The ornamental design for a drinking cup with a spiral straw, as shown and described.

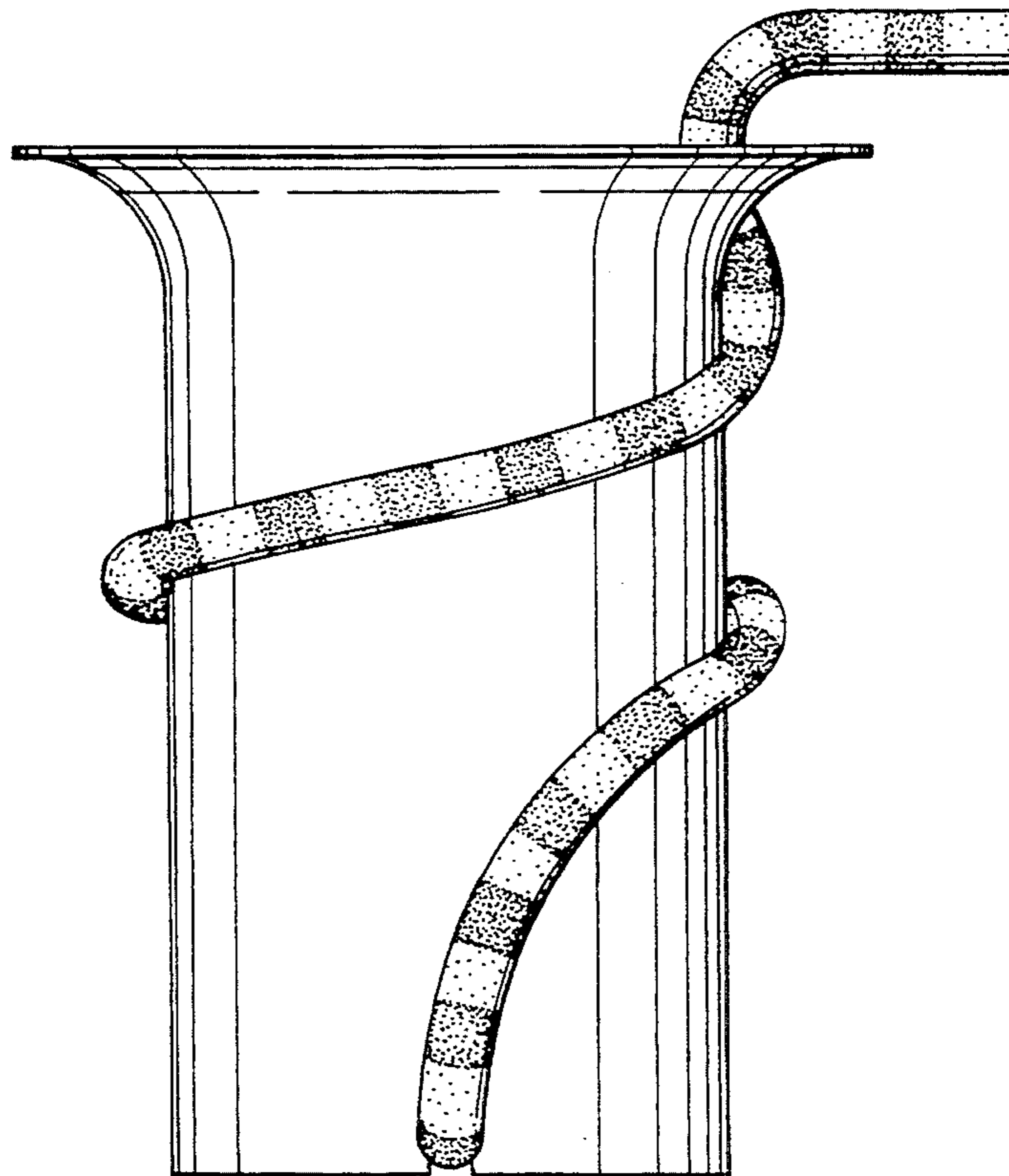
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention;
 FIG. 2 is rear elevation view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention as shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention as shown in FIGS. 1 and 2;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention as shown in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3;
 FIG. 5 is a top view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention as shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 3 and 4;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention as shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5; and,
 FIG. 7 is an isometric view of a drinking cup with a spiral straw embodying my invention as shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.
