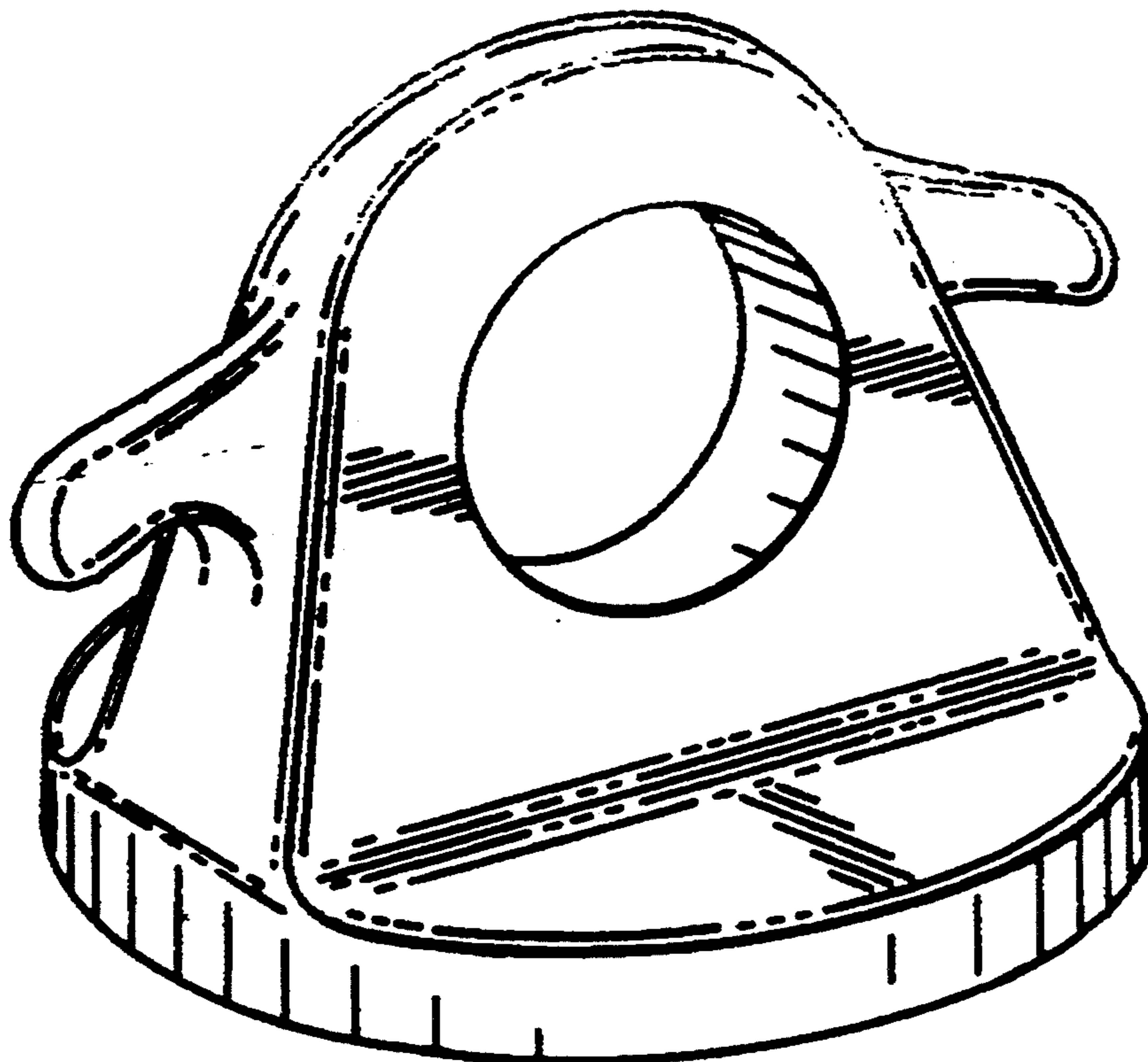

The ornamental design for a tie down eyelet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a sectional view taken along the line 1—1 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.



