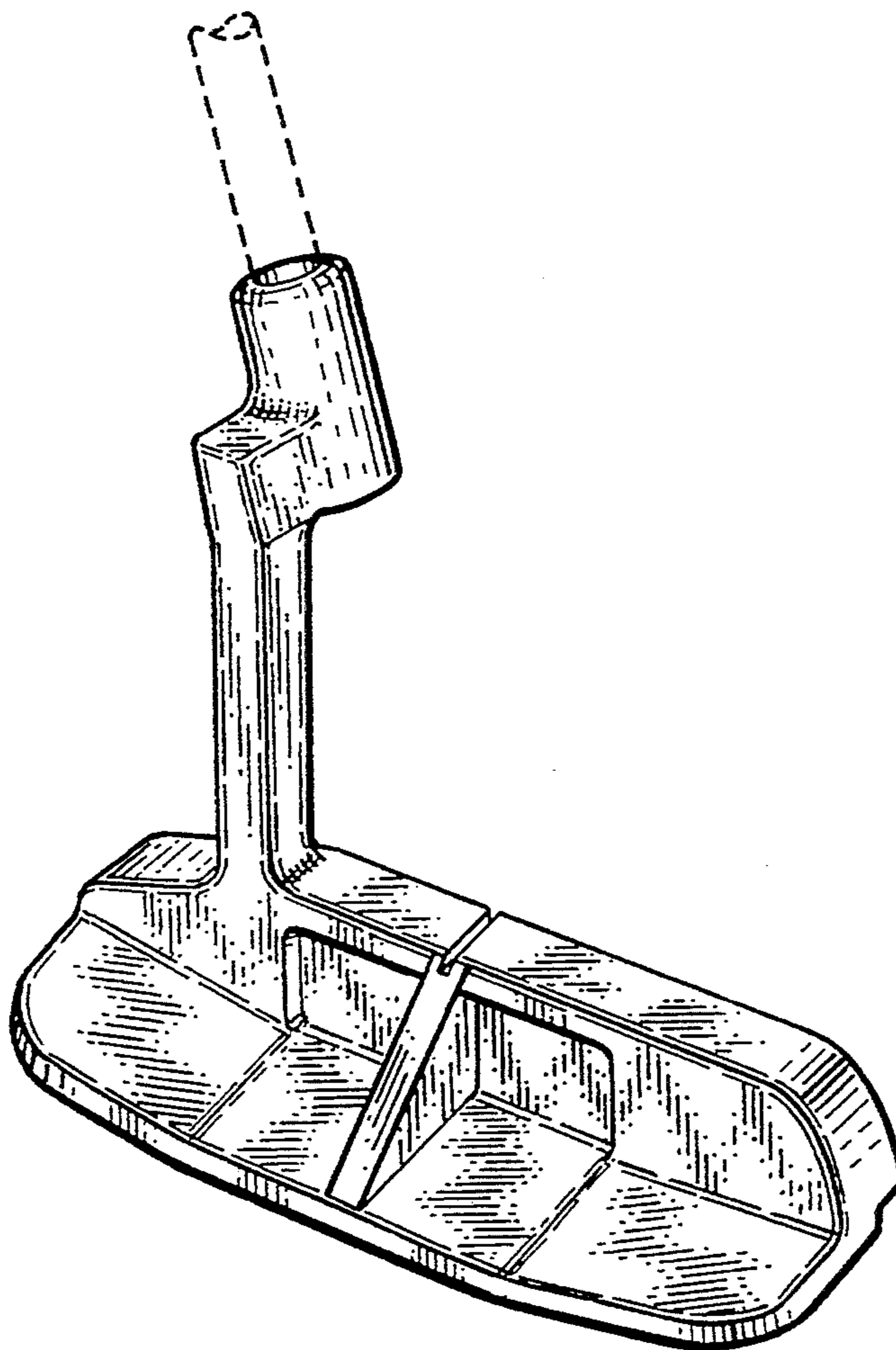
## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a