 The straw has been shaded to show color contrast.

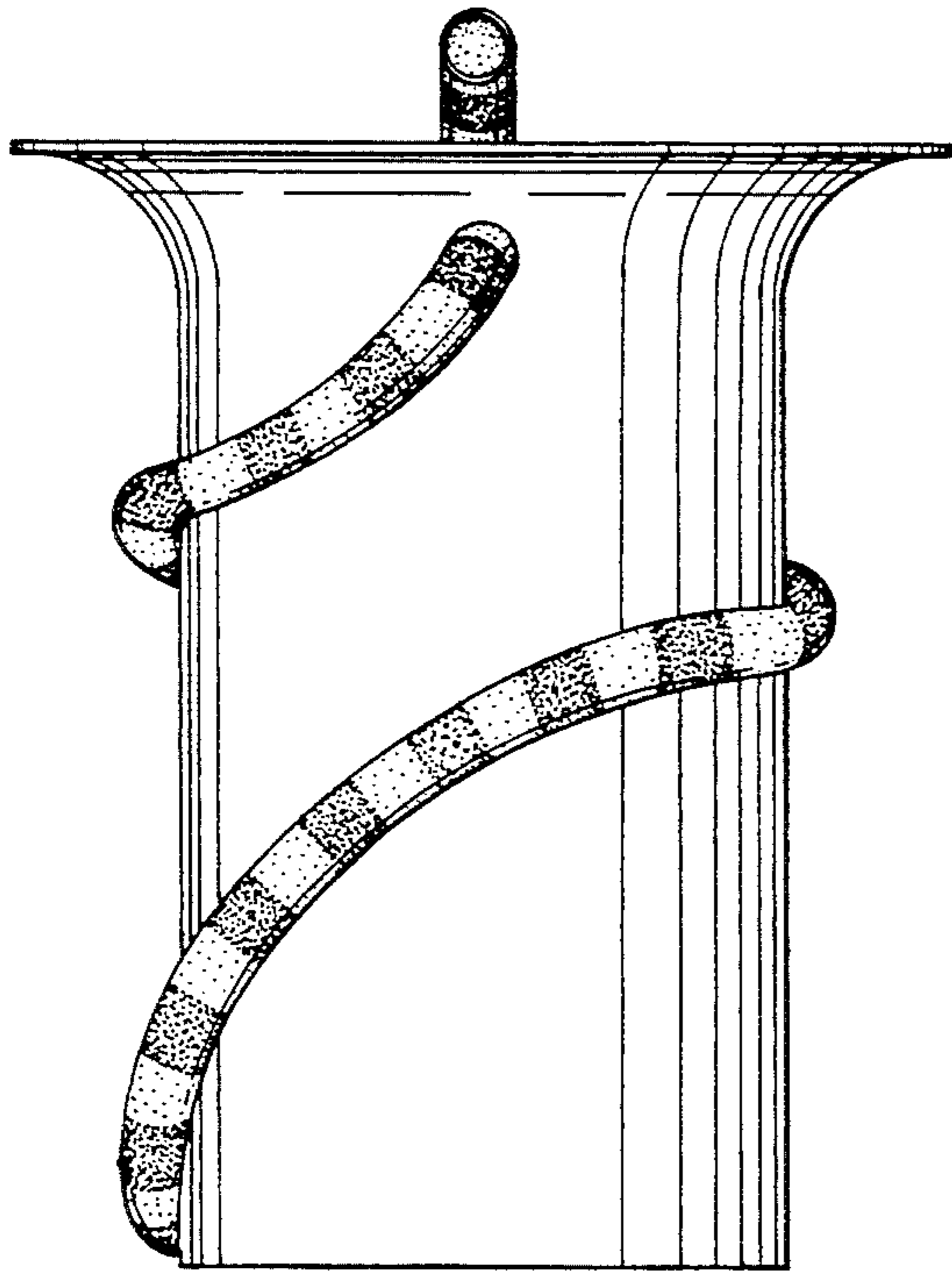