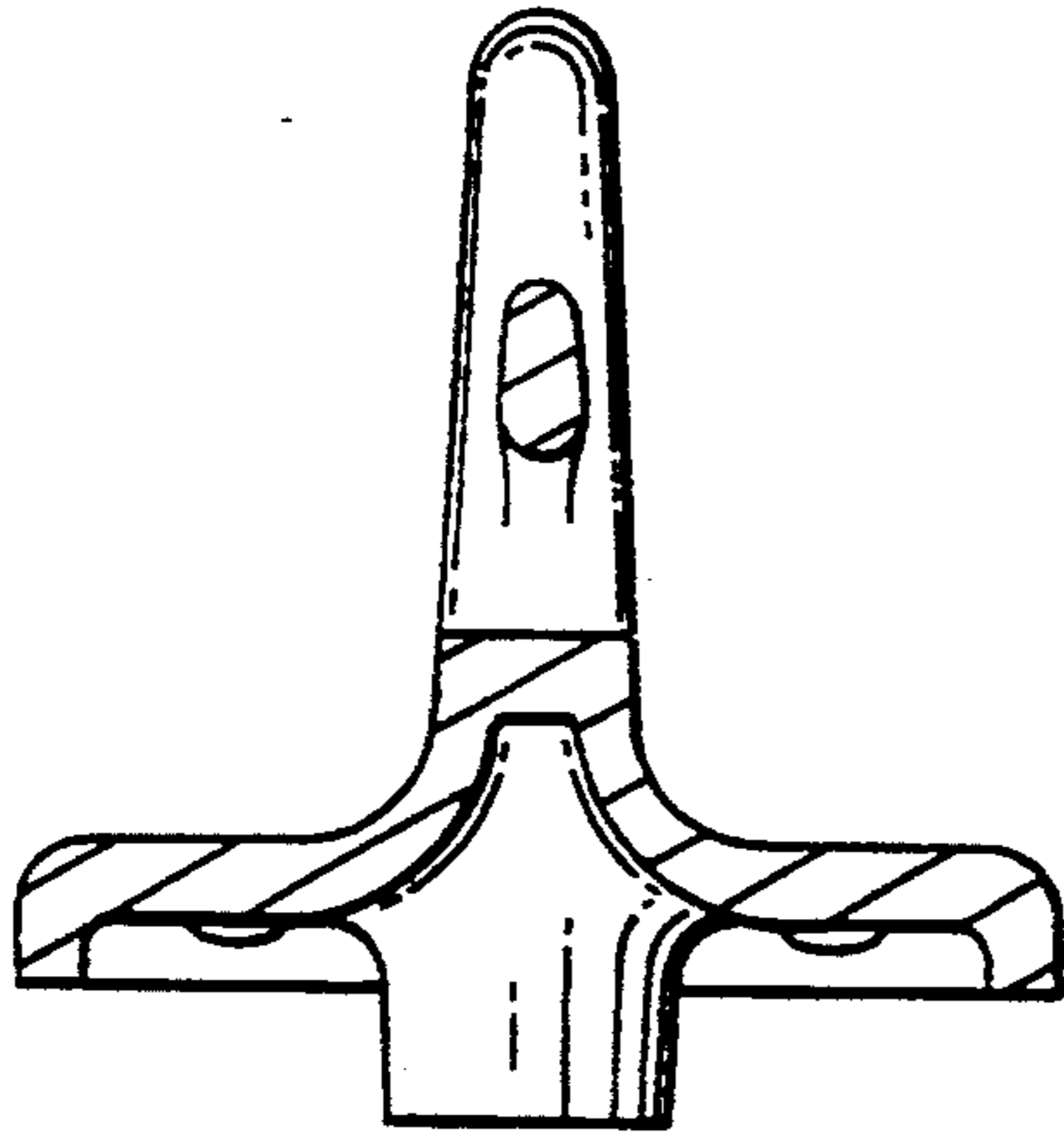

