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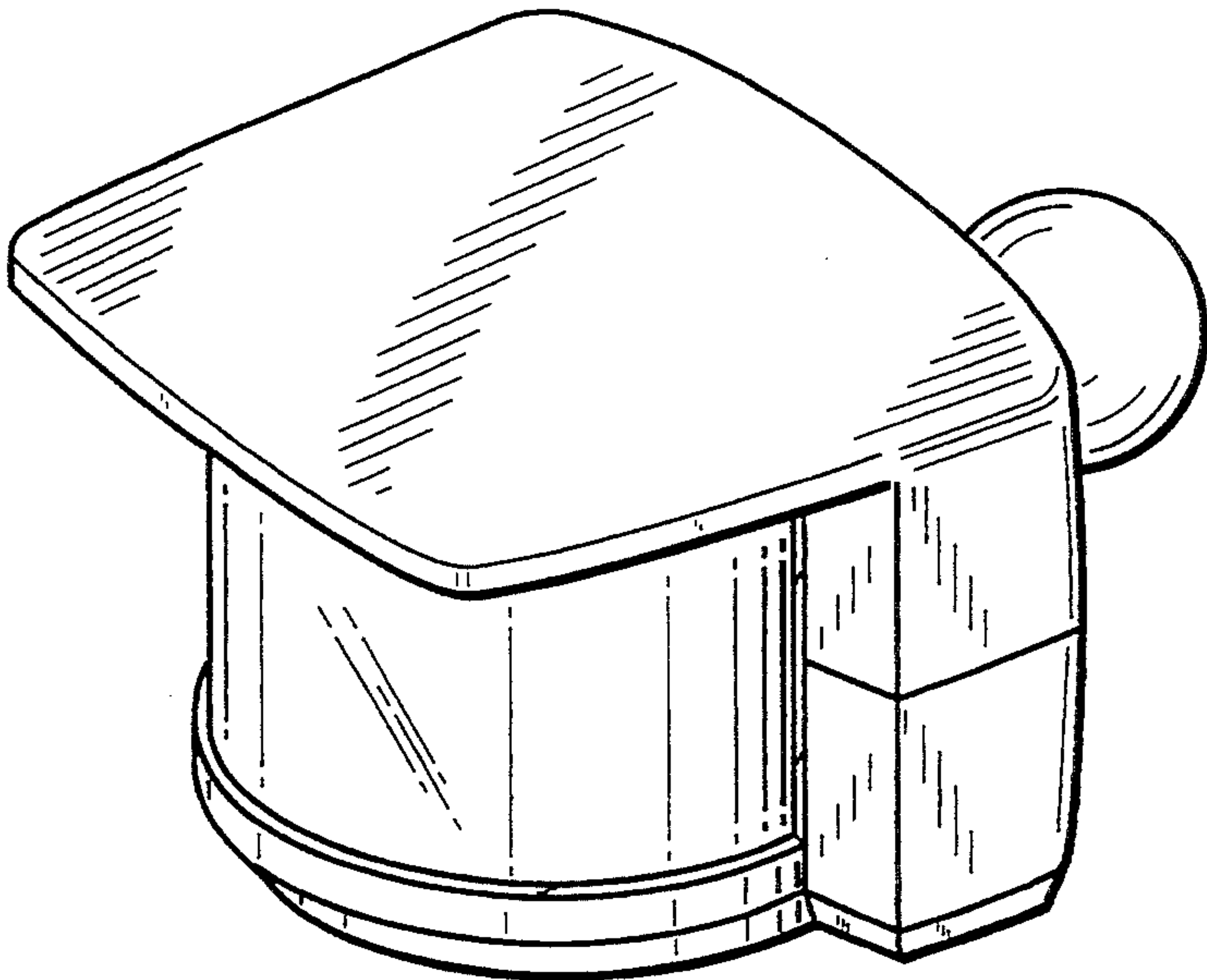

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sensor