FIG. 1 is a front, top and end perspective view of the combined beach mat and sunshade showing my new design;

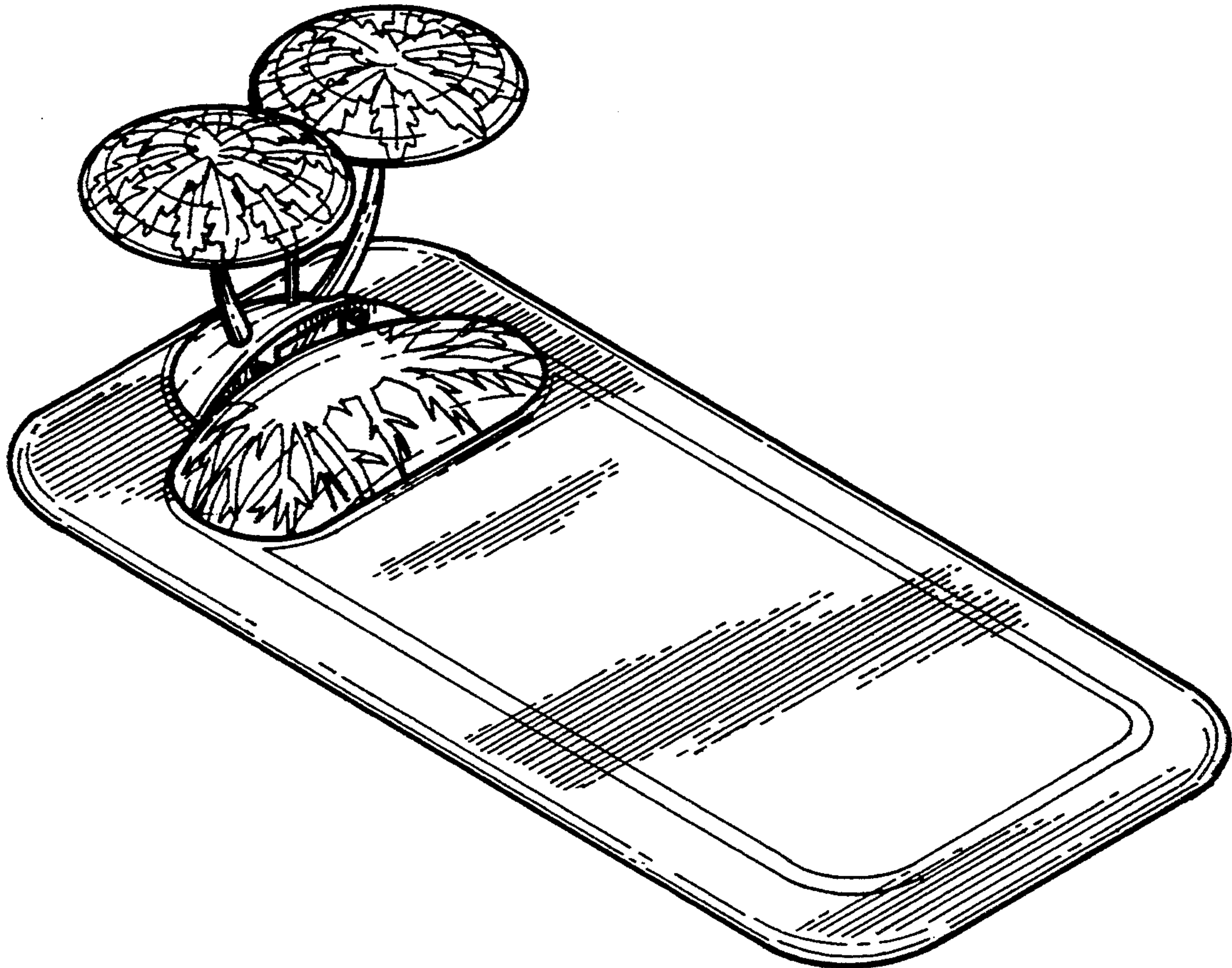