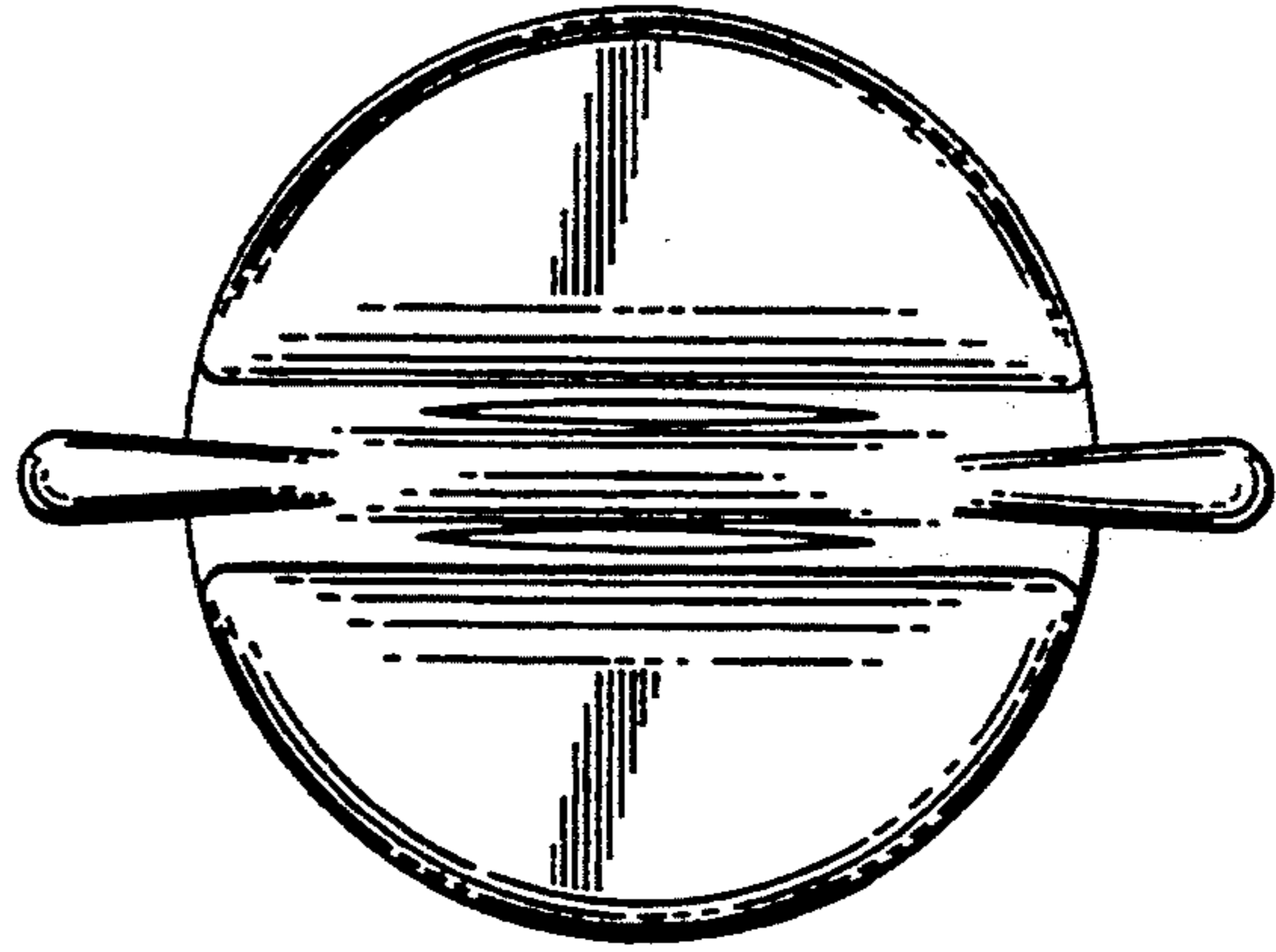