head for a passive infrared motion detector showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



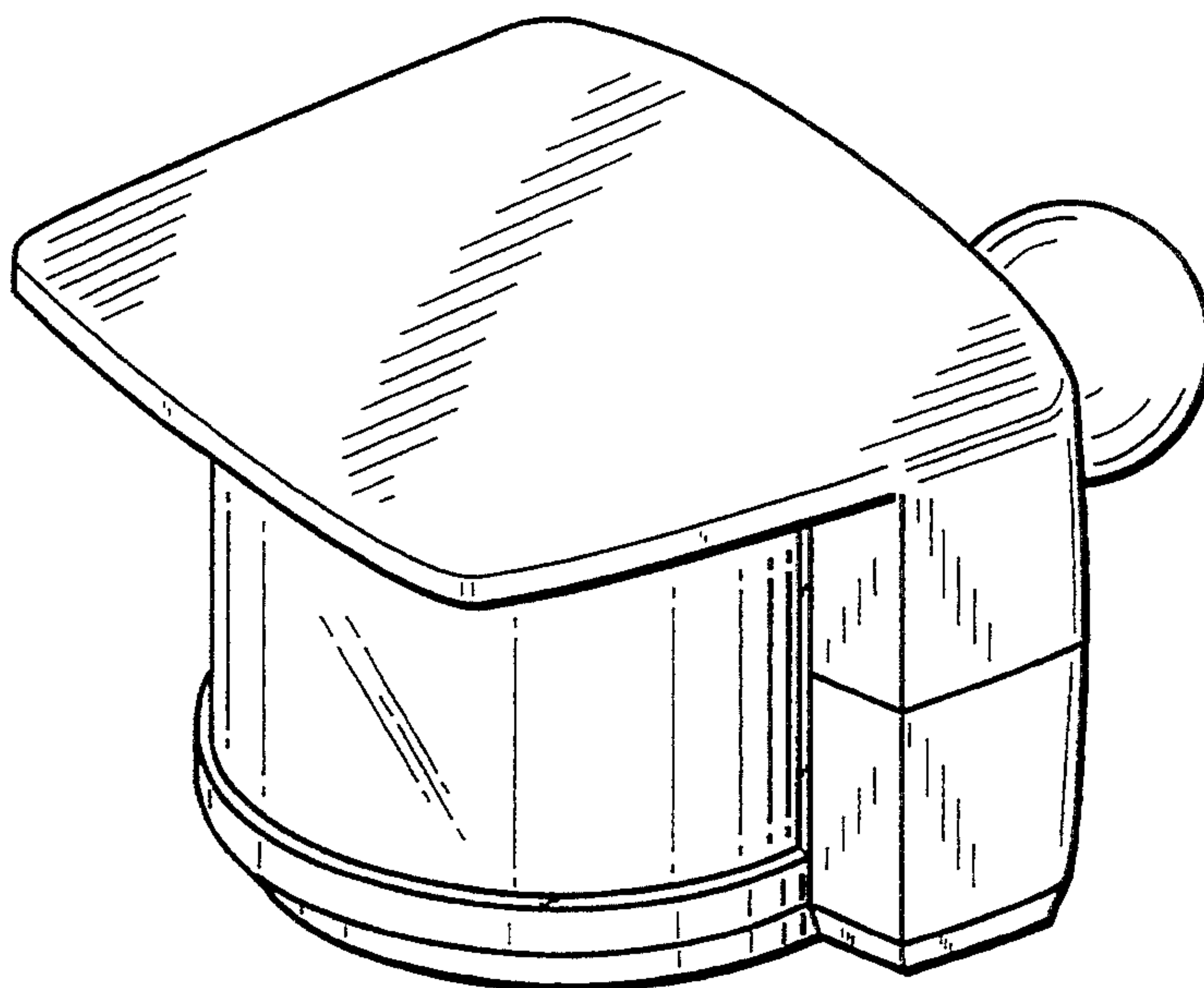