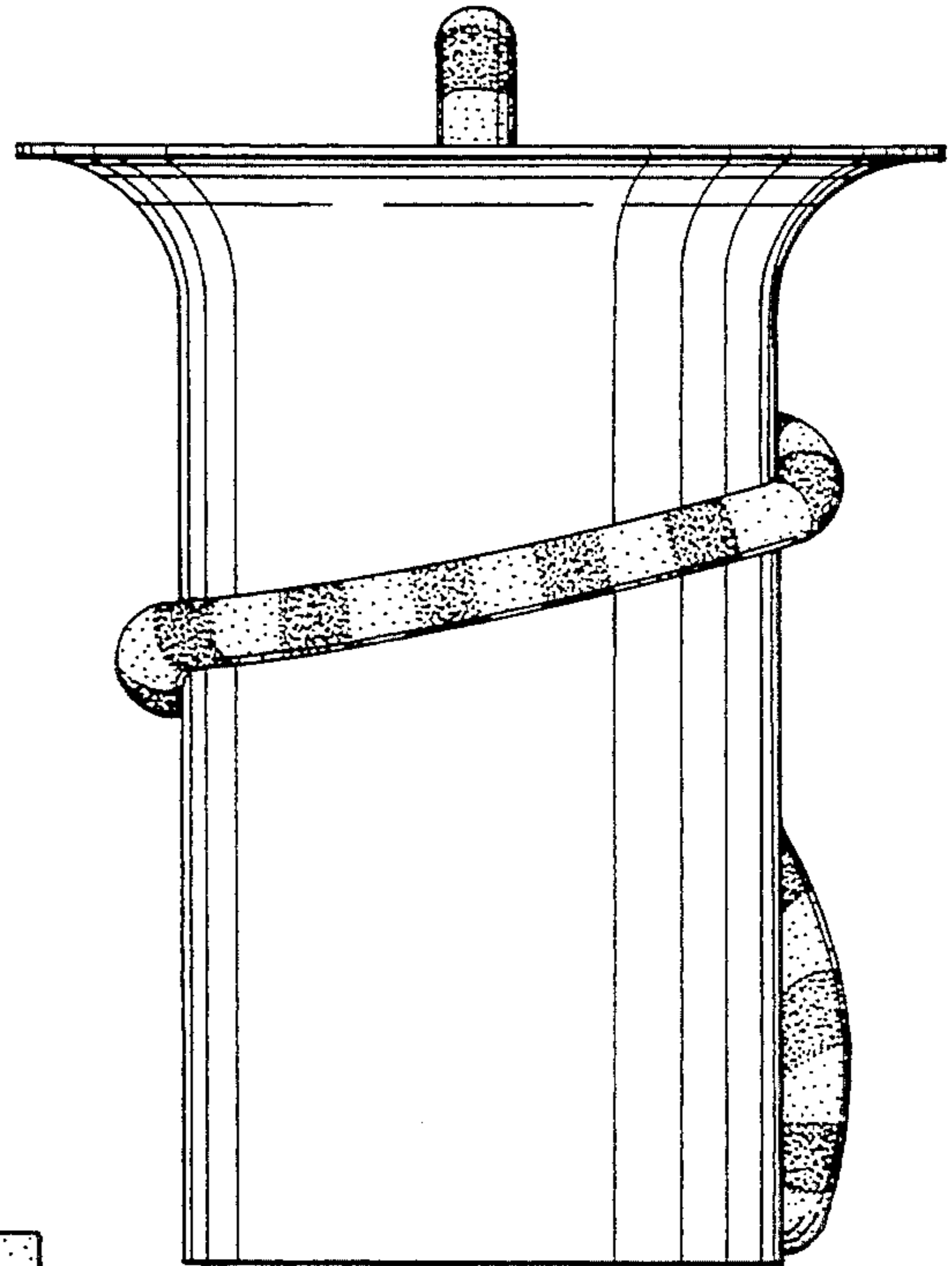

