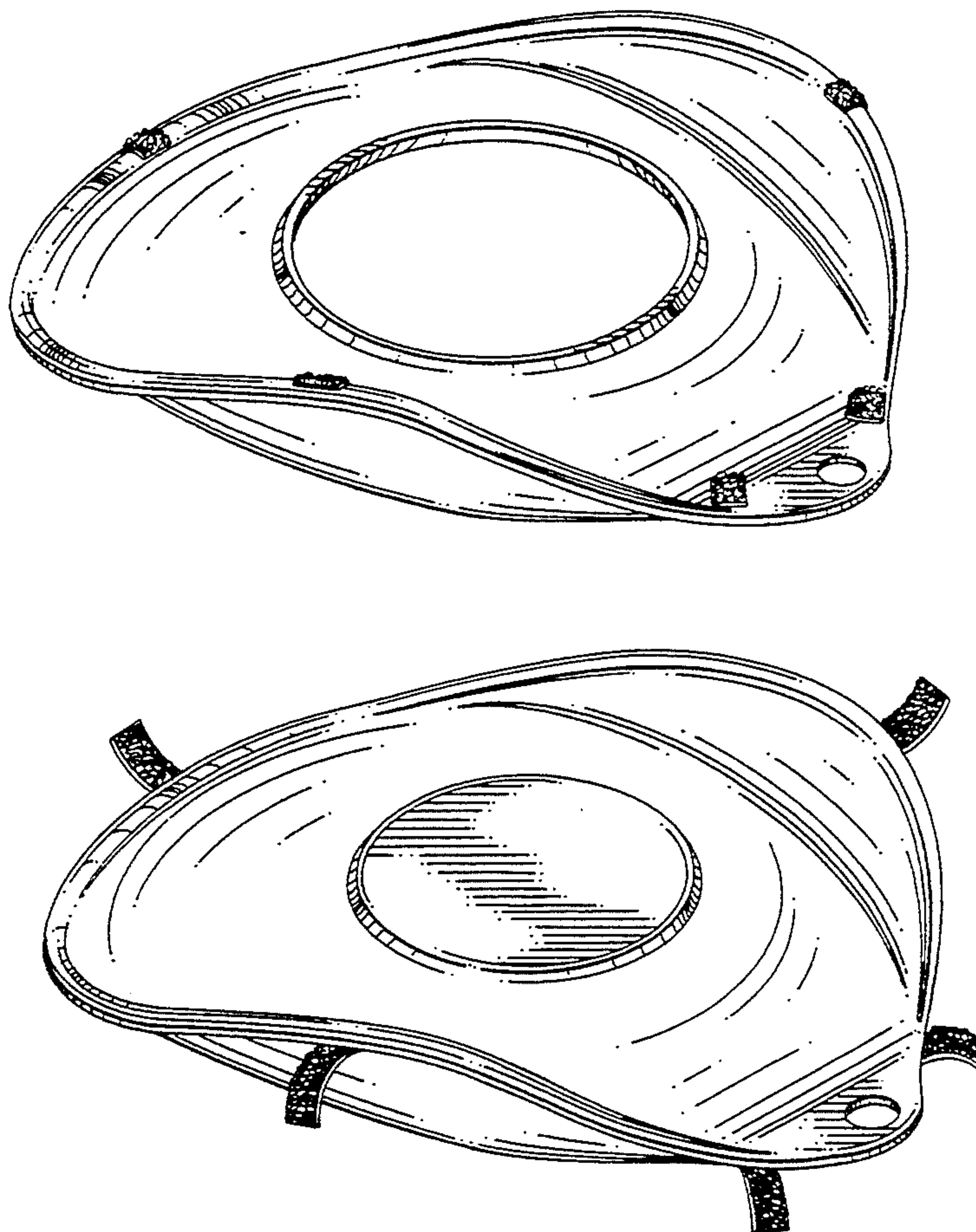

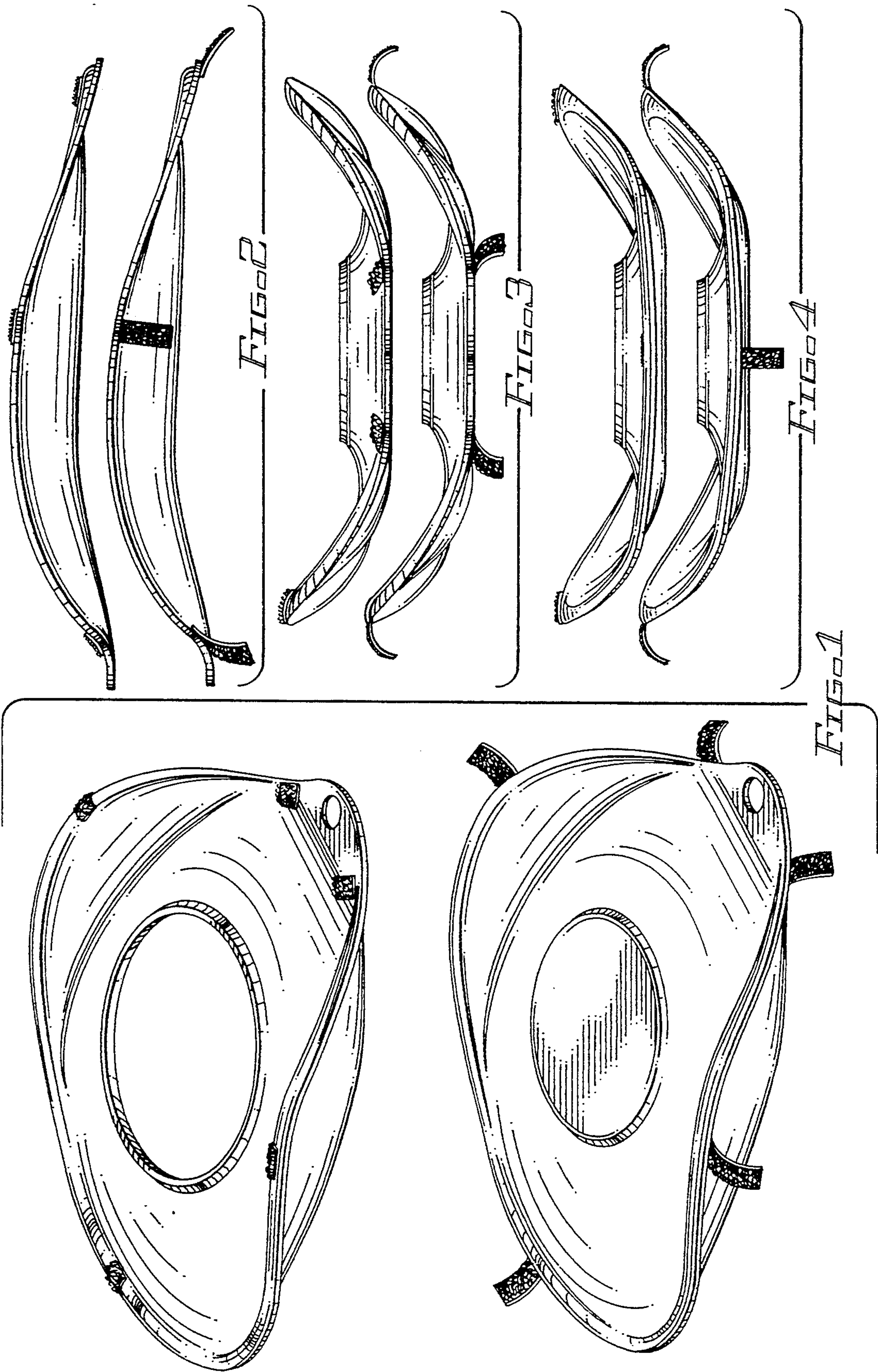
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a two part hat shaper, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above of a two part
hat shaper showing my new design in an exploded view;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the two part hat
shaper in a disassembled state, the right side elevational
view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the two part hat
shaper in a disassembled state;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the two part hat
shaper in a disassembled state;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the upper part of the two
part hat shaper, shown separately for purposes of illus-
tration;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the lower part of the two
part hat shaper, shown separately for purposes of illus-
tration;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the upper part of the
two part hat shaper, shown separately for purposes of
illustration; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the lower part of the
two part hat shaper, shown separately for purposes of
illustration.