golf putter head, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a golf putter head showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken line showing of a fragmented shaft in figure is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



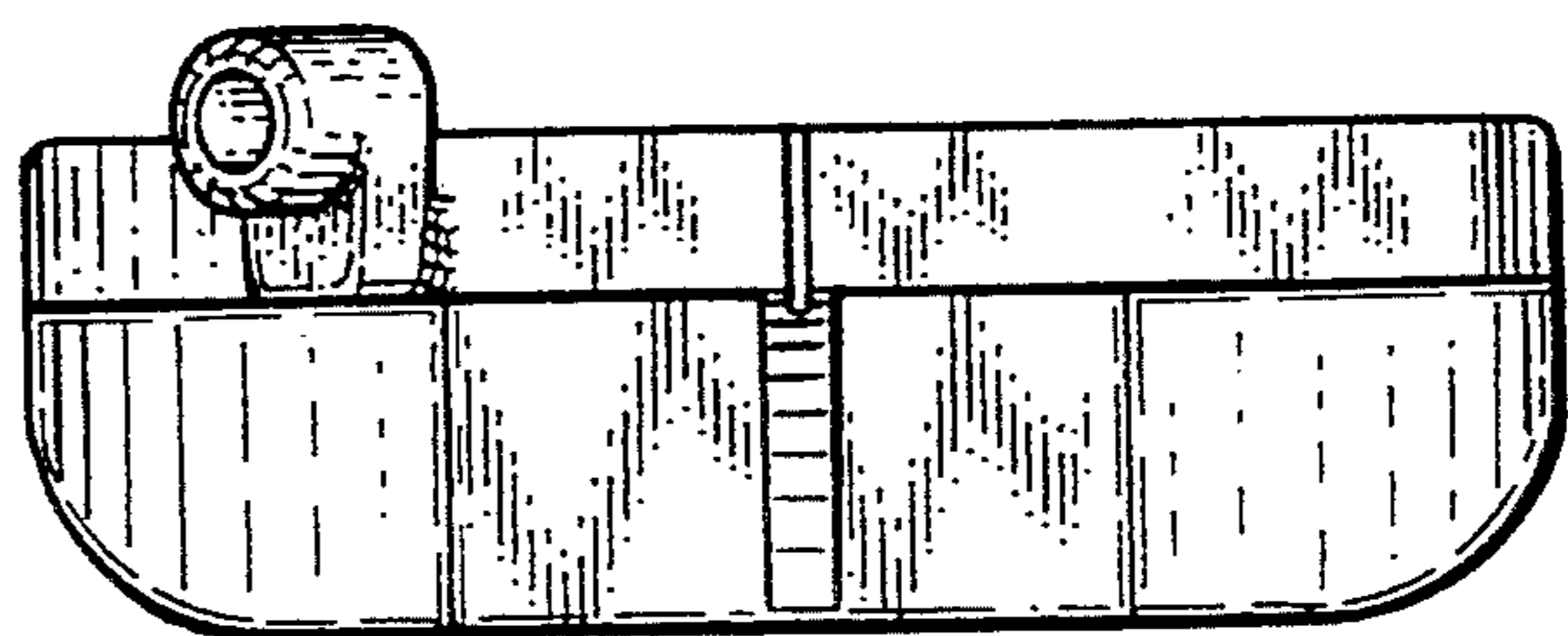
