The ornamental design for a therapeutic toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the therapeutic toy embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

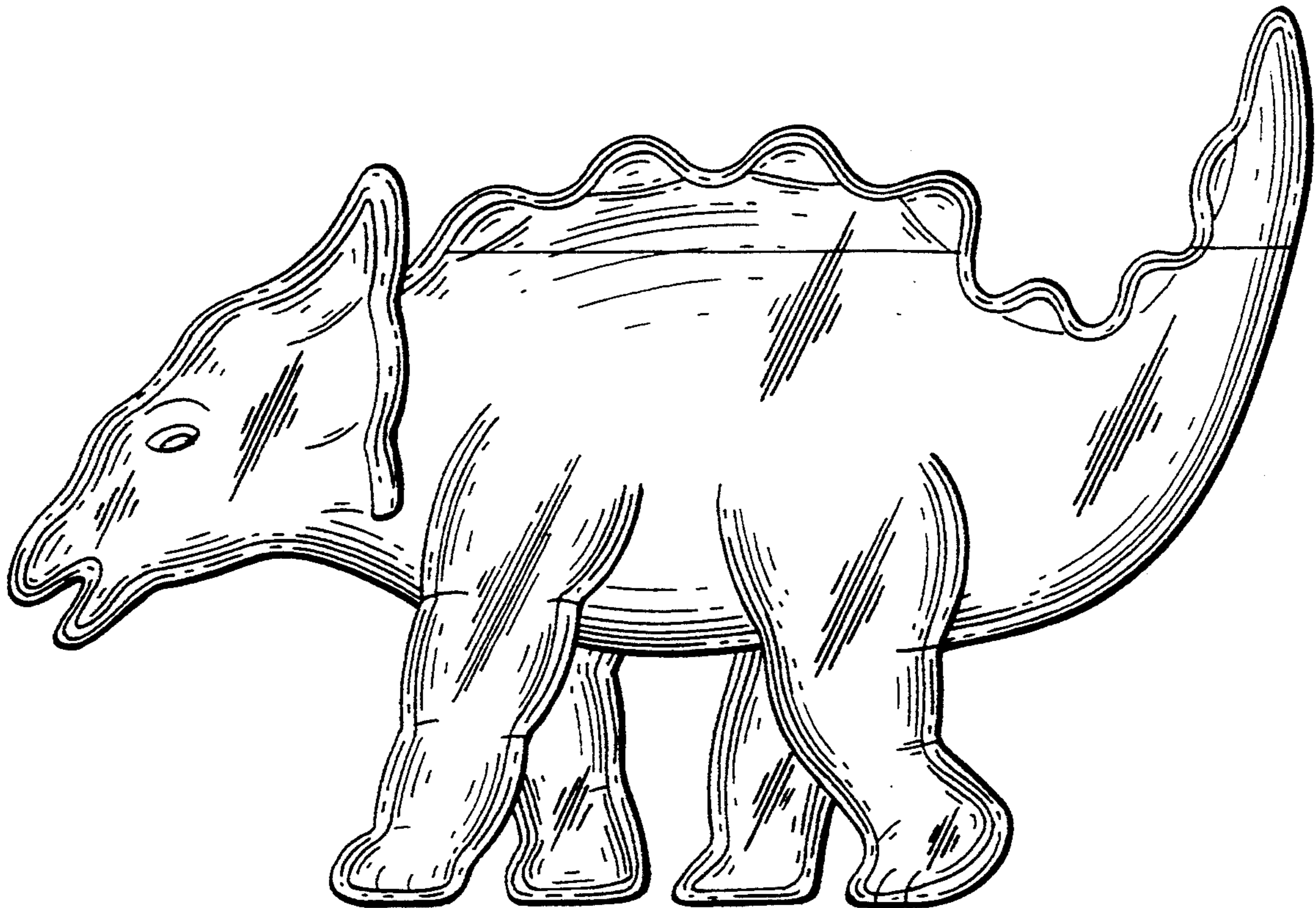