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



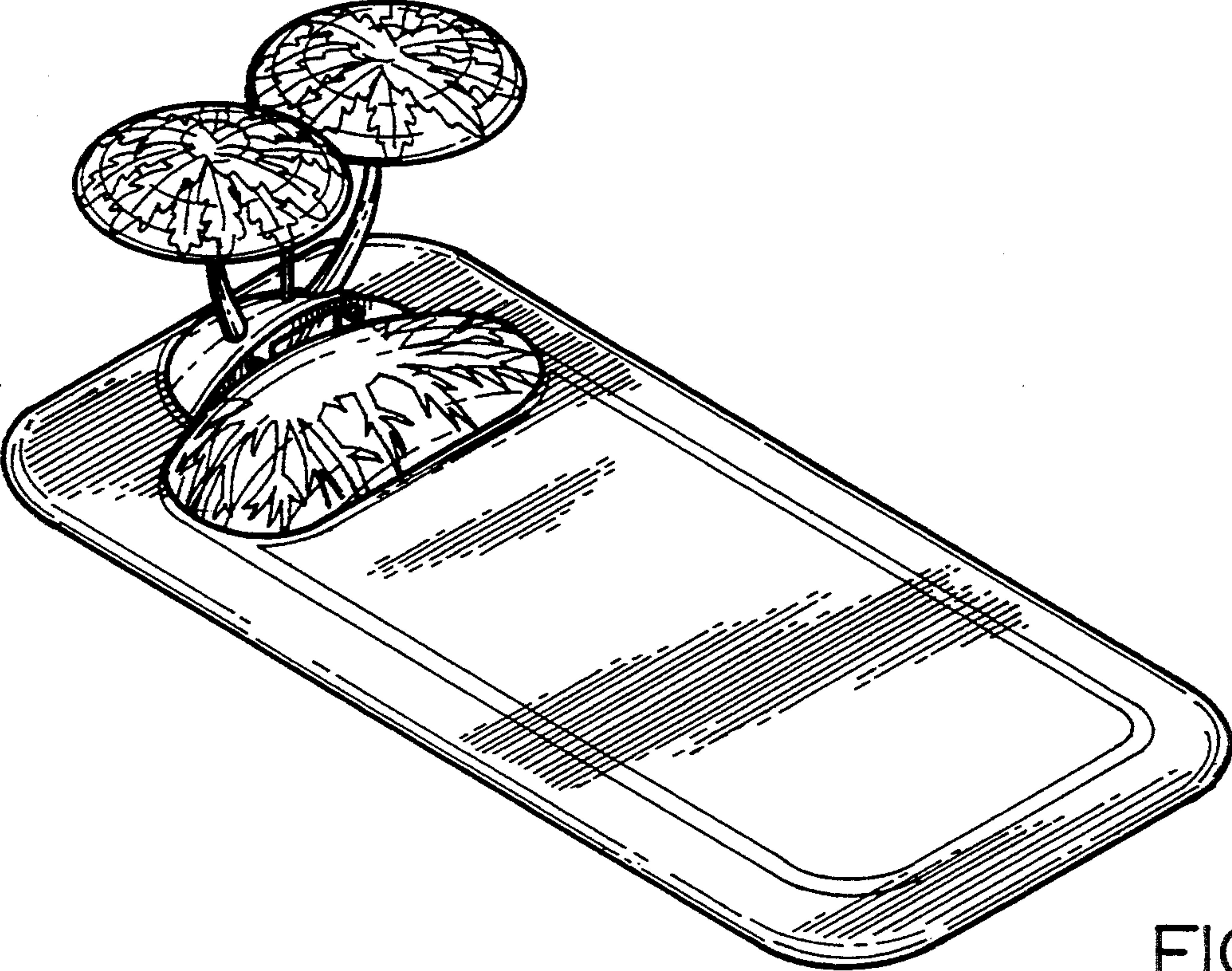

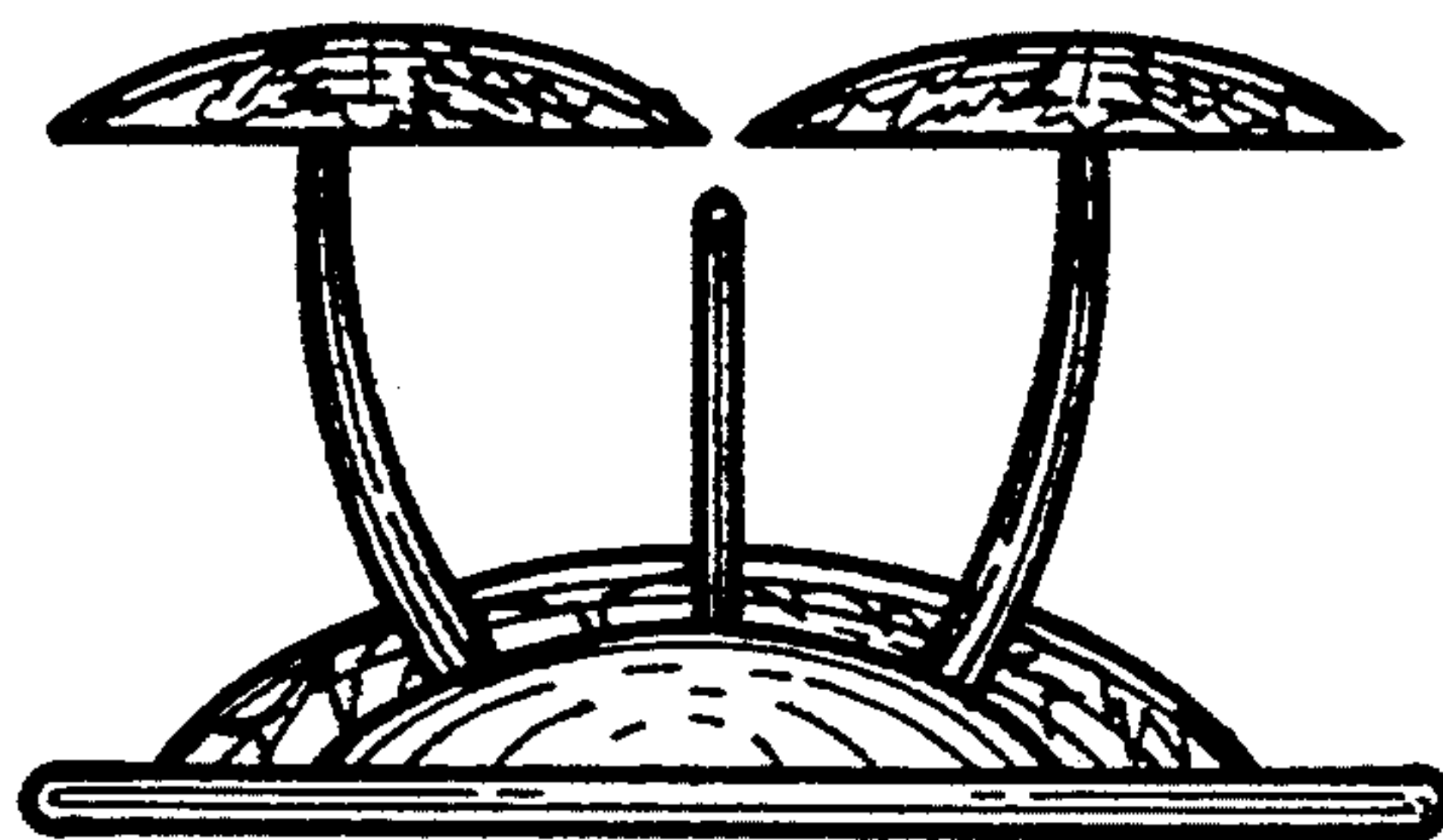