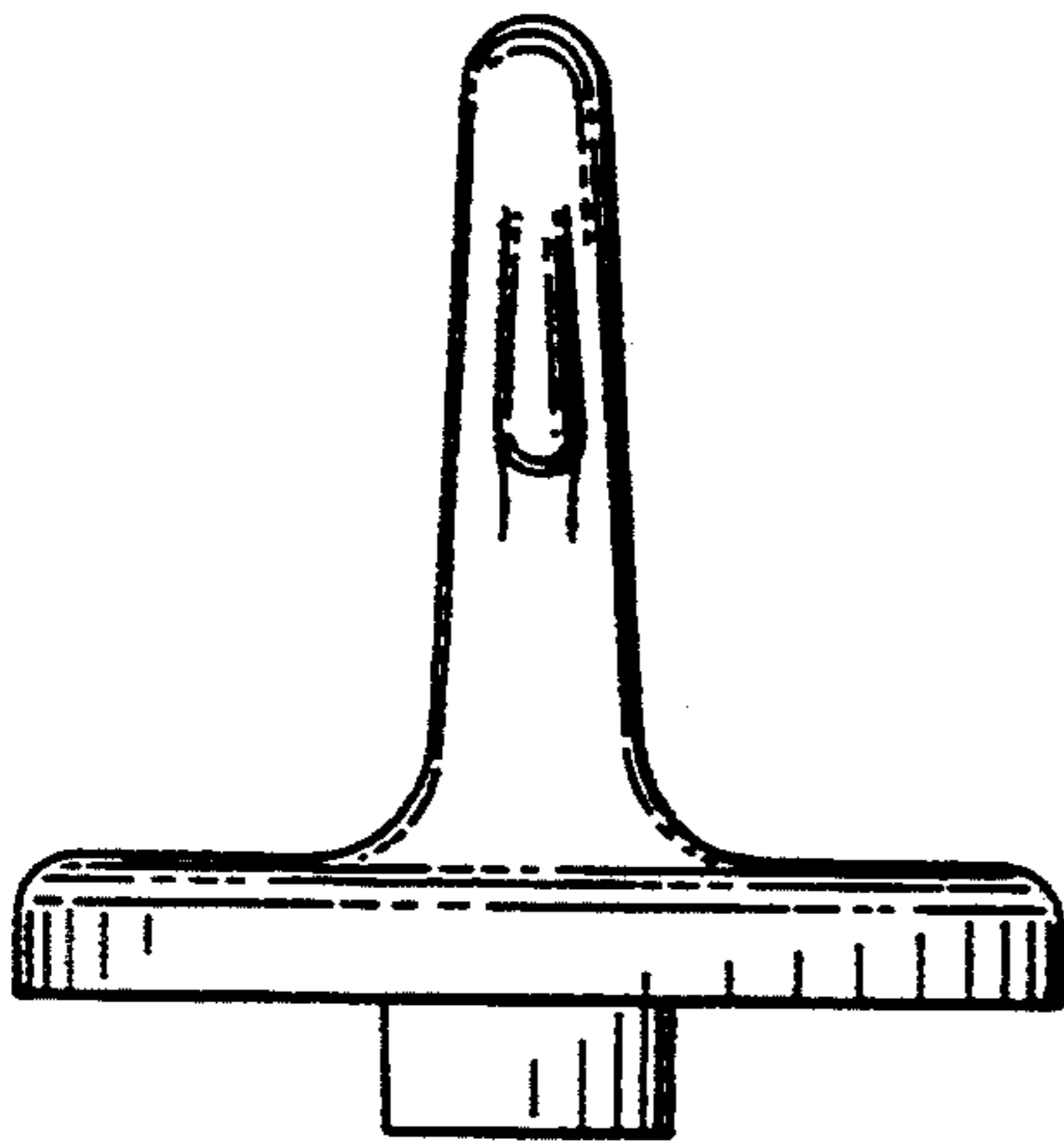

