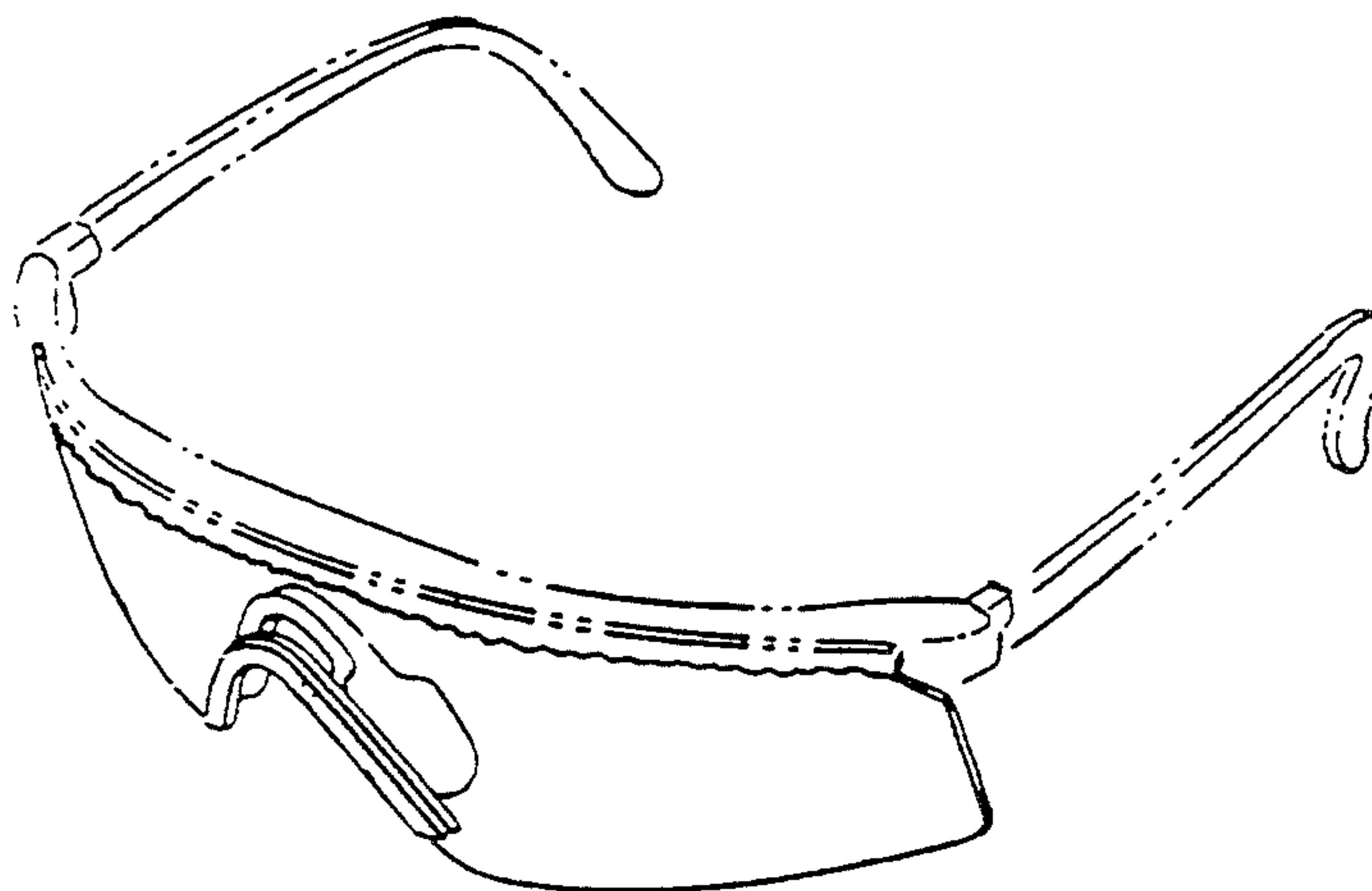

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of an