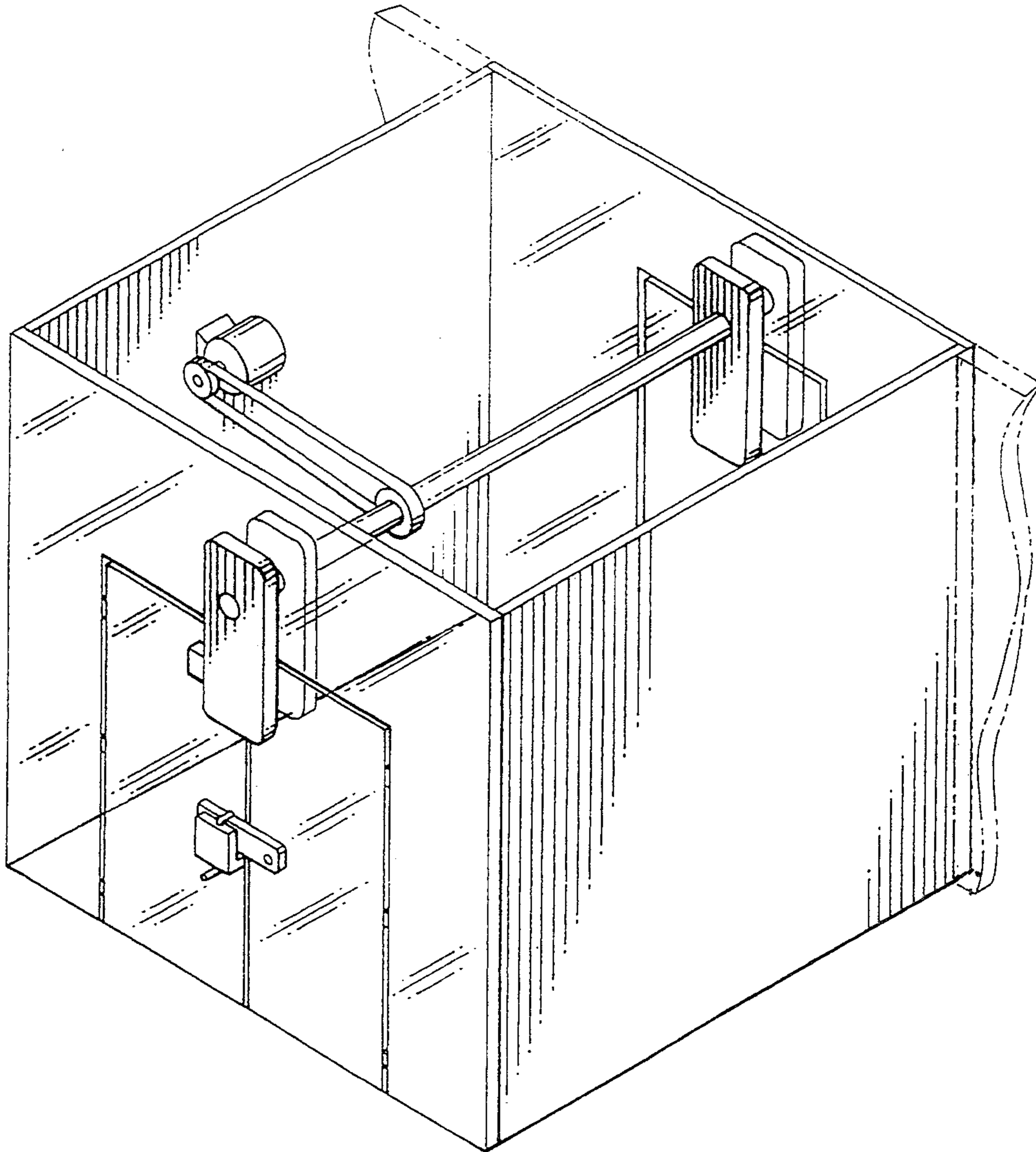

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof, showing doors unlocked, and with manual latch lock in locked position.