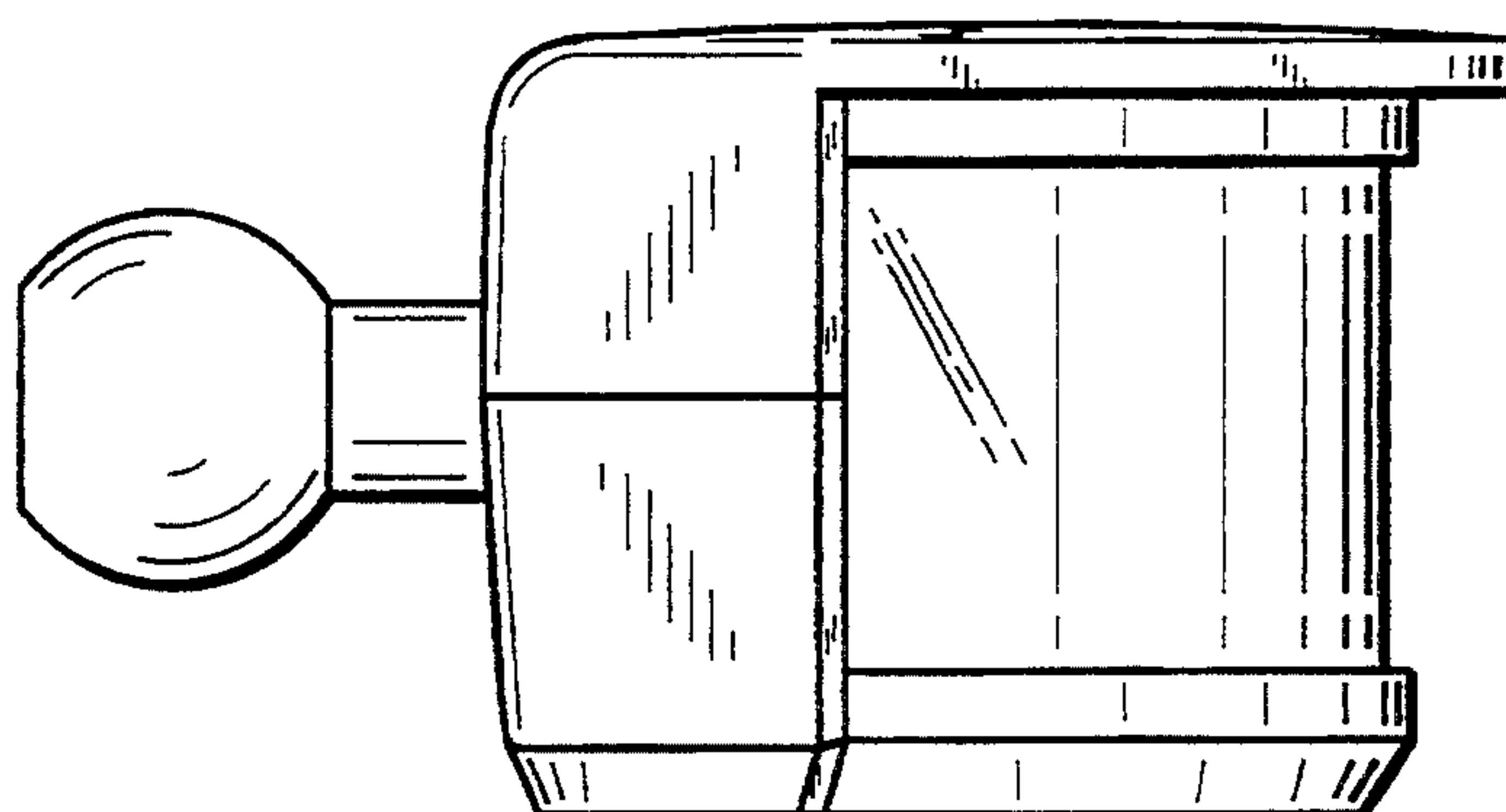

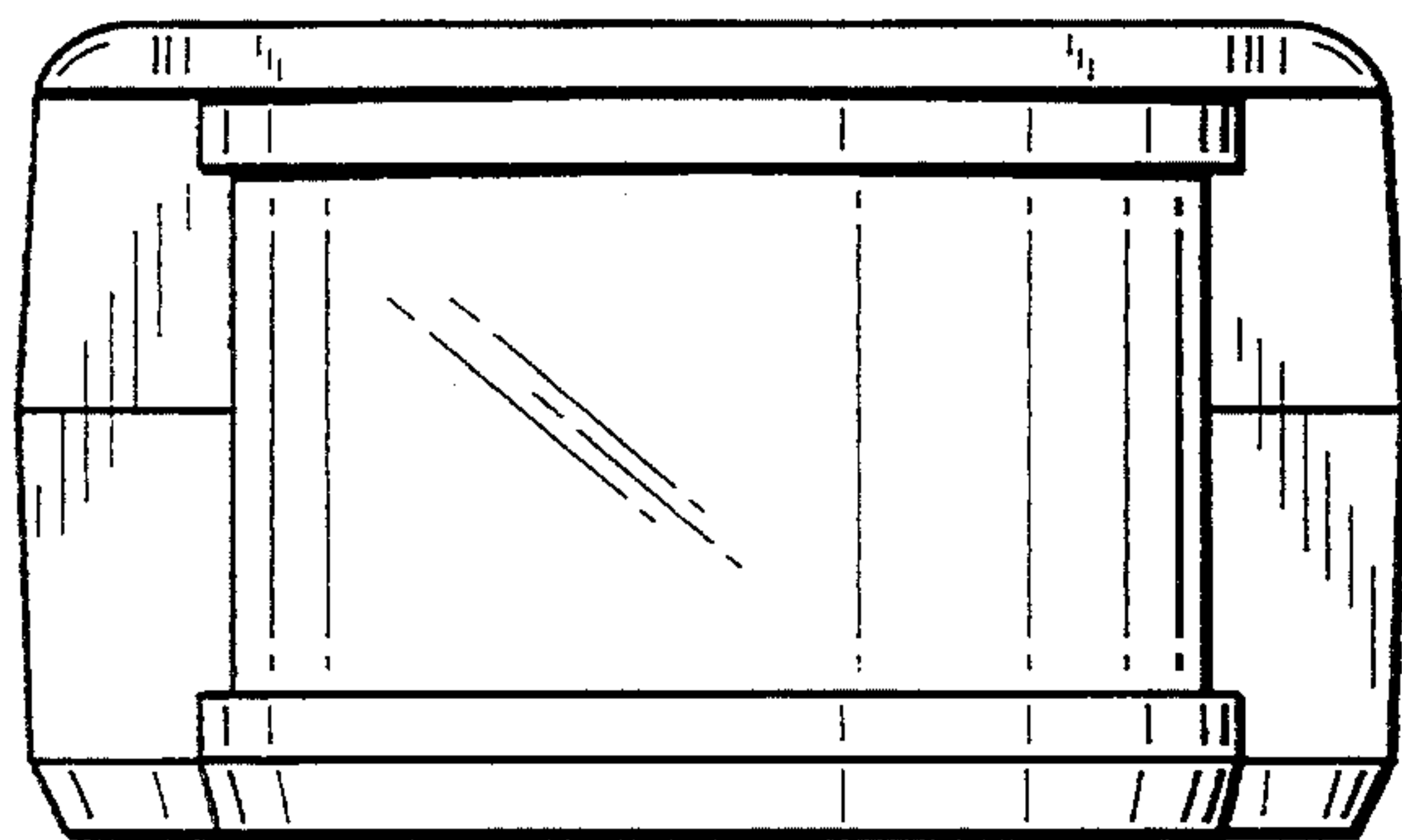