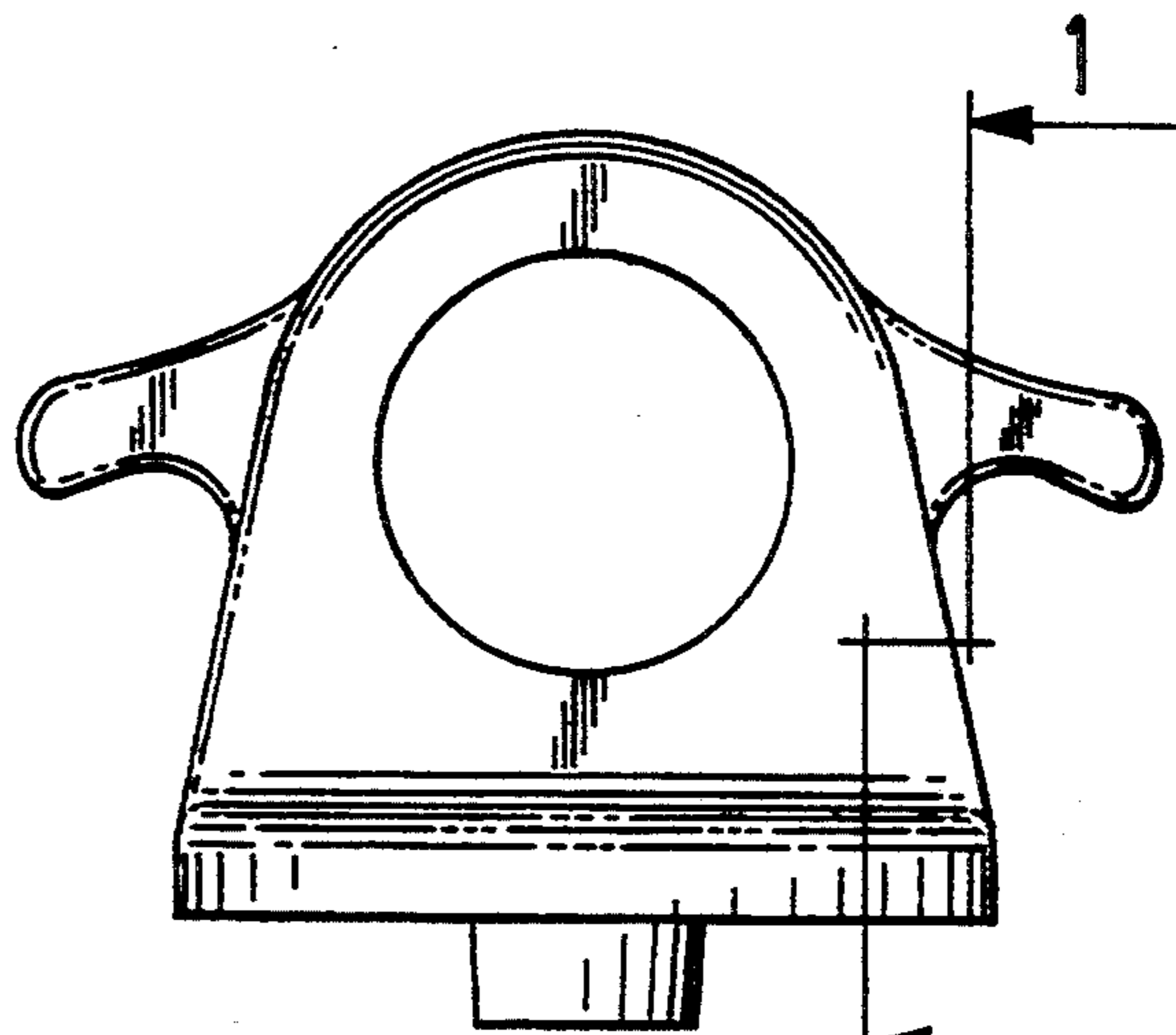