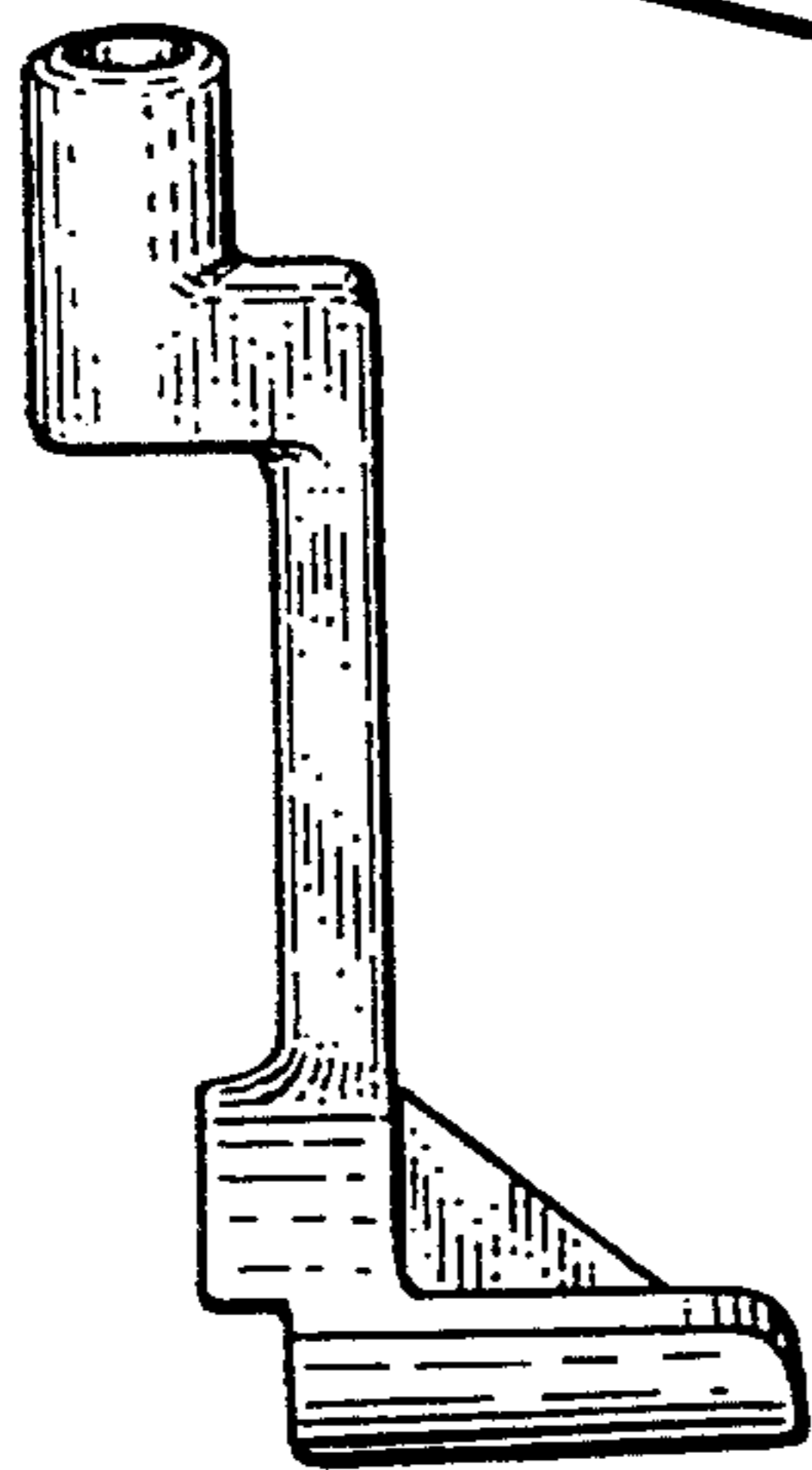
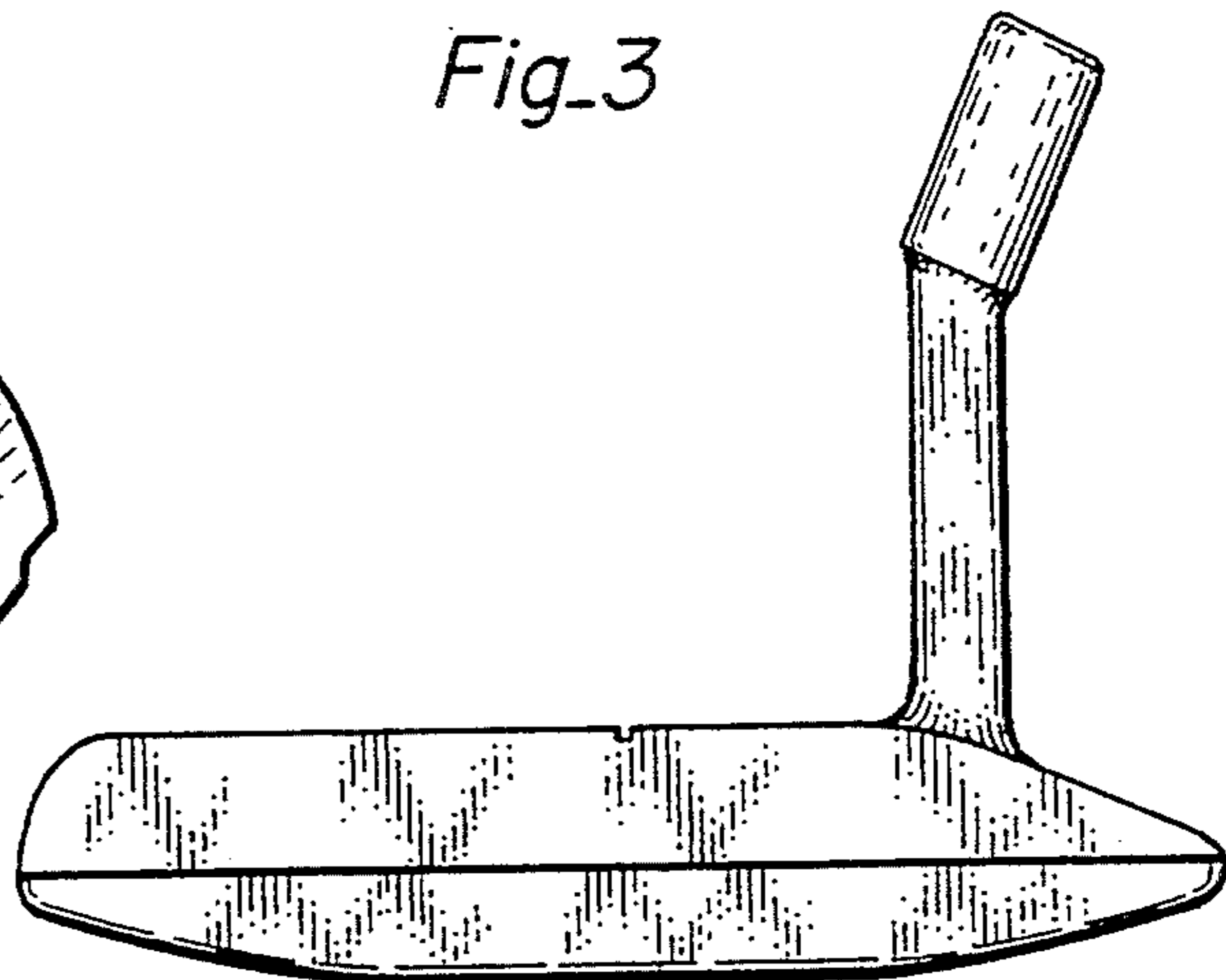
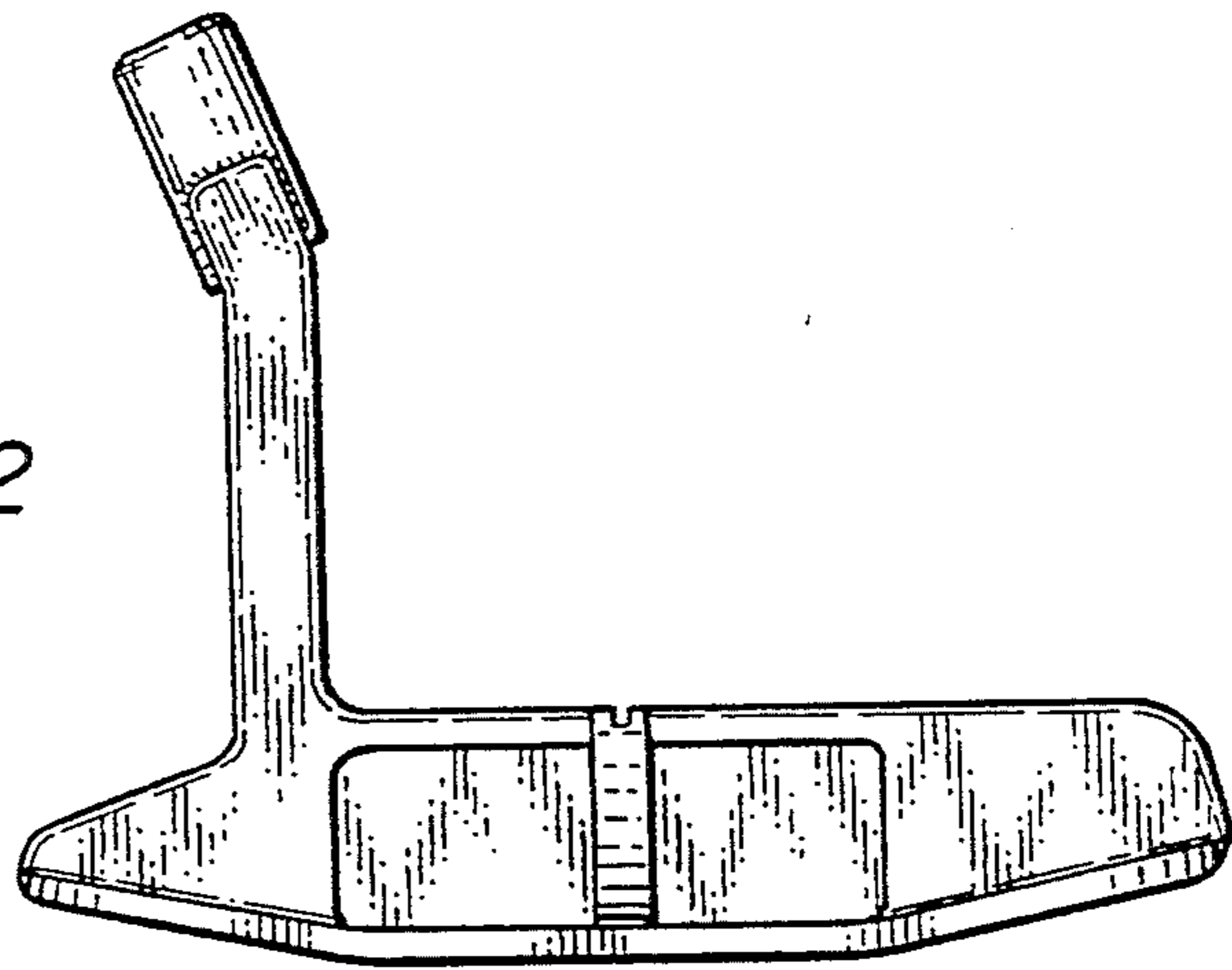
