DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the bunk bed for dogs showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

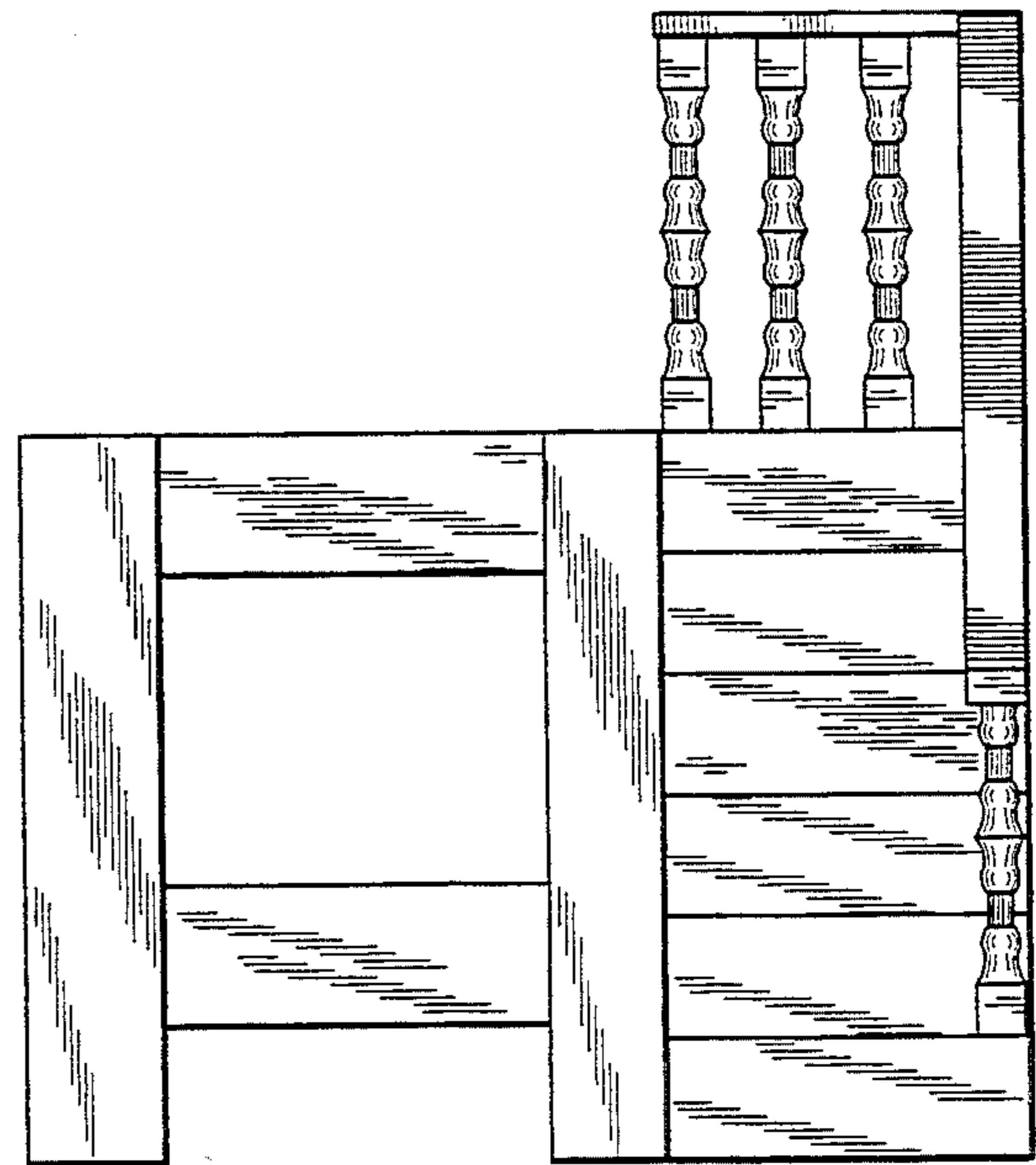