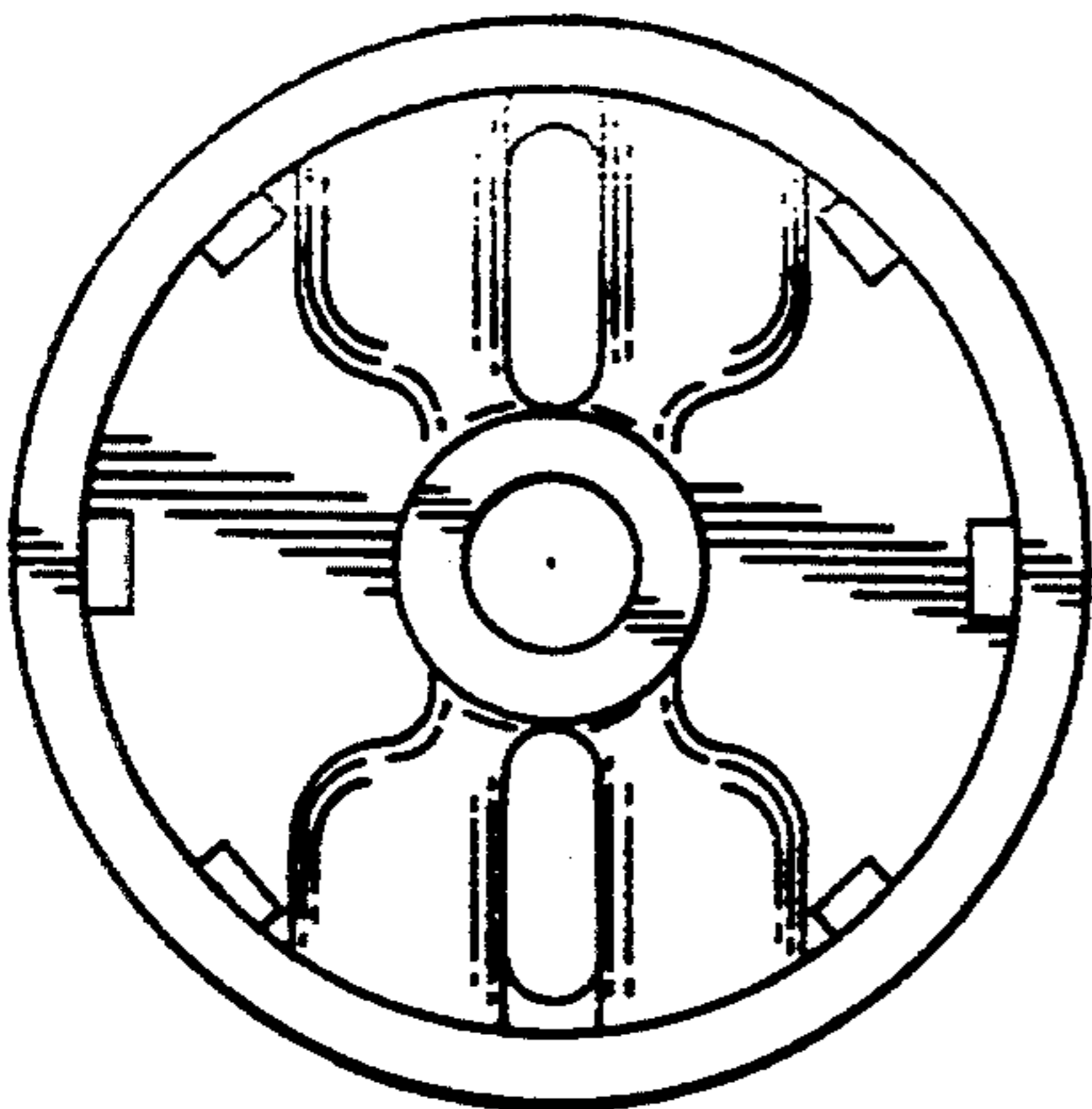