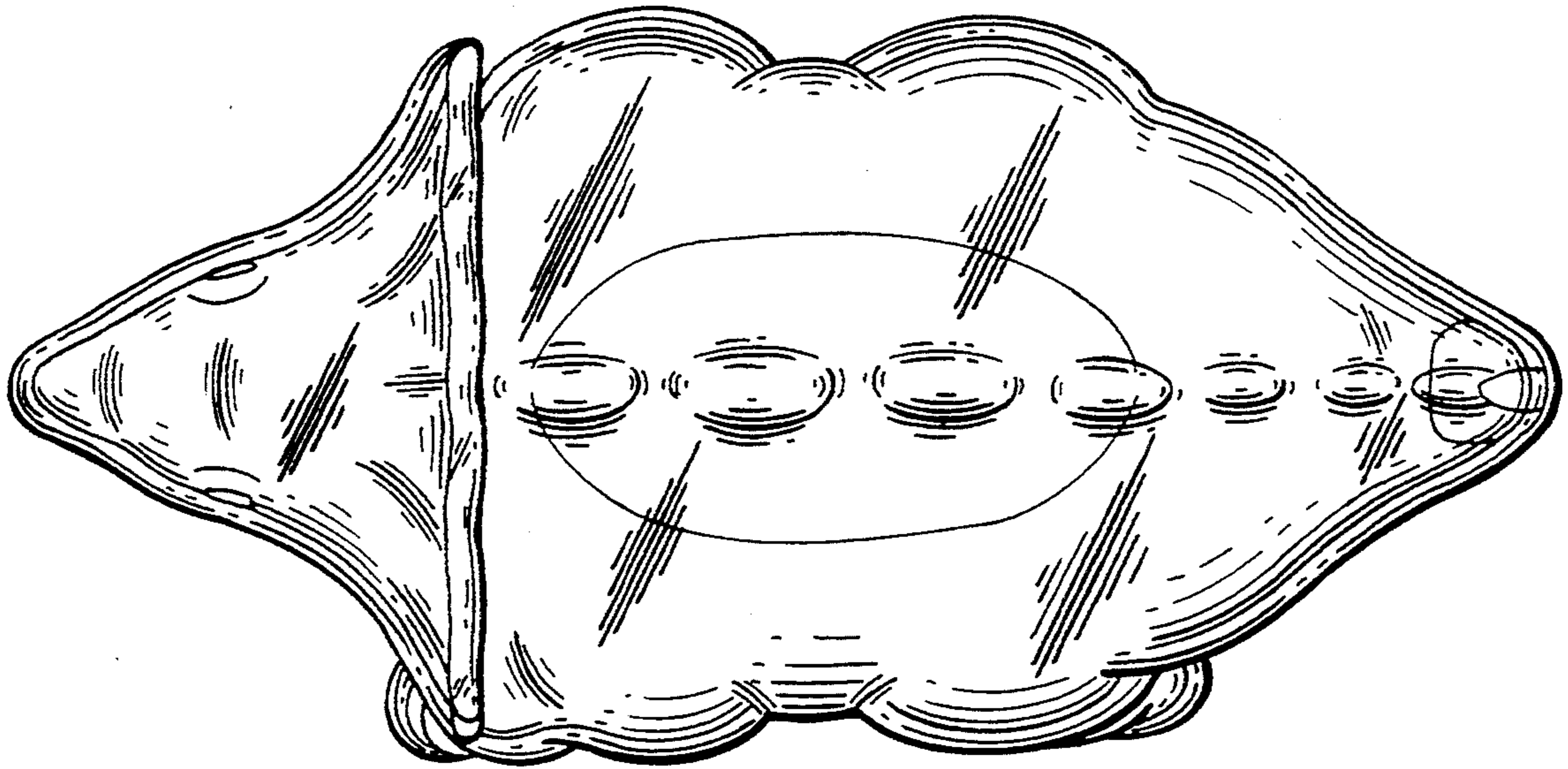

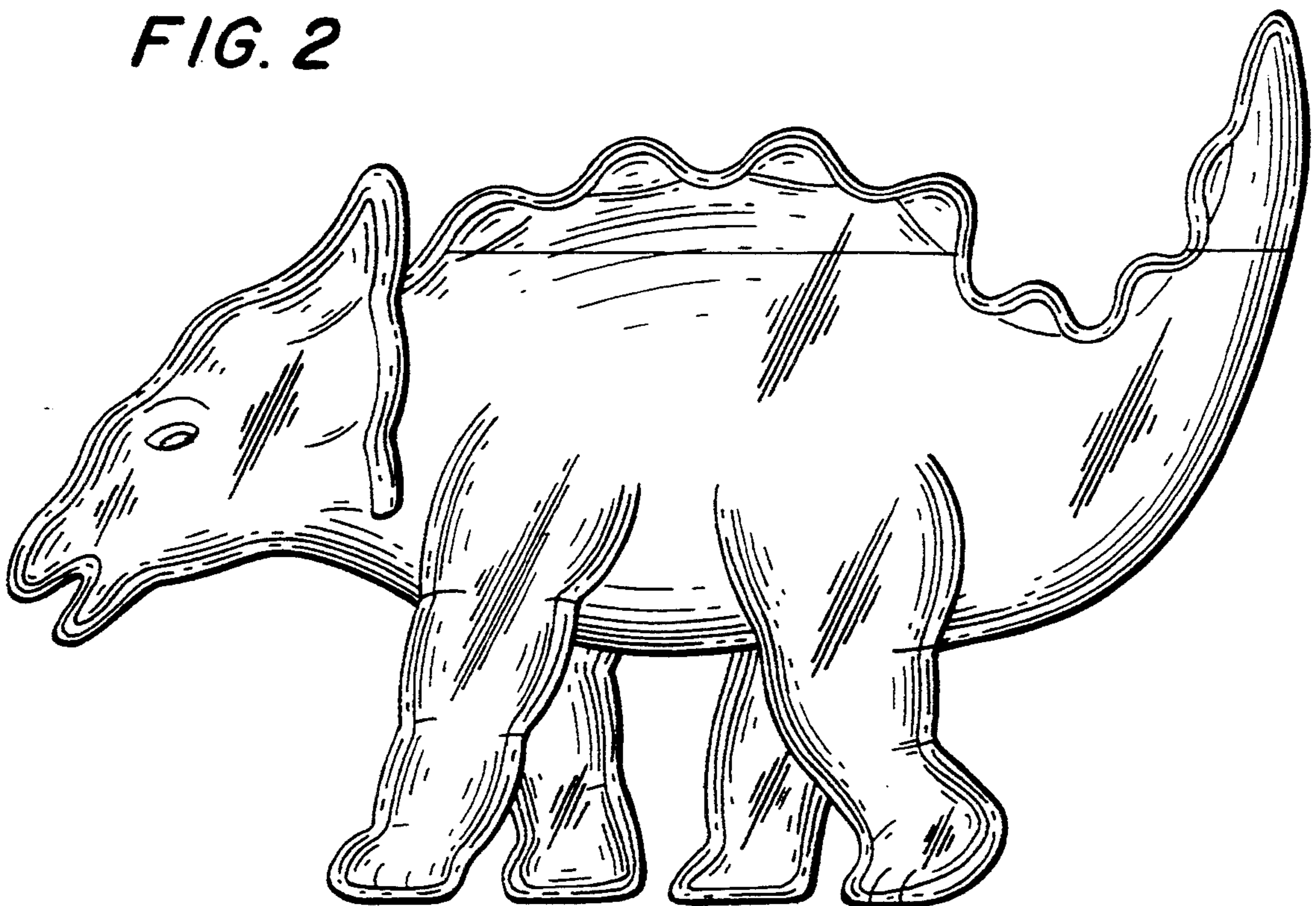

