[57] **CLAIM**

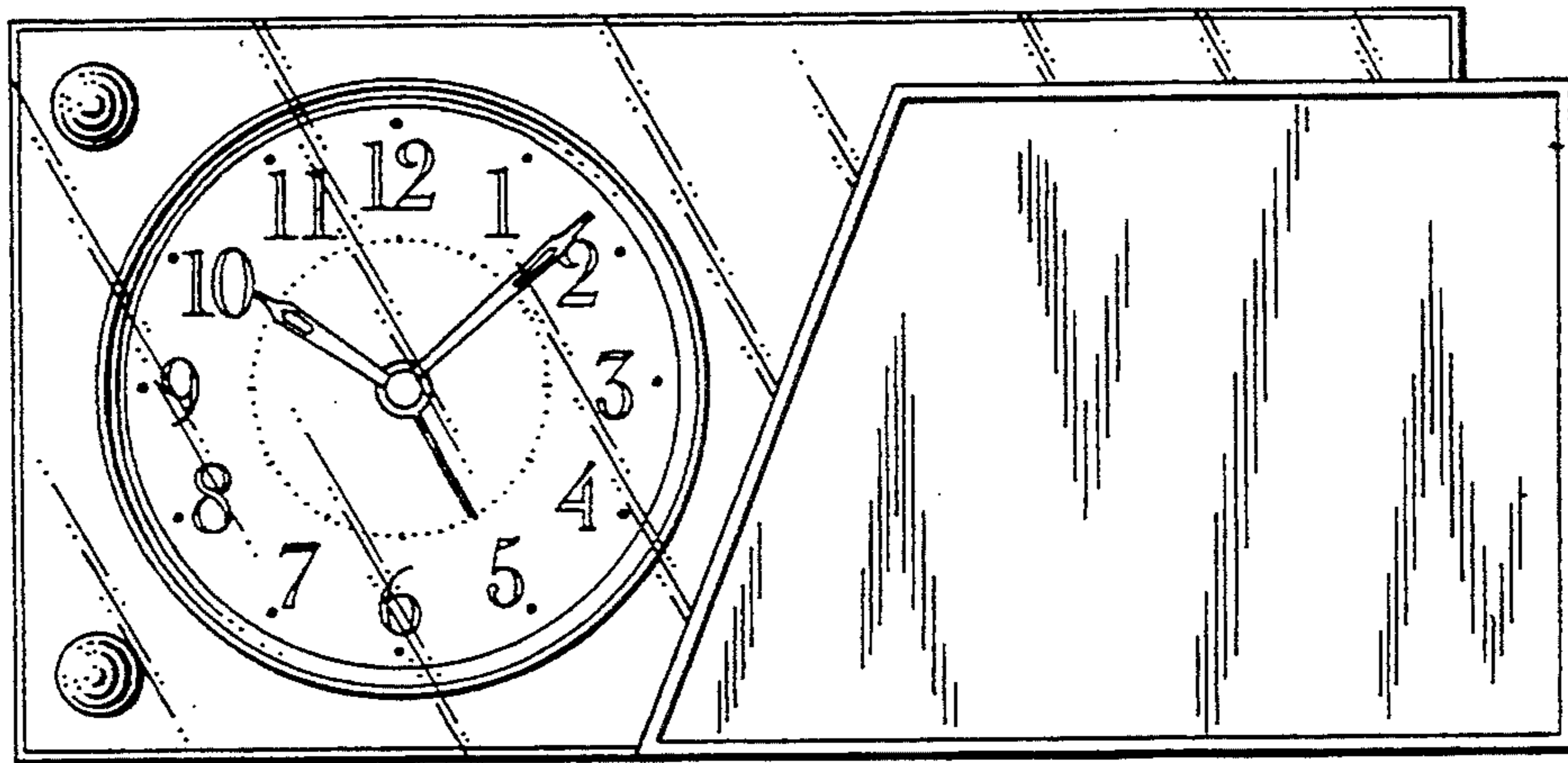
The ornamental design for a clock with card holder, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock with card holder showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof showing a representative card or the like placed in the card holder; and,  
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof showing a representative card or the like placed in the card holder. The broken line showing of cards in FIGS. 7 and 8 is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.