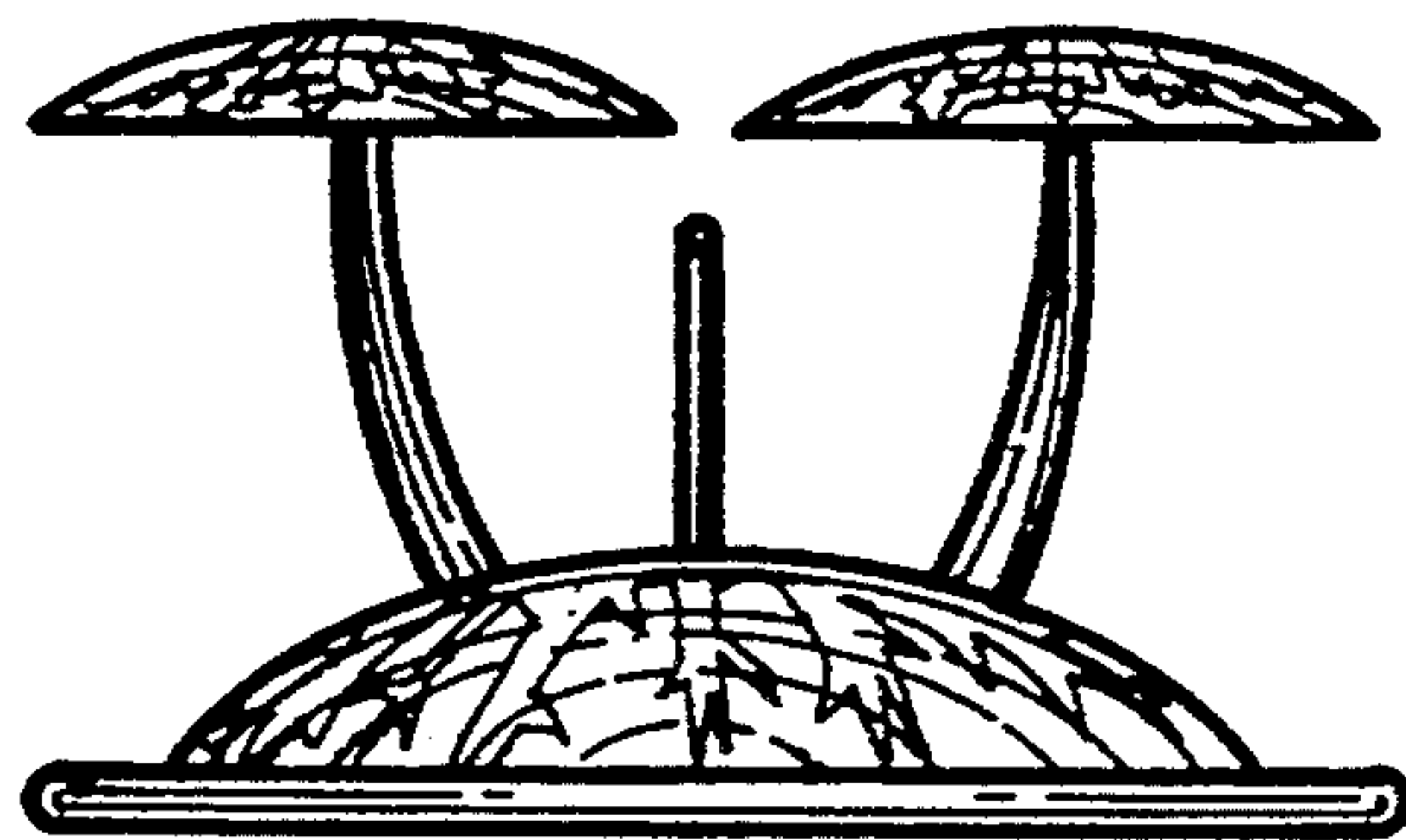