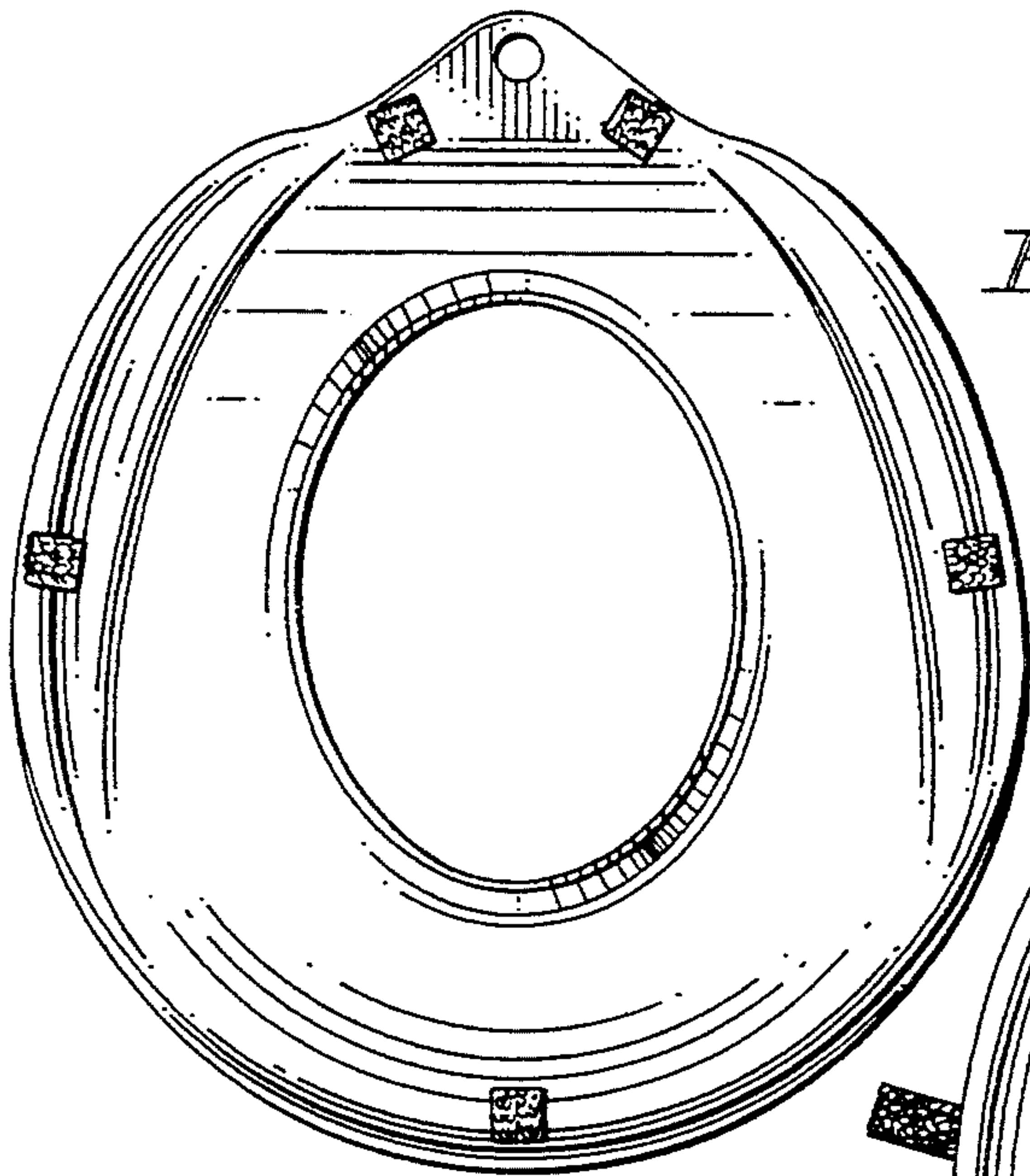