eyeglass lens, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an eyeglass lens showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line disclosure of a top to the lens in FIGS. 1-6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



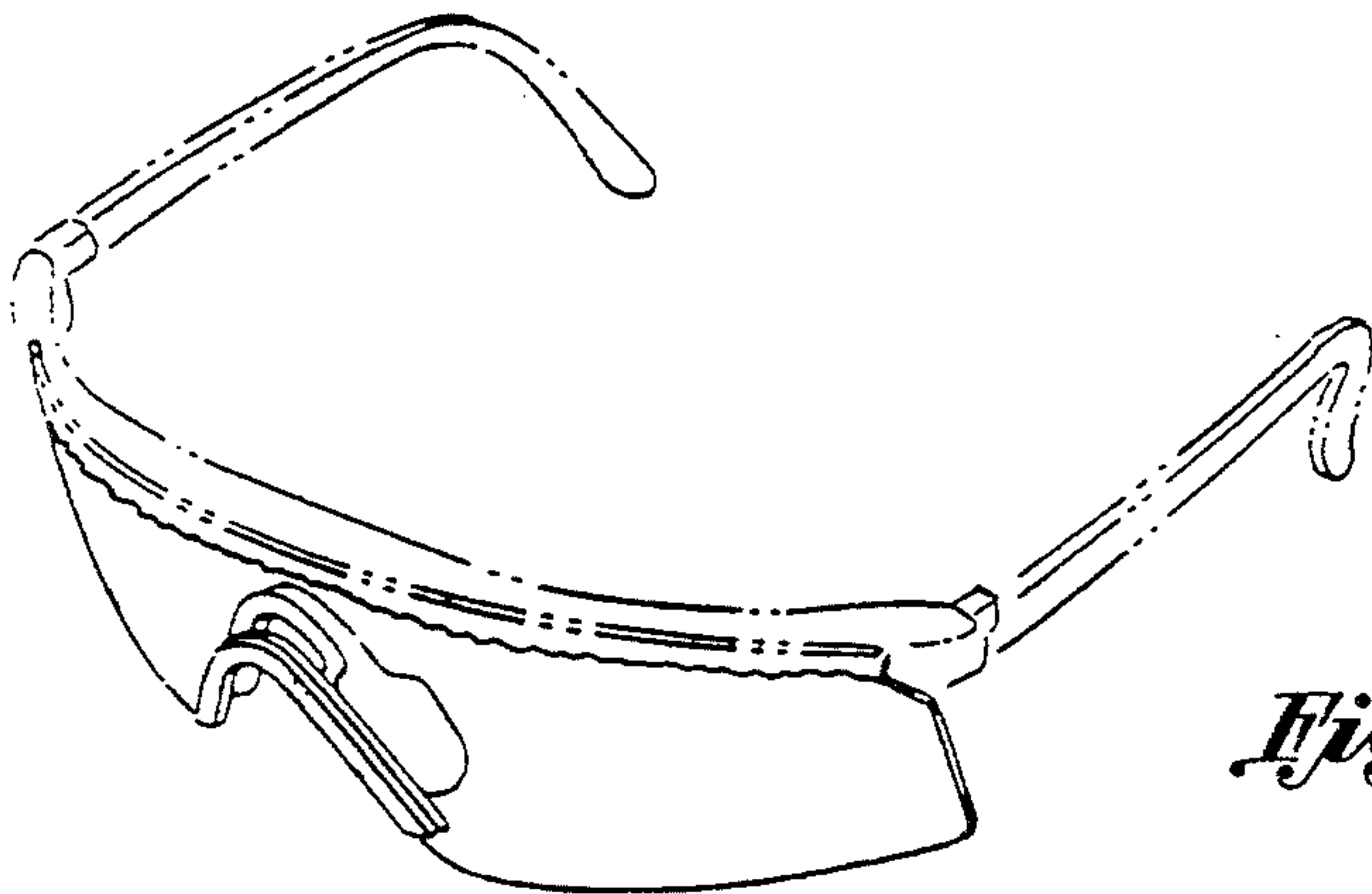