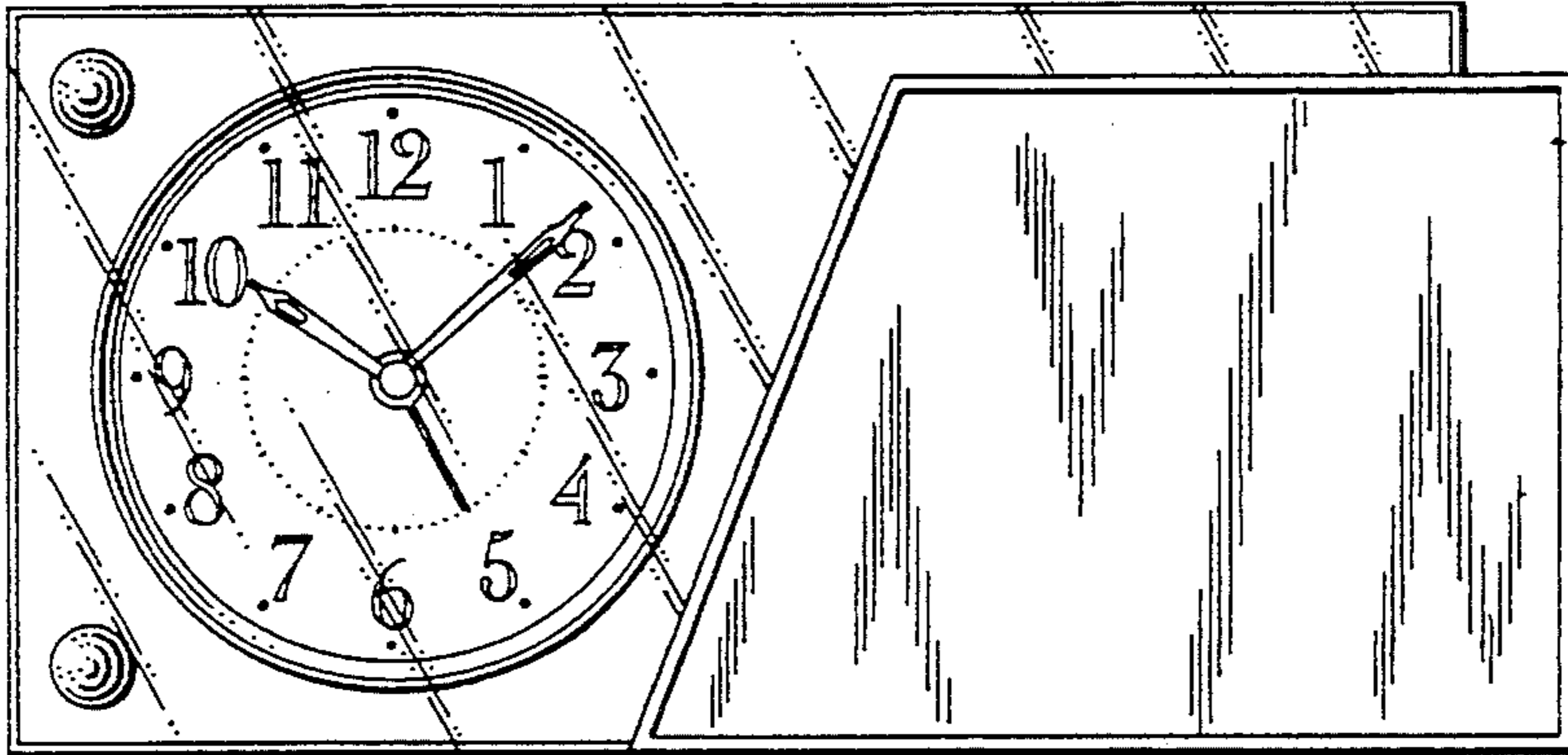