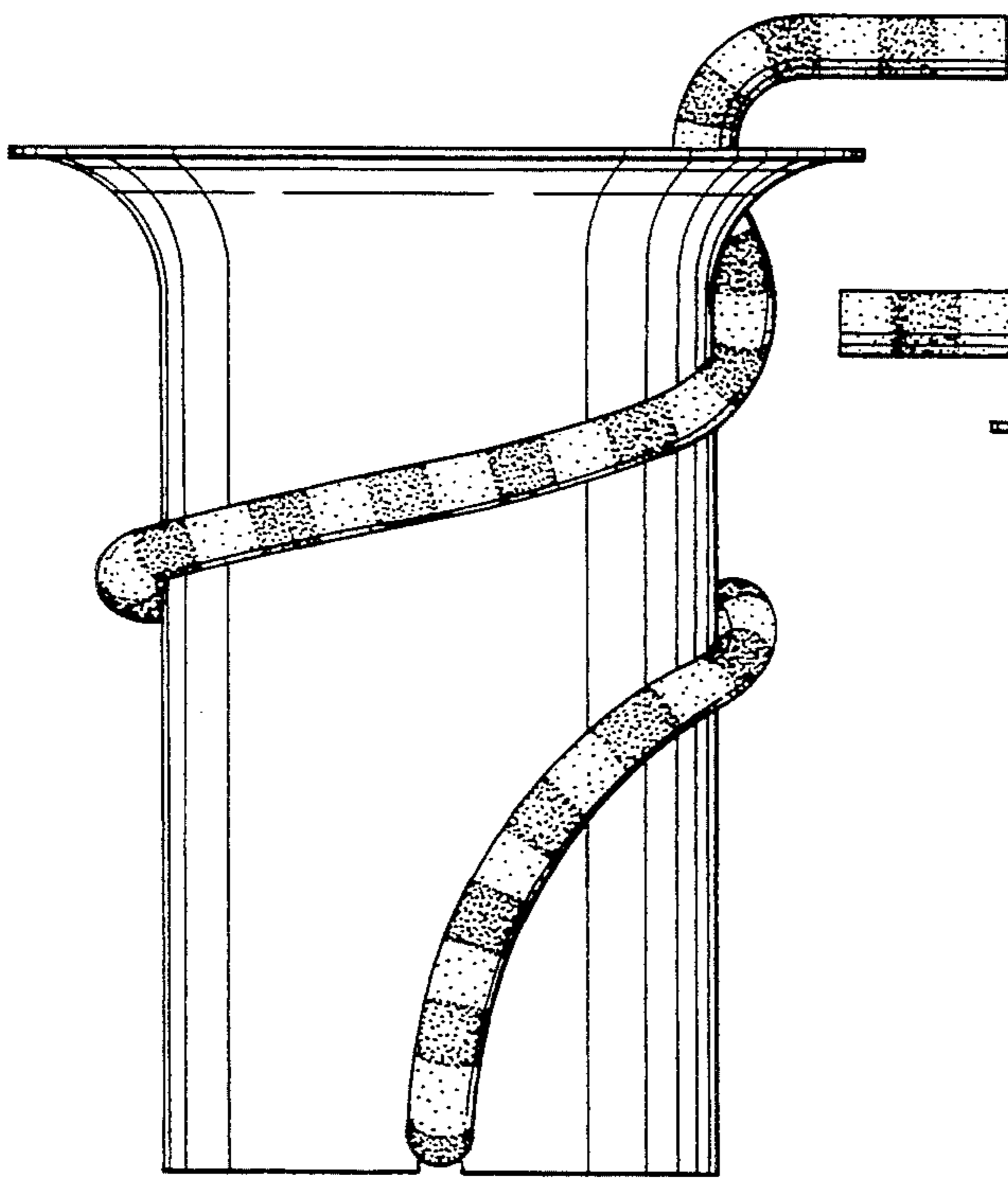

