[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a merchandising display, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front and left sides of a merchandising display embodying my new design, with the dotted lines representing folding areas; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevation being a mirror image of the left side as shown;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing the rear and right sides thereof.

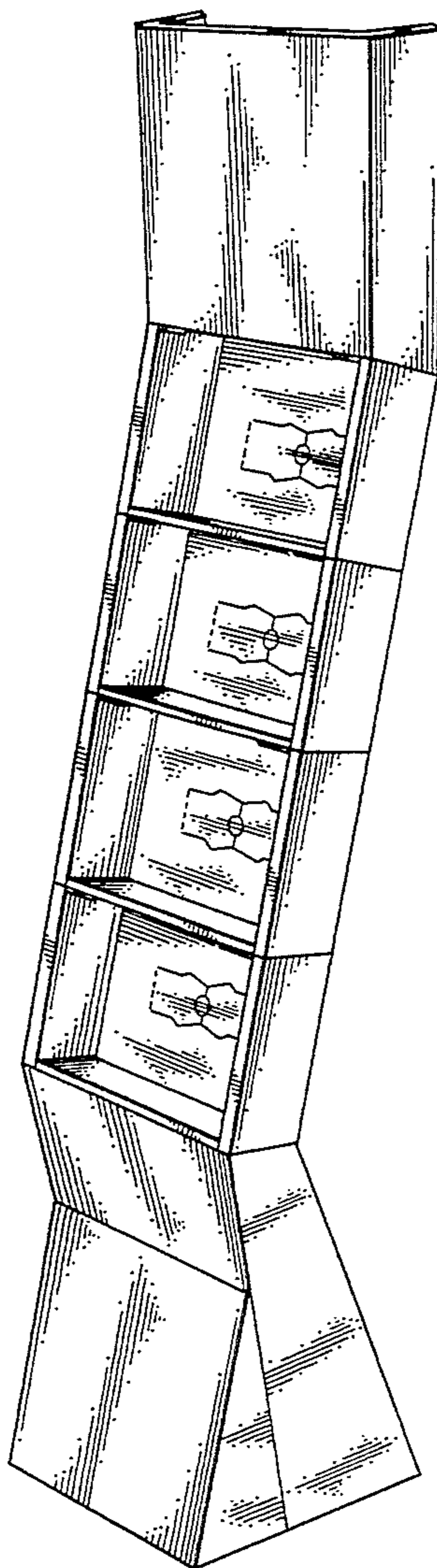

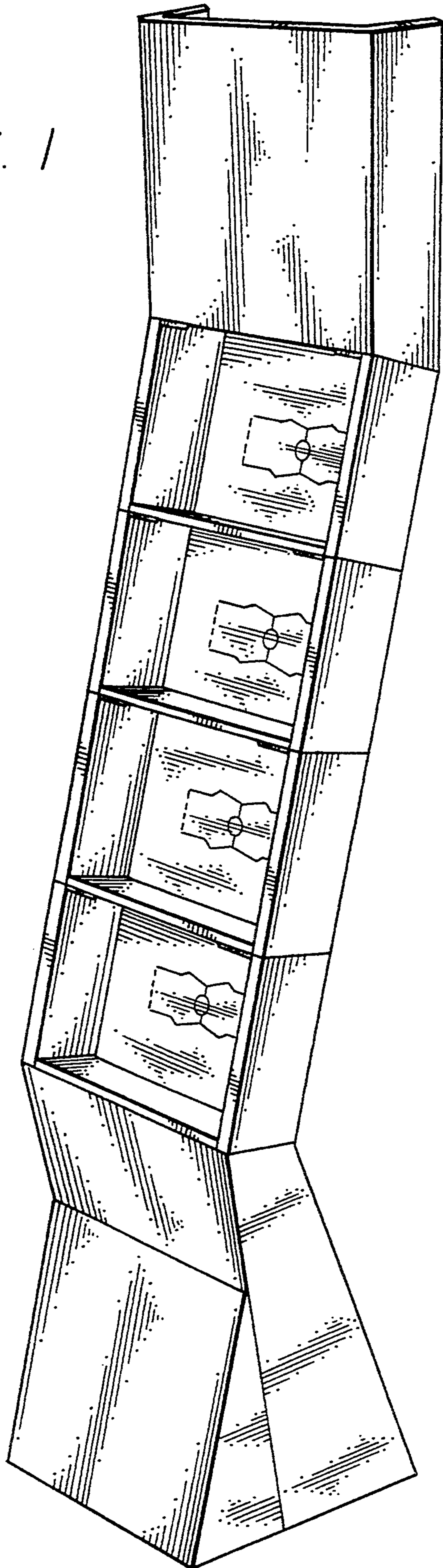

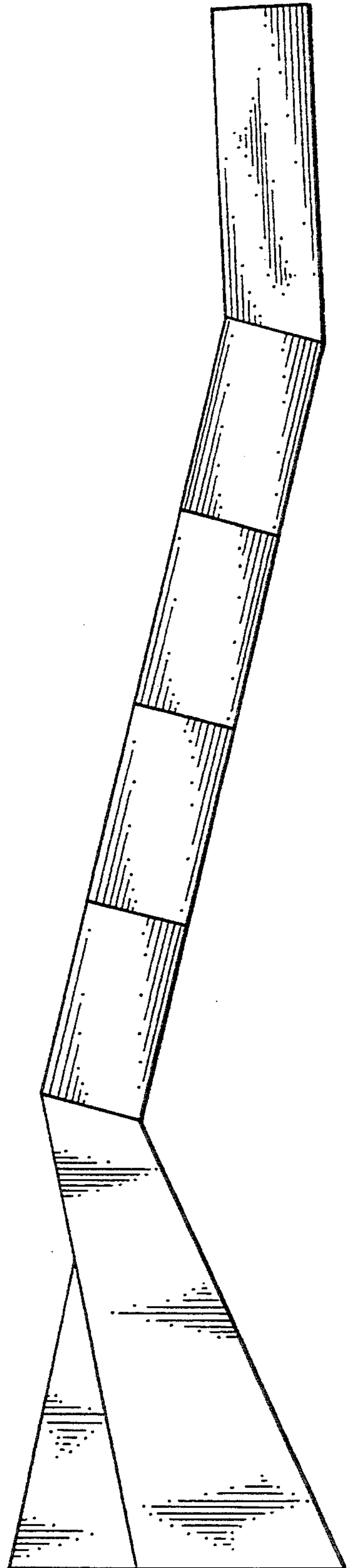

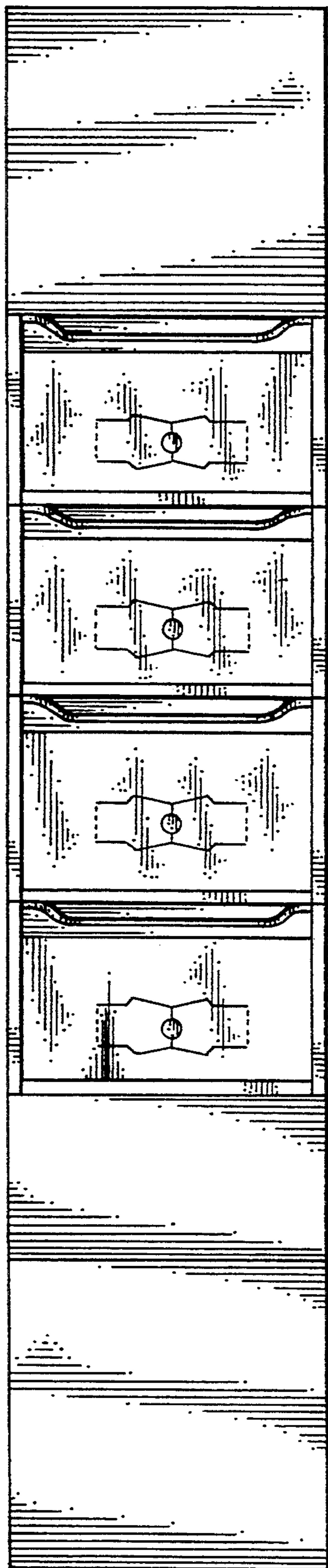

