CLAIM

The ornamental design for a golf putterhead, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a golf putterhead showing my new design and showing a shaft attached to the putterhead in dotted lines;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the putterhead;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation of the putterhead;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is an elevation view of the toe taken along the line 5-5 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is an elevation view of the heel taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of the golf putterhead with the shaft shown in dotted lines;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the golf putterhead;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a front elevation of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a toe end elevation view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 14 is a heel end elevation view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 15 is a rear elevation taken along the line 15—15 of FIG. 14;

FIG. 16 is an enlarged front perspective view of the putterhead in FIG. 1;

FIG. 17 is an enlarged front perspective view of another embodiment of the putterhead in FIG. 1;

FIG. 18 is an enlarged front perspective view of still another embodiment of the putterhead in FIG. 1;

FIG. 19 is an enlarged front perspective view of the putterhead in FIG. 9;

FIG. 20 is an enlarged front perspective view of another embodiment of the putterhead in FIG. 9;

FIG. 21 is an enlarged front perspective view of still another embodiment of the putterhead in FIG. 9;

FIG. 22 is the same view of FIG. 16 with the shaft receiving opening in position for a left-handed golfer;

FIG. 23 is the same view of FIG. 17 with the shaft receiving opening in position for a left-handed golfer;

FIG. 24 is the same view of FIG. 18 with the shaft receiving opening in position for a left-handed golfer; FIG. 25 is the same view of FIG. 19 with the shaft

receiving opening in position for a left-handed golfer; FIG. 26 is the same view of FIG. 20 with the shaft

receiving opening in position for a left-handed golfer; FIG. 27 is the same view of FIG. 21 with the shaft receiving opening in position for a left-handed golfer;

FIG. 29 is a front elevation view of FIG. 28 with as shaft show in dotted lines;

FIG. 30 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 29;


FIG. 31 is a top plan view of FIG. 25;

FIG. 28 is a top plan view of FIG. 22;


FIG. 32 is a front elevation view of FIG. 31 with a shaft show in dotted lines; and,










