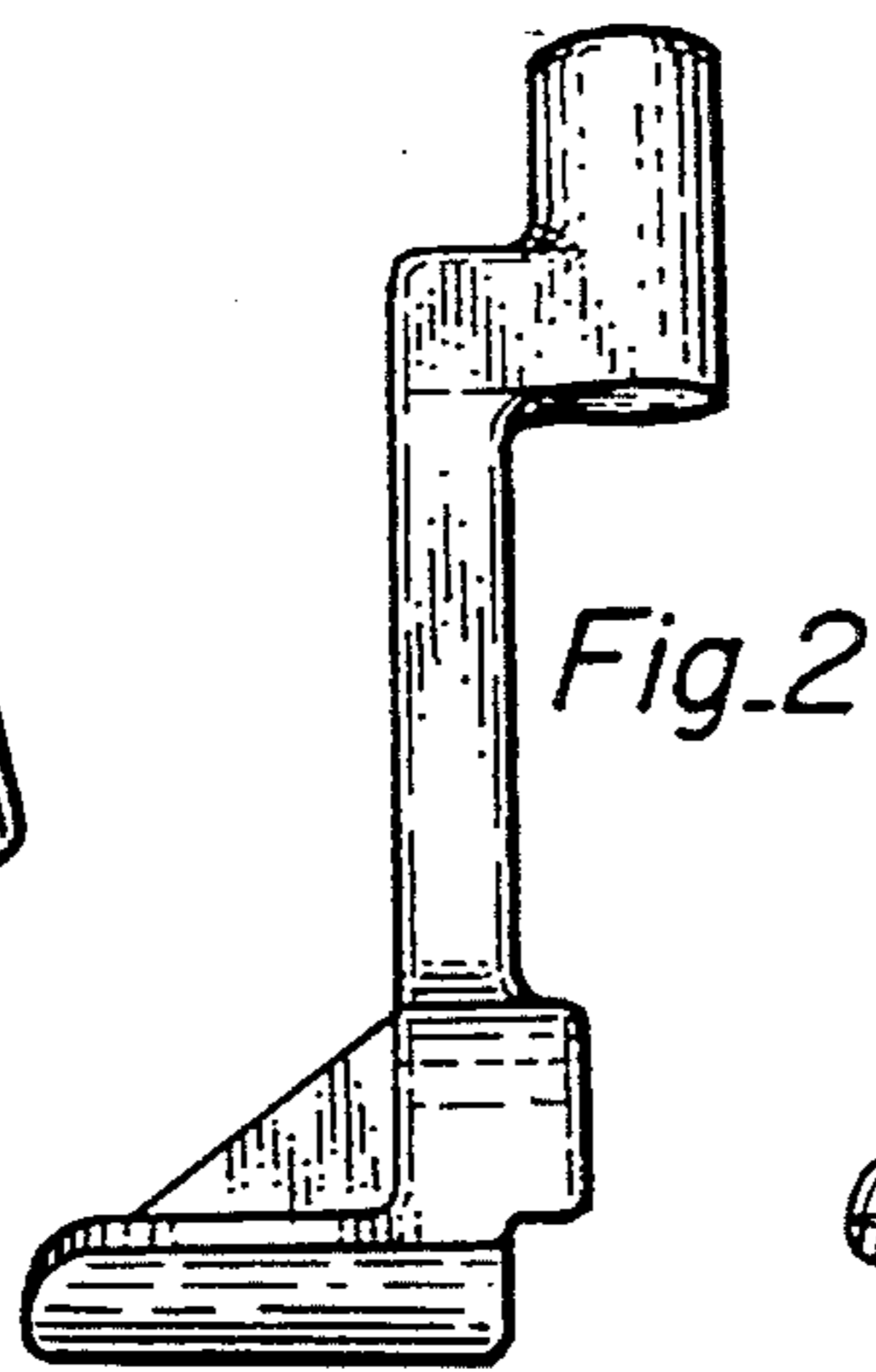
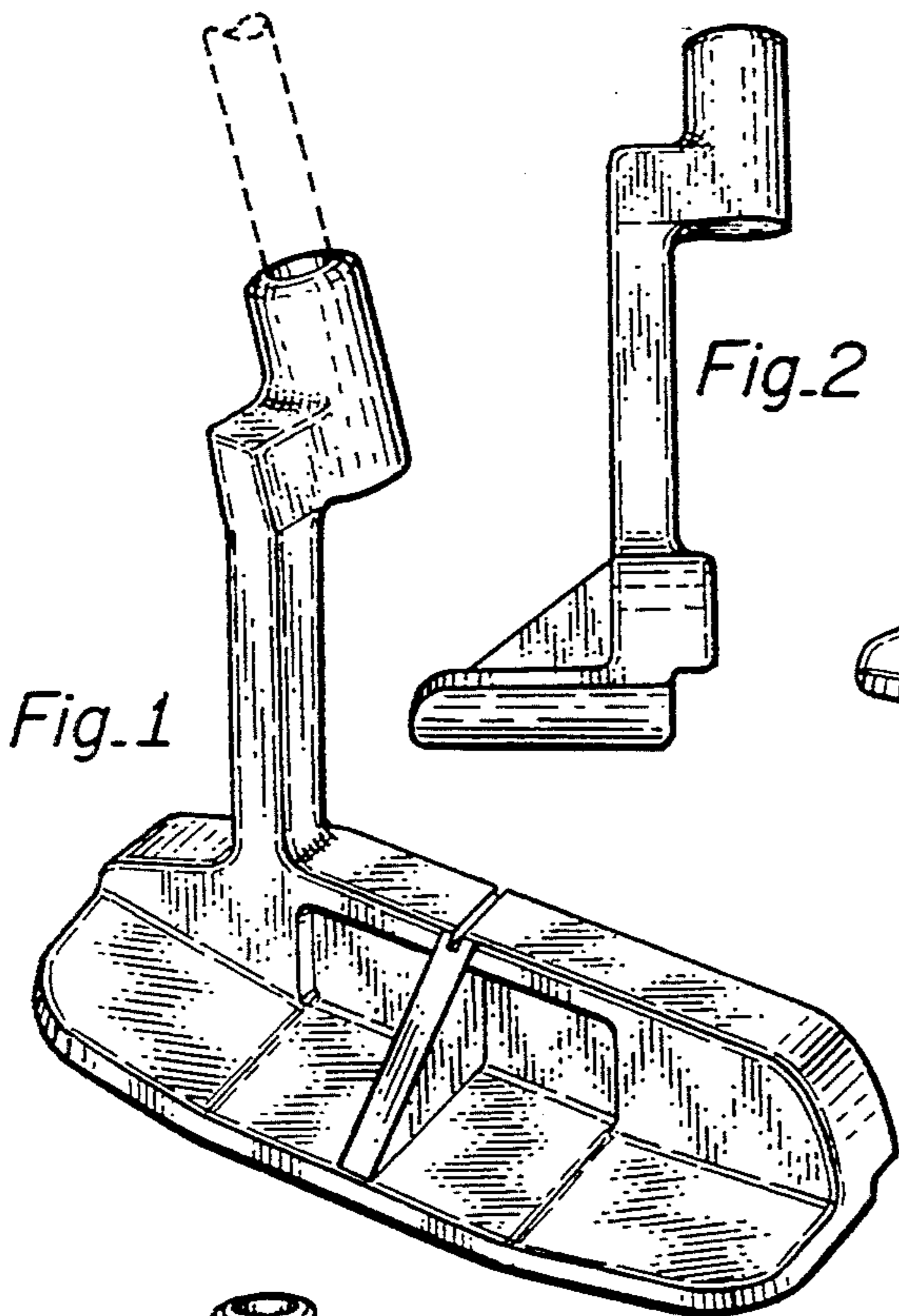