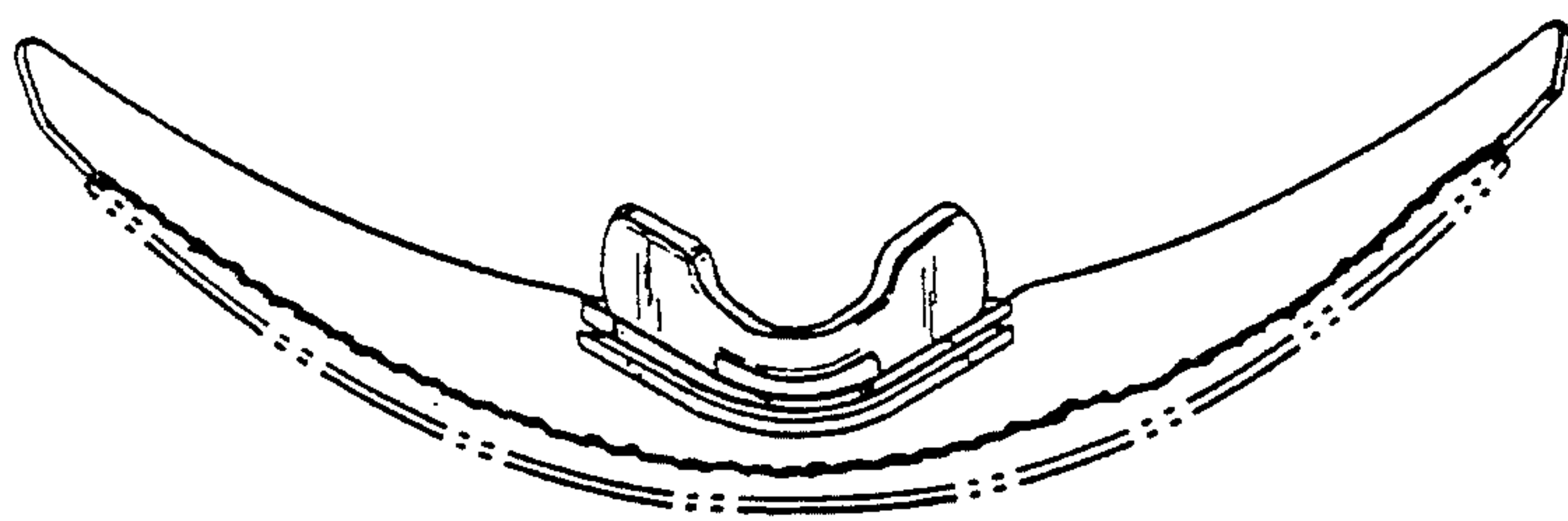

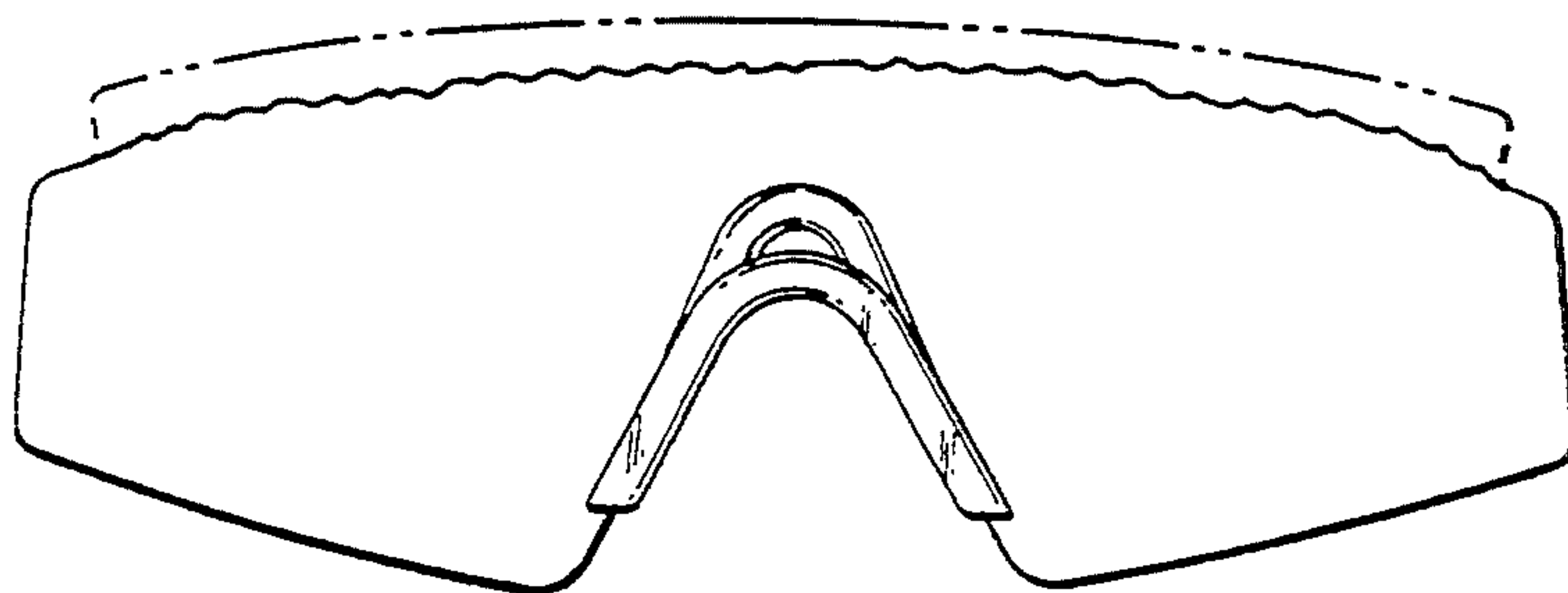

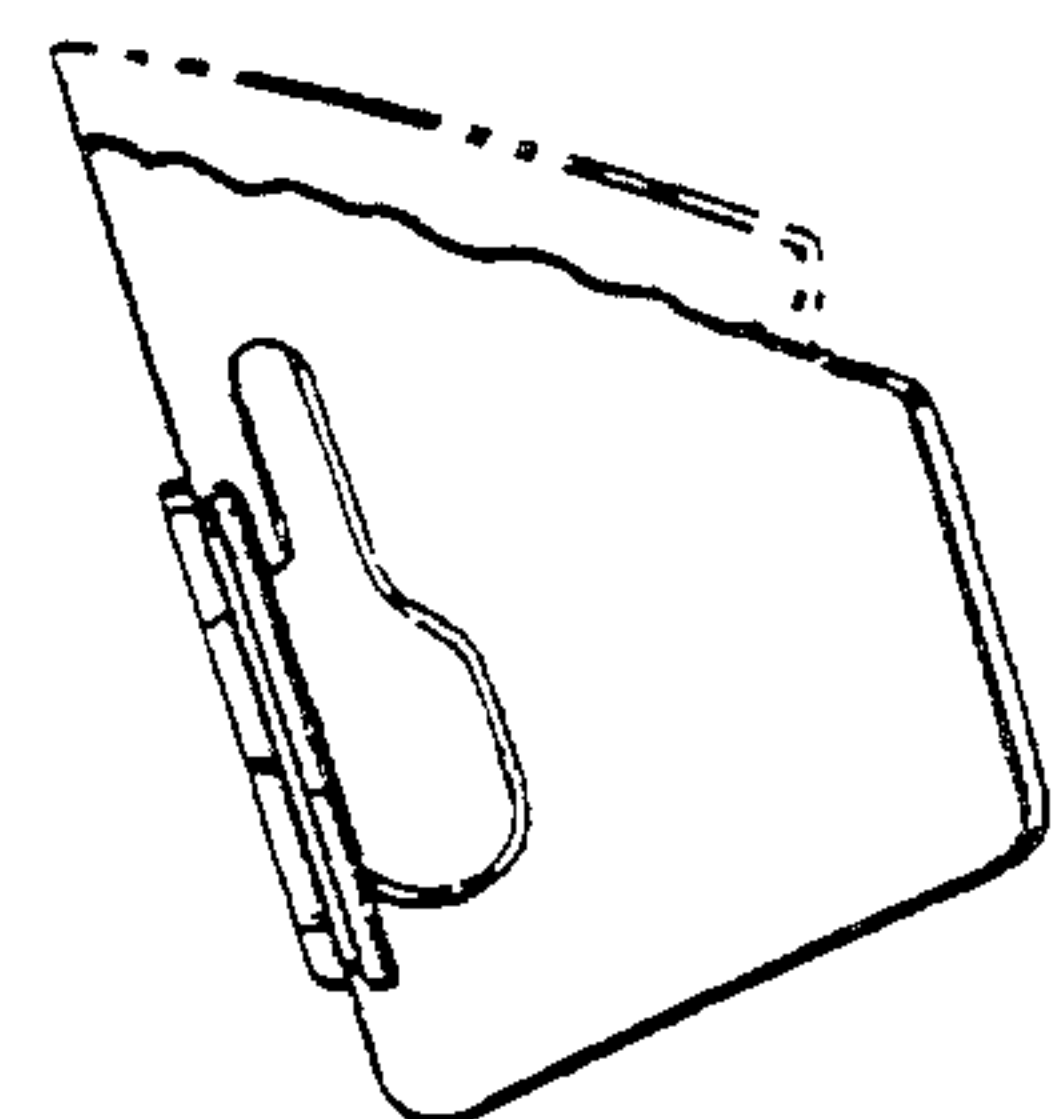