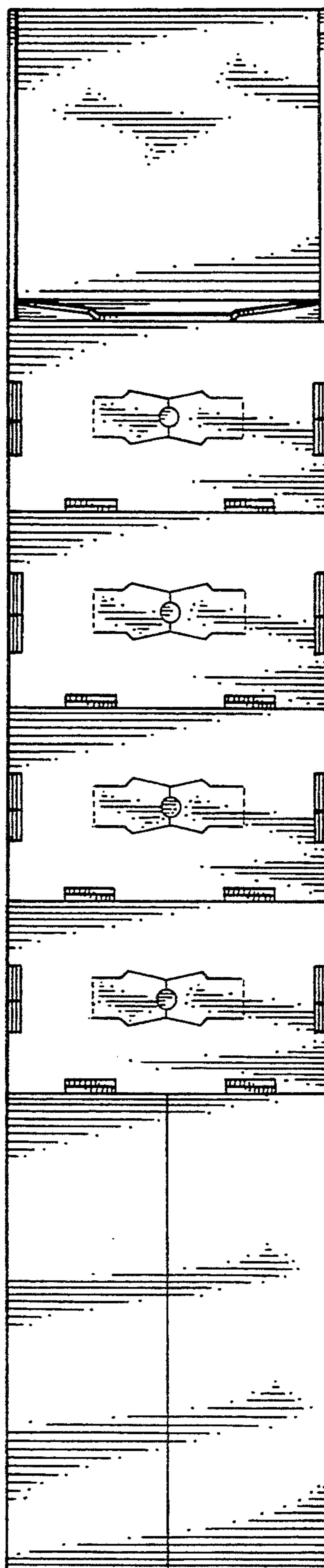

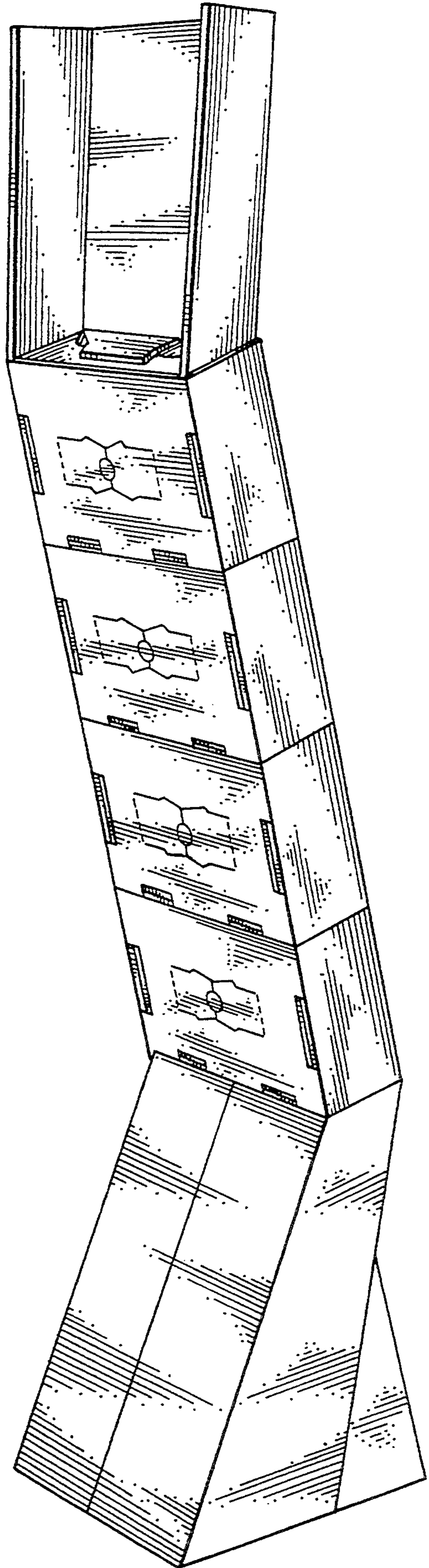

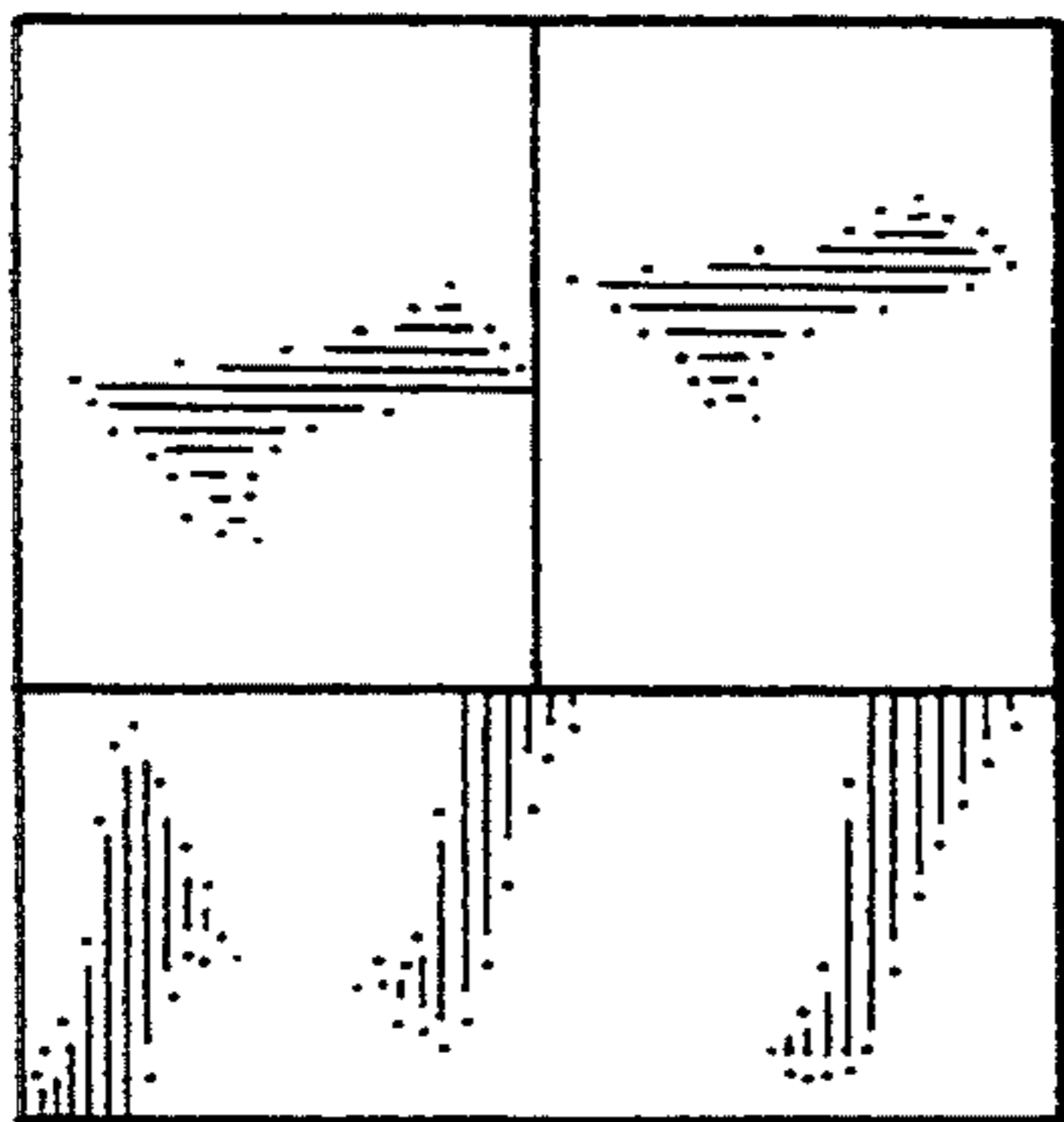
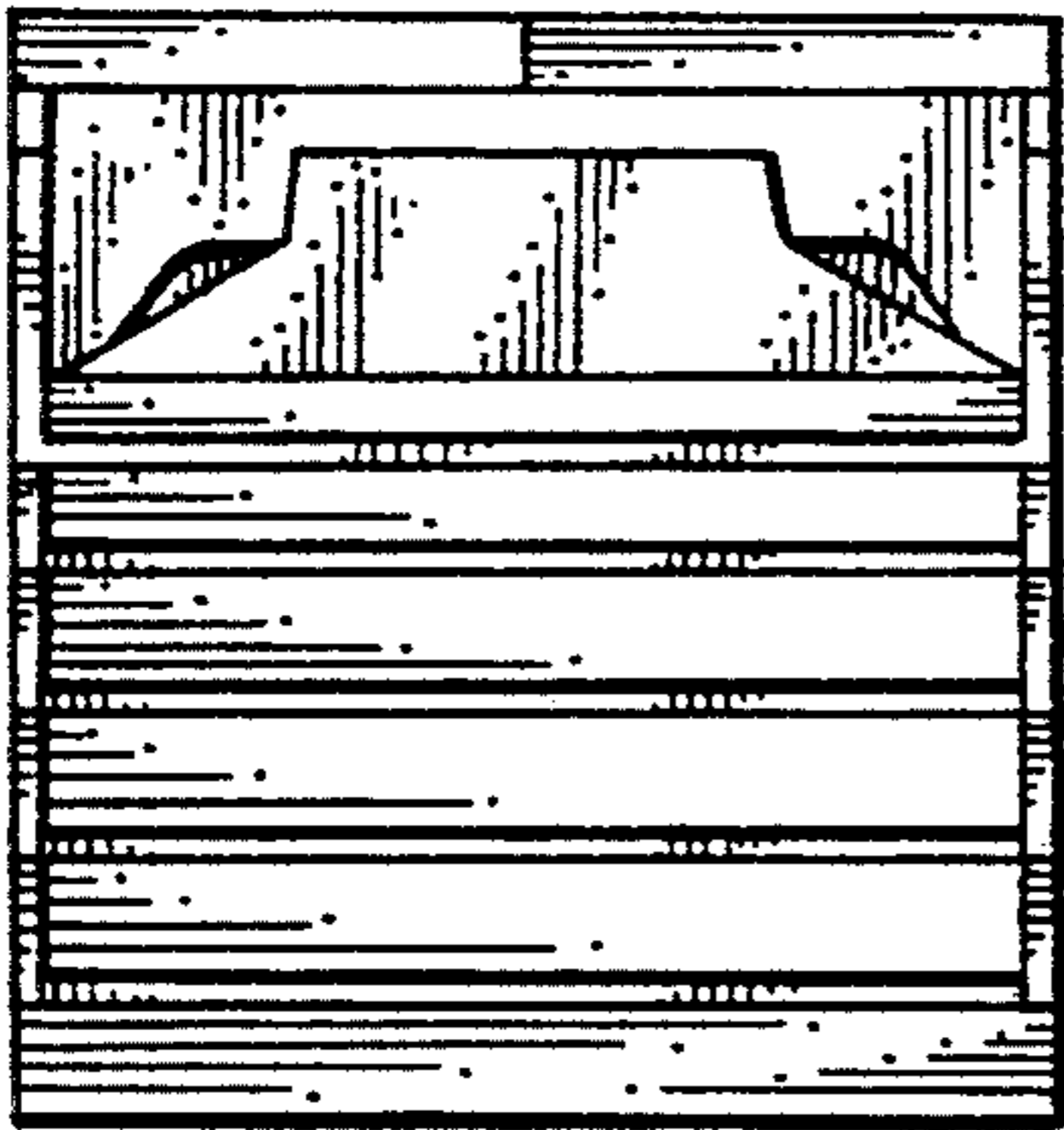