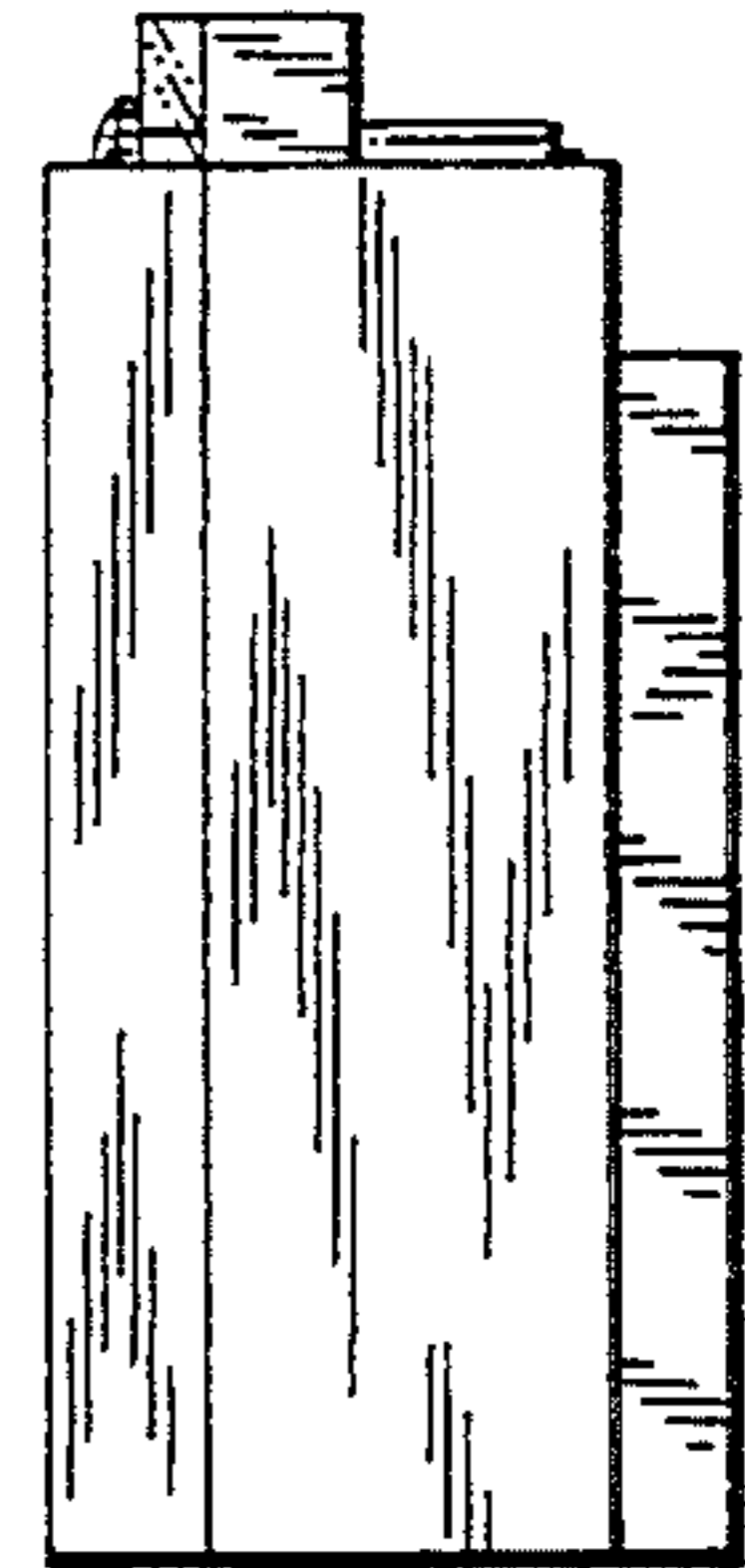