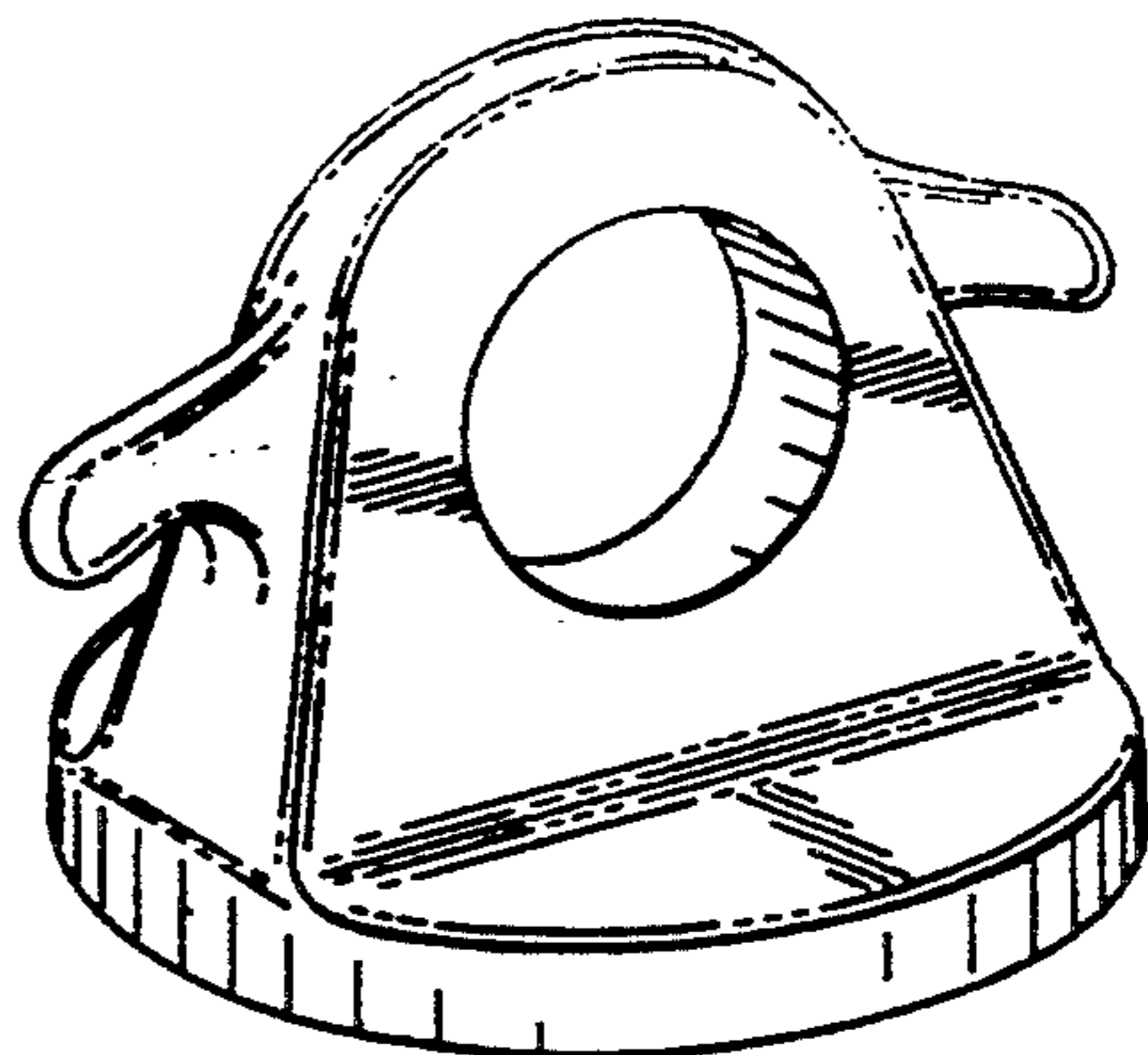