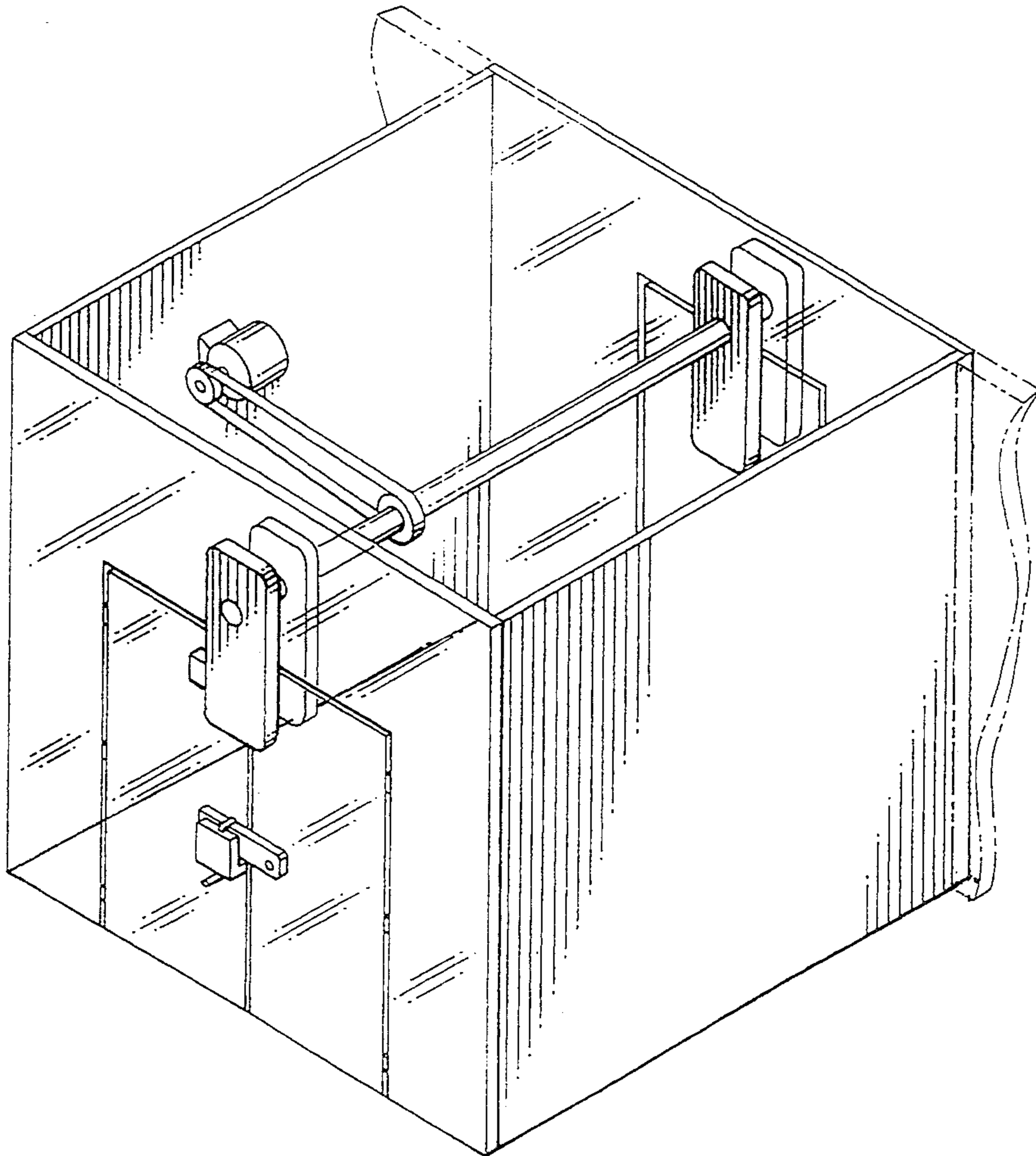