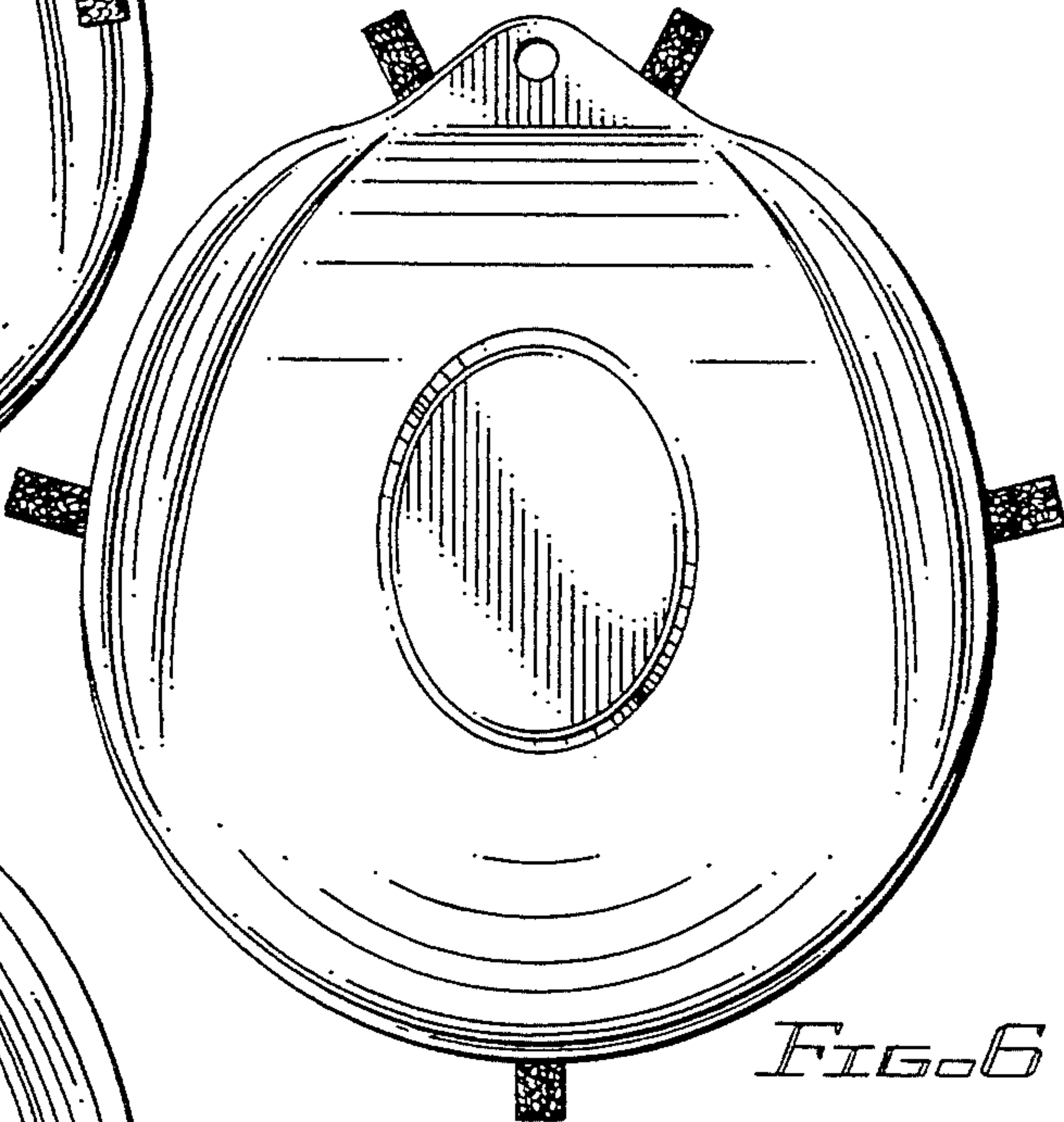