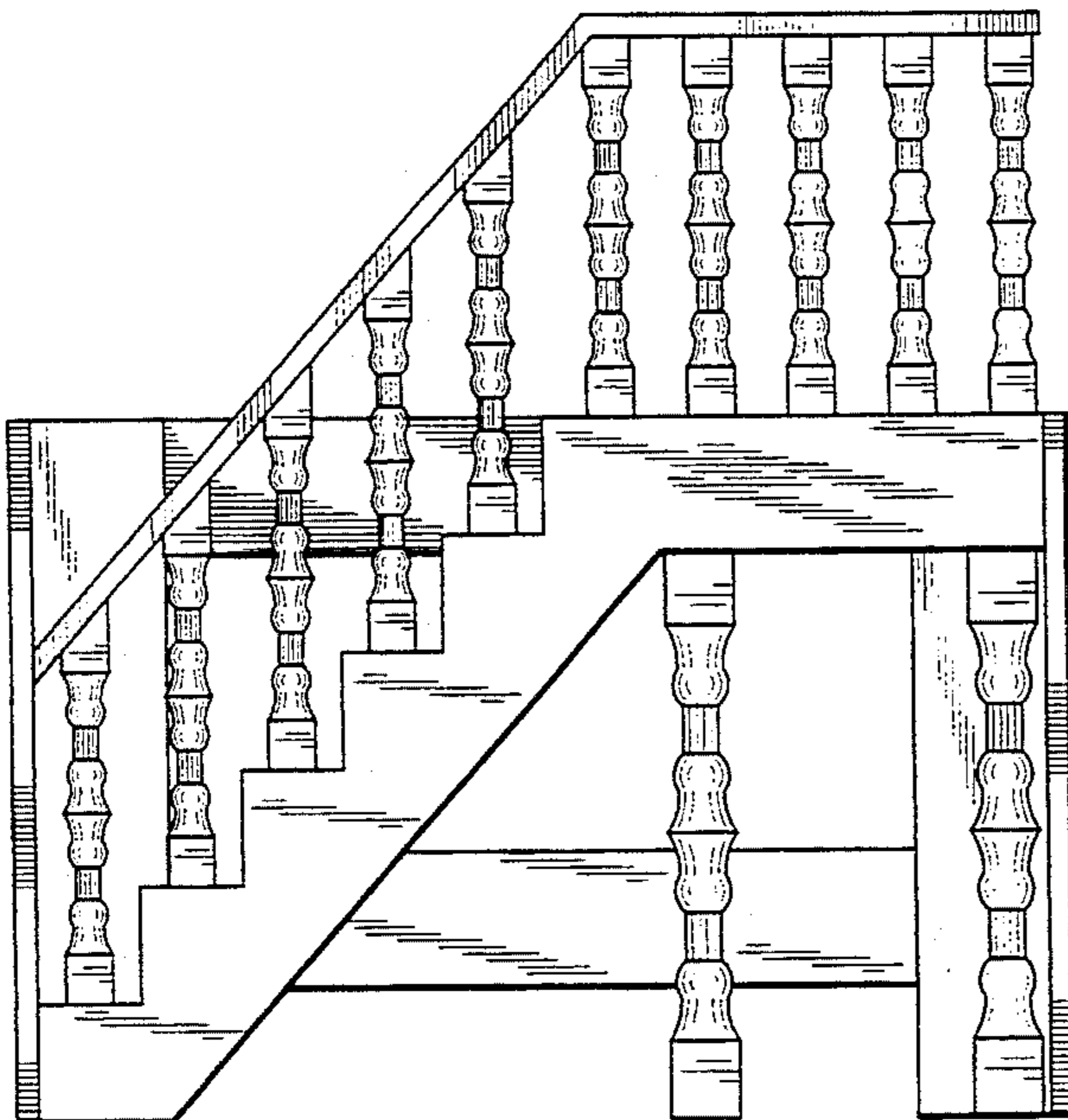

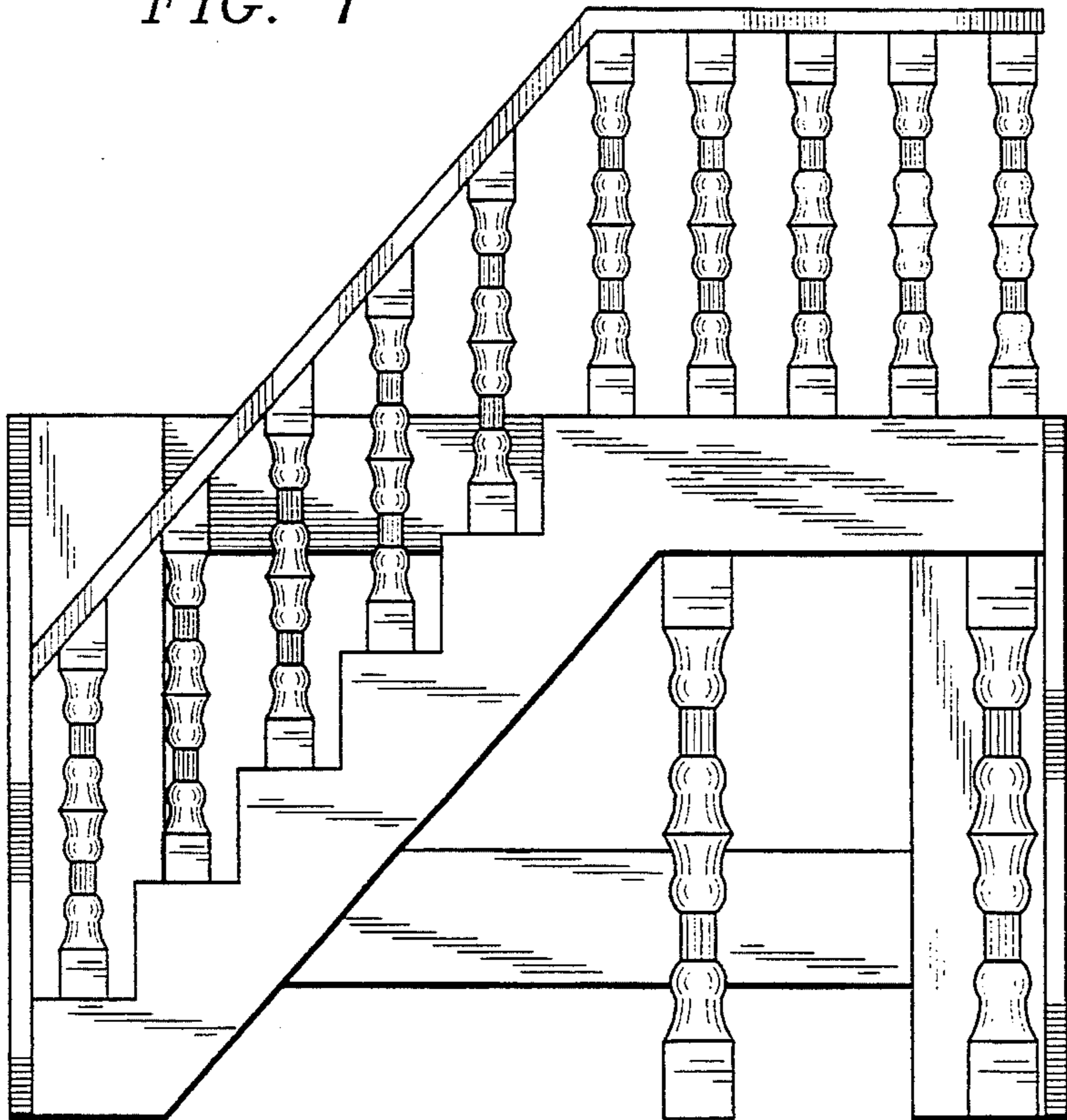