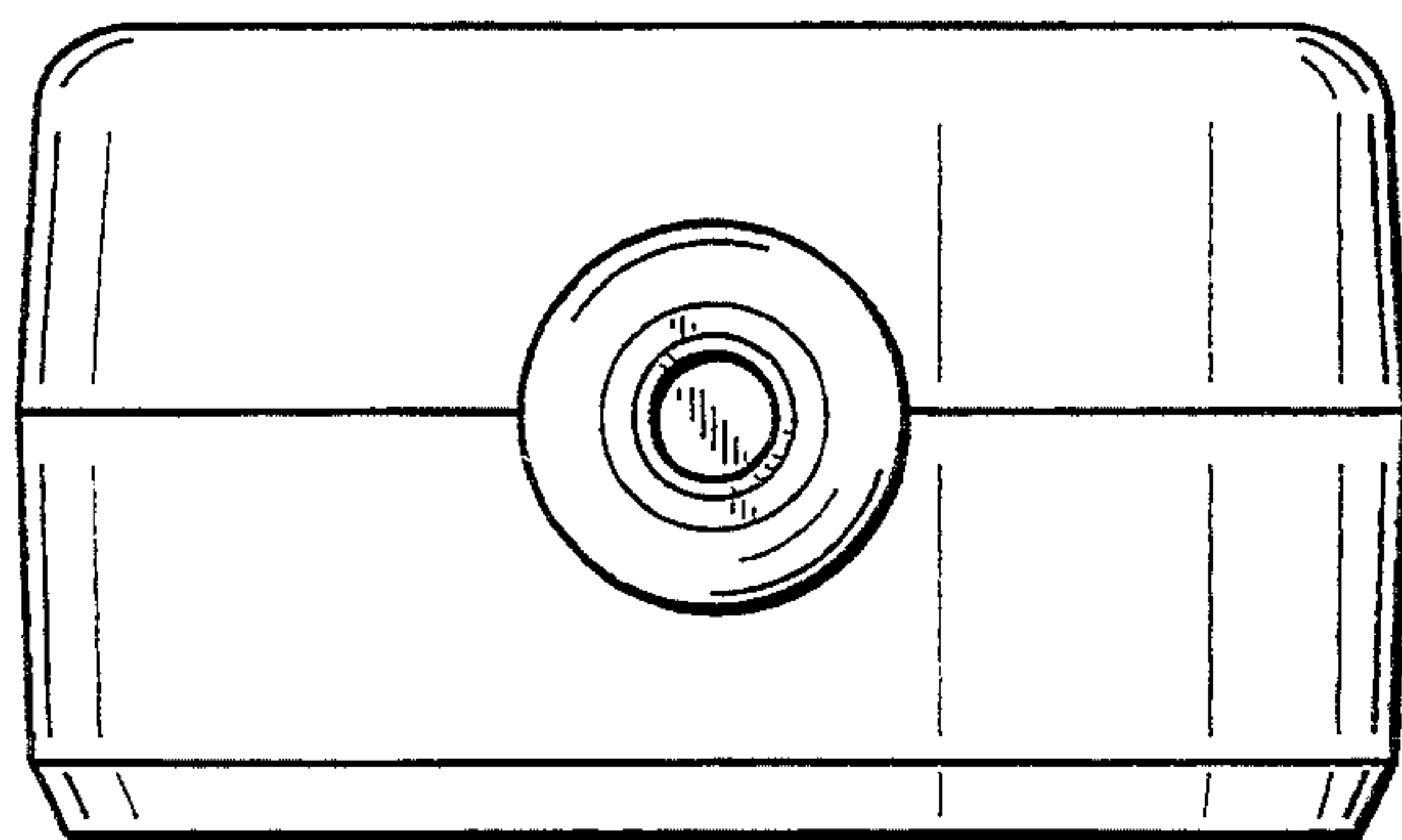