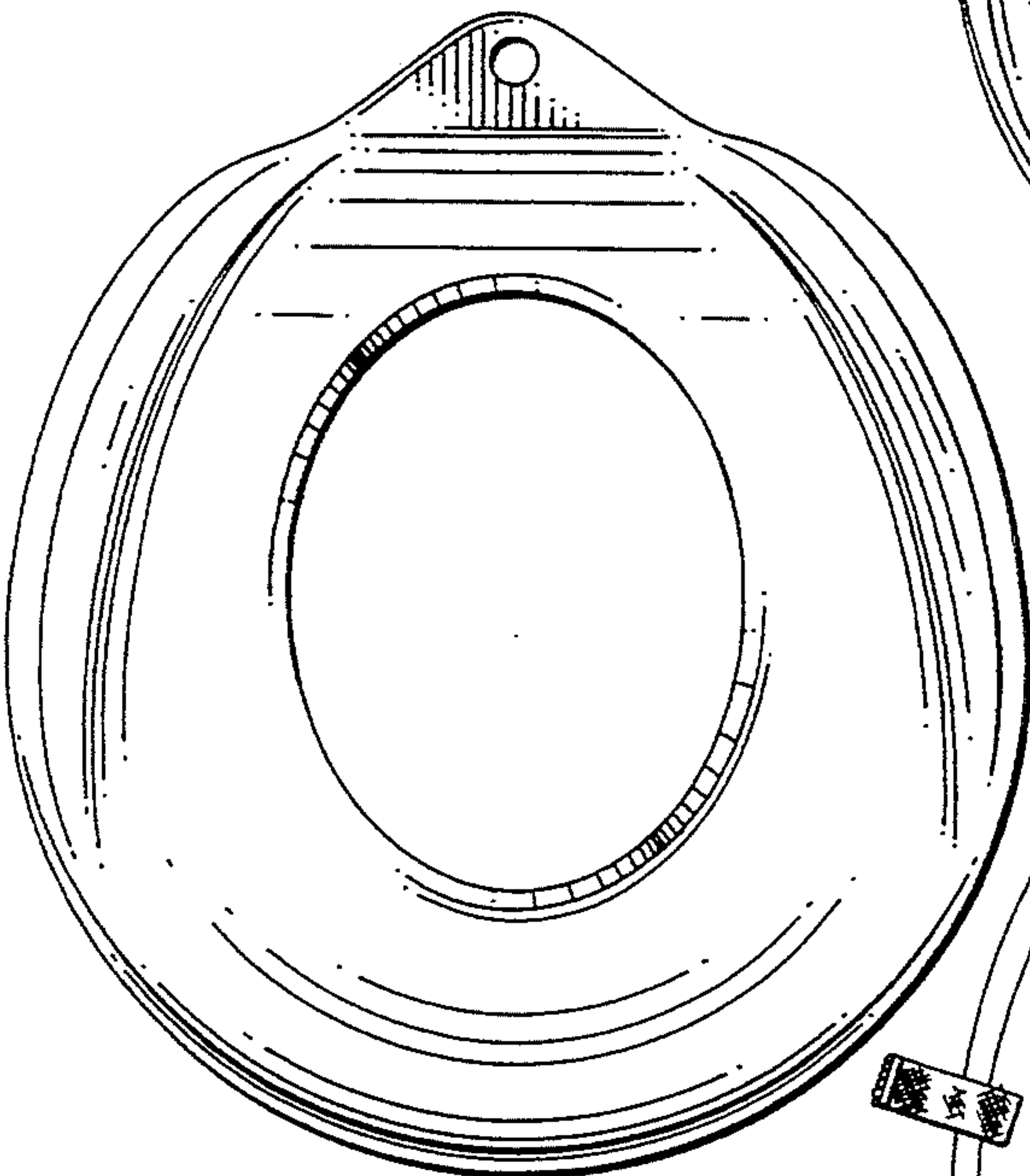