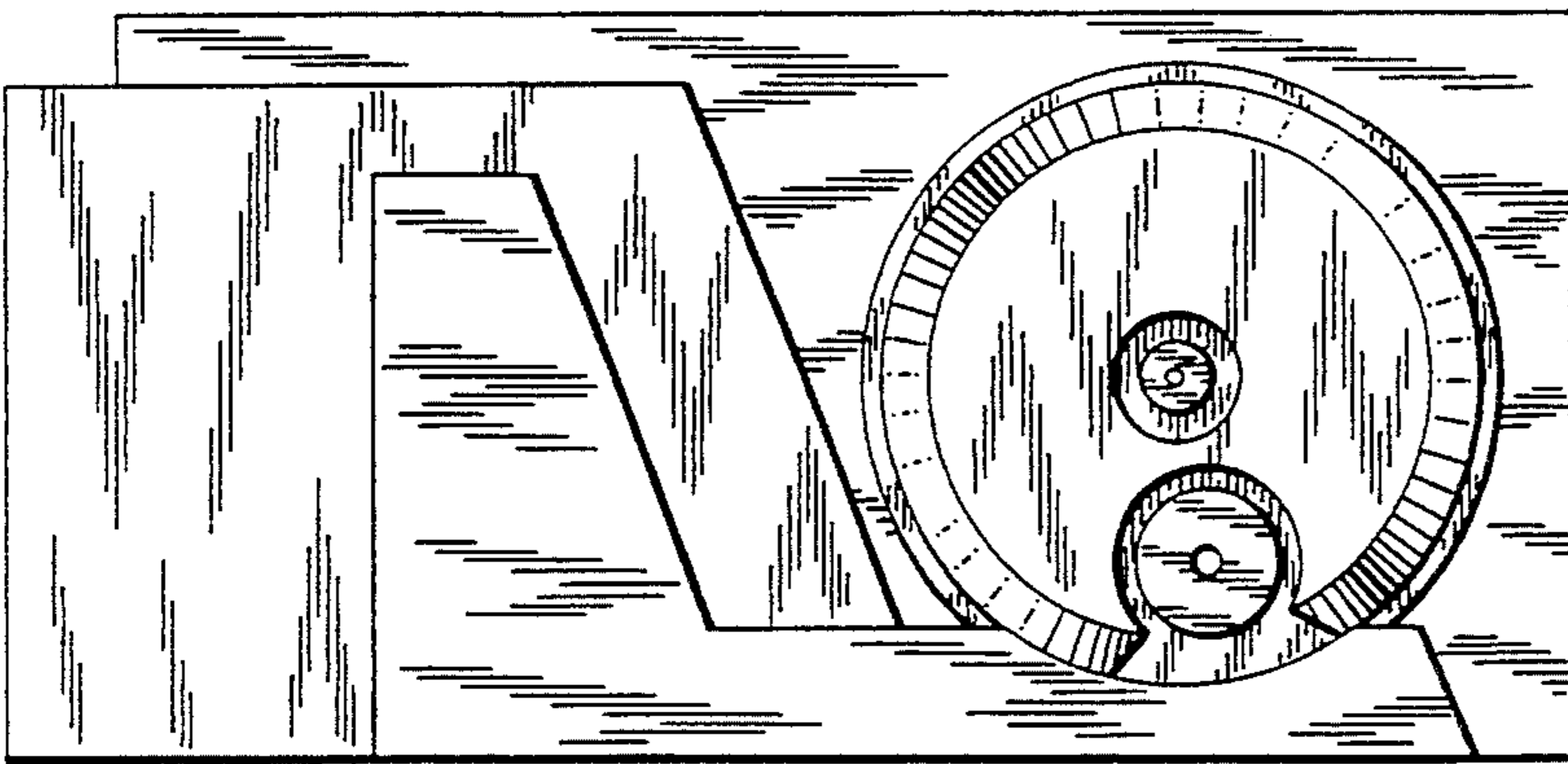

