FIG. 4 is a top, plan view showing my design, the bottom being plain and unadorned;
FIG. 5 is a perspective, rear, right side view of the design;
FIG. 6 is a perspective, left and front view of the design;
FIG. 7 is a left side view of a modification of the design illustrating the portable toilet cabana with an exterior water tank; the right side is a mirror image of the left side;