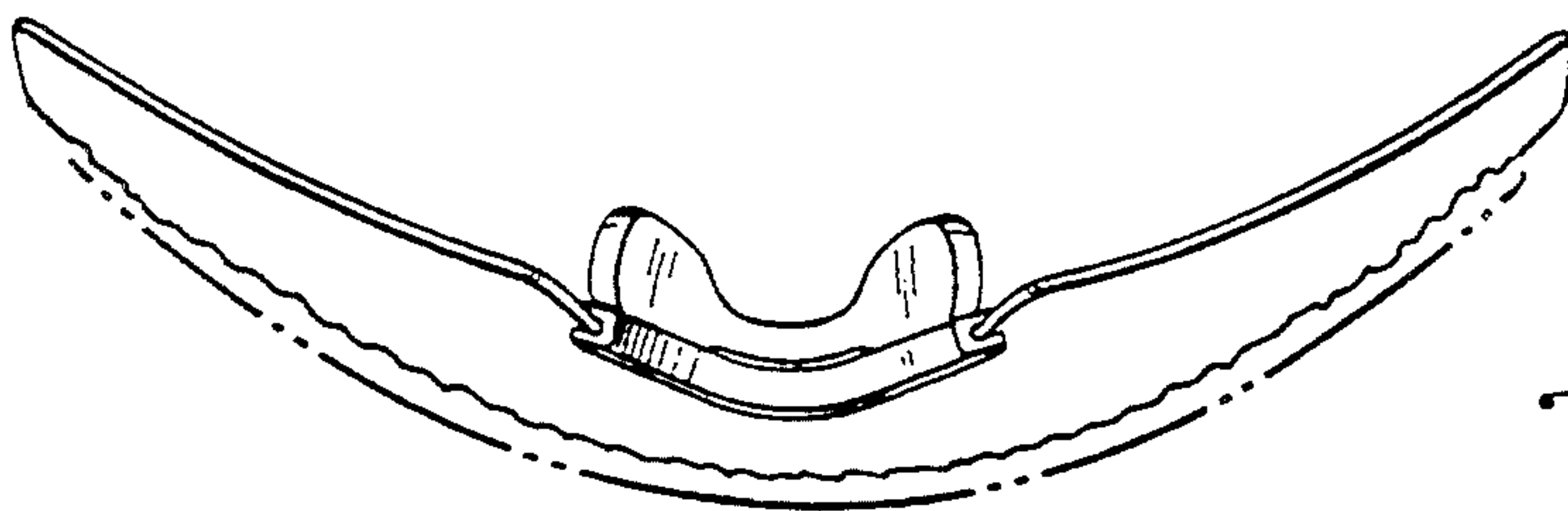

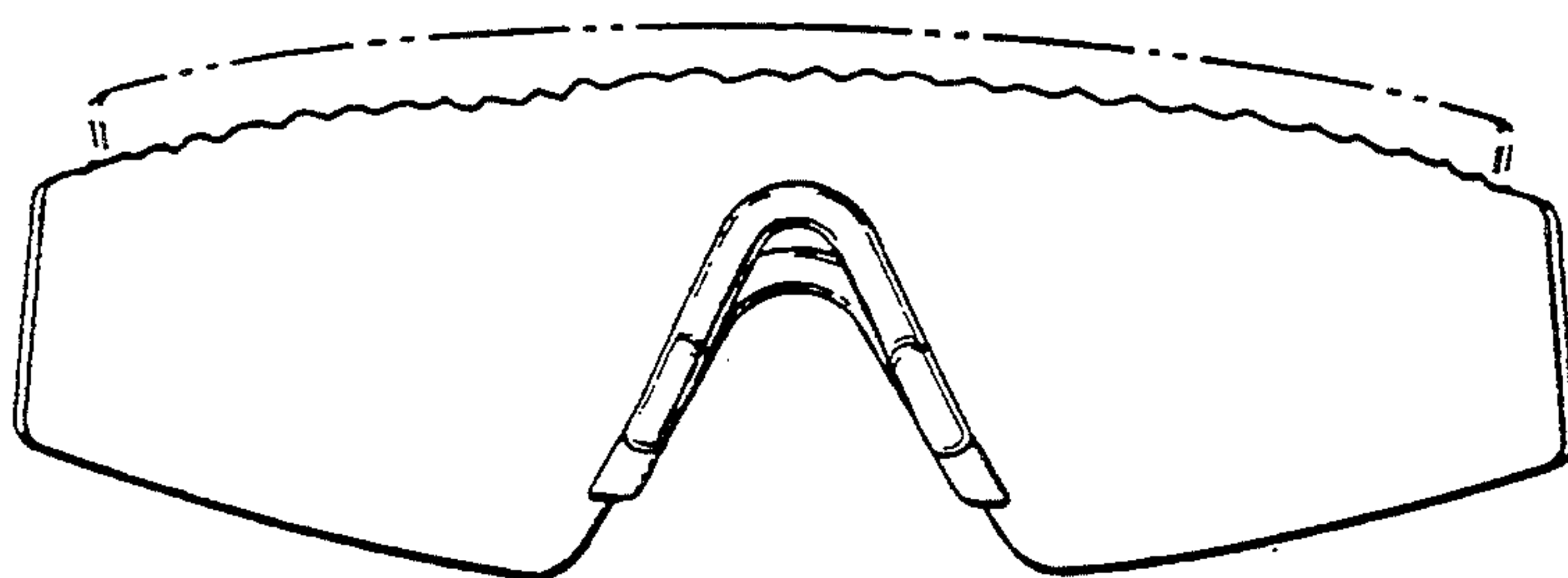