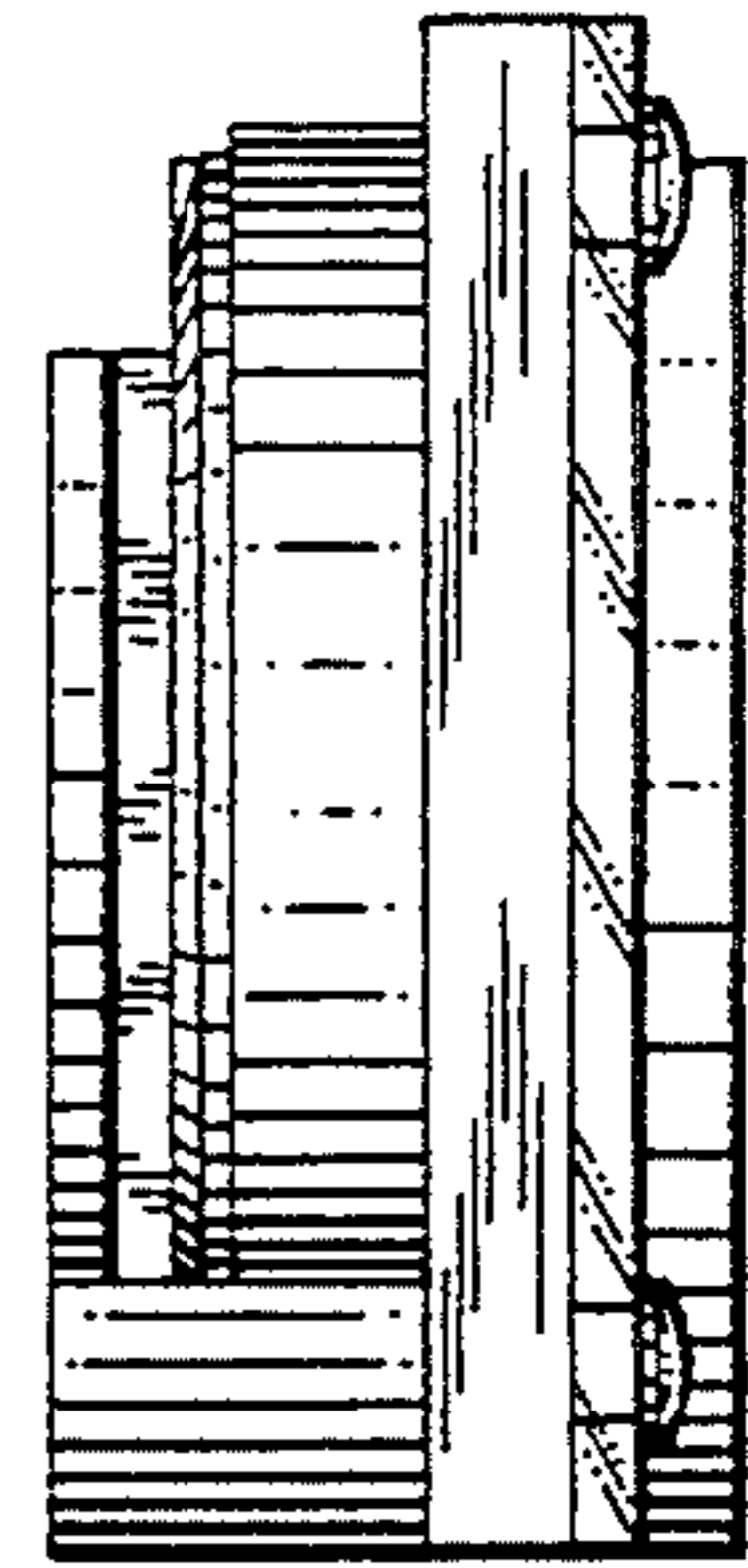

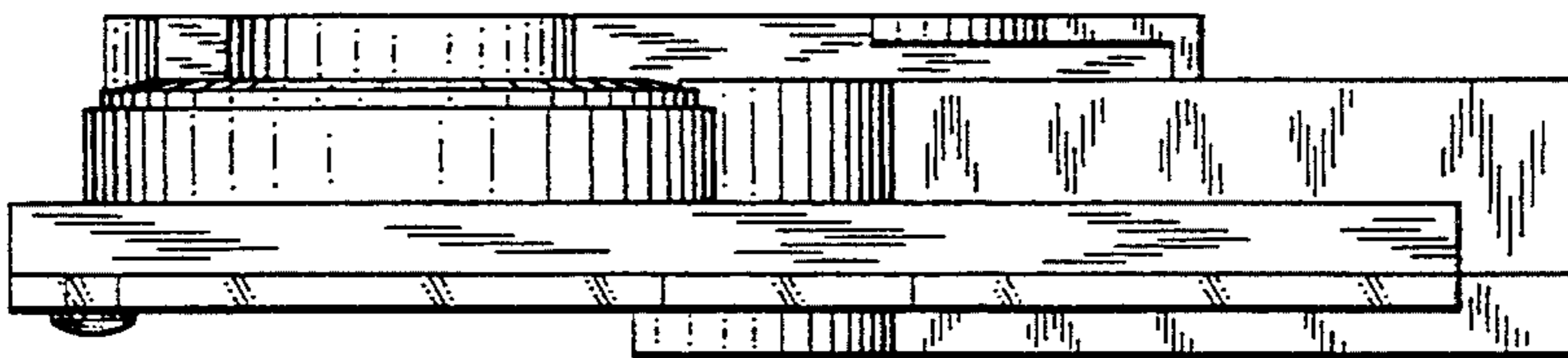