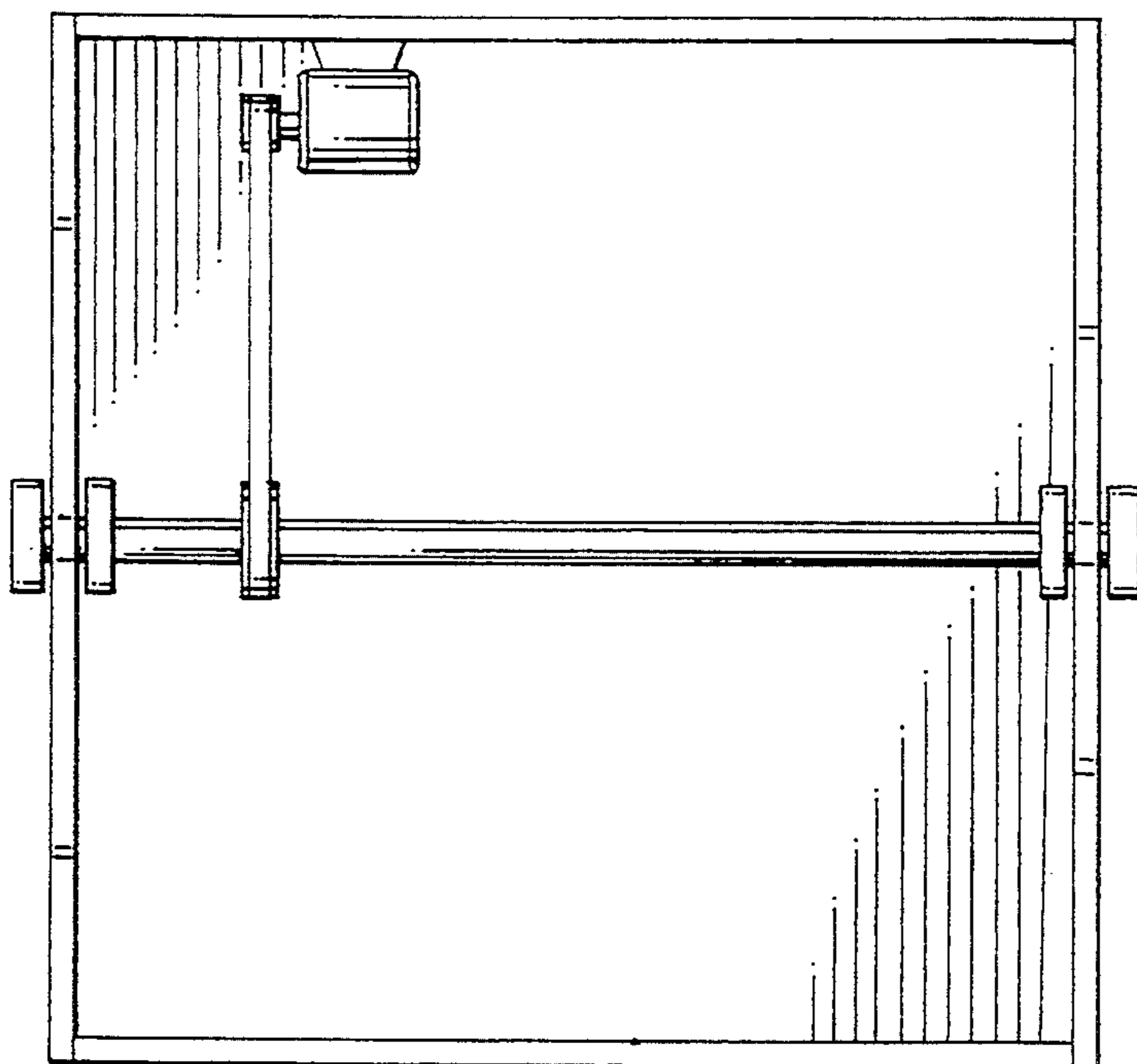