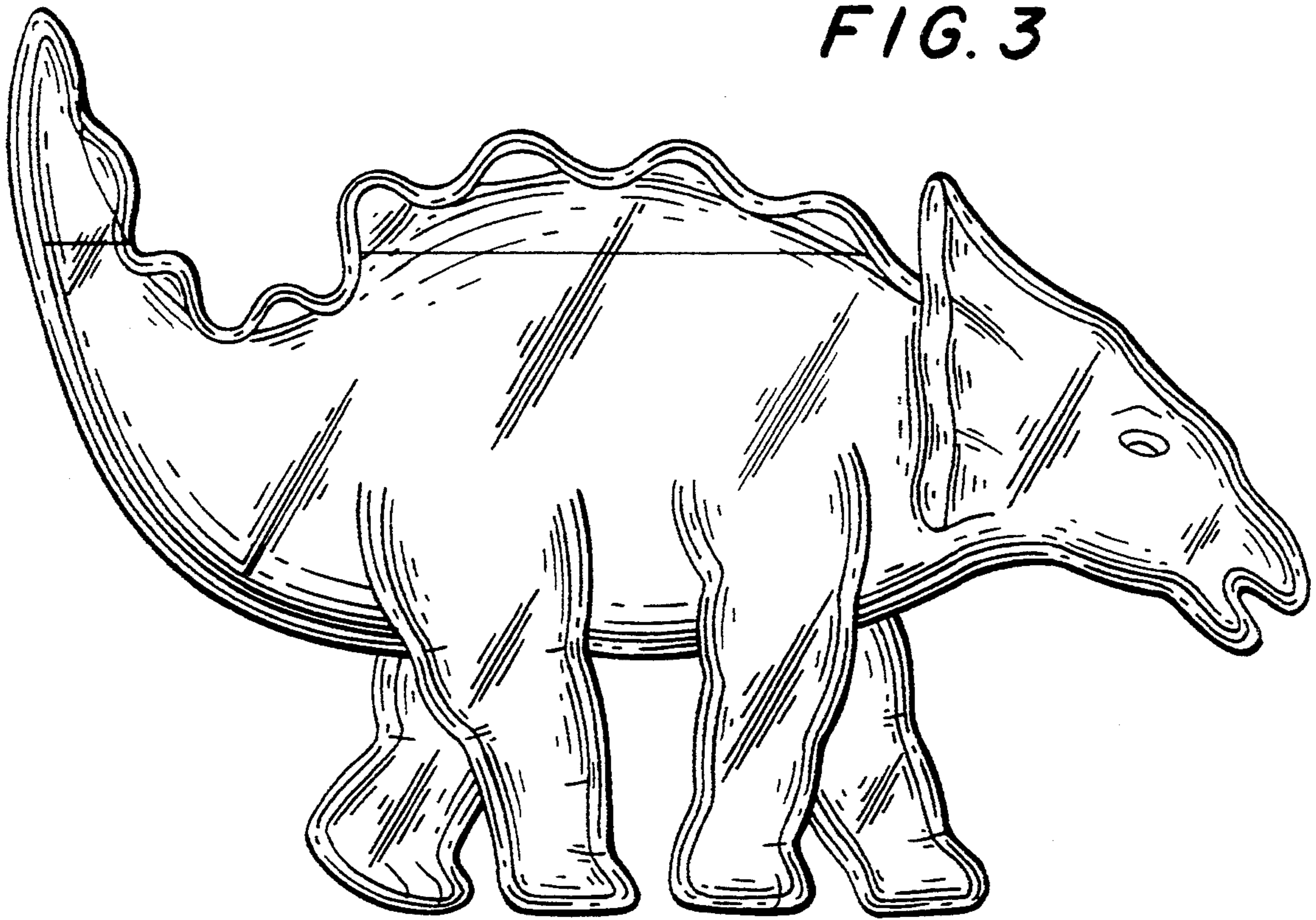