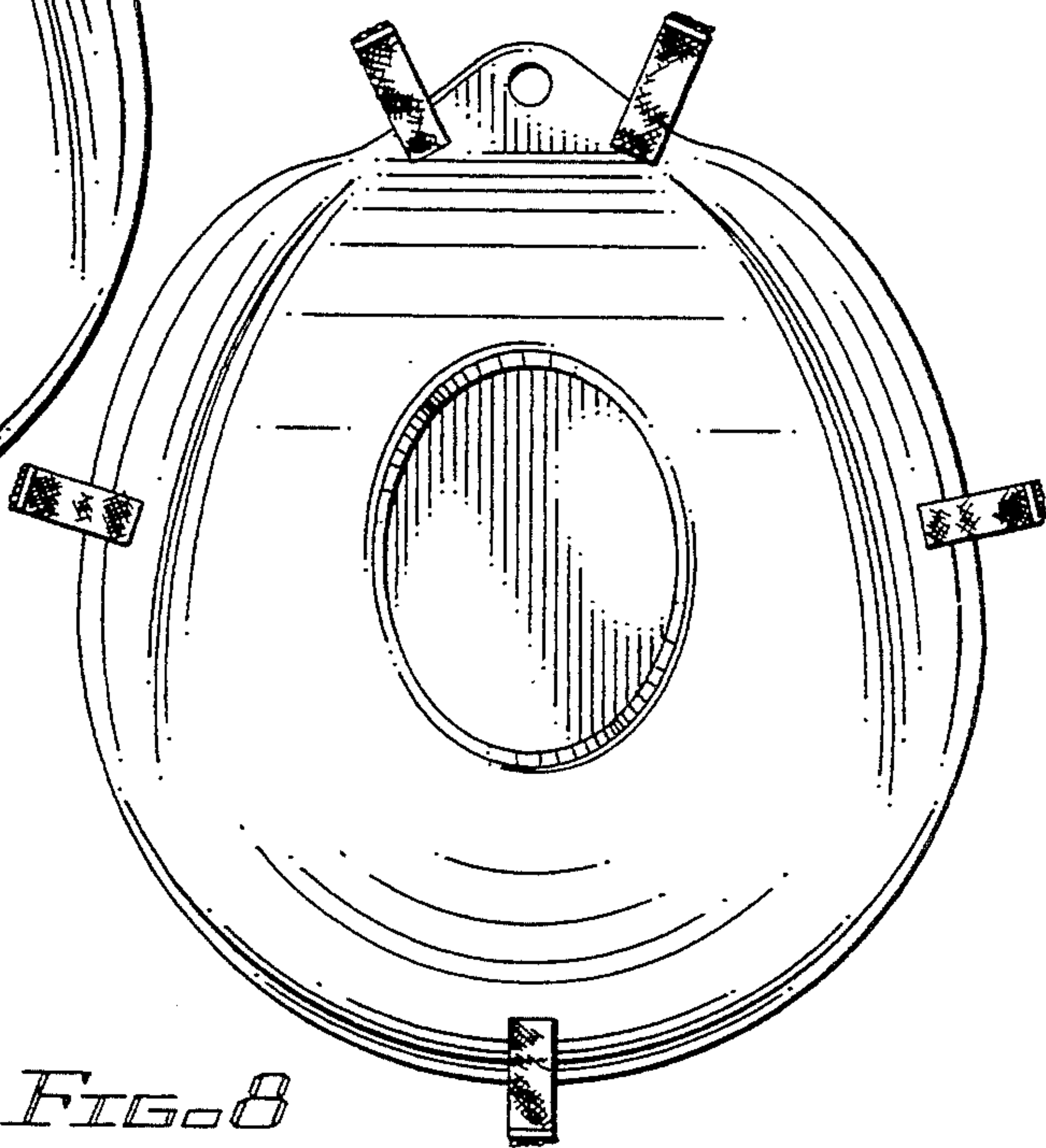