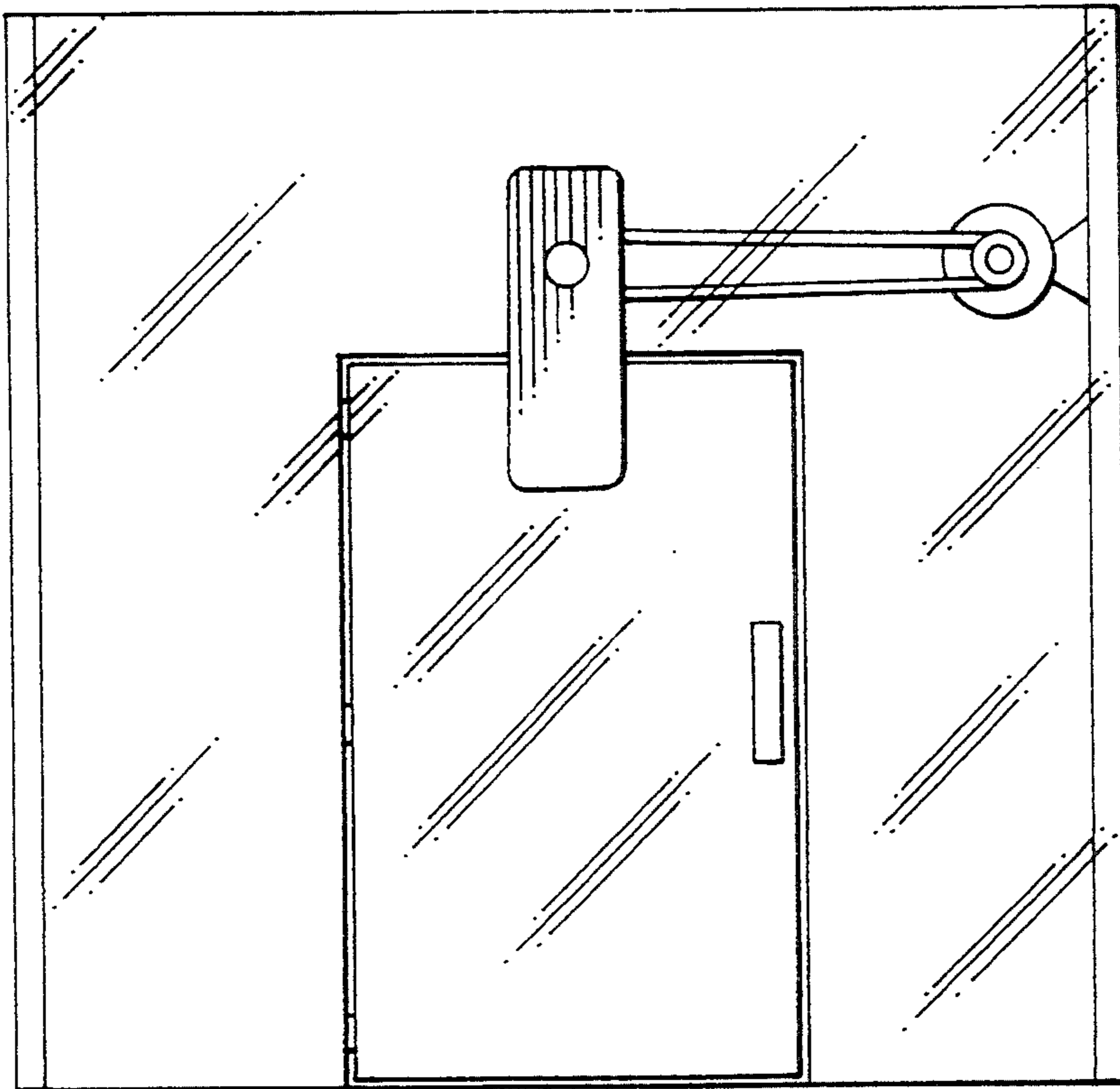