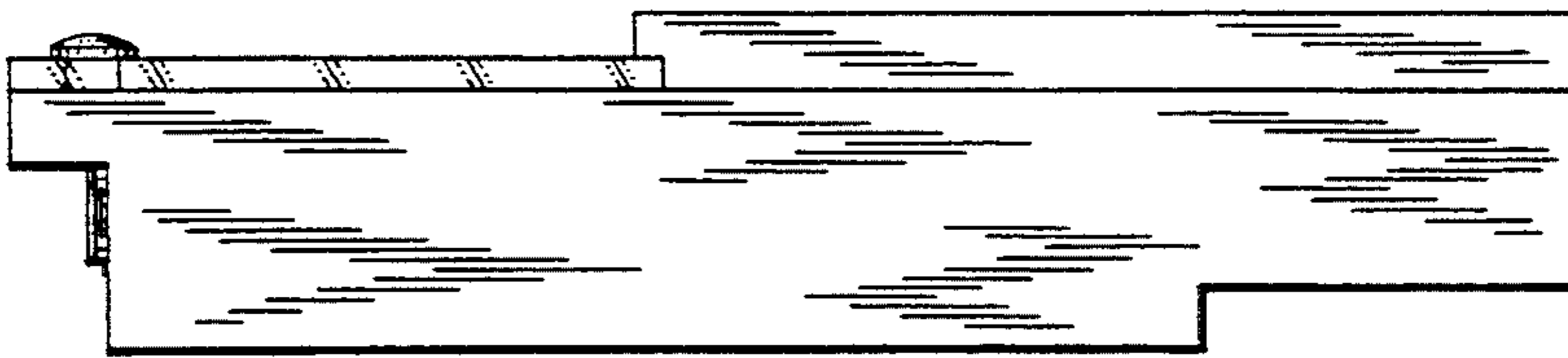
