[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a support for holding a paint roller vertically while being cleaned, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 15 is a reduced bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 16 is a top and front perspective view of a support for holding a paint roller vertically while being cleaned showing a fourth embodiment of my new design;


FIG. 17 is a reduced front elevational view thereof, the rear being identical in appearance;


FIG. 18 is a reduced side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;


FIG. 19 is a reduced top plan view thereof; and,


FIG. 20 is a reduced bottom plan view thereof.























