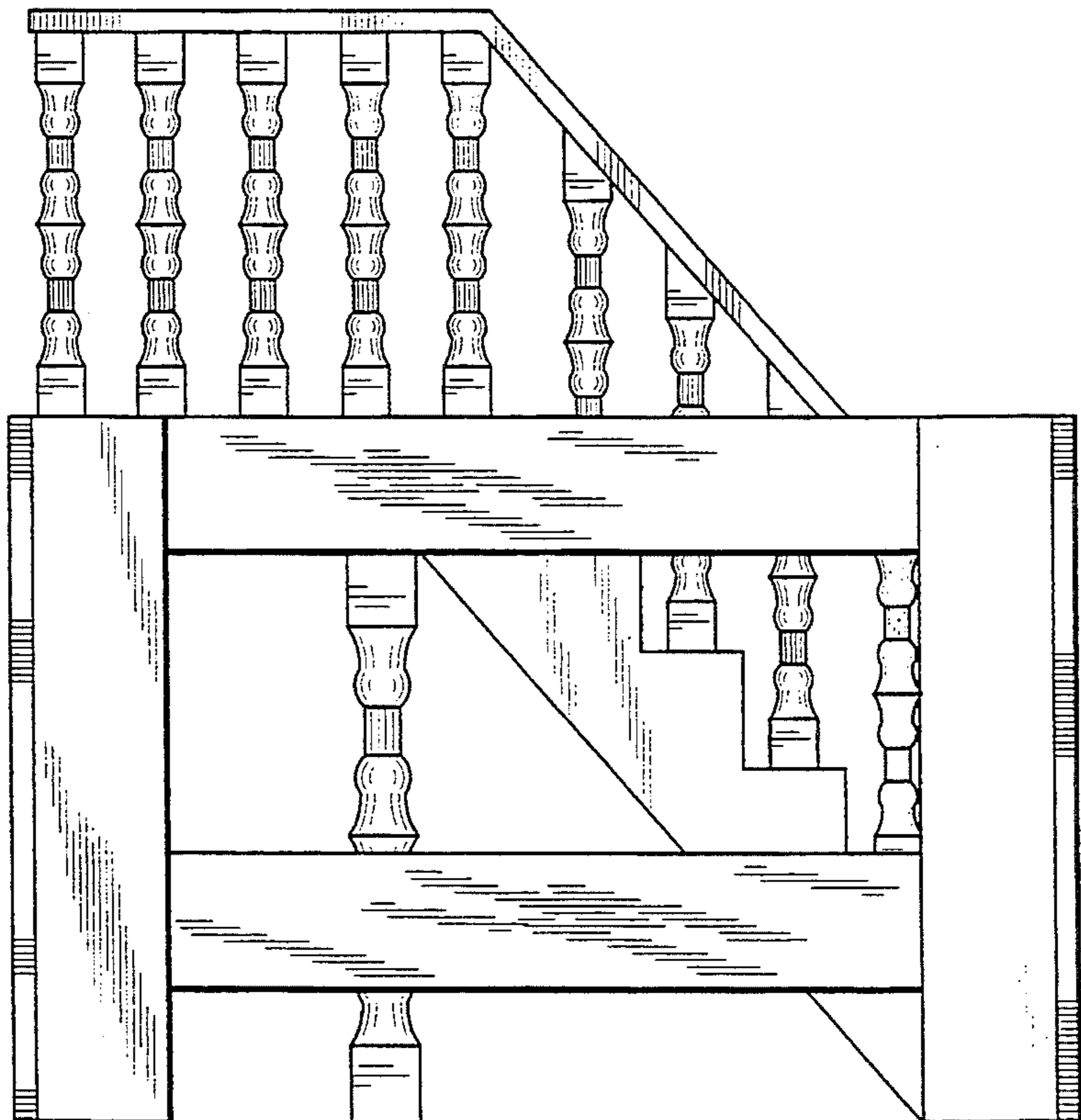