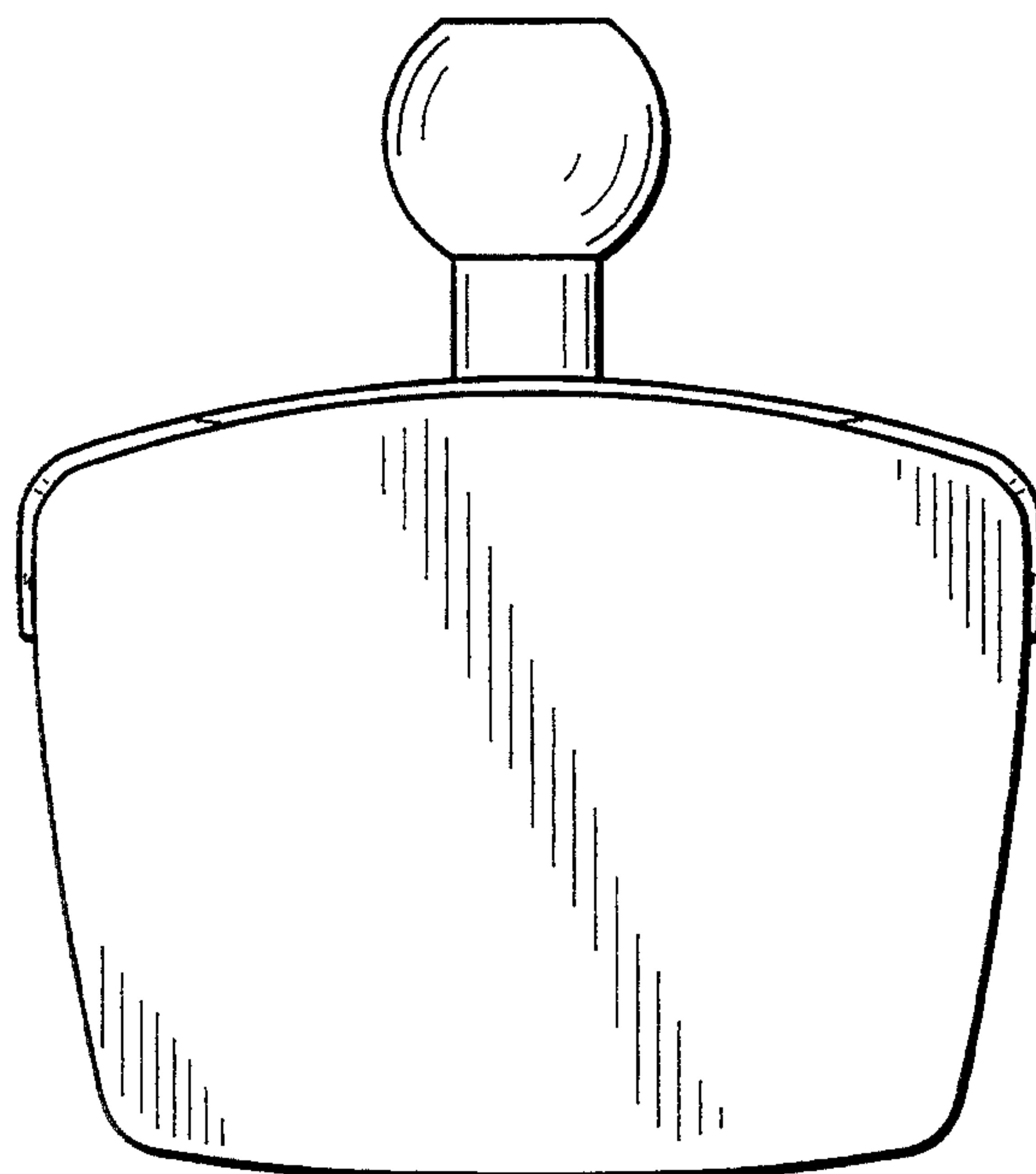

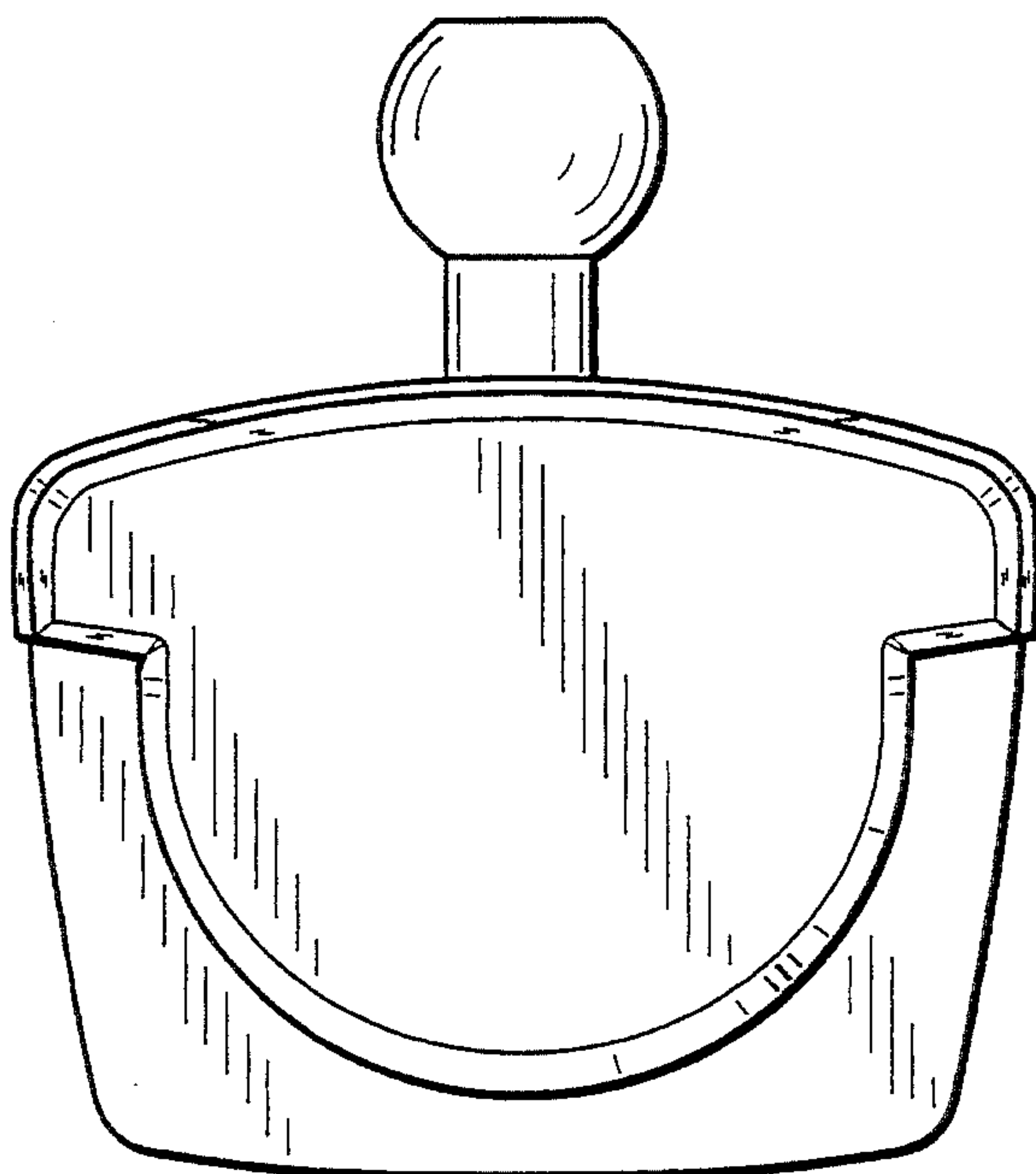