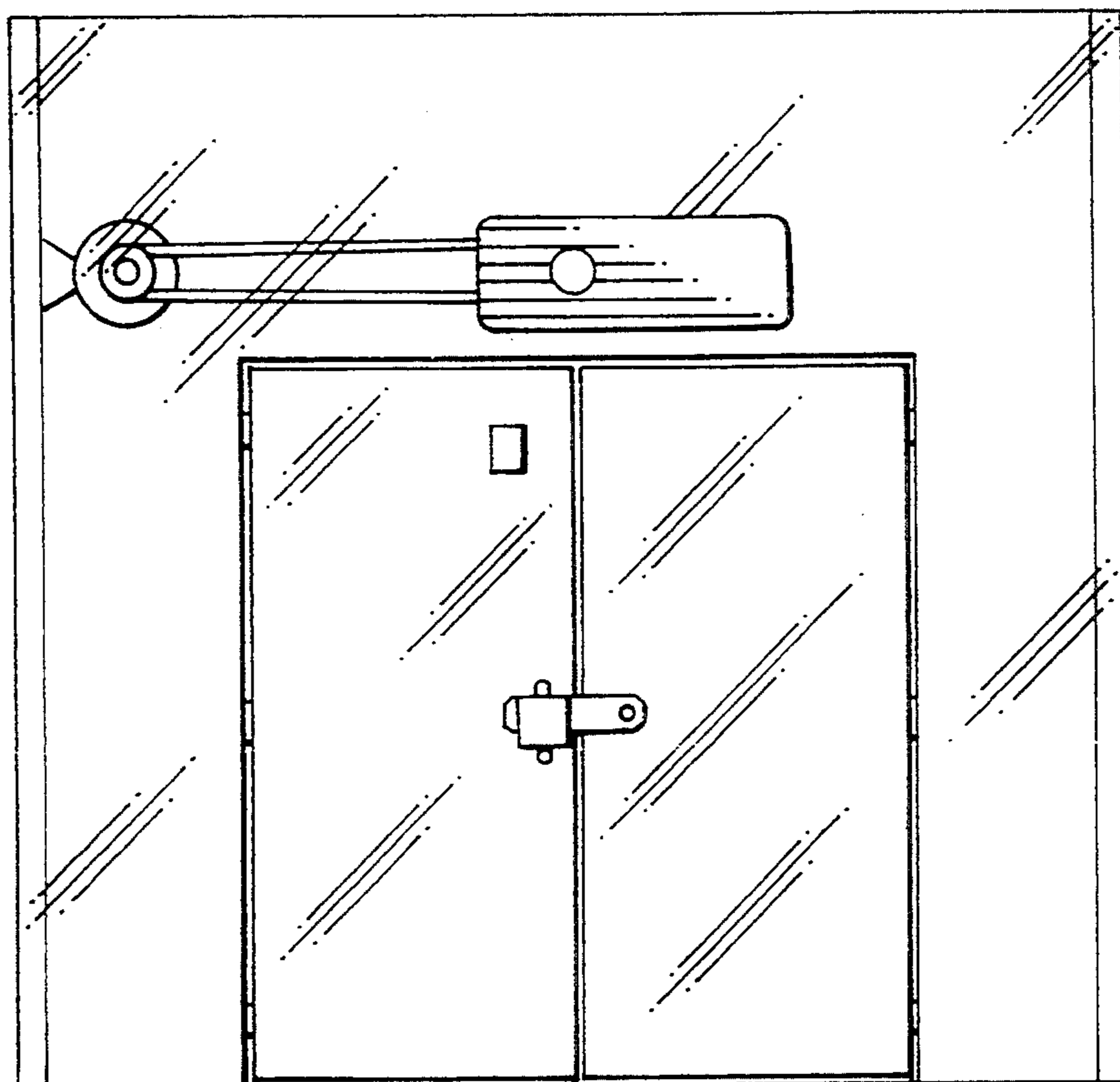