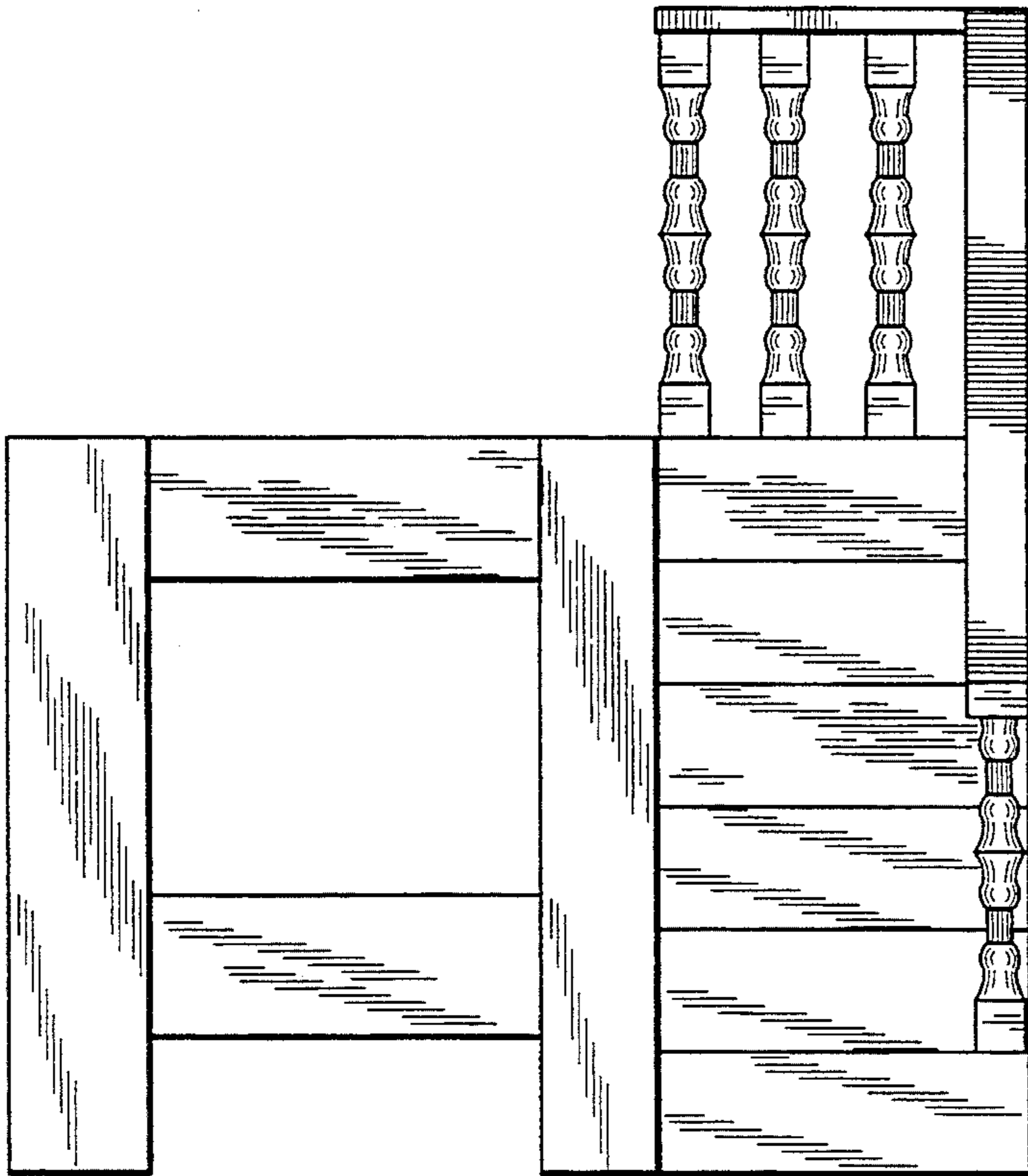

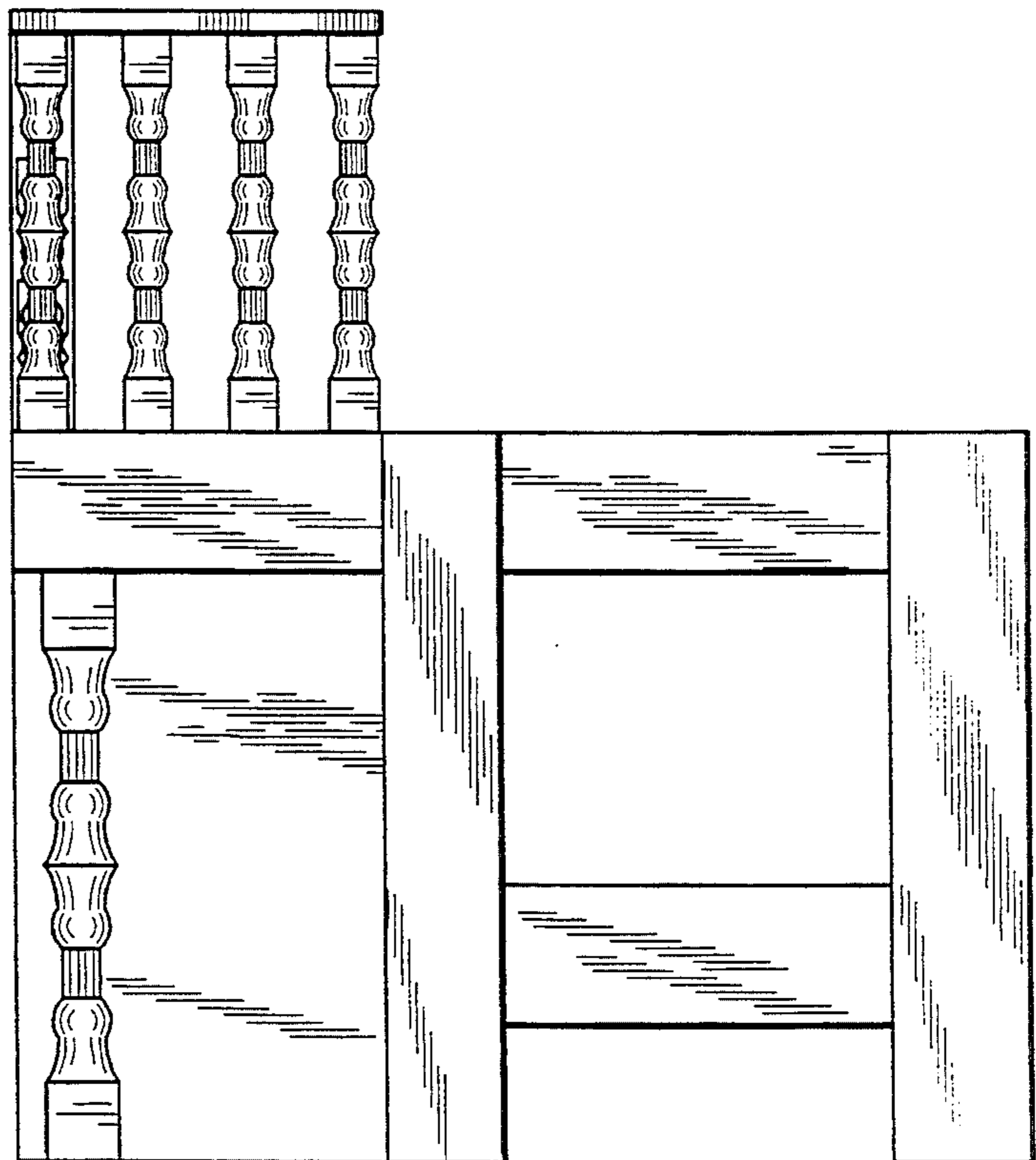