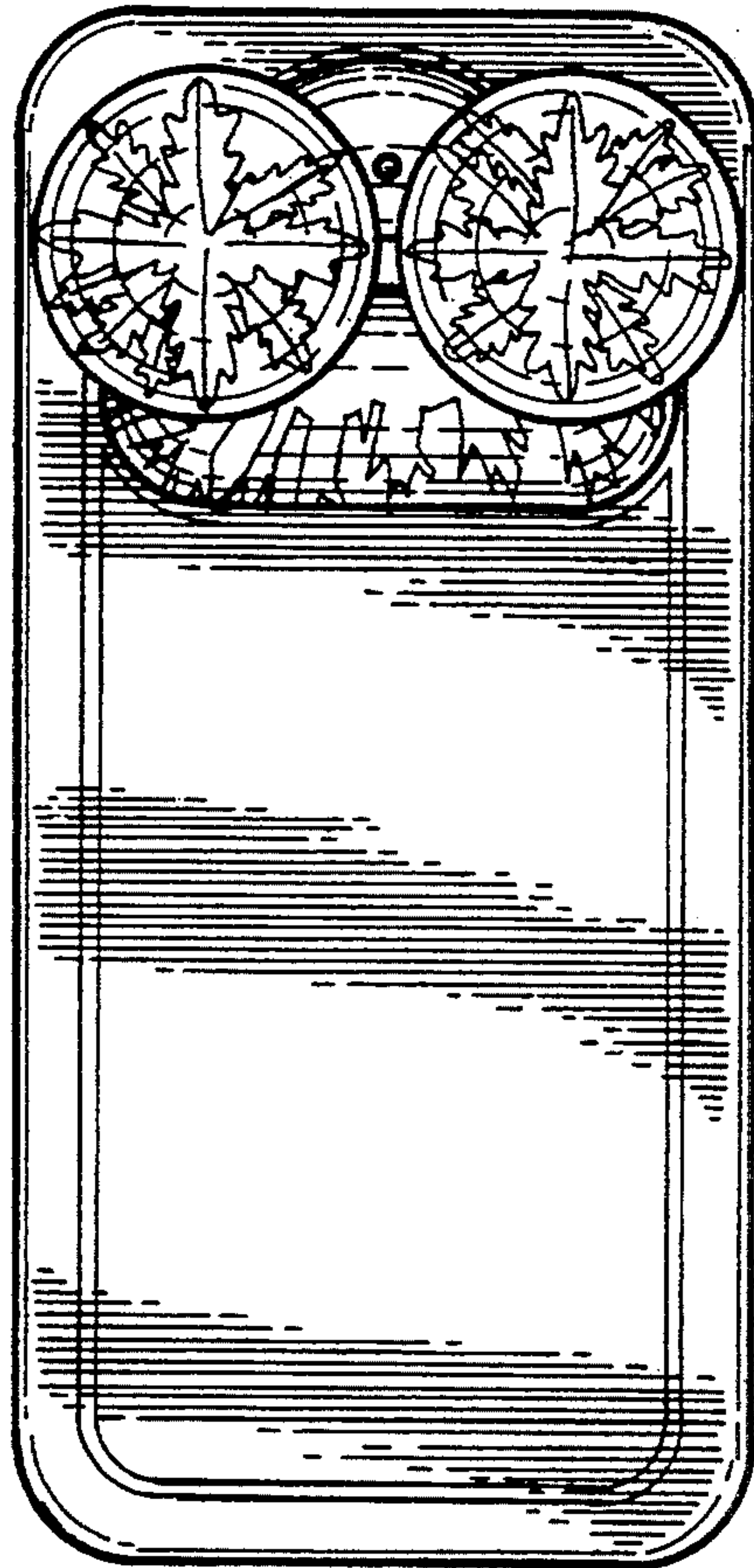

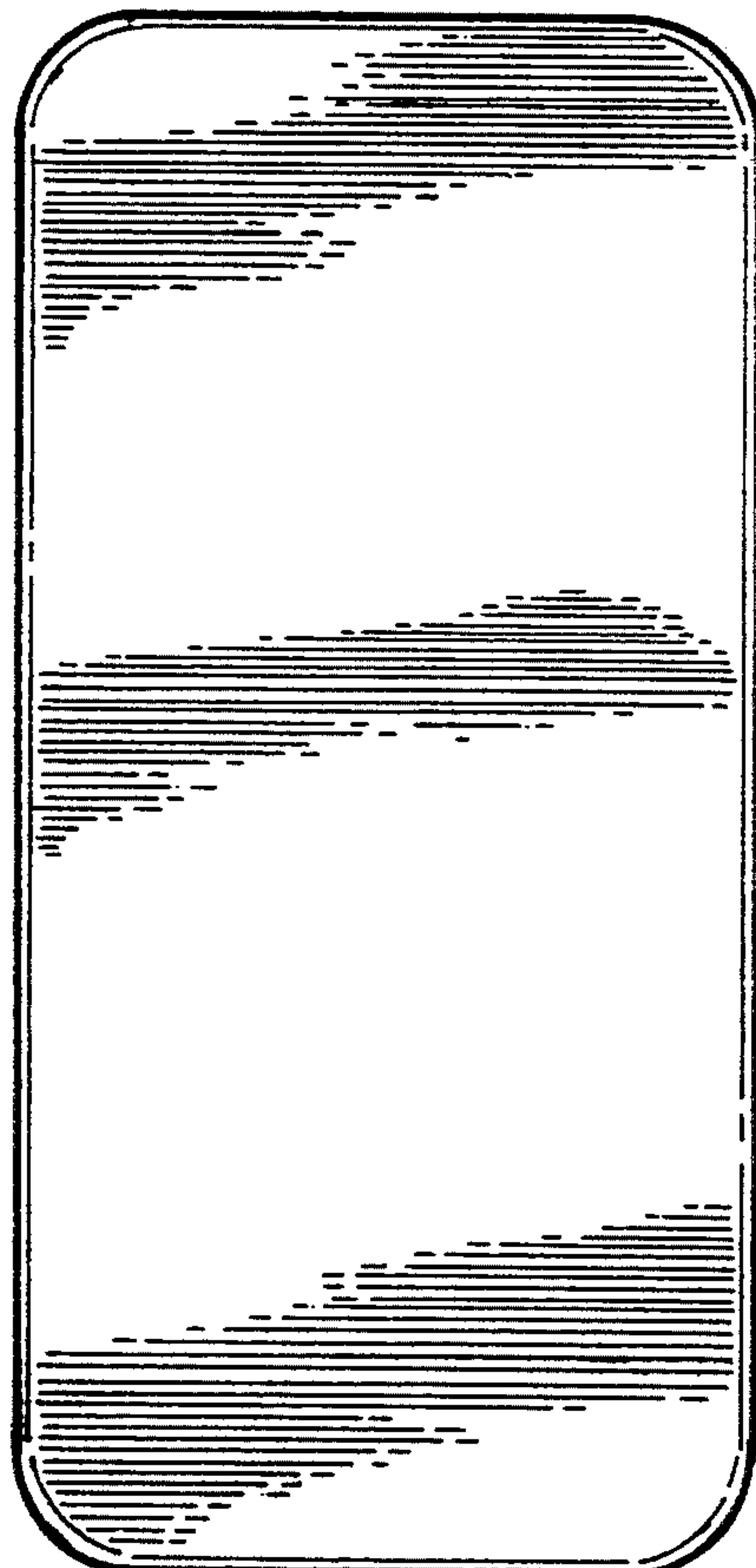