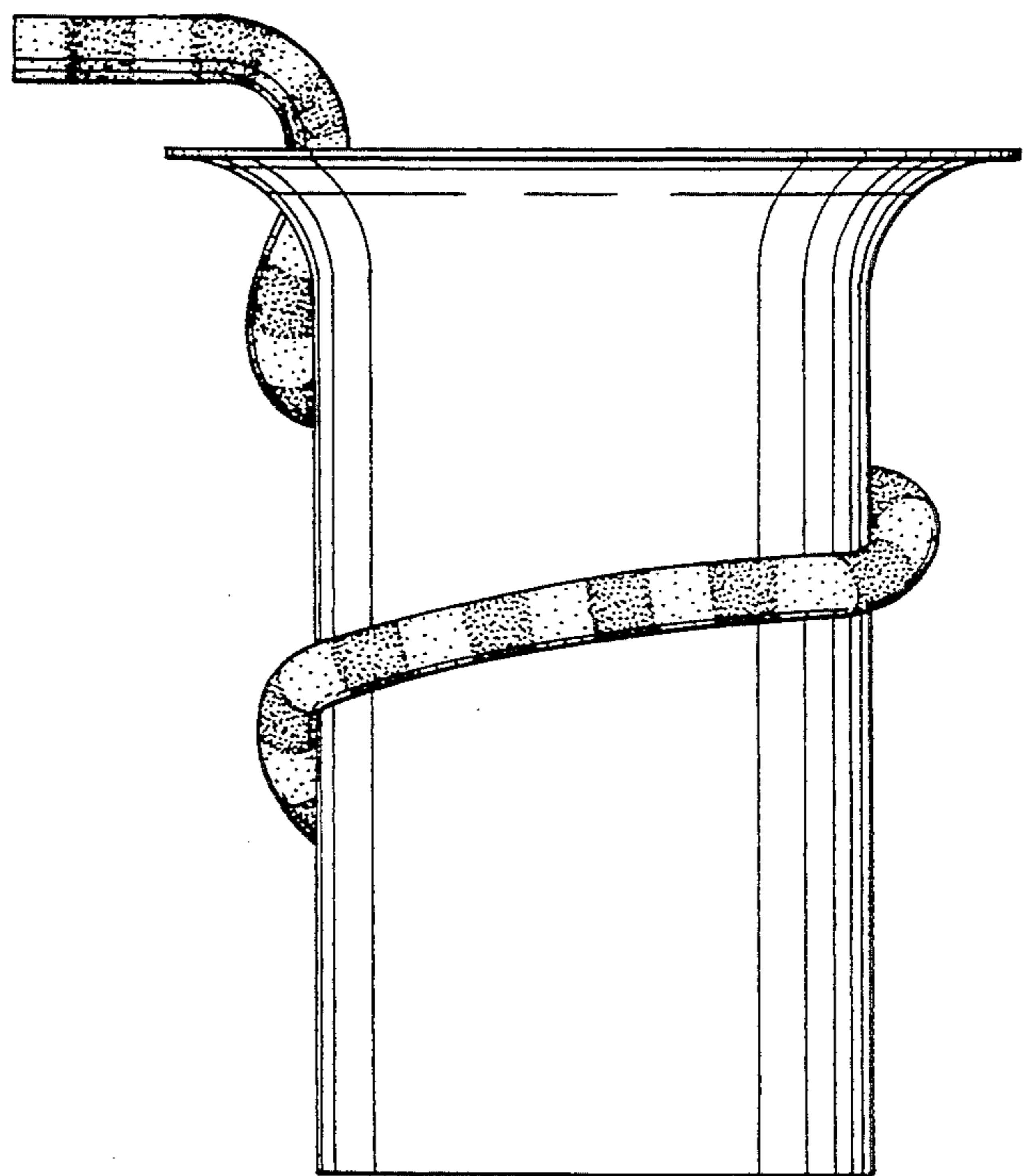

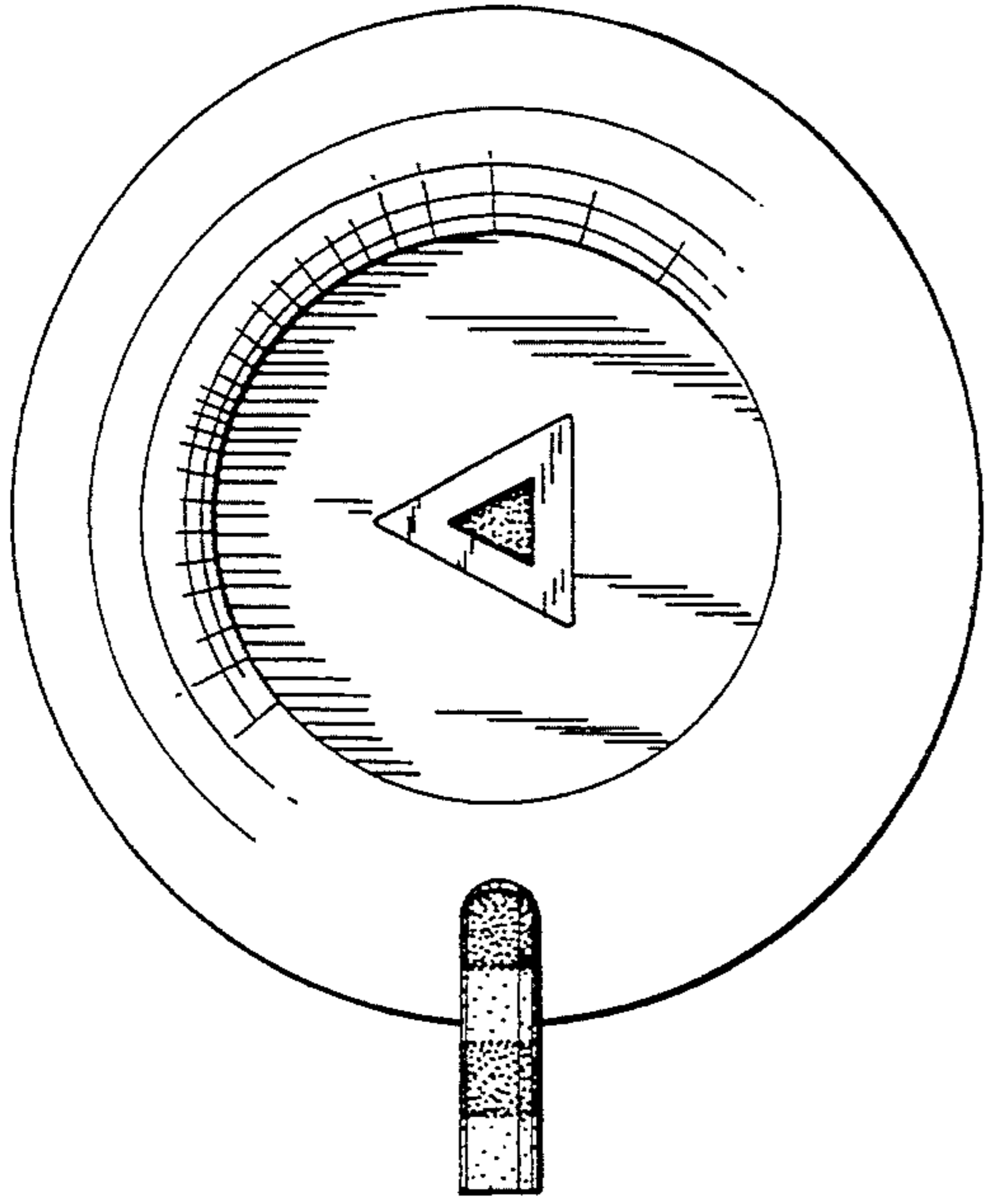