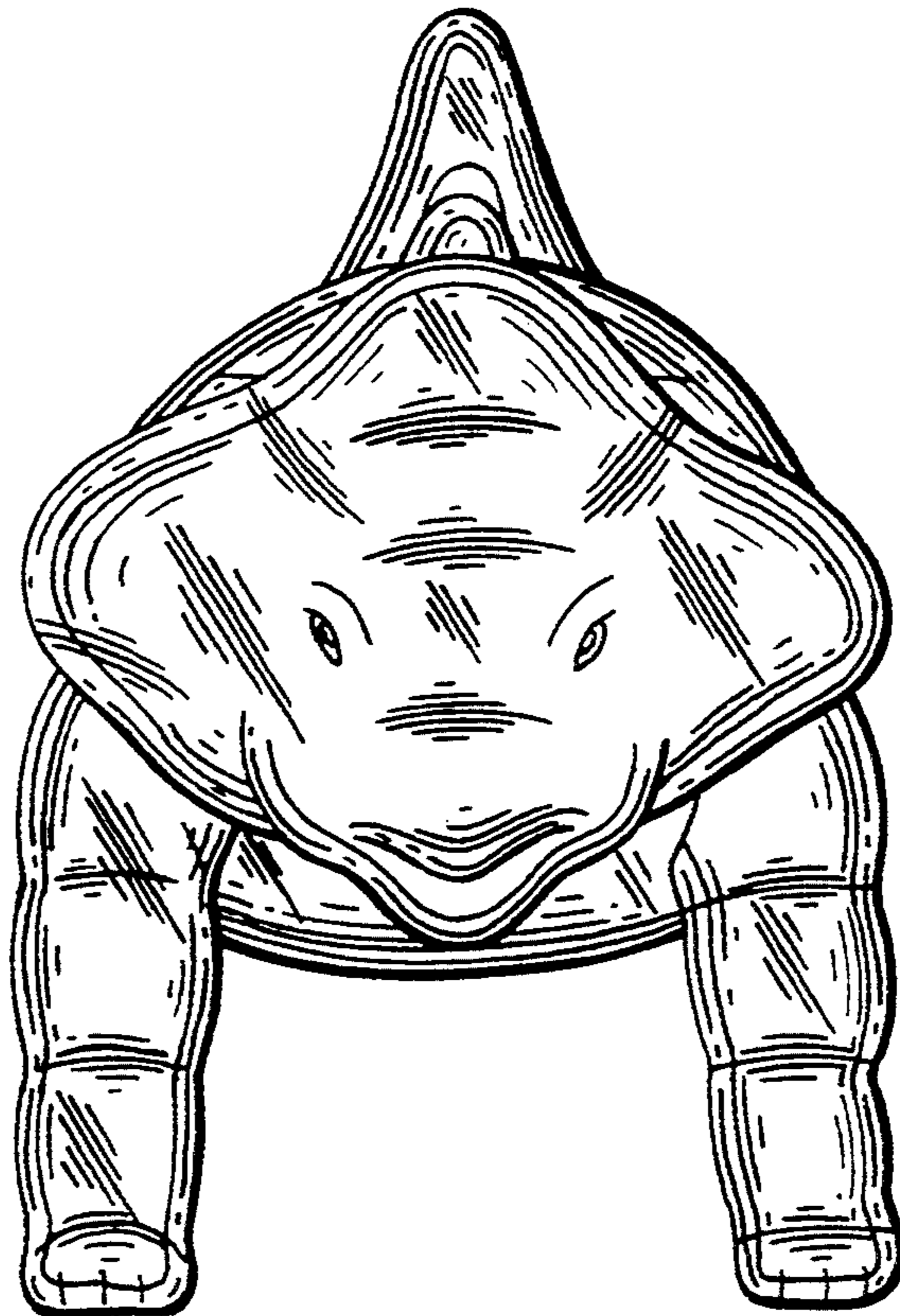

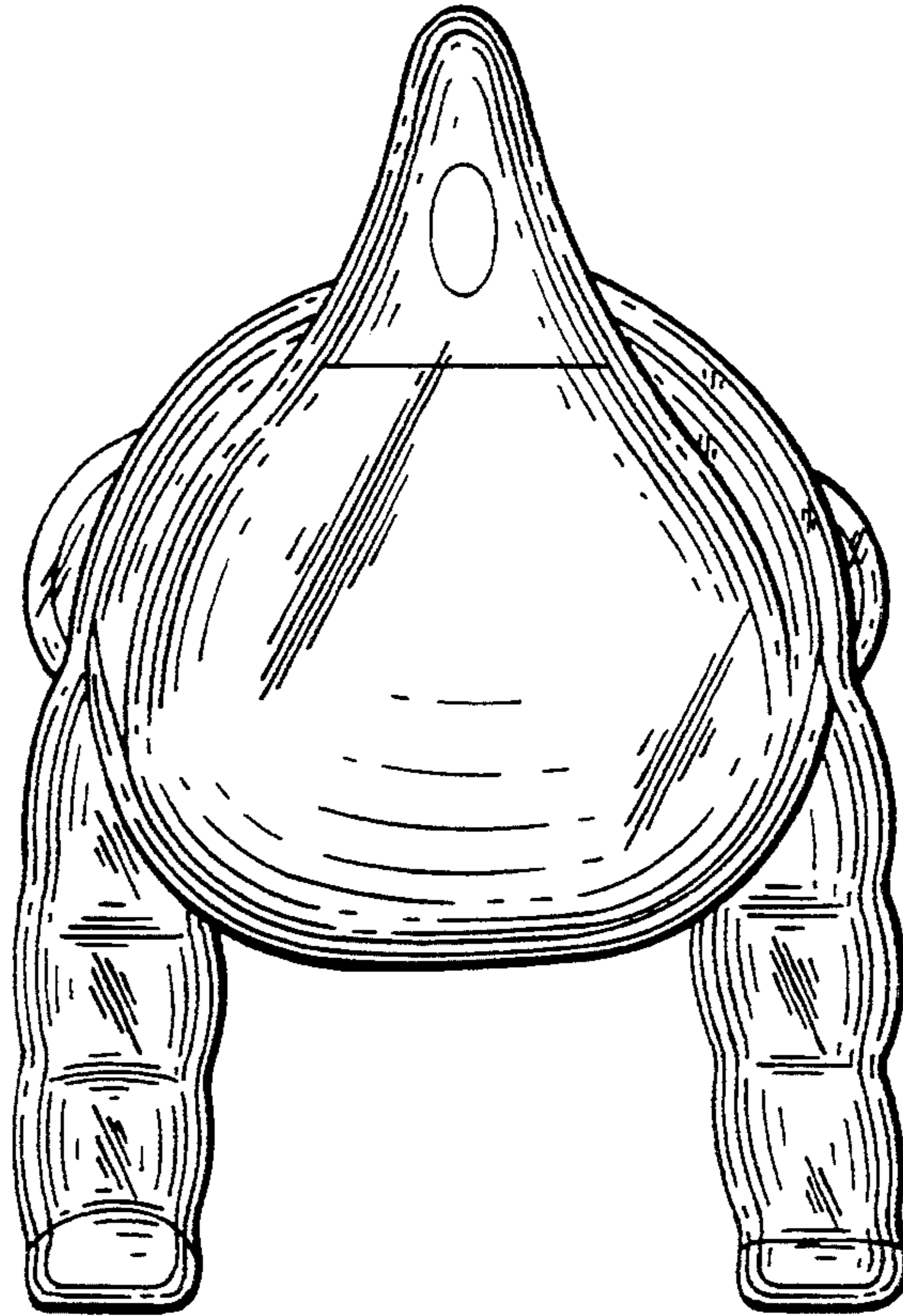