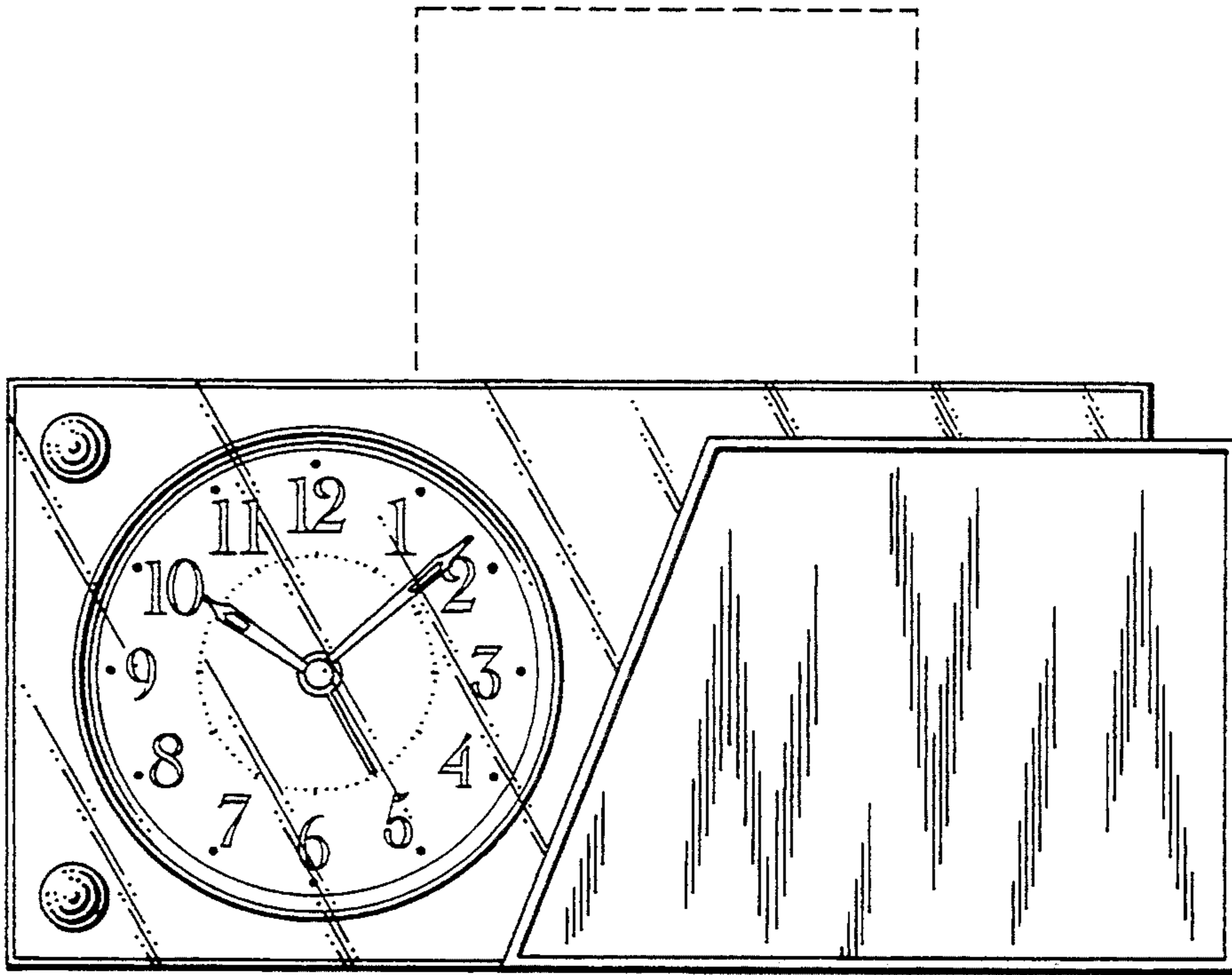
