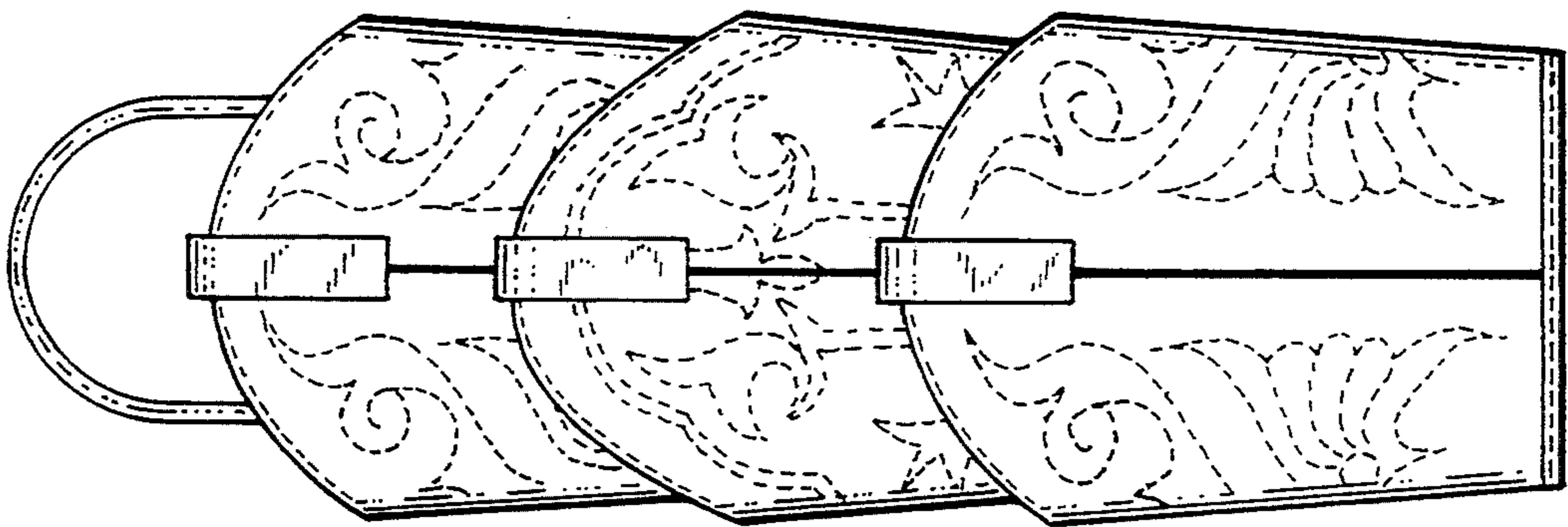

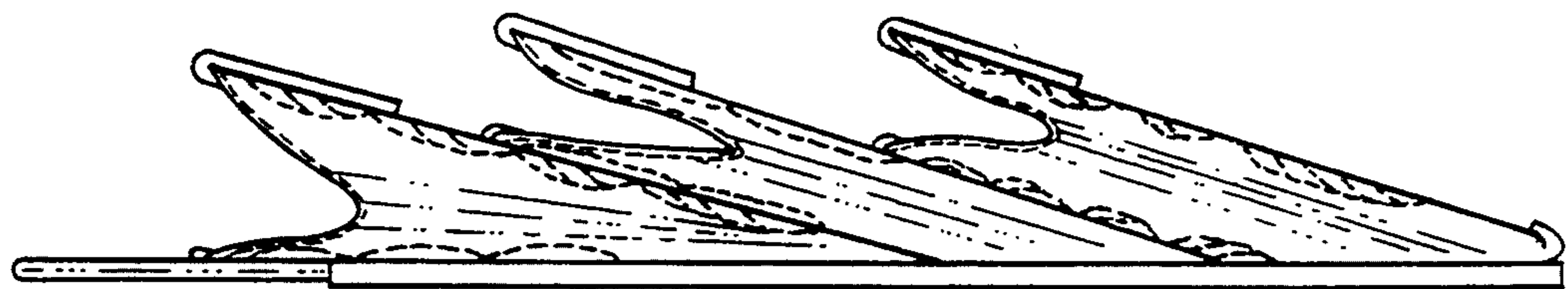