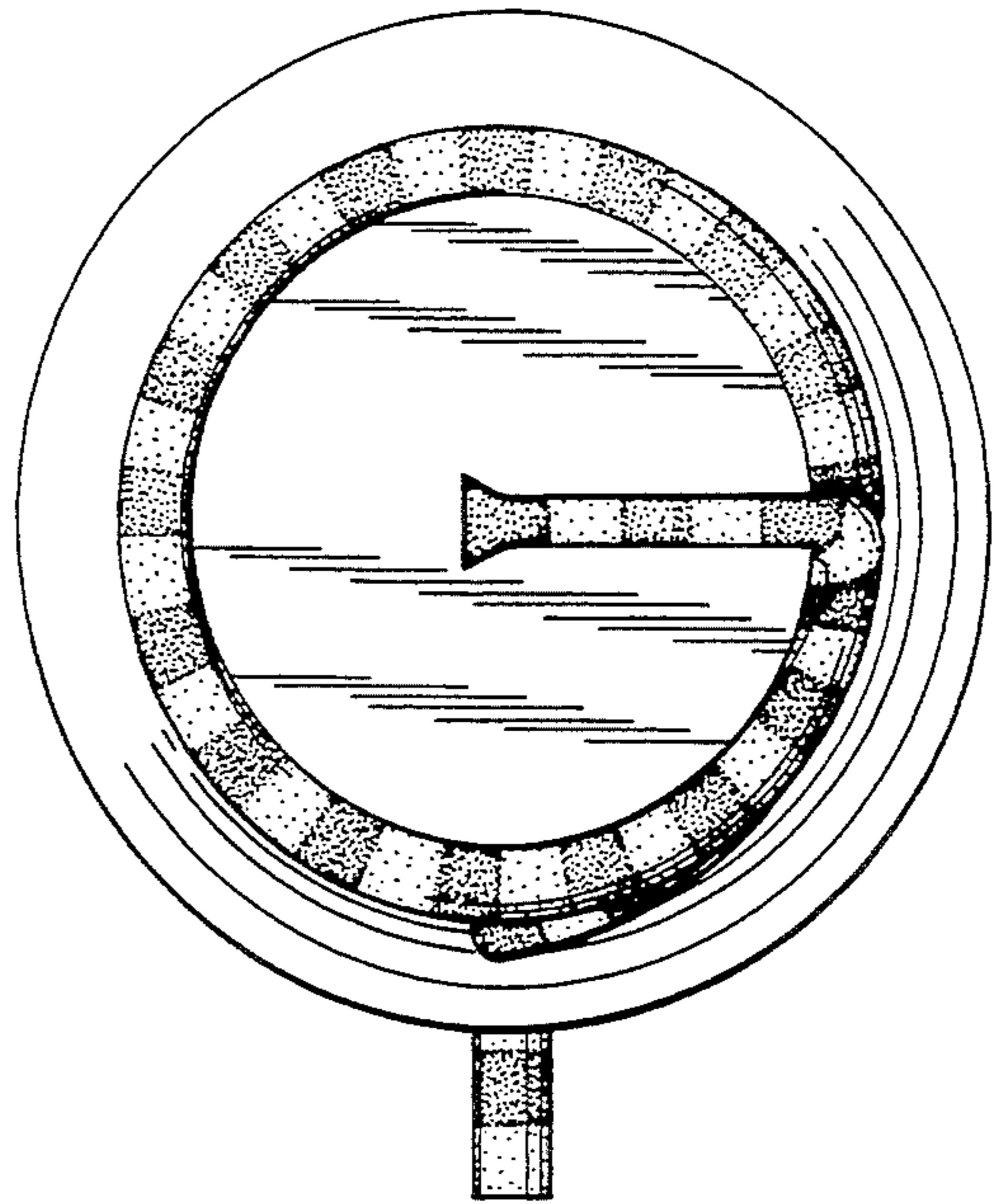