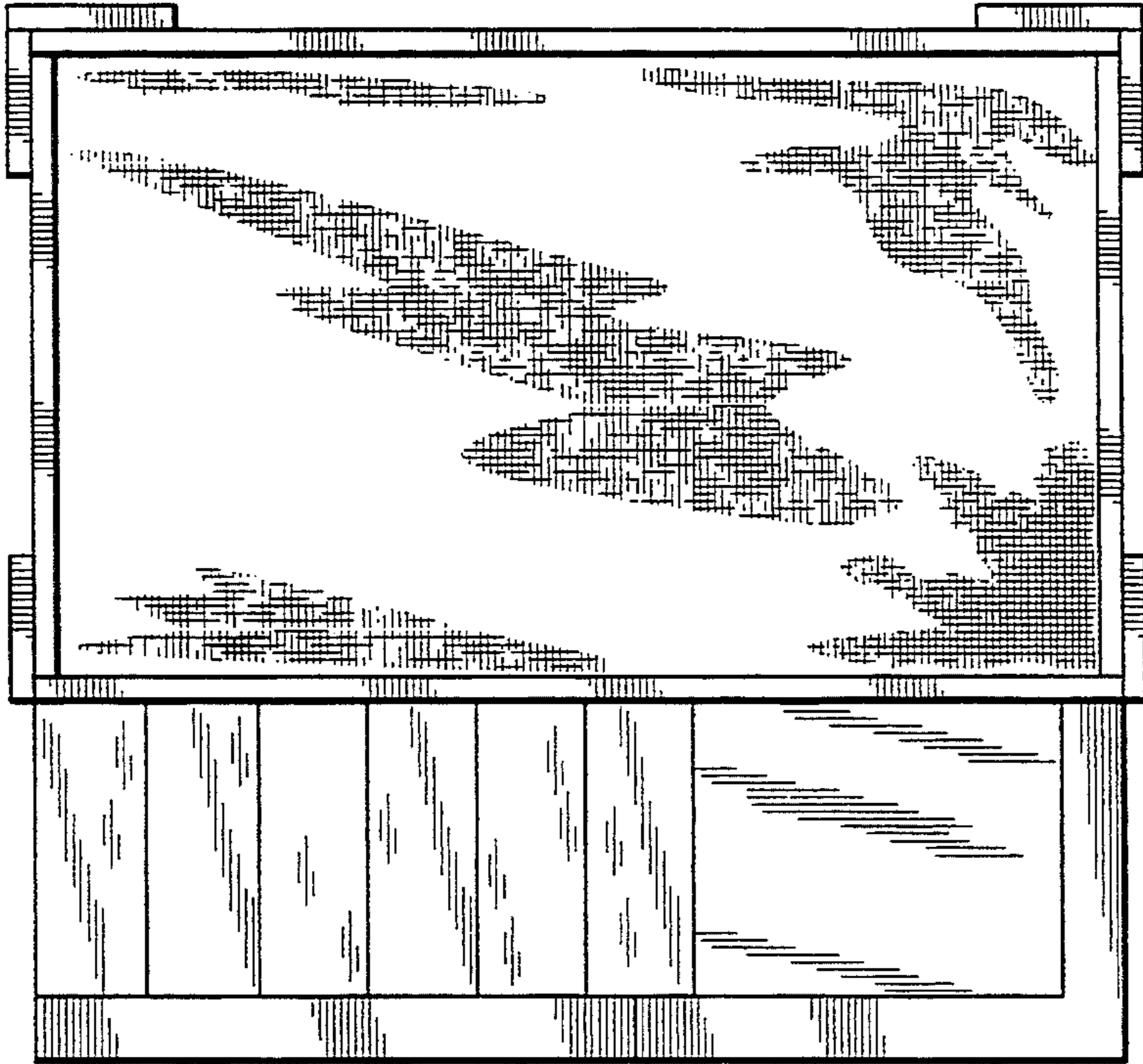