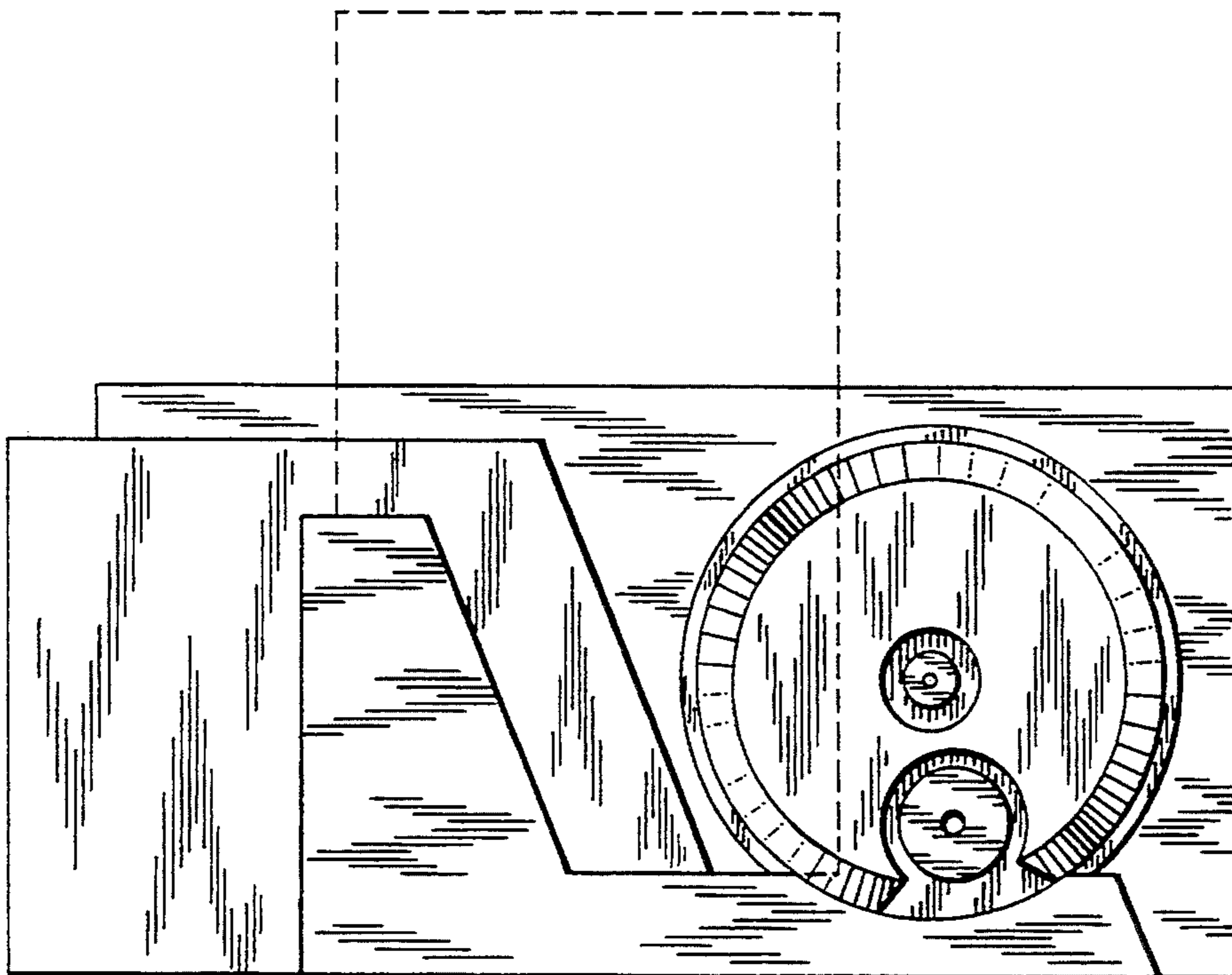