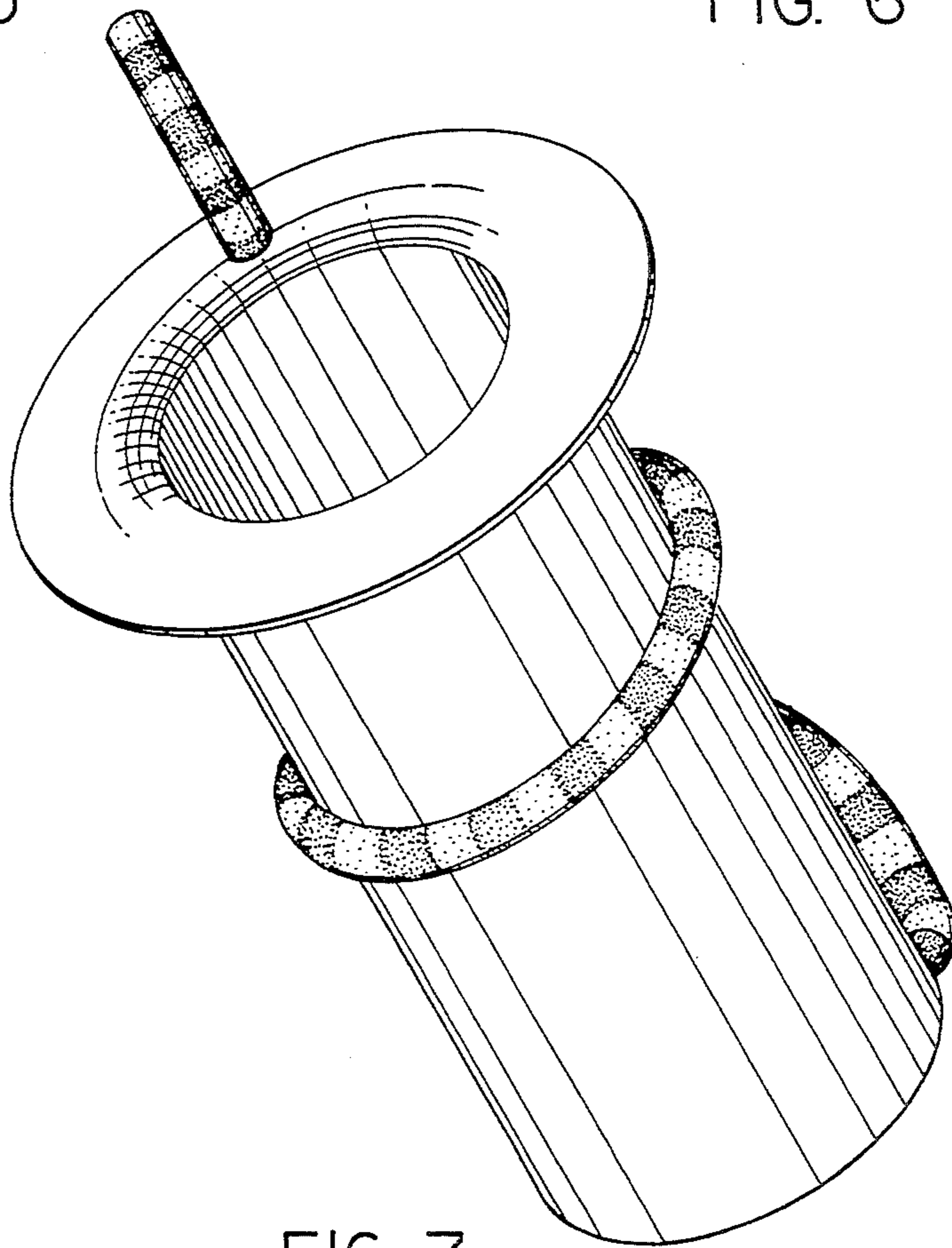
